# **STORYLINES**

Army looks to improve to 2-0 on the season when it welcomes Quinnipiac to Christl Arena on Sunday. The Black Knights rebounded from a three-point halftime deficit to defeat Pepperdine, 63-53, in Friday evening's season opener. Senior Kelsey Minato led all scorers with 28 points in the contest.

# **THE SERIES**

Quinnipiac owns a 5-0 advantage in the all-time series. The Bobcats earned a 79-64 victory over the Black Knights in the 2014-15 season opener on Nov. 15, 2014. Minato led Army with 18 points in the setback, while classmate Brianna Johnson netted a season-high 13 points and junior Dani Failor totaled 10 points and five rebounds. # LAST TIME OUT

Army earned a victory in its season opener for the first time since the 2012-13 season when it defeated Pepperdine, 63-53, on Friday night at Christl Arena. Senior Kelsey Minato led the way with a gamebest 28 points and a game-high-tying eight rebounds. Classmate Aimee Oertner also scored in double figures with 10 points and seven boards, while Jean Parker finished with eight poitns and five rebounds. The Black Knights trailed, 28-25, at the half before outscoring the Waves, 22-11, in the third period to take a 47-39 advantage heading into the final frame. Army shot 40.4 percent from the field and outrebounded Pepperdine, 44-34, while also owning a 24-14 advantage in points in the paint. Freshmen Madison Hovren and Gabby Purnell made their collegiate debuts, with Hovren totaling four points and five rebounds in nine minutes and Purnell dishing out an assist in six minutes of action.

- Give Army a 2-0 start to the season for the first time since winning five in a row to begin the year in

## SCOUTING QUINNIPIAC

Quinnipiac is coming off its best season in program history after finishing 31-4 overall and a perfect 20-0 in hte Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. The Bobcats earned a trip to the NCAA Tournament for hte second time in program history after defeating Marist, 72-61, in the league title game. Maria Napolitano is the leading scorer among returners after scoring 6.9 points per contest in 2014-15. Quinnipiac was selected for a third-place finish in the MAAC this season.

# FLASHBACK TO THE LAST MEETING

# November 15, 2014 Quinnipiac 79, Army West Point 64

HAMDEN, Conn. - The Army women's basketball team struggled from field and was unable to overcome a 50.9-percent shooting day from host Quinnipiac as the Black Knights fell to the Bobcats, 79-64, in their season opener on Saturday afternoon at TD Bank Sports Center.

Junior Kelsey Minato led Army with 18 points to include a 6-of-7 showing from the free-throw line, while classmate Brianna Johnson matched her career high with 13 points and knocked in a career-best nine free throws on 12 attempts.

Quinnipiac was led by seniors Nikoline Ostergaard and Samantha Guastella, who chipped in 18 points and 15 points, respectively. Ostergaard added a game-high eight rebounds, helping the Bobcats control a 47-29 advantage on the boards.

The Black Knights shot 74.2 percent (23-for-31) from the foul line on the afternoon, but managed just 34.5 percent (19-of-55) from the floor, including a 3-for-18 showing from long range. Quinnipiac was successful on 50.9 percent (29-of-57) of its field goal attempts and converted three-pointers at a 40.0 percent (6-for-15) clip.

Army stayed in contention during the first half thanks to a 10-of-12 performance at the free-throw stripe, but went 10-of-28 from the floor, while allowing Quinnipiac to hit 15-of-34 from the field in the half.

Johnson and senior Olivia Schretzman carried the Black Knights early on, with the pair accounting for the team's first 15 points before Minato's jumper gave Army a 17-14 lead with 13:26 remaining in the half. Guastella scored to cut her team's deficit to one before Minato hit a pair of free throws to build the visitors' lead back to three at 19-16.

Quinnipiac hit the next eight points as part of an eventual 14-2 run that lasted 4:41. The Bobcats went 3-of-3 from deep during the scoring stretch to include six points from Guastella.

## **CLIMBING THE CHARTS**

After moving into second place on Army's career scoring list after last season, senior **Kelsey Minato** netted 28 points in the season opener against Pepperdine to move to 1,841 career points. She finds herself just 101 points shy of passing Army Hall-of-Famer Katie Macfarlane (USMA '04) for first on the Academy's career scoring list. Senior Aimee Oertner has led the Black Knights in blocked shots during each of her first three seasons. Last year, she totaled 63 blocks to average just over 2.0 blocks per game. She finished with a game-high three blocks during Friday's season opener against Pepperdine at currently has 196 careers blocks and needs just 27 to pass Erin Anthony's (USMA '11) team record of 222 blocks.

## 2014-15 BALL CONTROL

One of Army's biggest strengths last season was limiting its number of turnovers. The Black Knights averaged 11.4 turnovers per game a year ago as opposed to 13.0 per contest in 2013-14. Army turned the ball over fewer than 10 times on 11 different occasions, including a season-low four turnovers in the Patriot League semifinals against Lehigh (3/9) and eight turnovers in the WNIT first round at St. John's (3/19). In total, the Black Knights committed 353 turnovers last season, which set a new team record for fewest in a season surpassing the previous mark of 414 set in 2012-13.

## MAGARITY VISITS TROOPS IN SOUTH KOREA

Head coach **Dave Magarity**, Army head men's basketball coach Zach Spiker and Director of Athletics Boo Corrigan visited Korea in late May to witness the U.S. Army's operations in the country. The weeklong trip offered the Corrigan, Magarity and Spiker the opportunity to speak with graduates and faculty and to tour a number of Army bases with some of hte soldiers deployed. The group was also accompanied by a contingent of West Point representatives, including Superindendent Lt. Gen. Robert Caslen.

"The trip to Korea and the National Training Center was one of hte most memorable experiences I've ever had," Magarity said. "To visit the Demilitarized Zone and see what our soliders are up against in terms of defending and supporting the South Koreans and to watch the training at Camp Irwin, was absolutely remarkable."

## **NEW LOOK**

As part of an athletics rebranding effort, the Army West Point Athletic Association unveiled a new priarmy logo during the spring of 2015. The primary mark, referred to as Athena's Shield, showcases four unique components.

- The Shield is among West Point's most potent symbols and represents the mission of the U.S. Army to support and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and domestic.
- The Helmet was worn by Pallas Athena, the Greek goddess of wisdom, just war, skill and justice. The helmet faces dexter, Latin for "right" from the viewpoint of the bearer of the field as opposed to sinister. The dexter side is considered the side of greater honor. The 13 segments that connect the helmet and the plume reference the 13 British colonies that declared independence from the Kingdom of Great Britain and became the first states in the Union.
- The Sword, also known as Xiphos, is a double-edged, single-hand sword used by the ancient Greeks. It symbolizes the scholar-warrior and signifies protection, righteousness and justice. While the original 1898 USMA crest had the sword sheathed, the sword here is unsheathed to allow the viewer to see the martial elements of Army West Point, the warrior spirit, more clearly.
- TheStar has multiple meanings, including the connection to the U.S. Army and its storied past. During World War II, every tank, truck and airplane in the U.S. Army sported a star as they fought to victory in Europe and the Pacific. The star also represents the connection to the American people and 50 stars from the flag.

# **ARMY WEST POINT**

On first reference, broadcasters and print media members are encouraged to use Army West Point. From there, simply Army or Black Knights are acceptable when referring to the team. Cadets is also an acceptable secondary reference, in addition to Black Knights. For scoreboards and score graphics, ARMY is permissible.

## **'TIS THE PRESEASON**

Army was selected as the Patriot League's preseason favorite for the second year in a row after advancing to its third straight national postseason tournament a year ago, while three-time All-Patriot League first-team selection, Kelsey Minato was named the league's Preseason Player of the Year.
