## ARMY STORYLINES

**WHAT HAPPENED LAST GAME** – Army saw its first loss of the 2025-26 season on Saturday night, falling to the University of St. Thomas Tommies (1-1), 76-83. Five Black Knights finished the game in double digits. Jacen Holloway and Jorn Everson finished with 16 points each. Jackson Furman added 15 points off the bench, Kevin McCarthy added 14 and Ryan Curry finished with 10 points in his first game of the season.

**THE WALLET** – A role player off Army's bench last season, Kevin McCarthy played an active role in Army's first two games of the season. In Army's game against Maritime, the sophomore sharpshooter scored a career-high 18 points and also added career-highs in field goals made (7), three-pointers made (4) steals (3), and minutes (28). He also tied his career-high in three-pointers made against St. Thomas on Saturday.

**THE SIXTH MAN** – Freshman guard Jackson Furman made an immediate impact for the Black Knights, tying McCarthy in averaging 16.0 points off the bench in only 16.3 minutes a game. Furman earned 17 points in his first collegiate game, the most a freshman has scored in his debut in 11 seasons and the second most since 2000. Tanner Omlid was the last Black Knight with numbers similar to Furman, scoring 18 points in his collegiate debut against Air Force on Nov. 8, 2013. Furman also finished with 15 points in 12 minutes against the Tommies.

**THE BOOGEYMAN** – Sophomore forward Jacen Holloway also saw a strong showing in Army's opening week of play. He finished Saturday's game with a team-high and career-high 16 points and tied his personal and season best in made field goals (5), rebounds (4) and assists (2). The sophomore also set career-highs in free throws made (5) and minutes (29). He also set several career-highs in Army's season opener against Maritime.

**JORNADO WARNING** – Jorn Everson played a key role off Army's bench last season and now serves as a primary member of Army's starting lineup. The senior had a strong showing against the Tommies, finishing with a team-high and season-best 16 points, while adding a career-high seven rebounds in 35 minutes of play, also a career-best. He also had season-bests in field goals made (7), three-pointers made (2) and assists (3).

**TATE ON THE BOARD** – Junior forward Tate Laczowski, the tallest player on Army's roster, serves as the biggest rebounding threat for Army. Laczowski has led the team in rebounding in both matchups, earning nine rebounds in his first career start against Maritime and a season-high eight rebounds against St. Thomas. The junior also added four points and one block against Maritime and five points in a career-high 31 minutes against St. Thomas.

**CHEF (RYAN) CURRY** – Curry returned to the court on Saturday for his third season after serving as a key role in for the Black Knights for the past two seasons. In his first game back, the junior finished with 10 points and added a team-high seven assists plus six rebounds. Last season, the junior played in all 33 of Army's games, starting in all but one matchup. He finished last season averaging 12.5 points a game, the third-highest on the team, plus led the team in assists and three-point percentage.

**FOR THE YOUNG GUNS** – The Black Knights' roster will look different this season after graduating an eight-person senior class. Now on the 18-man roster, there are five upperclassmen and 13 underclassmen, with nine sophomores and four freshmen. The new freshmen joining Army include Jackson Furman, Dillon Watt, Dylan Benner and Jahaan Green. Before joining the Academy, Furman, Benner and Green each played a year at the United States Military Academy Preparatory School (USMAPS).

**HELD IN HIGH REGARD** – Team captain, Jackson Mayo, was named USMA's Deputy Brigade Commander, the second-highest-ranked position in the Corps of Cadets, over the summer. The senior started the season scoring six points with two made three-pointers in Army's season-opener win against Maritime.

Army opened the game with early baskets from Jorn Everson and Kevin McCarthy, with Jacen Holloway facilitating and attacking the rim to set the tone offensively.

However, St. Thomas quickly established control with sharp execution on both ends. The Tommies built early momentum, creating a 10-point cushion midway through the first half.

The Black Knights responded with patience and poise on offense. Ryan Curry orchestrated the half-court sets effectively, setting up McCarthy and Furman for open looks from beyond the arc.

Around the eight-minute mark, McCarthy's pull-up three and Holloway's made free throws gave Army a spark that cut the deficit to single digits.

Despite Army's offensive rhythm improving, St. Thomas' inside attack proved difficult to contain. Everson battled in the paint, scoring on a hook shot and finding Tate Laczkowski on an alley-oop to keep Army within range.

In the closing minutes of the half, Furman and McCarthy buried back-to-back three-pointers to momentarily shift momentum, but St. Thomas closed the half strong with a quick 6-0 run. Army trailed 44-29 at halftime, but showed glimpses of offensive cohesion that would carry into the second half.

Army came out of the locker room determined to close the gap, and its renewed intensity was immediately evident.

Holloway sparked the offense with back-to-back drives, while Everson scored on a pair of hook shots inside to ignite a 10-4 Army run early in the half.

Curry's steady ball movement led to open looks for teammates, and his assist to McCarthy for a corner three trimmed the deficit to 64-55 at the midpoint of the half.

The Black Knights' offense found balance during this stretch, Everson was effective in the post, Holloway attacked the lane with confidence, and Furman added scoring from midrange and beyond the arc.

McCarthy drilled another three from the wing to keep the Tommies' defense honest, and Army's defensive pressure began to force St. Thomas into late-clock possessions.

However, each Army run was met by an answer from St. Thomas, and proved to halt Army's momentum each time the deficit narrowed to single digits.

In the final four minutes, Army refused to go quietly. Everson connected on a deep three, followed by Curry's pull-up triple to make it 77-70. Moments later, McCarthy hit another clutch three off a Curry assist, bringing the Black Knights within six points.

Down the stretch, Furman went a perfect 3-for-3 from the free-throw line to keep Army alive. Despite Army closing the final two minutes of the game on an 17-8 run St. Thomas executed at the stripe in the final seconds to close out the game.

### BLACK KNIGHT BULLET POINTS

- Jorn Everson played a key role in Army's offense, finishing the game with 16 points while shooting 50 percent from the floor. He also added a career-high seven rebounds alongside three assists.
- Jacen Holloway topped his career-high, also scoring 16 points for the Black Knights. The sophomore finished the game shooting 5-7 from the floor, adding five made free throws. He also added four rebounds and two assists.
- Freshman Jackson Furman had another strong showing off the bench for Army, finishing with 15 points while shooting 66.7 percent from the floor and from the three-point line. He added five made free throws.
- Kevin McCarthy had a second consecutive double-digit performance for Army, finishing with 14 points with four made three-pointers.
- Ryan Curry made his return to the floor in the matchup against the Tommies, adding 10 points and a team-high seven assists.
- Tate Laczkowski rounded out the Black Knight scorers, earning a team-high eight rebounds alongside adding five points and two assists.
- Four Black Knights also added a steal in the game: McCarthy Laczkowski, Dillon Watt and Dayon Polk.
- Army finished the game shooting 43.5 percent from the floor and 32.4 percent from the three-point line, while Tommies shot 50 percent from the floor but just 20 percent from the three-point line.
- The Tommies went on to beat Army in the battle of the paint, outscoring Army 50-28 in the paint. St. Thomas also earned 10 points off turnovers, while Army had only four.



# HEAD COACH KEVIN KUWIK

**3RD SEASON (28-39 RECORD) • 3RD CAREER SEASON (28-39 RECORD)**

Kevin Kuwik (COO-ick), was named Army West Point's Lee Anderson Head Men's Basketball Coach on March 29, 2023, and enters his third season in the role during the 2025-26 season.

Kuwik is the 32nd head coach in the program's 122-year history and brings more than 20 seasons of coaching experience to Army West Point.

His second season (2024-25) at the helm was an historic one, with the team finishing 17-16 overall and 10-8 in Patriot League play.

The 10-8 finish in Patriot League play tied for the program's best finish in League play in program history. The Black Knights were also the only team in the Patriot League that season to earn a win over a Group of Five school, defeating the UTSA Roadrunners (American Conference), 78-75.

Two Black Knights also saw Patriot League All-League honorees, with Jalen Rucker being placed on First Team, and Josh Scovens was named to the Second Team. Jalen Rucker also earned All-American honors, being named on the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division I North Atlantic All-District First Team, the only player in the Patriot League to receive those honors.

Army also received a postseason invite to the Purple College Basketball Invitational (CBI), the team's first postseason appearance under Kevin Kuwik. Then, in the opening round of play, the Black Knights shocked Elon University, defeating the Phoenix, 83-78.

The win over Elon broke the program's 55-year postseason tournament win drought, with last postseason win for the program in the postseason coming in the 1970 National Invitational Tournament (NIT) with three wins from Bob Knight and his squad.

In his first season (2023-24) leading the Black Knights, Kuwik's young team went 10-22 overall with a 6-12 mark in the Patriot League. Two of Army's main contributors were freshman, Josh Scovens and Ryan Curry. Scovens went on to win Patriot League Rookie of the Year after leading all Patriot League freshmen in points per game (11.9), rebounds per game (5.2), defensive rebounds per game (4.0), and blocks (1.2). He was also third amongst Patriot League rookies in assists (1.8). Scovens won Patriot League Rookie of the Week five times during the season.

Curry was named to the Patriot League All-Rookie Team starting in 30 of 32 games, averaging 10.2 points per game. Kuwik's signature win came when defeating Navy, capturing the star, as a part of the Army-Navy Star Series in dramatic fashion for the first time since 2020.

## TWO STINTS IN INDIANAPOLIS

Kuwik spent his final season before coming to West Point (2022-23) as an assistant coach at Butler under head coach Thad Matta. His impressive resumé includes both stints working for Matta for two seasons at Ohio State and serving under Brad Stevens at Butler for a single season.

As Butler's director of basketball operations on Brad Stevens's staff during the 2008-09 campaign, Kuwik helped the Bulldogs to a 26-6 record, capturing the Horizon League title and earning a berth in the NCAA Tournament.

## EXPERIENCE IN THE ATLANTIC 10

Before his stop at Butler, he spent five seasons (2017-22) at Davidson with the final four seasons as an assistant coach.

At Davidson, Kuwik helped the Wildcats to a record of 101-52 earning NCAA Tournament berths in 2018 and 2022 while making NIT appearances in 2019 and 2021. Davidson posted an impressive mark of 59-24 in Atlantic 10 play during his tenure. In addition to recruiting and scouting responsibilities, Kuwik worked with the team's frontcourt players, highlighted by 2022 Atlantic 10 Player of the Year Luka Brajkovic.

Before joining Davidson staff, Kuwik spent six seasons (2011-17) at Dayton.

While in Dayton, Kuwik helped the Flyers to a 139-65 overall record, 68-31 conference mark and five postseason appearances (four NCAA Tournaments and one NIT), including a trip to the NCAA Elite Eight in 2014. Kuwik coordinated the Flyers' defense, which ranked 15th nationally according to KenPom during the 2015-16 season.

## TIME IN THE BUCKEYE STATE

As a member of Matta's staff at Ohio State (2009-11), Kuwik served as the video coordinator. He was responsible for opponent scouting as the Buckeyes achieved a 63-11 overall record, Big Ten regular season and tournament championships in consecutive seasons, and a pair of Sweet 16 appearances.

Kuwik was an assistant coach at Ohio from 2001-08 as the Bobcats posted a 120-95 record with two postseason appearances.

The Bobcats' first tournament appearance came in the 2004-05 season. The Bobcats won their fourth MAC tournament championship that season, winning a thrilling overtime matchup against Buffalo, 80-79. The win allowed the program to make its first NCAA tournament appearance in the 2000s, with the team making a Round of 64 appearance against Florida.

Ohio qualified for its second postseason appearance during Kuwik's time in

Athens in the 2007-08 season. After falling in the MAC tournament quarterfinals, the Bobcats received a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI). The team would earn a first-round win over Brown before falling in the quarterfinals to Bradley.

## COACHING BEGINNINGS

Kuwik began his coaching career in 1998 as an assistant coach at Christian Brothers University in Memphis, Tenn. In his two seasons there, the Buccaneers improved from 3-22 to 12-14.

He then went to Saint Michael's College in Vermont to serve in the same role. He helped the Purple Knights to the best season in school history, finishing with a 27-4 record and the No. 3 ranking in the year's final NCAA Division II poll.

## KUWIK'S MILITARY TIES

Kuwik brings strong military ties as he was a Distinguished Military Graduate of Notre Dame's Army ROTC program. He was able to serve 10 years in the military as he also began his coaching career. While serving in Iraq, he earned a Bronze Star for meritorious service (the Army's highest merit award). He received an honorable discharge from the military in 2006.

While coaching at Ohio University, Kuwik took an 18-month leave of absence during 2004-05 to serve with the 113th Engineer Battalion of the Indiana National Guard in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. He used leave time to return to the Bobcats bench and help Ohio win the 2005 Mid-American Conference Tournament title and reach the NCAA Tournament.

## MORE ABOUT COACH KUWIK

A native of Lackawanna, N.Y., Kuwik attended the University of Notre Dame, where he served as a student assistant under former NBA coach John MacLeod for three seasons. Kuwik graduated summa cum laude from Notre Dame with a Mechanical Engineering degree in 1996. In his final year in South Bend, he was Senior Class President.

He has also participated in the prestigious TopConnect Seminar in each of the last three years (2020-22). TopConnect (formerly Villa 7) originated in 2003 by then-VCU Athletic Director Dr. Richard Sander, identifies the top basketball assistant coaches in the country and connects them with mid-major Athletic Directors providing tremendous networking opportunities for both parties.

Kuwik and his wife Kathryn are the proud parents of daughters, Natalie and Cara.
