OPENING TIP

The Army West Point men's basketball makes its first postseason appearance since 1978 when it takes on NJIT in the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament on Wednesday night. The game will tip off at 7:30 p.m. at the Fleisher Athletic Center and will be broadcast online on WatchCollegeInsider.com.

Seniors Tanner Plomb, Kevin Ferguson and Kyle Wilson earned First, Second and Third Team All-Patriot League honors, respectively. In addition to his second-team nod, Ferguson landed on the conference's inaugural all-defensive team.

Army's NCAA Tournament aspirations ended when the Black Knights lost to eventual Patriot League Tournament champion Holy Cross in the semifinal round. The Crusaders raced out to a 10-0 lead and never trailed in the 60-38 result on March 6. The Black Knights were forced into 18 turnovers in the loss. Kyle Wilson and Tanner Plomb each finished in double figures, with Wilson netting a team-high 12 points and Plomb coming away with 11 points and nine boards. Larry Toomey added five points and nine rebounds and Kevin Ferguson totaled four points and a game-high 11 rebounds.

NJIT enters the 26-team CIT field with a 17-14 record and closed the Atlantic Sun regular season with an 8-6 mark to finish second in the conference. Last year, NJIT won three games in the CIT before bowing out in the semifinal round.

Army has played 22 games with its regular starting lineup of Dylan Cox, Kyle Wilson, Plomb, Larry Toomey and Kevin Ferguson. In those games, Army is 15-7, averages 80 points per game, and outscores its opponents by 3.3 points per game thanks to an average of 9.2 threes per game. Cox has a 104-52 assist-to-turnover ratio, Wilson is scoring 16.7 points per game and Ferguson averages 13.8 points and 10.5 rebounds. When Ferguson and Plomb both start, Army has an 18-7 record.

In the 10 contests without its traditional starting five, Army's scoring drops to 71.4 points per game and the Black Knights are making 8.4 threes per game. The Black Knights are 4-6 in those games.

Kevin Ferguson is the conference's all-time leader in field goal percentage. He led the league with a 61.2 percent shooting percentage during the regular season and was first in rebounding with 9.7 per game. His 3.93 offensive rebounds per game ranks 10th in the nation. In addition, Ferguson averages 13.3 points per game and has totaled 12 double doubles, which is the highest total in the league.

Tanner Plomb is 35th in the country and leads the Patriot League in scoring with 19.8 points per game. He is currently 13th in Academy history in scoring with 1,339 career points. Plomb ranks third in the league in three-point field-goal percentage at 35.2 percent and is third in three-pointers made with 76 on the year. The last time an Army player averaged better than 20 ppg was Mark Lueking in 1994-95 (24.4 ppg).

Kyle Wilson averaged 16.2 points per game, which was fourth in the Patriot League. He led the conference in three-pointers per game (3.13) and was 20th in the nation in that category. Wilson's 99 threes rank 16th in the NCAA and are second on Army's single-season list. Wilson is six points shy of 2,000 for his career.

For the second straight year, Wilson and Plomb were the top scoring duo in the Patriot League. Last year they combined for 33.3 points per game and this season, they are averaging 35.8 points per game. They have combined for 1,048 points this year, which is fourth-best in Army history for a scoring tandem.

REACHING 1,000

Tanner Plomb and classmate Kyle Wilson were the third teammates from the same graduating class to reach the 1,000-point mark, joining 1981 graduates Bob Brown (1,282) and Marty Coyne (1,126) and 1990 graduates Todd Mattson (1,122) and Steve Rothert (1,054). When Kevin Ferguson joined the 1,000-point club at Boston University, the trio became the first three classmates to score 1,000 career points in Army history. Dylan Cox reached the 1,000-point mark against Lehigh and the group became the first four classmates in Patriot League history to accomplish the feat.

ROAD, SWEET ROAD

Army owns an 11-5 road record this season. The 11 road wins are the most in program history. Army's 11 road wins are the most in a season since the 1976-77 campaign when Mike Krzyzewski guided the Black Knights to a then program-record 10 road wins.

THREE IS BETTER THAN TWO

Army has made at least nine threes in 17 games and is averaging 8.9 three-point field goals per contest this season, which is 34th in the country. The Black Knights lead the conference and are 17th in the nation in three-point attempts (844). Kyle Wilson (3.09) is 21st in the nation in threes per game and Tanner Plomb is 41st (2.81). Army is shooting 33.6 percent from three-point land and 34.7 percent of its points have come via the three-pointer (KenPom.com), which is 50th in the NCAA.

STARTERS REUNITE

Tanner Plomb and Kevin Ferguson returned to the starting lineup at Lafayette on February 3 and combined for 39 points and 20 rebounds in the overtime victory. Army trailed by as many as 18 points, including 15 at halftime, but erased its largest deficit since 1996 in a victory en route to the 84-81 triumph. The win snapped a four-game losing skid for the Black Knights.

COX SETS ASSIST RECORD AT LAFAYETTE

Dylan Cox had a milestone night against Lafayette as he became to Academy's all-time leader in assists (475). Cox passed Randy Cozzens '85 (430 career assists) and was also one of four Army players to score in double figures with 13 points. Army is 7-1 this season when four players score at least 10 points.

ELITE COMPANY

Dylan Cox joins Randy Cozzens '85 as the only players in Army history to eclipse the 1,000-point, 500-rebound, 400-assist and 50-steal marks in their careers. He became the 14th Army player to reach the 500-rebound mark and the 32nd player to score 1,000 points.

CLEANING THE GLASS

Army is outrebounding its opponents by an average of 3.5 boards per game, which is second in the Patriot League. Ferguson leads the Patriot League and is 28th in the country in rebounding with 9.8 boards per game. Ferguson is 10th in the nation in offensive rebounds with 3.93 per contest.

2016 COLLEGEINSIDER.COM POSTSEASON TOURNAMENT

March 2016 will bring with it the 8th Annual CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) and for the fourth straight season the CIT will be broadcast on CBS Sports Network.

The CIT was created to give deserving teams an opportunity to participate in the postseason. The CIT has had more schools make their postseason debut (25) and more programs win their first-ever postseason game (24) than all other tournaments combined during the seven seasons since the CIT was established in 2009.

The 26-team field is made up of non-BCS programs, not selected to participate in the NCAA or NIT (ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 and SEC teams are not considered). All 31 games are played on campus sites. In an effort to minimize travel and limit class time missed, the CIT uses the old NIT model, with future round opponents determined by results of previous round. This ensures geographic stability. The 2009 and 2010 Tournaments were contested by 16 teams. The 2011 CIT consisted of 24 teams. The field expanded to 32 in 2012.

SPIKER CLIMBING WINS LIST

Zach Spiker has recorded 102 victories in his seven seasons at West Point. Spiker, Bob Knight and Mike Krzyzewski are the only three coaches in Army history to win at least 65 games in their first five seasons. Knight and Spiker are the only two to win at least 75 games in their first six seasons.

Spiker has been responsible for seven straight double-digit win seasons. He is the only Army coach to win at least 10 games in seven consecutive seasons. Knight had a six-season run from 1965-71.

Spiker has led Army to four straight 15-win seasons for the first time since the program had four 15-win seasons in a row from 1920-24.

Zach Spiker is 45-65 in Patriot League play during his seven seasons. It is the most league wins by an Army coach since joining the conference for the 1990-91 season.

Army has gone 33-35 in the last four seasons. The Black Knights posted winning conference records in two straight years for the first time in program history in 2012-13 and 2013-14.

Zach Spiker's substitution patterns will keep the table crew and broadcasters on their toes. Army will substitute as many as five players at a time as early as the first whistle.

PACE!!!

Overall, the Black Knights have the 33rd-ranked offensive tempo in the country according to Ken Pomeroy. Army's offense has an adjusted tempo of 72.8, which is an estimate of the possessions per 40 minutes a team would have against the average D-I tempo. Army's average offensive possession length is 15.2 seconds, which is 11th in the nation.

FREE BASKETBALL

During Zach Spiker's tenure, Army is 7-7 in overtime games, including a 2-2 mark in double-overtime contests. The last time Army played a triple OT game was Feb. 14, 2009 when it beat Lehigh 82-75. Army is 3-1 in overtime games this year after beating Navy in double OT, 100-99.

INTERMISSION INFORMATION

Army is 74-24 since the start of the 2009-10 season when leading at the break. In that span, Army is 18-15 when leading by five or less, 23-6 when its lead is between six and nine points, and 33-3 when holding a double-digit lead. In that same time frame, Army is 8-6 when tied, 15-22 when trailing by five or less and 1-34 when down by double digits. Army's lone win during the Spiker era when trailing at halftime by double digits was at Lafayette on Feb. 3, 2016 when Army overcame a 41-26 deficit.

DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE

Dating back to 2009-10, Army has posted a 43-13 record when holding foes to 60 points or less, including a 7-1 mark this season.

The Black Knights are 63-31 during that time when keeping their opponents below 70 points.

Army is 31-74 when the opposition scores 70 or more points, including a 1-14 mark when surrendering 90 points.

SPIKER HONORS KNIGHT

Army's game at Bryant on Dec. 8 marked the 50th anniversary of former Army head coach Bob Knight's first coaching victory, a 71-62 win over Worcester Tech (12/8/65). Knight coached six seasons at West Point and led the Black Knights to a 102-50 record before eventually compiling a 902-371 career record over 42 seasons at Indiana (29 years) and Texas Tech (seven years). For the game, Zach Spiker wore a sweater to honor the accomplishments of coach Knight and his players from the 1965 Army team and Army beat Bryant, 77-55.

SWEEPING THE EAGLES

Army built a nine-point halftime lead it never relinquished in a 65-59 victory at American. Senior center Kevin Ferguson recorded a double-double of 20 points and 14 rebounds to pave the way as Army swept the season series against American.

The win gave Army 15 wins for the fourth straight year, marking the second time in Army history it has won at least 15 games in four consecutive seasons. The other group to accomplish the feat were the Army teams from 1920-24.

PLOMB TAKES SECOND LEAGUE AWARD

After helping lead the Army men's basketball team to its fifth straight victory, Plomb was named the Patriot League Player of the Week on Dec. 14. It marked the second time this season Plomb was recognized by the Patriot League and the third weekly honor of his career.

Plomb and the Black Knights knocked off Service Academy rival Air Force, 90-80, in Colorado Springs, Colo., to improve to 8-2 for the second straight season. It was Army's first-ever victory in a true road game against the Falcons and Plomb also became the 30th player in Army history to reach the 1,000-point mark for his career.

The senior forward from Mukwonago, Wis., averaged 22 points over Army's two road victories against Air Force and Bryant. Plomb scored 15 of his 18 points against Air Force after halftime and converted 10-of-11 free-throw attempts, which equaled his career high. In the win over Bryant, Plomb did his damage from beyond the arc with six three-pointers en route to a game-high 26 points.

EDWARDS GRABS PATRIOT LEAGUE HONOR

For the second consecutive week, an Army men's basketball player was selected as the Patriot League's Player of the Week, as Kennedy Edwards was voted as the conference's standout performer on Dec. 7.

The junior forward delivered a career-best effort in Army's lone game of the week, an 84-71 road triumph against Maine, to help the Black Knights win their third straight game. Edwards registered a 21 points on 8-of-11 shooting, including a 4-for-5 show from beyond the arc. He also hauled in five rebounds and three steals in a career-high 28 minutes off the bench for the Black Knights. Fifteen of Edwards' points came in the first half as Army raced out to its largest halftime lead of the season at 50-21.

Army's win improved it to 6-2 for the second year in a row and the award is the first of Edwards' career. It followed Tanner Plomb's honor from the week prior.

STREAK SNAPPED

Tanner Plomb had scored in double figures in 30 consecutive games before being held to eight in Army's 72-68 win over Holy Cross. He had 16 performances of at least 20 points during the streak.

FERGUSON EARNS MULTIPLE HONORS (2/22)

Ferguson was named Co-Player of the Week by the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association, Patriot League Men's Basketball Player of the Week, ECAC Division I Men's Basketball Player of the Week, as well as the American Sports Network Men's Basketball Player of the Week.

Ferguson started the week with a career-high 25 points on a 12-of-16 shooting performance and pulled down 13 rebounds in a 72-68 victory against Holy Cross on Wednesday, before totaling 22 points and a career-best 19 rebounds in an 80-78 double-overtime victory at Navy. One of Ferguson's seven offensive boards came before he scored on a putback with 0.7 seconds left to lift the Black Knights to the win.

For the week, Ferguson made 20-of-30 shots (66.7%) and averaged 23.5 points and 16.0 rebounds per contest. Ferguson has 14 double-doubles and 18 double-digit rebounding games in his career, and also had four straight and eight-career outings of 20 points or more. He had six double-doubles in a row as Army was 5-1 since his return to the starting lineup at Lafayette.

NAVY NAIL BITER

Kyle Wilson's three-pointer at the end of regulation sent the game to overtime and Kevin Ferguson's putback with 0.7 seconds left in the second OT gave Army an 80-78 victory over Navy. Ferguson registered his sixth consecutive double-double with 22 points and a career-high 19 rebounds to lead the Black Knights. Tanner Plomb scored a game-high 24 and Kyle Wilson had 11 in the win. Dylan Cox handed out a game-high eight assists. Army trailed by 13 with 8:36 to play and by five with less than 30 seconds remaining.

The win improved Army to 17-11 on the season, including an 8-8 mark in Patriot League play, and gave the Black Knights their most wins since the 1977-78 season.

2015 BARCLAYS CENTER CLASSIC

Army defeated Arkansas - Pine Bluff (81-60) and Gardner-Webb (103-98) to claim the Barclays Center Classic title. Tanner Plomb recorded his first-career 30-point game with a 31-point outburst, including seven three-pointers in the win against the Runnin' Bulldogs in overtime of the championship game. Kevin Ferguson posted his sixth-career double-double against Gardner-Webb and became the 13th player in Academy history to reach 500 career rebounds. Army reached the 100-point mark for the first time during the Spiker era and the 17th time in Academy history. The 201 combined points tied the Christl Arena record (Army 113, Bethany 88 - Jan. 8, 2001) and Army's 27 assists tied the program record.

NEW LOOK

Army West Point Athletics introduced a new brand and identity system in April 2015 that sets the visual direction for years to come. With the goal of developing an innovative and consistent athletic identity that pays tribute to the Academy's legacy and tradition, U.S. Army and Academy leadership, Army West Point Athletics, Nike, current and former cadet-athletes, coaches, historians and West Point graduates, collaborated on a nearly 18-month brand evolution program. As part of the new identity, every athletic programs will showcase consistent logos, colors, lettering and numerals.

The primary mark, referred to as Athena's Shield, showcases four unique components.

- The shield is among West Point's most potent symbols and represents the mission of the U.S. Army to support and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and domestic.

- The helmet was worn by Pallas Athena, the Greek goddess of wisdom, just war, skill and justice. The helmet faces dexter, Latin for "right" from the viewpoint of the bearer of the field as opposed to sinister. The dexter side is considered the side of greater honor. The 13 segments that connect the helmet and the plume reference the 13 British colonies that declared independence from the Kingdom of Great Britain and became the first states in the Union.

- The sword, also known as Xiphos, is a double-edged, single-hand sword used by the ancient Greeks. It symbolizes the scholar-warrior and signifies protection, righteousness and justice. While the original 1898 USMA crest had the sword sheathed, the sword here is unsheathed to allow the viewer to see the martial elements of Army West Point, the warrior spirit, more clearly.

- The star has multiple meanings, including the connection to the U.S. Army and its storied past. During World War II, every tank, truck and airplane in the U.S. Army sported a star as they fought to victory in Europe and the Pacific. The star also represents the connection to the American people and 50 stars from the flag.

On first reference broadcasters, print and digital media members are encouraged to use **Army West Point**. From there, simply **Army** or **Black Knights** are acceptable when referring to the team. **Cadets** is also an acceptable secondary reference, in addition to **Black Knights**. For scoreboards and score graphics, **ARMY** is permissible.

SENIOR STARTERS

Army is the only team in the nation to regularly feature a starting lineup consisting of all seniors. The Black Knights typically open the game with Dylan Cox, Kyle Wilson, Larry Toomey, Tanner Plomb and Kevin Ferguson in the starting five, a combination that has been together 22 times in 2015-16.

WINNING WAYS

The Class of 2016 is responsible for 65 victories over its four seasons. Those 65 wins are the most victories for any class since 1971 when that group graduated with 71 wins. The four Army teams from 1966-70 posted a program-best 73 wins.

FDU TRIUMPH

Army's 96 points at FDU equaled the most for a Zach Spiker coached team in regulation and the Black Knights set a new field-goal percentage record during the Spiker era with their 64.8 percent effort (35-of-54). Army totaled 25 assists, including a career-high 11 by Dylan Cox as he posted the third double-double of his career. Cox's 11 assists were the most for an Army player since Josh Miller '10 had 11 against Brown on Jan. 2, 2008.

In addition, Ferguson reached the 20-point mark for the fourth time in his career and Wilson's 36 points were the most for an Army player since Ella Ellis '13 put in 37 at Yale on Nov. 24, 2012.

CAPTAINS ANNOUNCED

The Black Knights named their 2015-16 team captains prior to the start of the season. Seniors Dylan Cox, Tanner Plomb, Larry Toomey and Kyle Wilson were chosen by their teammates. Cox is in his third season as a team captain, linking him with Matt Bell '07 as the only three-year captains in program history.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

Army's roster features seven seniors, which is tied for the most in program history.

Army returned 91.6 percent of its scoring and 92.9 percent of its rebounding from last season.

The Black Knights added nine players as part of the Class of 2019.

Army's roster has players from 13 different states. North Carolina is home to five players, the most of any single state.

Army returned 140 of a possible 150 starts from the 2014-15 season, which is the second-most during Zach Spiker's tenure.

2014-15 HOT START

Army's 2-0 start was its first to include victories against two Division I opponents since 1970-71 when Bob Knight coached Army.

Army's first 3-0 start since the 2001-02 campaign and was 3-0 to start the season for the first time versus current Division I opponents since Bob Knight's team opened the 1968-69 season with consecutive wins over Lehigh, Cornell and Temple.

First time Army opened the season with four straight wins versus current Division I opponents since 1939. Started 4-0 for the first time since the 1978-79 season when Mike Krzyzewski held the position of head coach.

Army's first 5-0 start since the 1976-77 campaign and first 5-0 start versus current Division I opponents since 1939. First 6-1 start since the 1978-79 campaign. First 7-2 start since the 2009-10 season. First 10-3 start since the 1978-79 campaign.

Army started 6-1 on the road to mark its best road start since the 1976-77 campaign.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

Army achieved its highest team grade-point average in 10 years - 2.84 GPA in the fall 2014 semester. Seven players named to West Point Dean's List in the fall, including five returning players. Mac Hoffman (3.571 GPA), Larry Toomey (3.122), Dylan Cox (3.089), Austin Williamson (3.086) and Jacob Kessler (3.083).

Hoffman and Cox landed on the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll. Hoffman was one of only five Patriot League student-athletes to post a GPA of 4.0 or higher with his 4.008 score during the spring. Cox registered a 3.204 GPA to make his first appearance on the list. Hoffman, Cox and Richard Brown (3.011) also were placed on the West Point Dean's List for the spring semester.

BRANCH NIGHT

On Nov. 19, all members of the First Class (senior) assembled inside Eisenhower Hall for Branch Night. The Commandant, Brig. Gen. John C. Thomson III, spoke about the importance of the evening in relation to the future officers' chosen profession in the Army.

For the first three years at the Academy each cadet receives information about each of the 16 Branches. By the time Branch Night occurs they will understand what the normal duties, responsibilities, assignment patterns and locations are for each of the Branches. Late in the Cow Year (junior) each cadet must indicate, by order of preference all specialties for which they are qualified and eligible. Branches are then assigned according to performance, preference and current Branch goals [which means what the Army needs at that time].

Envelopes were then handed out to the Firsties that contained the insignia of the Branch to which they were assigned. On order the cadets opened their envelopes at one time. Exultation, cheers, groans, high-fives and more could be heard coming from Ike Hall once the envelopes were opened. Relaxation and refreshment with the Branch representative and the other members of their Branch "family" followed the news.

SPIKER VISITS TROOPS IN KOREA

Head men's basketball coach Zach Spiker, head women's basketball coach Dave Magarity and Director of Athletics Boo Corrigan visited Korea in late May to witness the U.S. Army's operations in the country.

The weeklong trip offered Corrigan, Magarity and Spiker the opportunity to speak with graduates and faculty and to tour a number of Army bases with some of the soldiers who are deployed. The group was also accompanied by a contingent of West Point representatives, including Superintendent Lt. Gen. Robert Caslen.

"It was a very educational, humbling and motivating experience," Spiker said. "We saw former players, cadet-athletes and West Point grads in high-ranking leadership positions everywhere we went. Army West Point Athletics was well represented and it was an honor to see how our Army soldiers work and what they do on a daily basis."

"The trip to Korea and the National Training Center was one of the most memorable experiences I've ever had," Magarity said. "To visit the Demilitarized Zone and see what our soldiers are up against in terms of defending and supporting the South Koreans and to watch the training at Camp Irwin, was absolutely remarkable."

On the first full day in Korea, the group toured the United States Forces Korea base before speaking with Academy graduates at a West Point graduates luncheon.

The trip also included a visit to the Demilitarized Zone (DMZ) along the border of North Korea and South Korea and a tour of the Joint Security Area. The travel party flew by helicopter to Camp Casey to witness static display tours of a number of military vehicles.

Included on the trip back to West Point was a stop at the National Training Center in Fort Irwin, Calif., to observe a realistic training session before returning to New York.

ELLIS '13 SELECTED IN NBA D-LEAGUE DRAFT

Former Army men's basketball standout Ella Ellis was selected by the Maine Red Claws in the 2015 NBA Development League Draft on Oct. 31. Ellis, a 2013 graduate of the U.S. Military Academy, earned an invite to Red Claws' training camp, which began on Nov. 3.

Ellis was Maine's second pick of the draft and was chosen in the second round at 31st overall. The Red Claws serve as the minor league affiliate of the NBA's Boston Celtics and are one of 19 D-League teams, who each have a direct association to an NBA franchise.

Ellis graduated as Army's fifth all-time leading scorer with 1,585 career points. He is the only player in Academy history to amass at least 1,500 points, 450 rebounds (466), 150 assists (161) and 40 blocked shots (45). Ellis was Army's first two-time member of the All-Patriot League First Team since 1996 and captured second-team All-NABC District 13 honors in consecutive seasons, a program first since all-time leading scorer Kevin Houston (1986-87).

KNICKS CAMP AT CHRISTL

For the second consecutive year, the New York Knickerbockers of the National Basketball Association held their annual preseason training camp at the United States Military Academy.

The team, under the direction of second-year head coach Derek Fisher, arrived at West Point on Monday, Sept. 28 and conducted a team building session at the start of camp. Tuesday morning the Knicks visited the Arvin Cadet Physical Development Center where they witnessed combative and boxing training, indoor obstacle course testing (IOCT) in Hayes Gymnasium, and aquatics and lifetime sport instruction at Crandall Pool, as well as cadet training in the Combat Water Survival Lab.

The team held two practices each day on Tuesday and Wednesday at Christl Arena, the home of the Army men's and women's basketball programs, including a Wednesday evening session that was open for Cadets to attend. An autograph and photo session with the Knicks followed the workout.

On Wednesday afternoon, Knicks President Phil Jackson, a 13-time NBA champion, and Willis Reed, one of the 50 Greatest Players in NBA History and a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer spoke to the Army football team.

Thursday morning, the Knicks staged a team photo at Trophy Point prior to their only practice and later in the evening the team shared a meal with cadets in the Cadet Mess Hall inside Washington Hall.

THE CLASS OF 2019

Approximately 1,270 cadet candidates, including 280 women, 425 minorities, 17 international cadets and 13 combat veterans began Cadet Basic Training this summer.

The incoming class was selected from a pool of 16,000 applicants. The 280 women represent 22 percent of the class. Minority enrollment, roughly 33 percent, includes 189 African-Americans, 93 Asian-Americans, 119 Hispanic-Americans and 10 Native Americans.

The Class of 2019 includes cadets from every state in the nation and 17 international cadets entering the class under the sponsorship of their respective countries. The countries represented include Bangladesh, Guyana, Mongolia, Montenegro, Netherlands, Malaysia, Pakistan (two), Panama, Philippines, Romania, Rwanda, Saudi Arabia, Taiwan, Tanzania, Turkey and the United Arab Emirates. Upon graduation, these cadets will return to their respective countries as officers in their armed forces.

KEY NCAA RULE CHANGES

Shot clock reduced from 35 seconds to 30 seconds.

Restricted arc expanded from three feet to four feet.

Reduction of 30-second timeouts from four to three; only two carry over to the second half.

A 30-second timeout called within 30 seconds of a media timeout will become the media timeout.

Coaches can only call timeouts during a dead ball situation.

Removed the five-second closely guarded count.

Officials will be able to use instant replay to look at the release of the ball on potential shot clock violations at any point during the game for made baskets only.

PRESEASON POLL

Army was picked to finish fourth in the Patriot League's annual preseason poll. The Black Knights earned 108 points in the poll. Lehigh claimed the top spot with 156 points and 12 first-place votes, the defending regular-season champions Bucknell finished second in the voting with 150 points and eight first-place nods, while Boston University was third with 126 points.

Behind the Black Knights was American (84), defending conference champions Lafayette (82) and Loyola (73) in seventh. Holy Cross (50), Colgate (36) and Navy (36) rounded out the list.

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The Crusaders earned a spot in the Patriot League Championship with their third straight road victory and ended Army's NCAA Tournament hopes. The Black Knights have the potential to play postseason basketball with their 19-13 record, and the 19 victories are the most since the 1977-78 season.

Kyle Wilson and Tanner Plomb each finished in double figures, with Wilson netting a team-high 12 points and Plomb coming away with 11 points and nine boards. Larry Toomey added five points and nine rebounds and Kevin Ferguson totaled four points and a game-high 11 rebounds.

Robert Champion led the way for the Crusaders (13-19) with 15 points to go along with six boards. Malachi Alexander tallied 13 points and seven rebounds and Anthony Thompson ended the afternoon with 12 points, seven rebounds and five assists.

Holy Cross raced out to a 10-0 lead on consecutive threes by Alexander and Thompson and took advantage of four Army turnovers in the first three minutes. A Wilson three after an offensive rebound put the Black Knights on the board at 16:45. Turnovers haunted the Black Knights throughout the game as they finished with 18 compared to Holy Cross' nine.

Alexander and Plomb traded threes and by the 11-minute mark, Holy Cross had an 18-6 lead following consecutive threes by Matt Husek and Karl Charles.

Holy Cross opened the game 6-for-11 from beyond the arc after consecutive triples by Champion pushed the lead back to 12 (24-12) four minutes later. A Wilson corner jumper pulled Army back within single digits and sparked a 9-2 run for the Black Knights that cut the deficit to 26-21 with 3:20 left. Wilson's third three of the period punctuated the run.

Holy Cross went into halftime with a 34-26 lead after shooting 45.2 percent (14-for-31) from the floor. The Crusaders limited Army to 26.9 percent shooting on the other end (7-for-26). Army had nine first-half turnovers, compared to two for the Crusaders, with Wilson (12) and Plomb (8) combining for 20 points.

Army opened the second half with a three from Larry Toomey, but Holy Cross came back with six straight points to take a 40-29 lead and never looked back.

The run continued when Charles hit three in opposite corners, surrounding a layup by Toomey. A free throw by Alexander and two Husek free throws extended the spurt and put the Crusaders up by 18 (49-31) with 13 minutes remaining. Three minutes later, a reverse layup by Thompson capped the 17-2 run and extended the lead to 20.

Army never got any closer than 18 the rest of the way in the 22-point loss.
