STORYLINES

Army opens the 2015-16 season at home, welcoming Pepperdine to Christl Arena. This year marks the Black Knights' first season opener at home since 2011-12. That season, Army defeated Wagner, 70-46, on Nov. 11, 2011 before finishing the year 14-16.

THE SERIES

Army and Pepperdine are tied at a game apiece in their all-time series. The Black Knights collected a 56-44 victory over the Waves last season, on Nov. 30, 2014 in Malibu, Calif. Senior **Kelsey Minato** led the way with 23 points for Army, while classmate **Aimee Oertner** recorded her only double-double of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds. Pepperdine earned an 87-67 win in the series back on Jan. 9, 1981 in a contest also played in California. This year's meeting marks the first between the schools at West Point. SEASON OPENERS

Army begins the season at home for the first time since the 2011-12 season when it defeated Wagner to start the year. The Black Knights defeated Wagner on the road to kick off 2012-13 before falling on the road at St. Francis Brooklyn and Quinnipiac in the 2013-14 and 2014-15 season openers, respectively. Army is 9-8 all-time when opening the year at home and is 17-21 in all season openers.

A WIN TONIGHT WOULD ...

- Be Army's first victory to open the season since defeated Wagner, 65-62, in the 2012-13 opener.
- Give the Black Knights their second win in as many years against Pepperdine and improve their series record to 2-1 versus the Waves.
- Be head coach **Dave Magarity's** 170th victory at Army.
- Improve Army's record in season openers to 18-21.

SCOUTING PEPPERDINE

Pepperdine begins its season tonight after going 8-22 in 2014-15. Senior Keitra Wallace is the Waves' leading scorer among returning players after averaging 12.8 points in 30 games last year. Wallace finished with six points and five rebounds against Army in last year's meeting. Junior Allie Green is also back for Pepperdine after 11.8 points per contest a season ago.

INDICATOR OF SUCCESS

Since head coach **Dave Magarity** took the reins prior to the 2006-07 season, one of the strongest indicators that Army will win or lose a game is its shooting percentage, with the Black Knights' magic number at 40. Magarity has been head coach for 274 games and of those 274 contests, Army wins over 76 percent of the time when it shoots at least 35 percent from the floor. When that success rate goes above 40 percent, the Black Knights are nearly unstoppable, winning over 88 percent of the time. Since 2011-12, Army is 51-3 in games which it shoots at least 40 percent. Conversely, when Army makes under 35 percent of its shots, the Black Knights win just over 28 percent of the time.

Shooting correlation under Magarity:

Army shoots > 40% - 105-14 (.882)
Army shoots > 35% - 145-44 (.767)
Army shoots < 35% - 24-61 (.282)

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Kelsey Minato moved up to second place on the team’s career scoring list (1,813 points) by the end of her junior season and enters her senior campaign 129 points shy of passing Army Hall-of-Famer Katie Macfarlane (USMA ’04) for first on the Academy’s career scoring list. Minato also begins her final season fifth in the Patriot League and stands in striking distance of the conference’s career scoring record of 2,462 points, held by 2003 Bucknell graduate Molly Creamer.

OERTNER’S BLOCK PARTY

Senior Aimee Oertner has led the Black Knights in blocked shots during each of her first three seasons. Last year, she totaled 63 blocks to average just over 2.0 blocks per game. She enters her senior campaign with 194 career blocks and needs just 29 to pass Erin Anthony’s (USMA ’11) team record of 222 blocks.

2014-15 BALL CONTROL

One of Army’s biggest strengths last season was limiting its number of turnovers. The Black Knights averaged 11.4 turnovers per game a year ago as opposed to 13.0 per contest in 2013-14. Army turned the ball over fewer than 10 times on 11 different occasions, including a season-low four turnovers in the Patriot League semifinals against Lehigh (3/9) and eight turnovers in the WNIT first round at St. John’s (3/19). In total, the Black Knights committed 353 turnovers last season, which set a new team record for fewest in a season surpassing the previous mark of 414 set in 2012-13.

2014-15: A BANNER SEASON

Army continued its recent success last year by making a program-record third straight trip to a national postseason tournament, as the Black Knights played in the WNIT, following appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 2014 and the WNIT in 2013. Army finished the year 23-8 to mark the first time in team history the Black Knights have reached the 20-win mark three seasons in a row. Army will add to its collection of banners in Christl Arena prior to its season opener against Pepperdine, with the addition of a new banner commemorating its 2015 WNIT berth.

NEW LOOK

As part of an athletics rebranding effort, the Army West Point Athletic Association unveiled a new primary logo during the spring of 2015. The primary mark, referred to as Athena's Shield, showcases four unique components.

- **The Shield** is among West Point's most potent symbols and represents the mission of the U.S. Army to support and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and domestic.

- **The Helmet** was worn by Pallas Athena, the Greek goddess of wisdom, just war, skill and justice. The helmet faces dexter, Latin for "right" from the viewpoint of the bearer of the field as opposed to sinister. The dexter side is considered the side of greater honor. The 13 segments that connect the helmet

and the plume reference the 13 British colonies that declared independence from the Kingdom of Great Britain and became the first states in the Union.

- **The Sword**, also known as Xiphos, is a double-edged, single-hand sword used by the ancient Greeks. It symbolizes the scholar-warrior and signifies protection, righteousness and justice. While the original 1898 USMA crest had the sword sheathed, the sword here is unsheathed to allow the viewer to see the martial elements of Army West Point, the warrior spirit, more clearly.

- **The Star** has multiple meanings, including the connection to the U.S. Army and its storied past. During World War II, every tank, truck and airplane in the U.S. Army sported a star as they fought to victory in Europe and the Pacific. The star also represents the connection to the American people and 50 stars from the flag.

ARMY WEST POINT

On first reference, broadcasters and print media members are encouraged to use Army West Point. From there, simply Army or Black Knights are acceptable when referring to the team. Cadets is also an acceptable secondary reference, in addition to Black Knights. For scoreboards and score graphics, ARMY is permissible.

'TIS THE PRESEASON

Army was selected as the Patriot League's preseason favorite for the second year in a row after advancing to its third straight national postseason tournament a year ago. The Black Knights received 155 points and 13 first-place votes to lead the 10-team league. Three-time All-Patriot League first-team selection, Kelsey Minato was named the league's Preseason Player of the Year for the second consecutive season while earning a spot on the five-player Preseason All-League Team.
