GAME NOTES

UP NEXT: The Falcons will travel to Minneapolis, Minnesota, to take on the 20th-ranked Minnesota Golden Gophers, Sun., Dec. 2, with a tip-off time slated for 3:00 p.m. CT. Sunday's game will mark the third meeting between the programs.

AIR FORCE AT A GLANCE: Air Force is led by a pair of young guards in Kaelin Immel and Briana Autrey, who average 13.6 and 11.7 ppg, respectively. Immel is shooting .500 from downtown while Autrey shoots .526 from the field. Junior Kassady Huffman, who leads the team in rebounds (9.0 rpg) and blocks (14), averages 7.3 ppg in six starts this season. Sophomore guard Emily Conroe is on the cusp of averaging 10 ppg while averaging the second-most minutes on the court (27.5 min), only behind Immel who averages 28.8 minutes.

Autrey's freshmen teammates, Riley Snyder and Haley Jones, have already made significant contributions early in their career. Snyder has four double-digit scoring performances and averages 8.3 ppg-- she is the only freshman to have started in every contest this season. Jones averages 6.8 ppg and has been consistent on the boards (5.0 rpg), splitting her season total with 16 offensive and 14 defensive boards.

As a team, Air Force shoots .587 from the line, .397 from the field and .330 from the arc with an +5.2 scoring margin. The Falcons have out-rebounded opponents by 5.8 boards per game.

LAST TIME OUT: Air Force ignited for a 13-0 scoring run in the fourth quarter but came up short of mounting a comeback against an undefeated Northeastern team at home. The Falcons split the weekend on the road, 1-1, to even out at 3-3 this season. Northeastern improved to 5-0.

Shooting troubles and turnovers were the difference in the game as Air Force shot only 30.8 percent from the field while giving up a season-high 27 turnovers. Emily Conroe led the Falcons with 13 points while classmate Kaelin Immel scored nine while shooting 50 percent from the field. Senior team captain Venessannah Itugbu led the defensive effort with three blocks and four steals. Junior forward Kassady Huffman registered 10 rebounds and five points while shooting 3-4 from the free throw line.

BEAT ARMY--CHECK: Air Force outscored Army, 19-6, in the fourth quarter to surge past the Black Knights at home, Wednesday evening, in Christl Arena, West Point. The win marks the Falcons first against Army since beating them at home in 2007. **AIR FORCE NOTABLES VS. Army:**

- The last time Air Force beat Army by more than 11 points was in Dec., 2005, at USAFA (73-61)
- Air Force freshmen combined for 45 points-- Air Force underclassmen (Fr.-So.) combined for 64 points.
- Briana Autrey and Riley Snyder recorded season-high scoring marks
- Kaelin Immel and Snyder recorded their fourth double-digit scoring performances while Autrey had her second
- Venessannah Itugbu, who walked on as a freshman, is the first Air Force senior to enjoy a win over Army in over a decade

A RECORD DAY AGAINST FAIRLEIGH DICKINSON: Twelve Falcons scored 85 points to beat Fairleigh Dickinson, 85-37, in what became Air Force's largest margin of victory in the program's Division I era. The last time Air Force won by such a large margin was against San Diego State in the 2005-06 season where the Falcons beat the Aztecs, 74-45.

Junior forward Kassady Huffman led the squad with her second-straight double-double this season, scoring 10 points and snagging 11 rebounds on the night. Sophomore guard Emily Conroe shot over 50-percent from the field to lead the team with 16 points. Conroe also tallied seven rebounds, three steals and a block on the night.

LAST SEASON IN A NUTSHELL: Air Force's five wins in the 2017-18 conference slate are the most in the Mountain West era. The Falcons surpassed the previous mark of four wins, set in 2005-06 and 2007-08. Air Force's signature win came in the home regular season finale, a 57-47 win over then-first place Wyoming.

Air Force set a Div. I era record for fewest points allowed per game at 62.3. The Falcons 59.7 ppg allowed in MW play is also a new record. The Falcons held opponents below 60 points 11 times last season. Air Force ranked fourth in the MW in scoring defense and were first in steals and turnovers forced, second in turnover margin and fifth in blocked shots.

NORTHERN COLORADO AT A GLANCE: The Bears (3-2) are led by R-Sr. guard Savannah Smith who averages nearly 18 ppg, shooting .344 from the field, .333 from down range and .800 from the free throw line. Smith had a season-high 32-point performance against Colorado and most recently dropped 19 points against San Francisco. Smith is accompanied by Krystal Leger-Walker and Shalise Fernander who average 11 points apiece this season. Ali Meyer, a 6-1 R-Sr., averages 10 rebounds per game to lead the team.

As a team, UNC averages 64.2 ppg and shoots .411 from the field and .316 from the beyond the arc. The Bears average more than five rebounds per game than opponents faced. Air Force and UNC share a common opponent in Denver. The Bears beat Denver, 74-66, while the Falcons fell, 66-92.

UNC'S LAST TWO GAMES:

at Colorado State, W, 53-47

There was no quit in the Northern Colorado women's basketball team Tuesday night as they defeated Colorado State, 53-47, in comeback fashion. The Bears overcame a 13-point deficit early in the third quarter, storming back with lockdown defense. Micayla Isenbart led the way for the Bears offensively with a career-high 17 points.

While UNC closed the gap to seven by the end of the third quarter, the fourth quarter is when the team clamped down on defense to secure the win. The Bears held the Rams to one basket and just three points in the final quarter of play outscoring them, 16-3.

at San Francisco, W, 68-63

After a sluggish start UNC completed its second-straight double-digit comeback win Friday afternoon, defeating San Francisco 68-63. The Bears trailed by as much as 15 in the second quarter before storming back for the win.

Alexis Chapman and Savannah Smith led the way for UNC scoring with 19 each, while Ali Meyer had a monster game on the boards grabbing 17 rebounds in 24 minutes of play.

Against Colorado State on Tuesday, UNC dug themselves a 13-point hole, this time the Bears trailed by as much as 15. The comeback is tied for the second biggest in the program's Division I history.

LAST TIME THEY MET: Air Force dropped a 71-44 contest to Northern Colorado at Clune Arena. Dee Bennett led the Falcons with 14 points. Kassady Huffman had a team-high nine rebounds.

Northern Colorado had four players in double-figures scoring. Guard Savannah Scott led the Bears with 15 points and 10 rebounds. Air Force was out-rebounded by Northern Colorado 45-26.

Northern Colorado led 15-10 after the first quarter and 36-18 at half-time. The Falcons improved on their scoring in the second-half, with 12 points in the third quarter and 14 in the fourth.





MOUNTAIN WEST NOTES

IN THE WEEK AHEAD

- Boise State (5-1), are atop the Mountain West standings after defeating 2017 WNIT participants Idaho (91-85) and Northern Iowa (61-60) at the Long Beach Classic. This weekend, the Broncos will play in their first true road game of the season as they visit Washington State.
- On Wednesday, the Mountain West will have members participating in six contests. Notably, Fresno State will visit USC and Colorado State will visit Gonzaga for road contests. New Mexico will host Big 12 opponent Oklahoma and will look to improve its home record to 3-1.
- Mountain West fans will want to keep their eye on a pair of Sunday contests with San Diego State hosting Arizona (1 p.m. PT), while Air Force visits Minnesota (3 p.m. CT).

MW RANKINGS

- In the latest RPI rankings, Boise State leads the Mountain West at No. 41, while Utah State (62) and New Mexico (75) round out the top 100.
- In the Associated Press Top 25, Boise State received two votes, while New Mexico received one vote in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

NOTABLES

- New Mexico's **Aisia Robertson** was named the Mountain West Player of the Week after notching a triple-double in the Lobos double-overtime victory against Houston (89-84). Robertson's performance was the sixth triple-double in Division I hoops this season and the 17th in the history of the league. Robertson leads the nation in assists per game (10.0).
- The Wyoming Cowgirls are shooting well to start the 2018 season, ranking No. 7 nationally in 3-point field-goal percentage (43.5%), No. 22 in field-goal percentage (47.5%).
- Colorado State improved to 83-20 at Moby Arena under seventh-year head coach **Ryun Williams** this past weekend after defeating Cornell (56-53).
- Through five games, UNLV's **Katie Powell** is averaging 16 points per game, and in the final contest of the Lady Rebel Classic scored 22 points and grabbed six rebounds.

- The San José State women's basketball team had five players score in double figures, while shooting 54 percent from the floor, helping lead the Spartans to an 82-72 victory over CSU Bakersfield last weekend. SJSU's **Cyndi Lewis** is pacing the Spartans offense, averaging 10.0 points per game.

BY THE NUMBERS

- 3:** Three MW teams rank in the top 25 nationally in fewest turnovers: Colorado State (T-16th; 55), Fresno State (T-20th; 57) and Wyoming (22nd; 58).
- 14:** Nevada's **Jade Redmon** finished with a team-high 14 points against USC and was named to the Nugget Classic All-Tournament team following this past weekend. Redmon has scored in double figures in all five games this season.
- 64:** New Mexico's **Jaisa Nunn** is currently 14th in the nation in shooting percentage. The senior center, and Lisa Leslie Award Watch List Candidate, is shooting 64.6 percent from the field through four games.

20TH SEASON OF MOUNTAIN WEST WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

The 20th season of Mountain West women's basketball tipped off on Nov. 6. Led by the vision of then-Colorado State President Dr. Albert Yates, the Mountain West was formed when presidents of eight institutions - Air Force, BYU, Colorado State, New Mexico, San Diego State, UNLV, Utah and Wyoming - decided to form a new NCAA Division I-A intercollegiate athletic conference.

2018-19 MW WOMEN'S PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE/PREDICTED ORDER OF FINISH

The Mountain West announced its 2018-19 preseason women's basketball predicted order of finish and All-Conference team on Nov. 1. Boise State has been selected as the preseason favorite to win the league title for the second consecutive year after receiving 19 first-place votes and 229 total points. Broncos junior **Riley Lupfer** earned MW Preseason Player of the Year honors, while teammate **Jade Loville** was tabbed MW Preseason Freshman of the Year. Colorado State guard **Mollie Mounsey** is the MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year.

The MW's preseason predicted order of finish, all-conference team and individual honors were voted on by a panel of the Conference's 11 head coaches and select women's basketball media from around the league.

The Broncos, who finished the 2017-18 season with a 23-10 record and a 14-4 MW mark en route to a regular and postseason Conference championship, finished just 21 points ahead of UNLV. The Lady Rebels earned 208 points and the remaining four first-place votes. Fresno State placed third in the poll with 175 points, while Wyoming (158) and New Mexico (150) round out the top 5.

HEAD COACH

(USC, 1977)

FOURTH SEASON AT AIR FORCE
39TH SEASON AS A HEAD COACH

Chris Gobrecht enters her fourth season as women's basketball coach at the Air Force Academy in 2018-19. With a track record of 38 years of head coaching experience, Gobrecht was entrusted by the previous Air Force Director of Athletics, Jim Knowlton, to lay the foundation and build the program to reach new heights.

In May 2018, Gobrecht signed a five-year contract extension with Air Force athletics under director Col. Jennifer Block, extending her service as head coach through the 2022-23 season. Gobrecht was originally hired on April 14, 2015 and was the first hire of then-Air Force Director of Athletics Jim Knowlton. Gobrecht came to the Academy from Yale, where she served as head coach from 2005-15.

A proven winner and program builder, Gobrecht has coached at programs in the Pac-12 and Atlantic Coast Conference. During her 10 seasons at Yale she restored the program's status as one of the premier women's basketball programs in the Ivy League. Gobrecht has 36 years of head coaching experience, all at the Division I level, and has a career record of 553-552 (.500) which ranks among the nation's top 30 active coaches. Gobrecht is the winningest coach all-time for two schools, Washington and Yale.

"I'm thrilled to bring Chris Gobrecht to the Academy to lead our women's basketball program," Knowlton said. "She is a proven winner and has turned around every program she's led and done it the right way. To get someone of her caliber to the Academy makes me very excited about the future of the program."

"After meeting with Chris during her visit to the Academy, I know our women's basketball program will be in great hands," said USAFA's 19th Superintendent, Lt. Gen. Michelle Johnson. "Chris embodies the values our Academy stands for and her passion for leading young people is unmistakable."

"It is hard to put into words what the opportunity to build the women's basketball program at the Air Force Academy means to me and my family," Gobrecht said. "I am honored to be asked to lead the outstanding young women who make the choice to prepare themselves for service to their country as officers in the Air Force, and I am dedicated to their experience on the court producing success in competition as well as contributing greatly to their accomplishments towards the overall mission of the Academy."

Through her first two seasons, Gobrecht has laid the groundwork towards building the program towards new heights. In the 2016-17 season, Air Force doubled its win total from the previous season. The Falcons improved in scoring, rebounding, blocked shots and free throw percentage. Then-freshman Mariah Forde led the Mountain West freshmen in scoring, averaging 11.0 points per game.

In the 2017-18 campaign, Coach Gobrecht and the Falcons continued on the path to new heights as Air Force's five wins in conference became the most in the Mountain West era, surpassing the previous mark of four wins, set in 2005-06 and 2007-08. Air Force's signature win came in the regular season home finale, posting a 57-47 win over then-first place Wyoming. In addition to winning four of the last six games of the season, Air Force smashed five team records, highlighted by a staunch defense that only allowed 62.3 ppg in the regular season and 59.7 ppg in league action, setting new team records in each respective category. The Falcons held opponents below 60 points 11 times on the season, testament to the progression of the defense under Gobrecht and staff. Air Force's 2017-18 season also yielded six new individual school records including the program's first-ever Mountain West Freshman of the Year in Kaelin Immel, who set four program-records highlighted by the most-ever points scored by an Air Force freshman in the Div. I era.

Prior to coming to Air Force, Gobrecht built Yale's program up to become an annual contender for the Ivy League championship over her last six seasons. She coached the Bulldogs to 56 wins from 2012-14 which tied for the second-most wins in a four-year stretch and most since the class of 1980 won 57 games. Under Gobrecht's leadership, Yale has also recorded the top two marks for most Ivy League wins in a four-year span with 34 Ivy victories set by the Class of 2013 and 33 wins set by the Class of 2014.

During her tenure at Yale, Gobrecht coached 27 players that earned Ivy League postseason awards, including two Ivy League Rookies of the Year, five All-Ivy first team honorees, three All-Ivy second team honorees, six All-Ivy honorable mention players, five All-Ivy rookie team players and seven Ivy League academic team honorees. Prior to Gobrecht's arrival at the school, a Bulldog player had not earned All-Ivy League first team accolades since the 1997-98. Gobrecht has also coached two players who competed on the international level.

Yale posted its sixth straight top-four finish in the Ivy League standings in 2014-15 with a 7-7 mark in Ivy play, while posting an overall mark of 13-15. Gobrecht became just the second coach in program history to record 100 victories at Yale with a victory at Columbia on Jan. 31, 2014. She was 117-162 (.419) in her 10 seasons at the school.

The Bulldogs enjoyed their most successful season under Gobrecht's leadership in 2011-12, finishing with a 16-12 record and an 8-6 mark in Ivy League play in a season that included Yale's first-ever meeting with the nation's top-ranked team (No. 1 Baylor, Nov. 22, 2011). It was their winningest season since a 16-10 finish in 1993-94 and the third straight season with at least eight Ivy League victories. The season included several milestones, including Gobrecht's 500th career victory which happened on Feb. 10, 2012, against Cornell.

In 2010-11, Gobrecht guided the Bulldogs to their first-ever appearance in the Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT). The Bulldogs finished with a 14-15 overall record, which, until 2011-12, was Yale's highest win total since the 2001-02 season (14-13). Gobrecht coached the Bulldogs to the biggest win in program history, a 91-85 win over then-No. 14 Florida State. It was Yale's first win over a nationally ranked opponent in the program's 38-year history. She followed that historic victory by guiding the Bulldogs to a 10-4 finish in Ivy League play, which matched the most wins for Yale in League play (10-4, 1988-89). The 2010-11 Ivy League season included Yale's first sweep of Harvard since the 1993-94 season, which helped the Bulldogs finish in second place in the Ivy League standings for the first time since 1988-89, clinching the Ivy League's automatic berth in the WNT.

After posting a 3-24 mark in her first season with the Bulldogs, Gobrecht led the team to 12 wins in the 2006-07. The nine-win improvement was one of the best in Division I that season. The 2006-07 season was highlighted by a six-game winning streak and a 15-point victory over a Marist squad that would reach the Regional Semifinals (Sweet 16) of the NCAA Tournament. Yale was also the only Ivy League team to defeat league champion Harvard.

Though the 2008-09 team was hampered by a multitude of injuries, Gobrecht led her team to an 11-17 record and a landmark victory over North Carolina State, Yale's first win over an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent. Gobrecht also reached a milestone 450th career coaching win last season.

Prior to coaching at Yale, Gobrecht was the head coach at her alma mater, Southern California, where she posted a 93-108 record in seven seasons. She became the 33rd active coach to reach the 400-win mark during her time with the Women of Troy. She reached the milestone with a victory over Pepperdine on Dec. 4, 2002. Gobrecht took over a struggling Florida State program in 1996 for year, leading the school to a 5-22 record before going to USC.

Gobrecht coached the University of Washington from 1986-96. In 11 seasons at Washington, her teams went to the NCAA Tournament on nine occasions. The Huskies reached the NCAA Regional Semifinals four times during her tenure, and advanced to the Regional Finals (Elite Eight) in 1990. She won at least 16 games every year at Washington, including eight 20-win campaigns (six consecutive), and is the Huskies' all-time winningest coach with a 243-89 record. Washington won three conference championships and finished second four times during her tenure. A two-time Pac-10 Coach of the Year, Gobrecht led Washington to a school-record 28 wins and a number-three national ranking in 1989-90. The Huskies were the only team to beat eventual NCAA Champion Stanford that season. In lieu of her success with the Huskies, the University of Washington announced Gobrecht as one-of-seven individuals along with one team to be inducted into the Husky Hall of Fame in October 2018.

Gobrecht began her Division I coaching career with a struggling Cal State Fullerton program in 1979-80. She coached the Titans for six seasons, posting an 84-92 record. She led Cal State Fullerton to an 18-12 record in her third season on the job. In the 1984-85 season, Gobrecht's last with Cal State Fullerton, the Titans posted a 19-11 record and made their first appearance in the WNT, making her a finalist for national Coach of the Year honors.

She served as an assistant for a USA Basketball select team that played in Czechoslovakia and Italy in 1990. In addition, six of Gobrecht's former players have played professionally in the WNBA and ABL.

Her coaching career began in 1978 at Santa Fe Springs (Calif.) High School, where her team went 20-4 and made the CIF AAA playoffs. The next year, Gobrecht led Pasadena City College to a 25-5 record, a conference championship and second place in the state junior college tournament.

A Toledo, Ohio, native and a graduate of Huntington Beach (Calif.) High School, Gobrecht earned a bachelor's degree in public affairs from USC in 1977. Then known by her maiden name of Chris Geiger, she was a three-year starter for the Women of Troy from 1974-76 and also played two seasons of volleyball at USC. After graduation, she spent a year volunteering in the Peace Corps, where she worked as an English teacher at St. Mary's College in Apia, Western Samoa.

She and her husband, Bob, have two children, Eric and Madeline. Eric is a graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy and a graduate of the Air Force's flight school. A captain, he is a pilot stationed at Beale AFB, CA. In October 2011, Eric married Catherine Cheney, a 2010 graduate of Yale. Mady graduated from Yale in 2011 after four standout seasons on the women's basketball team. She married Greg Moviel, a 2007 graduate of Vanderbilt University, in 2015. Mady is currently a registered nurse serving at Memorial Hospital in Colorado Springs.
