STORYLINES

Army aims to continue its winning streak to begin the 2015-16 season when it hosts Central Connecticut State. The Black Knights overcame a slow start and an early fourth-period deficit to grab a 67-57 victory over Quinnipiac on Nov. 15.

Senior **Kelsey Minato** leads Army in scoring (27.0 ppg) and rebounding (7.5 rpg) early this season and currently ranks 10th nationally in points per game.

THE SERIES

Army is unbeaten in seven games against Central Connecticut State in a series that dates back to the 1983-84 season. The Black Knights earned a 74-60 win over the Blue Devils in New Britain, Conn., last season. Thursday marks CCSU's first trip to West Point since Dec. 31, 2006. Senior guard **Kelsey Minato** and freshman forward **Madison Hovren** were honored in the first addition of Patriot League weekly awards on Monday, as Minato was named the league's Player of the Week for the 12th time in her career and Hovren drew Rookie of the Week praise. Minato averaged 27.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in two games last week, while Hovren posted averages of 4.5 points and 4.0 rebounds per contest.

Army began the season 2-0 for the first time since 2003-04 after defeating Quinnipiac, 67-57, on Nov. 15. The Black Knights shot above 40-percent for the second game in a row, finishing the Quinnipiac game with a shooting percentage of 42% (21-of-50) after hitting shots at a 40.4% (23-of-57) clip in the opener against Pepperdine on Nov. 13. Senior **Kelsey Minato** led the way in scoring (26 points) and rebounding (7 rebounds) for the second game in a row, while classmate **Brianna Johnson** set career standards in points (15), three-pointers (3) and steals (3) versus the Bobcats. Senior **Aimee Oertner** was the third Black Knight to score in double figures against Quinnipiac, as she finished with 10 points. Army led by a point at the half before Quinnipiac snagged a three-point lead to begin the fourth period. Freshman **Madison Hovren**, who finished with five points and three rebounds in the second half, came up with key offensive rebounds in the final quarter to help send Army to the eventual 10-point win.

Central Connecticut State is coming off a 64-53 victory over UMass Lowell on Wednesday night in New Britain, Conn. Aleah Epps poured in a game-high 15 points for the Blue Devils, while Tejahne Malone and Kayla Miller each contributed 13 points. CCSU led, 25-24, at the half and held a two-point cushion at the end of three periods before outscoring the visiting River Hawks by nine in the fourth quarter. Miller leads the Blue Devils in the majority of statistical categories, including scoring (13.5), rebounding (9.5), and steals (4.0). CCSU fell to Vermont in its season opener on the road by a score of 79-63. The Blue Devils were selected third in this year's Northeast Conference Preseason Poll after finishing in a tie for first place in the league with Bryant last season to mark their highest finish in the conference in program history. CCSU also sent a program standard with 19 wins as part of a 19-13 overall record and advanced to the first round of the WNIT, where it fell to Fordham.

After finishing near the bottom of the Patriot League in the rebounding department in 2014-15, Army currently stands third in the conference with 43.5 rebounds through two contests this year. The Black Knights collected 43 boards in the season opener against Pepperdine before grabbing 44 versus Quinnipiac. Army reached the 40-rebound mark three times last season. Senior **Kelsey Minato** leads the way early in the season with 7.5 rebounds per game, while classmates **Aimee Oertner** and **Jean Parker**, and junior **Dani Failor** average 5.5 boards per contest. The early play of newcomer **Madison Hovren** (4.0 rpg) has provided the Black Knights with another solid rebounding threat, as Hovren also averages a team-leading 3.0 offensive rebounds this season.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

After moving into second place on Army’s career scoring list after last season, senior **Kelsey Minato** netted over 20 points in the first two games of this season to move to 1,867 career points. She finds herself just 75 points shy of passing Army Hall-of-Famer Katie Macfarlane (USMA ’04) for first on the Academy’s career scoring list. Minato also stands within striking distance of the Patriot League’s career scoring record of 2,462 points, held by 2003 Bucknell graduate Molly Creamer. Minato passed Navy graduate Courtney Davidson for fourth on the league’s career scoring list after her 26-point effort against Quinnipiac (11/15/15).

OERTNER’S BLOCK PARTY

Senior Aimee Oertner has led the Black Knights in blocked shots during each of her first three seasons. Last year, she totaled 63 blocks to average just over 2.0 blocks per game. So far this season, she has four blocks and currently has 197 blocks for her career. She needs 26 blocks to pass Erin Anthony’s (USMA ’11) team record of 222 blocked shots.

The team, under the direction of second-year head coach Derek Fisher, arrived at West Point on Monday, Sept. 28 and conducted a team building sessions and practices before departing on Saturday, Oct. 3.

MAGARITY VISITS TROOPS IN SOUTH KOREA

Head coach **Dave Magarity**, Army head men’s basketball coach Zach Spiker and Director of Athletics Boo Corrigan visited Korea in late May to witness the U.S. Army’s operations in the country. The weeklong trip offered the Corrigan, Magarity and Spiker the opportunity to speak with graduates and faculty and to tour a number of Army bases with some of hte soldiers deployed. The group was also accompanied by a contingent of West Point representatives, including Superindendent Lt. Gen. Robert Caslen.

“The trip to Korea and the National Training Center was one of hte most memorable experiences I’ve ever had,” Magarity said. “To visit the Demilitarized Zone and see what our soliders are up against in terms of defending and supporting the South Koreans and to watch the training at Camp Irwin, was absolutely remarkable.”

’TIS THE PRESEASON
