#### All-Time Versus the Black Knights:

Air Force has played 21 total games against Army and sits at an all-time record of 9-10-2, extending back to the first matchup between the two programs in 1992, a road loss for the Falcons, 2-1. The most recent meeting between the programs was a 4-3 Black Knights win at Cadet Soccer Stadium on September 13, 2024. Out of the last five matches, Air Force has won three, with a pair of shutouts.

#### Last Time Out:

During their first outing on the road, Air Force dropped to Colorado, 4-1, on Sunday August 17.

Across fulltime, the Falcons saw one goal from senior **Peyton Ferrell**, totaled 15 shots with eight on goal, accompanied by a trio of saves from veteran goalkeeper **Kylie McElroy**. **Caeli Sherman** and **Kendall Rippley** each recorded a pair of shots on goal.

At the start of the first half, the Falcons found themselves even with the Buffs, seeing four shots on goal but could not break through. Air Force defenders held strong pressure over Colorado until the 15th minute when the Buffs shot off the goalpost, surprising **McElroy** in goal and taking the lead. An accidental trip in the box gave CU the chance to capitalize off a penalty kick that hit left into the goal, opposite **McElroy's** lean for a 2-0 advantage at 26'.

Colorado came out of the locker room ready to go after halftime, scoring their third goal off a corner kick with a sneak, past McElroy. At 64', **Lauren Steinlage** crossed the ball from the right side for an assist as she set up **Ferrell** for a perfect finish into the back of the net, scoring Air Force's sole

goal of the match. Following four more Falcon shots, the goal momentum fell, and CU finished with a late header to score the final goal of the afternoon in the 85'.

**Experienced Falcons:**

**Caeli Sherman, Addie Doyle, Chase Borntreger, and Kendall Rippley** are leading the attacking efforts with four shots apiece; Sherman and Rippley put three on goal.

Defensively, **Annika Jost, Jordan Dillingham, Raine Komata, and Samantha Sharp** have been applying the pressure on the backline.

**In Goal:**

The Falcons have started two different goalkeepers, **Trishelle Lopez** and **Kylie McElroy**. Against DU, freshman Lopez made her collegiate debut with a pair of saves for a .500 save percentage. The Cape Coral, Fla., native posted a strong first outing as a Falcon. Familiar face, McElroy took the start and played fulltime at Colorado, logging three saves in return to the goal.

**Captain Ferrell:**

**Peyton Ferrell** is a seasoned veteran on the pitch for the Falcons, as she is a three-year starter and has compiled 2,727 minutes of play over the course of her career. So far this season, the midfielder marks a strong line of one shot, one goal and remains one of the most consistent and efficient athletes on the pitch for the Falcons, as expressed by head coach Laura Busby. For her efforts to score the only goal against Colorado, Ferrell was named the Academy's Cadet-Athlete of the Week.

**Collegiate Debuts:**

Air Force saw eight newcomers take the pitch for the first time in their collegiate careers against DU. Cape Coral, Fla., native, **Trishelle Lopez**, earned her first start in goal and played fulltime with a pair of clutch saves in the first half of the match. **Melissa Araujo, AJ Heap, and Ellie McCarron** recorded shots in their first appearance for Air Force. **Zahra Friess, Nai'a Garana, Sammi Kinoshita, and Nalei Shannon** also saw playing time.

**Preseason Power:**

On August 4th, the Falcons participated in a neutral exhibition game against Montana in Columbia Falls, Mont. Air Force managed to defeat the reigning Big Sky champions, 1-0, after **Reagan Wilson** scored the game winner off a corner kick from **Ava Ortiz**. The exhibition match consisted of three 30 minute periods and every Falcon who was fit to play saw the field. Because of basic cadet training requirements, the freshmen only completed one training session with the entire women's soccer team, so they were used conservatively in the exhibition.

The upperclassmen displayed strong experience across the backline and defended well to secure the shut out.

In the second period, newcomer **Sammi Kinoshita** hit the post for the best chance, while **Maddy Walsh** recorded a shot that was cleared off the line. Freshman, **Trishelle Lopez** made her debut in goal during the same period.

**Zahra Friess**, a freshman forward, created a third period scoring opportunity, but narrowly missed the goal.

While in Montana, the team had the opportunity to visit Glacier National Park, spend time at the lake, and volunteer with the

**2024 Recap:**

The Falcons concluded the fall season of 2024 with an overall record of 5-10-3 and a 1-8-2 Mountain West record.

Air Force saw victories over non-conference opponents Northern Colorado, California Baptist, Hawaii, Northern Arizona, with a single league win against Nevada.

Air Force recorded four of their wins at Cadet Soccer Stadium, leaning into home field advantage and opened 2024 with a three-game win streak, the best start since 2019.

The team collected 19 goals with 13 assists for 51 total points, led by **Annika Jost** and **Kendall Rippley** who had three goals, two assists, and eight points each. The Falcons notched five game winners and 116 shots on goal.

In goal, the pair of goalkeepers logged 67 saves and **Kylie McElroy** marked six shut outs across the season.

**Fresh Faces:**

Air Force welcomes 11 freshmen to the squad. The new additions consist of two goalkeepers: **Trishelle Lopez** and **Sydney Nelms**; four midfielders: **Melissa Araujo**, **AJ Heap**, **Sammi Kinoshita**, **Nalei Shannon**, and **Nai'a Garana**; three defenders: **Ayla Janssen**, **Ella Johnson**, and **Ellie McCarron**; along with one forward: **Zahra Friess**.

The class of 2029 enters with strong experience and numerous accolades from high school and club soccer careers.

**Welcome Back:**

A strong 21 Falcons are returning from the 2024 season, providing experience and healthy leadership.

Seniors, **Peyton Ferrell**, **Raine Komata**, and **Samantha Sharp** will serve as the 2025 captains. #14 **Ferrell**, has played a vital midfield role and started all 37 games she has played, scored a pair of goals and marked one assist for five points in 2,614 minutes on the pitch. Defender, **Komata**, has logged 2,474 minutes on defense and collected six points off a pair of goals and assists across 45 matches. **Sharp** is a defender who has collected three points off one goal and one assist in 1,025 minutes of play, from 29 appearances and nine starts.

The rest of the leadership council is made up of **Addie Doyle** and **Annika Jost**. #13 **Doyle**, acts as a forward and midfielder, accounting for three goals and two assists across 36 total appearances and 1,788 minutes. C3C **Jost**, started 10 games out of 17 appearances during her freshman campaign for the Falcons, tallying eight points off three goals and two assists.

**A Look at Army:**

The Black Knights are coming off a 4-1 win over Manhattan. As a team, Army totaled 14 shots with seven on goal during their second match of the season. Forward, Sophia Henry was responsible for a pair of goals two minutes

apart in the first half. The goalkeeper logged one save in fulltime. In 2024, Army went 12-6-1 overall with a Patriot League record of 5-3-1.

### LIFE AT THE ACADEMY

#### **NOMINATIONS**

Nominations to the Academy may be obtained through a congressional sponsor or by meeting eligibility criteria in other categories of competition established by law.

#### **FRESHMEN**

All new cadets begin with six weeks of basic cadet training (BCT) in their first summer prior to classes.

#### **SUMMER TRAINING**

Summer training for cadets is divided into three, three-week training periods. There are a variety of programs available, and each cadet is required to complete two training periods each summer with leave during the other period.

Combat survival training (CST) is a required threeweek program during cadets' second summer. For other second-summer training periods, cadets have options such as working with young airmen in an operational unit at an Air Force installation, airborne parachute training, soaring or basic free-fall parachute training.

During their last two summers, all cadets are offered leadership training as supervisors or instructors in summer programs, such as basic cadet training, survival training, freefall parachuting and soaring.

#### **GRADUATION**

Each cadet graduates with a bachelor of science degree and a commission as a second lieutenant in the Air Force.

#### **MILITARY COMMITMENT**

Although it depends on your job, basic service requirement is five years after graduation. All graduates begin their military career as 2nd Lieutenants.

#### **FLYING**

Basic pilot and UAV Pilot (Drones) service requirement is 10 years. Pilots must undergo undergraduate pilot training (UPT) prior to actual service time for 1-4 years depending on aircraft (transport, fighter, etc.).

#### **SQUADRON JOBS:**

In order to prepare for life as an officer, the Cadet Wing at the United States Air Force Academy simulates the organization of an operational Air Force wing. Cadets are responsible for running and operating the wing – an unparalleled leadership opportunity to understand the importance of respect amongst peers and how to be an honorable, well-balanced officer. All cadets learn how to use a chain of command, how to function as part of various military formations and how military units organize to accomplish collective tasks. The Cadet Wing's 4,000 members are organized into four groups of 10 squadrons each. Cadets live, eat and take part in military training with their squadrons.
