STORYLINES

Army enters Sunday after having a week off, last playing at #14/9 Duke on Nov. 22. The Black Knights led for nearly the entire first half, including possessing a three-point halftime lead, before eventually taking a 72-61 setback. Due to its competitive showing against the Blue Devils, Army is receiving national attention this week, as it is receiving two votes in the latest USA Today Coaches Poll.

Senior **Kelsey Minato** leads the Black Knights in scoring with 25.0 ppg through four contests this season and finds herself 29 points shy of becoming the Academy's career scoring leader. Minato currently stands at 1,913 career points and is second only to Army Hall of Famer Katie Macfarlane's (USMA '04) program record of 1,941 points.

THE SERIES

Army trails Rider, 4-2, in an all-time series between the schools that dates back to the 1995-96 season. The sides last met on Dec. 7, 2012, with Rider taking a 66-60 victory in Lawrenceville, N.J. For more on the Army-Rider series, see page 3.

LAST TIME OUT

Army took its first loss of the season with a 72-61 setback at a Duke team ranked 14th in the AP Poll and ninth in the USA Today Coaches Poll on Nov. 22. The Black Knights shot at least 40 percent for the fourth game in a row, finishing the contest with a shooting percentage of .400 (22-of-55). Senior **Kelsey Minato** scored 23 points for the second game in a row to reach the 20-point mark for the fourth time this season while also adding six rebounds. Classmate **Jean Parker** contributed 12 points and six rebounds and sophomore **Lena' Hicks** registered career highs of 11 points and four rebounds down low. Army controlled a 23-14 advantage with 44 seconds remaining in the first period before taking a 34-31 lead into the halftime break. The Black Knights struggled to shoot the ball in the third quarter, making just 1-of-12 attempts from the field to enter the fourth period trailing, 50-39. Army and Duke both scored 22 points in the final period as the Blue Devils came away with the 11-point win.

A WIN TODAY WOULD ...

- Snap a two-game losing streak for Army against Rider

SCOUTING RIDER

After beginning the season with back-to-back wins, Rider has fallen in each of its last two games, most recently dropping a 78-59 decision against a Princeton team receiving votes in both the AP Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll on Nov. 24. Junior Robin Perkins and senior Manon Pellet each reached double figures for the Broncs, with 13 points and 10 points, respectively. Rider led, 8-6, at the 7:08 mark of the opening period before Princeton finished the frame on a 15-5 run and took an eight-point advantage that it never gave up. Perkins paces the Broncs with 15.5 points per game this season, while junior Julia Duggan also averages in double figures with 11.8 points and is the team's leading rebounder with 6.8 boards per contest. Along with its top two scorers, Rider possesses offensive balance with additional threats, Pellet (8.5 ppg) and sophomores Kamila Hoskova (7.5 ppg) and C'quoya Houghton (6.5 ppg).

CRASHING THE BOARDS

After finishing near the bottom of the Patriot League in the rebounding department in 2014-15, Army currently stands fourth in the conference with 40.2 rebounds through four contests this year. The Black Knights collected 44 boards in the season opener against Pepperdine before hauling in 43 and 44 rebounds versus Quinnipiac and Central Connecticut State, respectively. Army reached the 40-rebound mark three times all of last season and has done so three times this year, coming short of 40 rebounds just once (30 at Duke, 11/22). Senior **Aimee Oertner** leads the way early in the season with 6.3 rebounds per game, while classmates **Kelsey Minato** (6.0) and **Jean Parker** (4.8) have also been strong contributors on the glass. The early play of newcomer **Madison Hovren** (3.0 rpg) has provided the Black Knights with another solid rebounding threat, as Hovren is also second on the team with 1.8 offensive rebounds this season.

NATIONAL ATTENTION

Army is receiving two votes in this week's USA Today Coaches Poll after playing to a 72-61 loss at a Duke team ranked 14th in last week's AP Poll and ninth in the USA Today Coaches Poll. The Black Knights led by as many as nine late in the first period before controlling a 34-31 advantage at halftime. Army also moved up to 24th in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 Poll for its performance through the first four games of the year.

WINNING WAYS

The Army Women's Basketball Class of 2015 holds the program record with the most victories over a four-year span, with an 84-41 overall record. The Class of 2016 has a chance to surpass last year's seniors for the most wins in team history and currently owns a 73-26 record over its first three-plus seasons. The Black Knights' current senior class includes guards **Kelsey Minato**, **Brigette Ocran** and **Jean Parker** and forwards **Brianna Johnson** and **Aimee Oertner**.

BRANCH NIGHT

West Point seniors celebrated Branch Night on Nov. 19 and found out which branch of the U.S. Army they will serve in upon graduation in May. Army's five seniors will join the following branches after graduating and becoming a 2nd Lieutenant: **Brianna Johnson** (Medical Service Corps), **Kelsey Minato** (Branch detail in Field Artillery before joining the Signal Corps), **Brigette Ocran** (Air Defense Artillery), **Aimee Oertner** (Branch detail in Field Artillery before joining the Adjutant General's Corps), **Jean Parker** (Corps of Engineers).

BENCH CONTRIBUTIONS

Army's reserves combined for 21 points during the first two games of the season against Pepperdine (11/13) and Quinnipiac (11/15), but have since scored 47 over the last two contests versus Central Central Connecticut State (11/19) and at Duke (11/22). Freshman **Madison Hovren** netted a season-best 11 points to lead a Black Knight bench that finished with a season high 31 points against Central Connecticut State before sophomore **Lena' Hicks** netted 11 points in leading an Army bench to 16 points at #14/9 Duke. Army's bench players are contributing to 25 percent of the team's scoring this season, accounting for 68 of the Black Knights' 272 points through four games. Hovren (20 points) and Hicks (17) are Army's leading scorers among reserves so far, while sophomore **Janae McNeal** is third with 16 points. CLIMBING THE CHARTS

After moving into second place on Army’s career scoring list after last season, senior **Kelsey Minato** netted over 20 points in the first four games of this season to move to 1,913 career points. She finds herself just 29 points shy of passing Army Hall-of-Famer Katie Macfarlane (USMA ’04) for first on the Academy’s career scoring list. Minato also stands within striking distance of the Patriot League’s career scoring record of 2,462 points, held by 2003 Bucknell graduate Molly Creamer. Minato passed Navy graduate Courtney Davidson for fourth on the league’s career scoring list after her 26-point effort against Quinnipiac (11/15/15).
