STORYLINES

Army comes into Thursday's game after earning a 57-42 victory over Rider on Nov. 29. The Black Knights received one of their most-balanced scoring outputs of the young season, as five players scored at least five points, including seniors **Jean Parker** (18 points) and **Kelsey Minato** (11), who both scored in double figures to keep Army unbeaten at home.

Minato leads the Black Knights in scoring with 22.2 ppg through five contests this season and finds herself 18 points shy of becoming the Academy's career scoring leader. Minato currently stands at 1,924 career points and is second only to Army Hall of Famer Katie Macfarlane's (USMA '04) program record of 1,941 points.

THE SERIES

Army holds an 18-10 lead over Yale in a series that dates back to Army's first-ever varsity season of 1977-78. The sides last met on Dec. 7, 2013, with the Black Knights winning, 68-56, at Yale. The Bulldogs control a 9-5 advantage in the series in games played in New Haven, Conn. For more on the Army-Yale series, see page 3.

Following its first loss of the season at Duke on Nov. 22, Army got back on the winning track with a 57-42 victory over Rider on Nov. 29. The Black Knights held the Broncs to 42 points, the lowest for an Army opponent this season, despite shooting its lowest percentage of the year (36.7). Senior **Jean Parker** made four three-pointers for the second game in a row and reached a season high of 18 points, while also grabbing six rebounds. Classmate **Kelsey Minato** struggled shooting the ball and finished with 11 points, while sophomore **Lena' Hicks** registered eight points and four rebounds after scoring a career-high 11 points at Duke. Senior **Aimee Oertner** equaled career standards of 12 rebounds and five assists to go along with five points and five blocks. Freshman **Izzy McMahon** was the fifth Black Knight to finish with at least five points, as she netted exactly five for the first points of her career. Army held a 32-26 lead at the half and outscored Rider, 25-16, in the second half to close out the win.

Having eight games under its belt already entering Thursday, Yale has won two of its last three contests, including a 62-36 home victory over Manhattan on Dec. 1. Senior Nyasha Sarju paced the Bulldogs with 12 points and seven rebounds, while sophomore Tamara Simpson (10 pts, 6 rebs, 6 stls) and junior Meghan McIntyre (10 pts, 6 assts) also had impressive showings for the home team. Yale controlled an early 25-10 lead following the first period before limiting Manhattan to 13 points, two points and 11 points in the final three quarters. The Bulldogs were successful on 42.6 percent (23-of-54) of their attempts from the field, while holding the Jaspers to a 20.8-percent (10-of-48) shooting night. Four players average at least 8.0 points per game for Yale, including Sarju (16.4 ppg), senior Whitney Wyckoff (9.5 ppg), sophomore Clara Mokri (8.5 ppg) and Simpson (8.4 ppg).

After finishing near the bottom of the Patriot League in the rebounding department in 2014-15, Army currently stands fourth in the conference with 40.4 rebounds through five contests this year. The Black Knights collected 44 boards in the season opener against Pepperdine before hauling in 40+ rebounds versus Quinnipiac (43), Central Connecticut State (44) and Rider (41). Army reached the 40-rebound mark three times all of last season and has already done so four times this year.

Senior **Aimee Oertner** was announced as one of 70 nominees from the NCAA Division I ranks to be up for the 2016 Women's Basketball Coaches Association Allstate Good Works Team on Dec. 2. Now in its fourth year, the award "recognizes players who have made outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement." Oertner has been involved in a number of volunteer efforts during her time at West Point to include: the Walter Hoving Home, the Friends of Jaclyn Foundation and the Special Olympics.

WINNING WAYS

The Army Women's Basketball Class of 2015 holds the program record with the most victories over a four-year span, with an 84-41 overall record. The Class of 2016 has a chance to surpass last year's seniors for the most wins in team history and currently owns a 74-26 record over its first three-plus seasons. The Black Knights' current senior class includes guards **Kelsey Minato**, **Brigette Ocran** and **Jean Parker** and forwards **Brianna Johnson** and **Aimee Oertner**.

BRANCH NIGHT

On Nov. 19, all members of West Point's First Class (senior) assembled inside Eisenhower Hall for Branch Night. For the first three years at the Academy, each cadet receives information about each of the 16 Branches. By the time Branch Night comes, they will understand what the normal duties, responsibilities, assignment patterns and locations are for each of the Branches. Late in the Cow Year (junior), each cadet must indicate, by order of preference, all specialties for which they are qualified and eligible. Branches are then assigned according to performance, preference and current Branch goals (what the Army needs most at the time).

Envelopes werer handed out to the Firsties that contained the insignia of the Branch to which they were assigned. Army's five seniors learned they will join the following sections of the U.S. after graduating and become a 2nd Lieutenant.

BENCH CONTRIBUTIONS

Army's reserves combined for 21 points during the first two games of the season against Pepperdine (11/13) and Quinnipiac (11/15), but have since scored 64 over the last three contests. Freshman **Madison Hovren** netted 11 points to lead a Black Knight bench that finished with a season high 31 points against Central Connecticut State (11/19) before sophomore **Lena' Hicks** scored 11 points at Duke (11/22) and eight more against Rider (11/29) in leading an Army bench to 16 points and 17 points in the two games, respectively. Army's bench is contributing to 25.8 percent of the team's scoring this season, accounting for 85 of the Black Knights' 329 points through five games. Hicks (25 points) and Hovren (21) are Army's leading scorers among reserves so far. For more on Army's scoring breakdown this season, see the chart at the bottom of the page.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

After moving into second place on Army’s career scoring list after last season, senior **Kelsey Minato** is averaging 22.2 points through five games this season and has moved to 1,924 career points. She finds herself 18 points shy of passing Army Hall-of-Famer Katie Macfarlane (USMA ’04) for first on the Academy’s career scoring list. Minato also stands within striking distance of the Patriot League’s career scoring record of 2,462 points, held by 2003 Bucknell graduate Molly Creamer. Minato passed Navy graduate Courtney Davidson for fourth on the league’s career scoring list after her 26-point effort against Quinnipiac (11/15/15).

OERTNER’S BLOCK PARTY

Senior **Aimee Oertner** has led the Black Knights in blocked shots during each of her first three seasons. Last year, she totaled 66 blocks to average 2.0 blocks per game. She has 12 blocks (2.4 bpg) so far this season, including a season-best five against Rider on Nov. 29. Oertner currently has 206 blocks for her career and needs 17 to pass Erin Anthony’s (USMA ’11) team record of 222 blocked shots.

MAGARITY VISITS TROOPS IN SOUTH KOREA

Head coach **Dave Magarity**, Army head men’s basketball coach Zach Spiker and Director of Athletics Boo Corrigan visited Korea in late May to witness the U.S. Army’s operations in the country. The weeklong trip offered the Corrigan, Magarity and Spiker the opportunity to speak with graduates and faculty and to tour a number of Army bases with some of hte soldiers deployed. The group was also accompanied by a contingent of West Point representatives, including Superindendent Lt. Gen. Robert Caslen.

“The trip to Korea and the National Training Center was one of hte most memorable experiences I’ve ever had,” Magarity said. “To visit the Demilitarized Zone and see what our soliders are up against in terms of defending and supporting the South Koreans and to watch the training at Camp Irwin, was absolutely remarkable.”



NEW LOOK

As part of an athletics rebranding effort, the Army West Point Athletic Association unveiled a new priarmy logo during the spring of 2015. The primary mark, referred to as Athena’s Shield, showcases four unique components.

- **The Shield** is among West Point’s most potent symbols and represents the mission of the U.S. Army to support and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and domestic.
- **The Helmet** was worn by Pallas Athena, the Greek goddess of wisdom, just war, skill and justice. The helmet faces dexter, Latin for “right” from the view-point of the bearer of the field as opposed to sinister. The dexter side is considered the side of greater honor. The 13 segments that connect the helmet

and the plume reference the 13 British colonies that declared independence from the Kingdom of Great Britain and became the first states in the Union.

- **The Sword**, also known as Xiphos, is a double-edged, single-hand sword used by the ancient Greeks. It symbolizes the scholar-warrior and signifies protection, righteousness and justice. While the original 1898 USMA crest had the sword sheathed, the sword here is unsheathed to allow the viewer to see the martial elements of Army West Point, the warrior spirit, more clearly.
- **TheStar** has multiple meanings, including the connection to the U.S. Army and its storied past. During World War II, every tank, truck and airplane in the U.S. Army sported a star as they fought to victory in Europe and the Pacific. The star also represents the connection to the American people and 50 stars from the flag.

ARMY WEST POINT

On first reference, broadcasters and print media members are encouraged to use Army West Point. From there, simply Army or Black Knights are acceptable when referring to the team. Cadets is also an acceptable secondary reference, in addition to Black Knights. For scoreboards and score graphics, ARMY is permissible.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION

Army was selected as the Patriot League’s preseason favorite for the second year in a row after advancing to its third straight national postseason tournament a year ago, while three-time All-Patriot League first-team selection, senior **Kelsey Minato** was named the league’s Preseason Player of the Year. Additionally, Minato was one of five players to be named to the Preseason All-League Team.
