NOTABLE:

- Air Force is looking for its first win at Viejas Arena since 2005 (17-straight wins by SDSU).
- Air Force enters game with 234 total games played on its roster, compared to 724 for SDSU.
- Air Force entered the season with 132 total games played and 48 starts made by its roster.
- 47.5 percent of the team scoring comes from the freshman class.
- Caleb Walker ranks 4th in the nation in field goal percentage at 71.8 percent shooting.
- Walker made 16 consecutive baskets across three games, the second longest streak in the nation.
- Freshman guard Kam Sanders set a school record for most consecutive free throws made in a game with 15 against South Dakota, breaking a 67-year old school record set back in 1958.
- Air Force has made a three in 500 straight games, dating back to 2009.

RECAPPING FIRST MEETING LAST SEASON - Jan. 8, 2025

Air Force men's basketball dropped a 67-38 contest at San Diego State (10-3, 3-1 MW) in Mountain West play on Wednesday night at Viejas Arena. Senior guard Ethan Taylor led the Falcons with 11 points.

In a wild first half, Air Force led by as many as 12, before a furious rally by San Diego that had the Falcons trailing 33-24 at the half.

Trailing by three early, the Falcons went on a 17-2 run to go up 20-8 with 11:01 to play. Air Force hit three three's during the run.

San Diego State then ratched up their defensive effort, going on a 12-0 run to tie the game up at 20-20 at the 5:45 mark. After the Falcons went back up with a bucket by Sam Duskin, SDSU went on a 10-0 run to go up 30-22. The teams traded buckets before the half ended.

The Aztecs opened the half with a 15-0 burst to put the game out of reach early in the second half. Air Force struggled with the defen-

sive pressure by San Diego State all night, committing 20 turnovers, which led to 24 points by the Aztecs. San Diego State also out-rebounded the Falcons 49-24 on the night, including a 24-2 advantage in offensive boards.

Guard Nick Boyd led three Aztecs in double figures with 16 points. Jared Coleman-Jones notched a double-double with 10 points and 14 rebounds.

Taylor was the lone Falcon in double figures. He made three three's and also led Air Force with five rebounds and three steals. Sophomore forward Luke Kearney scored nine points, going 4-for-4 from the line.

Air Force did block five shots, the most since the LIU game and one shy of the season high. Byron Brown led the Falcons with two blocked shots.

SECOND MEETING - Jan. 22, 2025

Air Force men's basketball dropped a 77-76 overtime contest to San Diego State (12-5, 5-3 MW) in Mountain West play Wednesday night at Clune Arena. Wayne McKinney III scored the game-winning basket as time expired in overtime to lift the Aztecs to the win.

The setback overshadowed a gritty performance by the Falcons, who clawed its way back from a double-digit deficit.

Trailing by one, center Wesley Celichowski tipped in a missed free throw with 4 seconds left to put Air Force ahead 76-75. On the ensuing play, McKinney took the inbounds pass & drove full court & was able to score on a layup as time expired.

Celichowski and senior Ethan Taylor com-

bined for 43 points to lead the Falcons. Celichowski went 8 for 8 from the field and tied a career-high with 22 points. Taylor scored 21 points, knocking down four three's and going 9 for 11 from the free throw line.

Sophomore Luke Kearney added 14 points, knocking down three three's. Freshman Kyle Marshall added 6 points and a career-high 11 rebounds.

Air Force went to the free throw line 44 times, making 30 free throws. The 44 free throw attempts set a program record for most free throws in a conference game, breaking the record of 42 set in 1994.

The 76 points was the most scored against SDSU since 2005.

A big run early by San Diego State put the Falcons down double-digits early. A 11-0 run by the Aztecs made it a 17-8 game. The Falcons came back and got to within 1 point with under 2 minutes in the half and would trail by 4 at 35-31 at the break.

The Aztecs got up by 10 with 14:33 in the second half, before the Falcons mounted their rally. Air Force responded with a 15-4 run to take the lead 53-52 at the 7:58 mark. The Falcons led by as many as four late, but the Aztecs went on a 6-2 run to close regulation to send the game to overtime.

Air Force shot 43 pct from the field & 40 pct from 3. The Falcons out-rebounded the Aztecs 39-37.

ETHAN TAYLOR A FIRST ROUND DRAFT PICK IN 2025 NBA G-LEAGUE DRAFT



2025 Air Force graduate Ethan Taylor was selected by the Greensboro Swarm, an affiliate of the Charlotte Hornets, in the first round of the 2025 NBA G-League Draft Saturday, Oct. 25, 2025. Taylor was selected with the ninth pick of the draft.

After the pick, Taylor was later traded to the Santa Cruz Warriors, the G-League affiliate of the Golden State Warriors. Taylor is attempting to become the first Air Force grad to play in the NBA.

Taylor is a 2025 Air Force Academy graduate and four-year letterwinner for the men's basketball program. As a senior, Taylor led the Falcons with 13.9 points per game, 5.4 rebounds and 3.5 assists for the Falcons, earning All-Mountain West honors. Taylor led the Mountain West with 98 three's made in 2024-25, which is the second-most in program history.

Taylor ranks 10th all-time in scoring at Air Force with 1,324 career points. He ranks first all-time at the Academy with 121 starts and his 256 career three's is second. He is the only player in program history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 300 assists.

Taylor most recently played in the 2025 NBA Summer League with the Los Angeles Lakers. The Houston, Texas, native appeared in five games for the Lakers, tallying 21 points and shooting 53.8 percent from three-point range. In his final game of the summer, Taylor erupted for 15 points against the Denver Nuggets. He shot 5-of-8 from three point range in the game, adding five rebounds, five assists and two steals.

Head Coach Joe Scott



Joe Scott enters year six of his second stint as head men's basketball coach at Air Force for the 2025-26 season.

Scott, who led the Air Force men's basketball program from 2001-04 to unprecedented heights, returns to the Academy to once again to lead

the program, announced on March 31, 2020, by Director of Athletics Nathan Pine.

A veteran of 34 years in the coaching ranks and 21 as a head coach, Scott returned to the Academy in 2020-21 after spending the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at Georgia. During his time at Georgia, Scott worked with freshman guard Anthony Edwards, who went on to become the top selection in the 2020 NBA Draft by the Minnesota Timberwolves.

Scott, who in 2013 was tabbed one of the nation's top-20 "Xs & Os" coaches in a survey of his peers by ESPN's Jeff Goodman, was also head coach at Princeton, his alma mater, for three campaigns and Denver for nine seasons.

Scott first came to the Academy in 2001, taking over a program that had not had a winning season in 22 years and led it to new levels of success. In just four seasons he led the Falcons to their only Mountain West regular season title, first NCAA tournament appearance in 42 years, a top 25 national ranking and a then-school-record 22 wins. He was named MW coach of the year, National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) coach of the year and finished fourth in the balloting for Associated Press national coach of the year in 2004. Scott compiled a 22-4 (.846) record at home over his final two seasons, including a 3-0 mark in 2003-04. Attendance surged by more than 300

percent during his time leading the Falcons.

Scott was the head coach at Princeton from 2004-07. The Tigers finished first nationally in scoring defense in 2006-07 after being second in Scott's first two seasons.

From 2007-16, Scott was head coach at Denver where he inherited a program that was 4-25 and ranked 335th (of 336) in the NCAA RPI prior to his arrival. He led the program to a school-record 22 Division I victories in 2012 and 2013. In 2012, Scott was a finalist for the Hugh Durham Award as the nation's top mid-major head coach. In 2013, Denver shared the WAC regular-season title, earned a National Invitational Tournament (NIT) bid and secured its first postseason win ever. Within his first five years, Denver was a top 100 RPI team and a top 65 RPI team at the end of his sixth season. Denver was 75-15 (.833) at home over a six year stretch, including a 15-game home winning streak which tied as the ninth longest in the nation entering 2010-11. Denver also had the fifth largest attendance increase in the country in 2011-12.

Not afraid of difficult situations and rebuilding programs, Scott has a 235-240 career record in 16 seasons as a head coach while recruiting and coaching 29 all-league players (10 in the Mountain West, four in the Ivy League, six in the Western Athletic Conference, five in the Sun Belt and four in the Summit). His teams have been known for playing with tenacity, tempo and collective toughness. His teams showed continued improvement and developed a culture of winning.

Before breaking into the head coaching ranks, Scott was an assistant coach at Monmouth and at Princeton. While at Princeton, Scott helped the Tigers to five consecutive postseason appearances, with trips to the 1996, 1997 and 1998 NAAs and the 1999 and 2000 NITs. The Tigers won three Ivy League titles from 1996-98, including perfect 14-0 records in the final two seasons. Princeton upset defending national champion UCLA in the 1996 NCAA Tour-

namment and ranked as high as No. 7 nationally in 1998 en route to earning a No. 5 NCAA seed, the highest ever for an Ivy League team.

Scott spent two seasons on Bill Carmody's staff at Holy Cross. Carmody was an assistant coach at Princeton when Scott was a four-year letterwinner from 1983-87. Scott also served as an assistant coach along with Carmody under Pete Carril from 1992-96.

Scott was a three-year starter and two-time All-Ivy selection at point guard at Princeton. As a freshman, he helped the Tigers win the Ivy League title and reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Scott led Princeton in steals as a sophomore, junior and senior and still ranks No. 7 among the Tigers' career leaders with 144. Scott connected on what was then a school-record 59 3-pointers as a senior. He scored 809 points in 99 career outings which is an 8.2 career scoring average.

Scott earned his bachelor's degree in history from Princeton in 1987 and then secured his law degree from Notre Dame in 1990. He worked for the Morristown, N.J., law firm of Ribis, Graham & Curtin before beginning his coaching career.

A native of Pelican Island, N.J., Scott was a three-sport prep star (basketball, football and baseball) at Toms River East High. He has been inducted into four halls of fame – the Tom Rivers Schools Athletic Hall in 2004, both the NJSIAA and the Toms River Regional Schools Halls in 2005 and the Jersey Shore Sports Hall in 2013.

Scott is married to the former Leah Spraragen, a 1992 Princeton graduate who was a four-year starter at point guard for the Tigers and was an assistant coach at Princeton, Dartmouth and Arizona State. The Scotts have two sons, Ben and Jack. Jack is a senior at Duke, and is a member of the men's basketball team.
