STORYLINES

Army hits the road for the first time this season to play its first-ever contest against Duke. The Black Knights are coming off a game in which three players scored in double figures, including seniors **Kelsey Minato** (23 points) and **Aimee Oertner** (14), and freshman **Madison Hovren** (11). After overcoming slow starts in its first two games of the year, Army came storming out of the gate to take a 20-point lead after the first period against Central Connecticut State on Nov. 19 before winning by 29 points.

Senior **Kelsey Minato** leads Army in scoring (25.7 ppg) and stands second on the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg) early this season, while Oertner paces the Black Knights with 7.0 rpg and lists second in scoring with 11.3 ppg. Minato and Oertner are the only two Army players to score in double figures in each of the first three games this season.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

After moving into second place on Army’s career scoring list after last season, senior **Kelsey Minato** netted over 20 points in the first three games of this season to move to 1,890 career points. She finds herself just 52 points shy of passing Army Hall-of-Famer Katie Macfarlane (USMA ’04) for first on the Academy’s career scoring list. Minato also stands within striking distance of the Patriot League’s career scoring record of 2,462 points, held by 2003 Bucknell graduate Molly Creamer. Minato passed Navy graduate Courtney Davidson for fourth on the league’s career scoring list after her 26-point effort against Quinnipiac (11/15/15).

Senior **Aimee Oertner** has led the Black Knights in blocked shots during each of her first three seasons. Last year, she totaled 63 blocks to average just over 2.0 blocks per game. So far this season, she has five blocks and currently has 198 blocks for her career. She needs 25 blocks to pass Erin Anthony’s (USMA ’11) team record of 222 blocked shots.

MAGARITY VISITS TROOPS IN SOUTH KOREA

Head coach **Dave Magarity**, Army head men's basketball coach Zach Spiker and Director of Athletics Boo Corrigan visited Korea in late May to witness the U.S. Army's operations in the country. The weeklong trip offered the Corrigan, Magarity and Spiker the opportunity to speak with graduates and faculty and to tour a number of Army bases with some of hte soldiers deployed. The group was also accompanied by a contingent of West Point representatives, including Superindendent Lt. Gen. Robert Caslen.

"The trip to Korea and the National Training Center was one of hte most memorable experiences I've ever had," Magarity said. "To visit the Demilitarized Zone and see what our soliders are up against in terms of defending and supporting the South Koreans and to watch the training at Camp Irwin, was absolutely remarkable."

'TIS THE PRESEASON

Army was selected as the Patriot League's preseason favorite for the second year in a row after advancing to its third straight national postseason tournament a year ago, while three-time All-Patriot League first-team selection, Kelsey Minato was named the league's Preseason Player of the Year.

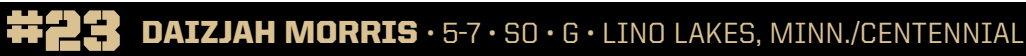
