



STORYLINES

Army hits the road for the first time this season to play its first-ever contest against Duke. The Black Knights are coming off a game in which three players scored in double figures, including seniors Kelsey Minato (23 points) and Aimee Oertner (14), and freshman Madison Hovren (11). After overcoming slow starts in its first two games of the year, Army came storming out of the gate to take a 20-point lead after the first period against Central Connecticut State on Nov. 19 before winning by 29 points.

Senior Kelsey Minato leads Army in scoring (25.7 ppg) and stands second on the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg) early this season, while Oertner paces the Black Knights with 7.0 rpg and lists second in scoring with 11.3 ppg. Minato and Oertner are the only two Army players to score in double figures in each of the first three games this season.

MINATO, HOVREN COLLECT WEEKLY HONORS

Senior guard Kelsey Minato and freshman forward Madison Hovren were honored in the first addition of Patriot League weekly awards on Monday, as Minato was named the league's Player of the Week for the 12th time in her career and Hovren drew Rookie of the Week praise. Minato averaged 27.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in two games last week, while Hovren posted averages of 4.5 points and 4.0 rebounds per contest.

LAST TIME OUT

Army began the season 3-0 for the first time since 2003-04 after topping Central Connecticut State, 81-52, on Nov. 19. The Black Knights shot above 40 percent for the third game in a row, finishing the CCSU game with a season-best shooting percentage of .450 (27-of-60) after hitting shots at a 40.4 percent clip and a 42 clip against Pepperdine (11/13) and Quinnipiac (11/15), respectively. Senior Kelsey Minato reached the 20-point mark for the third time this season after scoring a game-high 23 points, while classmate Aimee Oertner posted a double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds. Freshman Madison Hovren added a career-high 11 points off the bench and also contributed four boards. Army scored 17 unanswered points early in the opening period to take a 25-5 lead after one before closing the half with a 45-21 lead. After scoring eight points in the first half, Minato netted 15 in the second half, including a 4-for-4 showing at the free-throw line. Hovren knocked down 7-of-8 attempts at the foul line to help the Black Knights hold off CCSU for the 29-point victory.

SCOUTING DUKE

After winning its first two games to begin the season, #14/9 Duke fell at home to #12/12 Texas A&M on Nov. 18. Redshirt sophomore Rebecca Greenwell led the way for the Blue Devils with 22 points on 8-of-10 shooting, while classmate Azurá Stevens finished with a double-double after posting 12 points and 16 rebounds. Duke trailed by one at halftime and trailed, 52-47, after the third period and rallied in the fourth quarter to force overtime before taking the setback. Greenwell leads Duke in scoring after three games, with 16.0 ppg, while Stevens averages a double-double, with 15.0 ppg and 11.3 rpg. Greenwell and Stevens were among 30 players named to the Wooden Award watch list earlier this week. The award recognizes the top player in Division I women's college basketball. The Blue Devils finished the year 23-11 last season and advanced to the NCAA Tournament Round of 16 before falling to eventual Final Fourparticipant, Maryland.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

After finishing near the bottom of the Patriot League in the rebounding department in 2014-15, Army currently stands third in the conference with 43.7 rebounds through three contests this year. The Black Knights collected 44 boards in the season opener against Pepperdine before hauling in 43 and 44 rebounds versus Quinnipiac and Central Connecticut State, respectively. Army reached the 40-rebound mark three times last season. Senior Aimee Oertner leads the way early in the season with 7.0 rebounds per game, while classmate Kelsey Minato (6.0) and junior Dani Failor (5.3) have also been strong contributors on the glass. The early play of newcomer Madison Hovren (4.0 rpg) has provided the Black Knights with another solid rebounding threat, as Hovren is also second on the team with 2.3 offensive rebounds this season.
