## MAJOR AWARDS AND ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE SELECTIONS

• Army garnered three-of-five major awards from the Patriot League with five Black Knights earning All-Patriot League distinction.

• Kasey McCravey was tabbed the 2016 Player of the Year after being named the league's Defensive Player of the Year in 2015. She also earned first team All-Patriot League honors for the third time in her career, and was named to the second team as a sophomore.

• This is the sixth time in program history that a Black Knight bears this award as she joins Paula Bostwick, Sheri Schweiker and Hall of Famers Colleen McCabe and Nicki Robbins. Robbins was a three-time recipient.

• McCravey led the league in hitting this season with a .403 average. She boasted a league-leading 60 runs, 75 hits, 109 total bases, 30 stolen bases, 214 plate appearances and 186 at-bats. McCravey has broken Army's single-season records in runs scored and total bases, while eclipsing the top spot in five career categories including runs (171), RBI (159), home runs (26) and walks (79).

• Renee Poirier was given the honor of Rookie of the Year after leading the nation in saves the entire season. She is the third Cadet to earn this honor, joining Lindsey Gerheim and Morgan Lashley.

• Poirier broke the program and league record for single-season saves with seven on March 26. She is one save away from tying the career saves record of 12 held by Ashley Christian for both Army and the league.

• Head coach Michelle DePolo garnered the Coach of the Year title for the second time in her career at West Point. She led the team to a 37-18 record and eclipsed the 200 wins mark when the team defeated Yale 6-1 on April 6.

• Alea Rashenskis was named to the first team for the first time in her career after batting .382 with nine doubles, two triples, drove in 32 runs and scored 28 times collecting 68 hits. She also posted 81 total bases along with nine stolen bases.

• Kristen McPeck also earned first-team honors for the first time of her career as the at-large selection. The outfielder played stellar defensively from right field and worked her way

up the batting order as the season progressed. She closed-out the regular season batting .370 in league contests off 20 hits with 23 total bases.

• Emily Gray was named to the second team at the first base position after she garnered first team accolades in 2015 as the designated player. This season, the Naples, Fla., native batted .362 (50-for-138) and added 10 doubles and one home run. She drove in 34 runs on the season and scored 19 times.

• Caroline Smith earned the second team nod for the first time in her career and did so at the designated player position. From the circle, she posted a 1.56 ERA in league contests with only 11 earned runs against and held her opponents to a batting average of .223. Smith compiled an overall record of 15-4 this season and logged a team-leading 136 innings, including four complete games with 41 strikeouts.

• Smith pitched the first no-hitter of her career in the team's 7-0 victory over the Hawks. She was one play away from the perfect game after retiring 19-straight batters. It was the seventh no-hitter in program history and the first since 2011.

### GAME NOTES

**TEAMS: #1 LEHIGH • #2 ARMY • #3 BOSTON U. • #4 BUCKNELL**

- The Black Knights took away three-of-five Patriot League Major Awards:
  - Kasey McCravery - Player of the Year
  - Renee Poirier - Rookie of the Year
  - Michelle DePolo - Coach of the Year
- Army had a record-breaking regular season with 37 wins. The previous record was 35 set by the 2012 squad.
- It was the first time since 2013 that the Cadets had reached double-digit league victories. The most was 14 set back in 2012.
- 2016 marks the Black Knights' seventh-straight berth to the tournament. It is the 22nd time that the Cadets have made it to the league tournament. The Black Knights have made it to the tournament final 12 times.
- This season, Army boasts a 7-2 mark against the tournament field with three-game sweeps over Boston U. and Bucknell and a 1-2 performance against Lehigh.
- The hosting Mountain Hawks went 5-3 against the field. They split their series 1-1 against the Terriers and lost one game a piece to the Bison and Cadets to finish 13-4 in the league.
- Boston U. returns to the tournament after missing the cut last season and winning the title in 2014. The Terriers finished league play with an 11-6 record. They went 3-5 against opponents at the tournament.
- Bucknell is 3-6 against the four teams in attendance as the Bison picked up a solo win from each team to wrap-up conference play at 11-7.
- DePolo is in her seventh season at the helm of the Black Knights. During her tenure, Army has qualified for the Patriot League Tournament every year, and hosted as the regular season champions in 2010.
- Army's head coach is the seventh in school history. DePolo is the second female coach, but the first at the Division I ranks and is second on the Black Knights' all-time chart with 216 wins. She eclipsed the 200 win mark faster than any other coach in program history.
- DePolo has led the Black Knights to the Championship round twice, 2012 and 2013, capturing the crown in the latter.
- The Black Knights captured Patriot League championships in 1991, 1992, 2000, 2002 and 2013, the last two as the No. 2 seed.
- Army softball is in 38th year as a varsity sport.

- The team earned a bye in 2000.
