THIS WEEK: BACK TO LEAGUE CONTESTS

The Army West Point hockey team continues its road trip this weekend in Pittsburgh. It will mark the first Friday-Saturday contests of the season for the Cadets as they take on Robert Morris. Until this weekend, the Black Knights have only partaken in single-games each week and of their five games, only two have been against Atlantic Hockey opponents. This season, the Cadets are 2-0-0 against AHA foes with both wins coming over Sacred Heart in shutout fashion. Army's Parker Gahagen has not allowed a goal in league games this season. Robert Morris has only played in league contests with its only win coming over RIT (6-5). The Colonials have lost solo games to the Tigers (6-3) and

Plebe Zach Evancho netted his first-career off assists by firstie captain Ryan Nick and yearling Trevor Fidler. Then, one minute later, firstie C.J. Reuchlein connected with classmate Clint Carlisle to make it a one-goal game. Army was unable to post another goal in the even-shot contest. Robert Morris spent last weekend in Buffalo, N.Y., with a two-game series against Atlantic Hockey foe Canisius. Brady Ferguson had three points on the weekend for the Colonials off a goal and two assists, and Alex Tonge posted two power play goals in the Saturday night matchup.

When Brian Riley was named Army hockey's 16th head coach in 2004, he was familiar with West Point.

Following 14 years as an assistant to his brother Rob and a lifetime of hockey education from his father Jack, Brian Riley knew all about the U.S. Military Academy.

The knowledge, preparation and hard work have all paid off for Brian as he adds to the Riley legacy and Army hockey.

Just the third Army hockey coach in the past 62 years, Brian Riley has made his mark on a program coached by his father and brother in just eight seasons.

The Vice President for Membership of the American Hockey Coaches Association, Brian Riley is a three-time Atlantic Hockey Association Coach of the Year, has guided Army to eight consecutive Atlantic Hockey Association playoff berths, led the team to its the first regular season championship in program history, posted non-conference victories and had four players chosen to participate in the NCAA Frozen Four Skills Competition. Riley was recently appointed to the NCAA Division I Men's Ice Hockey Committee, which is responsible for the management of the NCAA Championship.

Brian Riley has posted a 136-233-62 mark during his tenure behind the West Point bench after succeeding his brother, Rob who briefly retired from coaching in 2004. Prior to Rob, Jack Riley, their father, stood behind the Black Knights bench for 36 seasons. In addition to his success at Army, Jack Riley also coached the U.S. Olympic hockey team to a stunning gold medal in the 1960 Games.

Utilizing a defensive system that focuses on physical, intense play and opportunistic scoring, Riley has led his squad to the Atlantic Hockey Association playoffs in all 11 of his seasons.

In 2014-15, Riley's team earned points every weekend in the final month of the Atlantic Hockey schedule going into the league's playoffs, including a win over eventaul tournament champion RIT on the road in Rochester. He tutored his first Atlantic Hockey Rookie of the Year in Tyler Pham and he was also named to the All-Rookie Team.

In 2013-14, the Black Knights took eventual Atlantic Hockey Champion Robert Morris to three games in their first round series. Riley's team forced a game three in the series with a 4-2 win in the second game. C.J. Reuschlein was named as part of the AHA All-Rookie Team after leading the Black Knights in scoring with 22 points, becoming the first rookie since Rob Ross had 17 as tops in 2004-05.

An upstart Riley club opened the 2012-13 season as one of the hottest teams in the AHA with early wins over Sacred Heart (2), American International and then No. 19th-ranked Robert Morris - all in the friendly confines of Tate Rink. The Black Knights sat in the upper echelon of the AHA standings throughout much of the first half of conference action, which ultimately helped the USCHO name Riley its mid-season Coach of the Year.

Army went on to finish the year with an AHA playoff berth, forward Joe Kozlak earned AHA All-Rookie Team honors and senior Andy Starczewski was among the initial candidates for the Hobey Baker Award. In addition to

the on-ice success of his players, Riley had the pleasure of coaching 2013 Men's Hockey Senior CLASS Award winner Cheyne Rocha, who also earned first team Academic All-America honors for the second year in a row.

In 2011-12, Army posted seven ties and four wins, including victories over Canadian rival Royal Military College (9-1), ECAC Hockey's Rensselaer (3-2) in the Toyota/UConn Classic and a dramatic 4-4 overtime tie with Air Force. Riley helped Army resume its rivalry with its military brethren for the first time since 2006 and then watched as 12 players registered points in the eight-goal victory. Army qualified for the Atlantic Hockey Playoffs but dropped a pair of games to Holy Cross in the opening round.

The 2010-11 team won 11 games and earned home ice for the playoffs while a pair of players – Marcel Alvarez and Cody Omilusik earned All-AHA accolades. Among the victories, was a 5-2 triumph at the University of Massachusetts at the Mullins Center, a dramatic 5-4 win at Air Force, a three-point weekend against Robert Morris and a 4-1 victory over AIC outdoors at Rentschler Field in Hartford, Conn.

During the 2009-10 season, Riley helped the Black Knights to an 11-win season and the No. 6 seed in the conference playoffs. Among the victories was a three-point weekend against Air Force at Tate Rink, a 4-4 overtime draw at Colgate and a 2-1 win at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, the second consecutive year of a non-conference win.

In the postseason, Riley was selected as an assistant coach of the East squad at the NCAA Frozen Four Skills Competition where he coached Army's Owen Meyer, the fourth Black Knight selected for the honor, joining Brad Roberts (2006), Luke Flicek (2008) and Zach McKelvie (2009).

In 2008-09, with a team of 12 freshmen, Riley guided the Black Knights to the Atlantic Hockey Association playoffs for the sixth straight season. Included in the wins was a shocking upset of No. 2 Miami, 3-2 in the consolation game of the Ohio Hockey Classic.

Six years prior, Riley led Army to its first regular season championship and won 19 games for the second consecutive season.

Army went 19-14-4 in 2007-08, winning the AHA regular season title and the top seed in the conference tournament. For the second straight year, Army advanced to the semifinal round.

During the 2007-08 season, Army put together a league-best nine-game unbeaten streak (8-0-1) to clinch the regular season title. Army won the first two games of the best-of-three series with Sacred Heart to advance to the semifinals where a loss to Mercyhurst ended the season.

In 2006-07, the Black Knights hosted a league playoff game at Tate Rink for the first time and beat Bentley, 6-2. They followed that with a 3-1 win over Connecticut in the semifinals before losing to Air Force in the finals.

Riley was named the league coach of the year for the first time in 2005-06 when the team finished fifth in conference play after overcoming a 0-7-1 start.

In his first campaign behind the Black Knights' bench, Riley engineered one of the biggest

upsets in the NCAA when Army stunned Colgate, 3-2, in Hamilton, N.Y., for his first career win.

Riley led his team to 11 wins during that initial season, setting the Academy record for most victories by a rookie head coach. He broke the record established by his brother, Rob, in 1986-87. In addition, the younger Riley also piloted the Black Knights to their first postseason win in more than a quarter century when Army defeated American International College, 5-3, in the first round of the Atlantic Hockey tournament.

Riley's father, Jack, started it all in 1951 when legendary football coach and athletic director at West Point, Earl "Red" Blaik, hired him to head the hockey program. What began as a one-year contract, turned into a 36-year Hall of Fame career that culminated in 542 victories.

Riley's brother, Rob, took the reins from his father in the fall of 1986 and racked up 306 victories of his own over 18 winters.

When Rob officially stepped down in the summer of 2004, he passed the torch (and family tradition) on to his younger brother.

Brian brings an extensive resume to his "dream job" at the Academy. No stranger to West Point or the "West Point Experience," the younger Riley has spent 14 years as an assistant coach to his brother, eventually rising to the position of associate head coach.

Brian played an integral role in recruiting many of the athletes that helped Army put together back-to-back 20-win seasons and tutored Corey and Ian Winer, former Colorado Avalanche forward Dan Hinote.

Riley also recruited Zach McKelvie, a hulking defenseman now part of the Calgary Flames organization. He originally signed two free agent contracts with the Boston Bruins while he was serving his country. McKelvie is just one of Riley's defensive gems, as his expertise in working with the defense has molded Army's squads into one of the most stingy blue line units in college hockey.

A 1983 graduate of Brown, Riley began his coaching career in 1984 with a three-year stint as an assistant coach at SUNY Plattsburgh. During that period, the Cardinals advanced to the NCAA Division III Tournament three times, reaching the championship game twice.

In 1988, Riley moved to the Division I ranks at the University of Massachusetts-Lowell. There, he teamed with his cousin, Bill Riley, for one season, directing the River Hawks to the NCAA Tournament, giving him his fourth straight postseason appearance.

The following winter, Riley joined his brother's staff at West Point for the first time where he spent the next seven seasons. In 1996, the West Point native left the comfort

STORYLINES FOR THE WEEKEND

LEAGUE SUCCESS

The Army hockey team has seen early success in Atlantic Hockey contests. The Black Knights sit atop the AHA standings for the second-straight week with four points. Army has earned two shutout victories in conference play to earn those points, both of which were over Sacred Heart. In statistical standings, the Cadets rank first in several categories. Army is first in the penalty kill with a .967 success rate. The team also boasts a +3 special teams net, a goals against average of 1.22 and a save percentage of .956 for tops in the league.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

Army currently ranks first in scoring defense nationally with an average of 1.25 goals per game. The Black Knights' penalty killing unit is tied for first with a .967 percent efficiency. Gahagen's goals against average of 1.23 ranks him first in the nation, while is .956 saves percentage places him second. His two shutouts have him tied for first in the category alongside players from No. 4 Boston U, No. 20 Bemidji State and UConn who is receiving votes.

SCOUTING THE COLONIALS

Whereas the Black Knights rank highly in defensive statistics, the Robert Morris offense is equivalently successful. Brady Ferguson leads Atlantic Hockey players in points per game with a 2.5 average. The Colonials have an successful power play rate and take up the top three spots in power play points. Ferguson leads the charge with seven over five games, while Eric Israel tallied six and Alex Tonge notched five, including two goals on the advantage. Robert Morris has seen its only win on the road in Henrietta, N.Y., as it took down defending AHA Champion RIT 6-5 during the opening series. This will be the Colonial's opening weekend at the 84 Lumber Arena as all of their contests so far this season have been played away. The women's ice hockey team at Robert Morris are also home this weekend with contests against Mercyhurst set up before the men's games versus Army.


