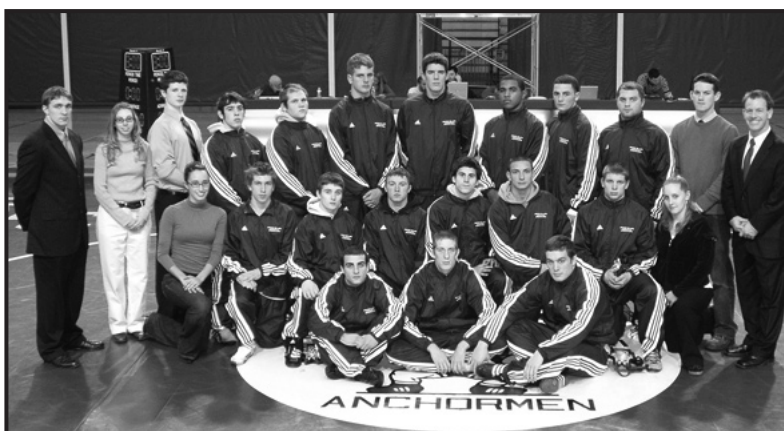

Meet the Head Coach

Head Coach Jay Jones



Jay Jones enters his ninth season as Rhode Island College's head wrestling coach. He also serves on the Executive Committee for the NCAA Div. III Wrestling Coaches Association.

In 2006-07, Jones earned his 100th career victory, only the second coach in program history to reach the century mark. The Anchormen were ranked as high as fifth in New England, highlighted by an outstanding NECCWA Duals Tournament which saw RIC down perennial N.E. power Springfield (34-15) and impressively shut out Norwich (36 - (-)1) and Williams (44-0), going 3-1 on the day.

In 2005-06, Jones led RIC to a 14-11 overall record, a 10-6 mark in the New England College Conference Wrestling Association (NECCWA) and a 4-2 record in the Pilgrim Wrestling League. The Anchormen had two wrestlers attain All-New England status.

In 2004-05, he led the nationally-ranked Anchormen to a 16-3 overall record and was 11-1 in the NECCWA. At the NECCWA Championships the Anchormen took home third place. It was the highest finish for the RIC grapplers since the 1992-93 squad also placed third. In addition, RIC had seven wrestlers earn All-New England status.

In the past eight years, Jones has coached one All-American, 30 All-New England wrestlers, three New England Champions, five national qualifiers and five Academic All-Americans. He has also led the Anchormen to two Pilgrim League Championships in 2002-03 and 2003-04.

In 2003, Jones was named the Rhode Island Man of the Year by *Wrestling USA Magazine*, earning the award for taking RIC wrestling from the bottom to the top, achieving the program's first national ranking since 1994. He was also named the NECCWA's Rookie Coach of the Year in '99-00 when he inherited a team that was 0-13 overall and finished 14th in New England in 1998-99.

Prior to coming to RIC, Jones was the Head Wrestling Coach at Barrington High School in 1997-98 and 1998-99. The team placed eighth at the State Championships, tying a school record, in '98-99. Before taking the Head Coach's position, Jones was an Assistant Coach at BHS from 1992-95 and again in 1996-97. During his seven-year stint at Barrington High School, he coached a total of four State Champions, four New England place-finishers and one New England Champion. The team won several league championships and BHS placed fifth at the New England High School Championships in 1997.

He graduated from Rhode Island College with a bachelor of arts degree in communications in 1994. He earned an additional bachelor's degree in secondary education from RIC, graduating magna cum laude with honors in teaching, in 1999.

While an undergraduate at RIC, Jones was a four-year letterwinner for the Anchormen as a wrestler from 1988-92. He was a member of four straight New England College Conference Wrestling Association (NECCWA) Championship squads at RIC between 1989-1992. Jones also played four years on the RIC baseball team as a second baseman.

In addition to his coaching duties, Jones is an English teacher at Cranston High School West. He is also the quarterbacks coach at Bryant University.

Jones is the proud father of a 12-year old daughter, Haley.



Meet the Assistant Coaches

Assistant Coach Dave Paquette



Dave Paquette enters his second season as an assistant wrestling coach at Rhode Island College. He assists Head Coach Jay Jones with all phases of the RIC wrestling program including recruiting, scouting, administering practices and match coaching. He also coordinates academic progress for the team.

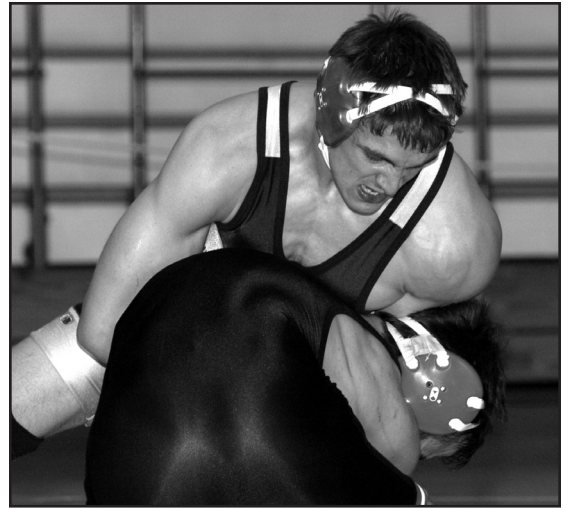
A two-year standout for the Anchormen, Paquette excelled on and off the mat. He played a key role as Rhode Island College captured the 2003-04 Pilgrim League title with a perfect 6-0 mark. In 56 matches, Paquette compiled an individual record of 33-23 (.589) and 132 points, including 97 takedowns, 23 reversals, 14 near-falls and five pins.

In his senior campaign in 2004-05, he solidified the middle of the lineup with a 21-13 record at 157 lbs. Paquette recorded a career-high in points (79), takedowns (69), and reversals (14). The 2004-05 All-New England grappler placed sixth at the New England College Conference Wrestling Association (NECCWA) Championships.

For his efforts in the classroom, Paquette was named to the 2004-05 NCAA Division III Wrestling Coaches Association Scholar All-American squad. He earned a bachelor's degree in computer information systems from Rhode Island College in 2006.

Prior to joining Rhode Island College, Paquette grappled two seasons at Johnson & Wales, registering an individual record of 31-31.

A native of Ledyard, Connecticut, Paquette is currently an account manager with Access TCA. He resides in Norwich, Connecticut with his fiancée' Rebecca Congdon.



Assistant Coach Bob Smith



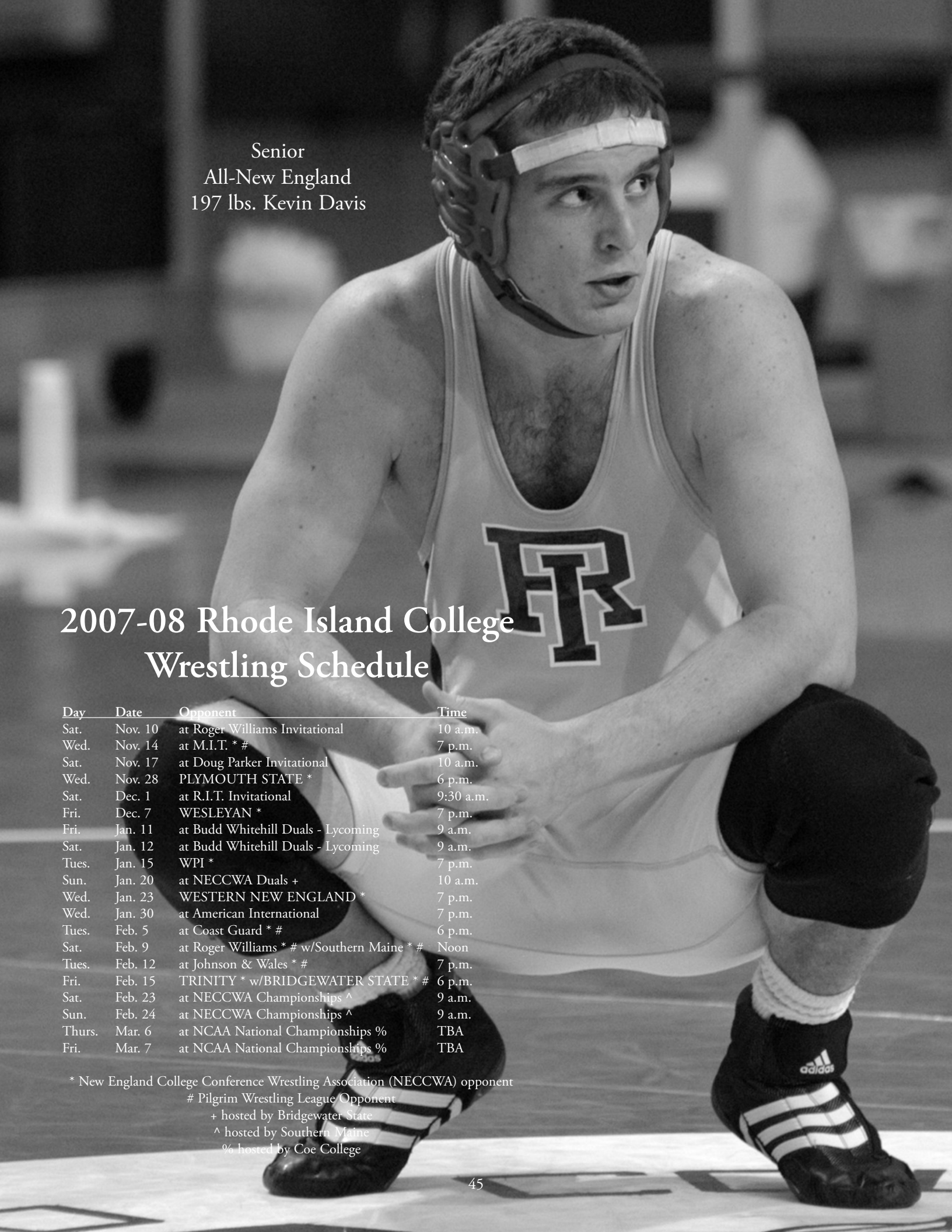
Bob Smith enters his second stint as an assistant wrestling coach at Rhode Island College. He spent six seasons as Coach Jones' assistant from 2000-06 before stepping down. Smith assists in administering practices, match coaching and with recruiting.

Smith is a legend in the high school wrestling ranks. He was an assistant and Head Coach at Coventry (RI) High School for 31 years from 1968 through 1999. He served two stints as CHS's Head Wrestling Coach, from 1972-76 and again from 1991-98. Under his tutelage, Coventry High School won an unprecedented 17 consecutive Rhode Island State Championships from 1982 through 1998, an unequalled nation-wide record.

In 1998-99 he was named the National High School Wrestling Coach of the Year, which was awarded prior to the NCAA Division I National Championships at Penn State. The Rhode Island Wrestling Coaching Association also named him the Coach of the Decade, along with fellow Coventry wrestling coach Dick Magarian. Coventry High School wrestling was named Team of the Decade in the 1990s by USA Wrestling and the National High School Wrestling Coaches Association.

Smith retired after over 31 years as a math teacher at Coventry High School. He is a 1968 graduate of the University of Rhode Island, earning a bachelor's degree in physical education/math.

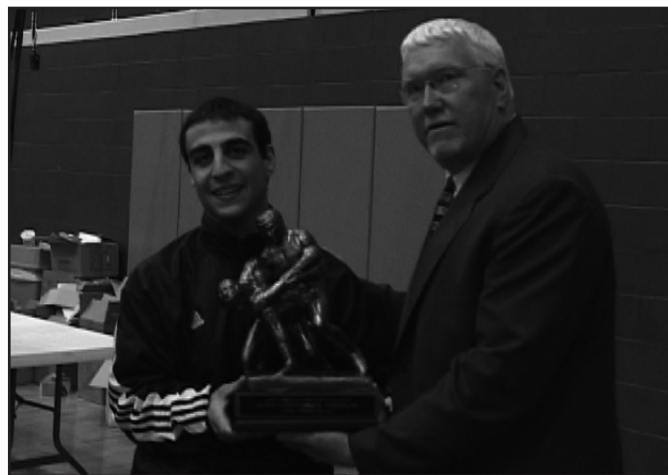

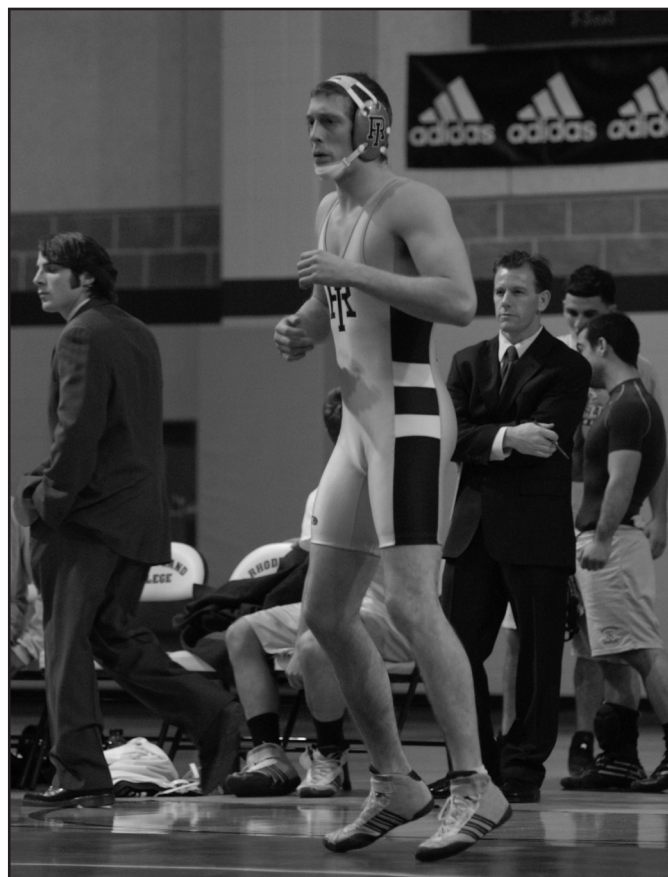

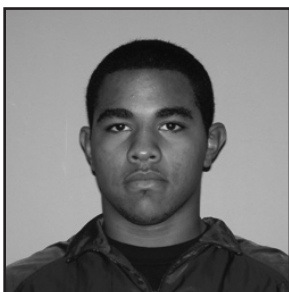
