KICKING OFF 2012-13

The 36th season of women's basketball at the United States Military Academy gets under way Friday night at Wagner College. The Black Knights are 16-19 (.457) all-time in season openers, including 2-4 under seventh-year head coach **Dave Magarity**. Army finished 2011-12 with a 14-16 record, including a 70-46 victory over the visiting Seahawks in the season's inaugural game. Wagner, which amassed a 2-27 record last season, has been Army's first opponent of the year in each of the last four seasons, alternating between Staten Island and West Point, N.Y., with the home team claiming victory in every contest.

ARMY-WAGNER SERIES

Army and Wagner have faced off seven times in program history dating back to 1978-79's 81-54 Black Knight victory at West Point. Following Wagner's three-point victory (66-63) at the 1983-84 Cornell Invitational, the two regional foes did not meet again until Jan. 9, 2008. Starting in the 2007-08 season, the Seahawks have

been on Army's schedule every year. The Black Knights own the all-time advantage, 4-3. Army's 24-point win over Wagner last season was its largest margin of victory over a Division I opponent since a 33-point rout of Presbyterian on Dec. 20, 2008. Last season's meeting also marked the first time Army reached the 70-point threshold since 2009-10's season opener - a 74-70 overtime win against Wagner.

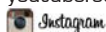

'Tis The [Pre]Season

After finishing the 2011-12 season in a tie for third place (8-6) in the conference standings, Army was tabbed No. 4 in the 2012-13 Patriot League Preseason Poll. The Black Knights collected 66 points and one first-place vote to list behind reigning tournament champion Navy, 2012 regular-season champion American and Holy Cross. In addition, senior guard **Anna Simmers** was voted to the five-player Preseason All-League Team.

Pocket Aces

Army caught the opposition off guard in 2011-12 thanks to a pair of hidden gems. After averaging just 2.0 ppg through her first two years at West Point, **Anna Simmers** enjoyed the true definition of a 'breakout year'. The Alaska native averaged a Patriot League-best 14.8 ppg, including 18.9 against conference foes for the highest average by a Patriot League player since 2003-04. Simmers' scoring output was supported by then-sophomore **Ben Hazlett** who added 12.9 ppg (a 10-point bump from 2010-11) while grabbing a team-best 7.5 rpg. Simmers and Hazlett formed the highest scoring duo in the Patriot League since 2002-03, earning All-Patriot League first and second team honors, respectively.

Man of the Century

Army head coach **Dave Magarity** enters his seventh season at the helm just one victory shy of the century mark. Magarity, who coached men's teams at Marist and St. Francis (Pa.) for a combined 23 years, eclipsed the 400-career wins mark last season and begins 2012-13 with a 412-414 record. Since taking the reins at West Point prior to the 2006-07 season, Magarity has amassed a 99-80 mark, averaging nearly 17 wins per year. Only two coaches in Army women's basketball history have reached triple-digit wins - Harold Johnson (1980-87; 123) and Lynn Chiavaro (1987-98; 132).

Scouting the Seahawks

Wagner is under the direction of first-year head coach Lisa Cermignano. Cermignano spent the previous three seasons on the sidelines at Illinois, where she was an assistant coach.

The new-look Seahawks hope to bounce back after a 2-27 season in 2011-12, which included a 1-17 record in the Northeast Conference. Wagner was tabbed 12th in the recently released NEC Preseason Poll.

Wagner returns a trio of starters in Marie-Laurence Archambault (7.9 ppg), Veronick Fournier (5.7 ppg) and Jacqui Thompson (6.1 ppg). Archambault went for six points and two rebounds against Army in the 2011 opener, while Fournier collected a bucket and Thompson was held scoreless.

The Seahawks' top scorer and rebounder in 2011-12, Kelly Clark (13.6 ppg, 7.8 rpb), graduated in May. Clark had a team-best 10 points against the Black Knights last season, while averaging over 8 ppg through four career contests against Army.

Check For Freshness

For the second season in a row, Army's opening-night starting lineup will feature two freshmen, as **G Kelsey Minato** and **F/C Aimee Oertner** are expected to be part of the Black Knights' starting five. In 2011-12, a pair of freshmen (**Olivia Schretzman**, Janelle Travis) started the first seven games as Army compiled a 5-2 record. Since **Dave Magarity** took the reins in 2006-07, a pair of plebes has been in the starting rotation 14 times, totaling a 10-4 record (.714). Of those 14 games, only one came during Patriot League play – a 56-42 loss to American on Feb. 17, 2010.

Extreme Makeover: Court Edition

Army's home for the past 22 seasons, Christl Arena, received a facelift during the summer of 2012. The updated court features light wood and dark wood contrasting inside the three-point line and the paint, as well as the ARMY logo, with pure black baselines and sidelines.

Home Cooking

The Black Knights are hoping their new-look digs at Christl Arena will bring them as much success as the previous design did. Army is 189-122 (.608) all-time at Christl Arena, including a 10-6 clip in 2011-12. The Black Knights have averaged nearly 10 home wins (9.8) per season under seventh-year head coach **Dave Magarity**.

Make It Count

Army totaled 414 points off of three-point field goals in 2011-12 to list sixth in the Patriot League. Despite what may seem like a low ranking, the quality of the Black Knights' three-pointers was greater than half the conference as Army ranked fourth when it came to threes as a percentage of its total points accumulated. Of **Jen Hazlett's** 12.9 ppg, 35.7 percent came from three-pointers made to lead the Black Knights.

Movin' On Up

Entering just her second season on the sidelines, **Colleen Mullen** was promoted to associate head coach in early July 2012. Mullen, whose primary responsibilities include coaching the guards and serving as recruiting coordinator, came to West Point after a three-year assistant coaching stint at Long Island.

A Welcomed Addition

In addition to **Colleen Mullen's** promotion in the offseason, Army added assistant coach **Emily Garner** to the staff. Garner came from Long Island where she was an assistant coach and director of basketball operations, after a successful four-year playing career at Patriot League foe Lafayette.

Three Of A Kind

Army took home three all-league certificates at the end of 2011-12, as **Anna Simmers** was named to the All-Patriot League first team, **Jen Hazlett** earned second-team laurels, and **Olivia Schretzman** snagged a spot on the all-rookie squad. The three all-league nods were the most by Army since 2007-08. In addition, two Black Knights also picked up academic accolades as **Jordan Elliott** and **Karleen Paulin** were named to the conference's Academic Honor Roll.
