BLACK KNIGHTS NOTES

A NEW ERA OF ARMY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

- On May 22, 2025, Army West Point Athletics announced the hiring of Katie Kuester as the 10th head coach of the Army West Point women's basketball program.
- A rising star in collegiate coaching, Kuester comes to West Point after a decade-long tenure on the Saint Joseph's coaching staff, where she also played for four seasons from 2008-12.
- Joining Kuester on the bench this season will be associate head coach Maggie Gallagher and assistant coaches Amber Raisner, Mary Sheehan and Janelle Danielson.

BUILDING ON SUCCESS

- Despite a new staff taking over the program this season, the Black Knights will look to build off their success from the 2024-25 season.
- Army won 25 games last year en route to a trip to the Patriot League Tournament championship game and a bid to the WNIT, in which Army defeated Bryant in the opening round.
- Trinity Hardy, Reese Ericson and Fiona Hastick were all named to the All-Patriot League teams following the season.

THE 2025-26 CAPTAINS

- While Army women's basketball is led by a new coaching staff, the captains will remain the same from the 2024-25 season. Reese Ericson – Army's lone senior – and Fiona Hastick will continue their roles from last season as team captains.
- Both players figure to be contributors on and off the court this season. Each averaged over 10 points a game last year.
- Hastick was named to the Preseason All-Patriot League team prior to the 2025-26 season.

ROSTER STABILITY

- In an era of roster turnover, Army will return 10 players from last year's squad and nearly its entire starting lineup.
- Army returners combined for 132 starts last season. Additionally, the Black Knight have just one senior on this year's squad – Reese Ericson – meaning the roster continuity will remain through not just this season but for many more to come.

Army has five new coaches this season, including first-year head coach Katie Kuester. Joining her on the bench is associate head coach Maggie Gallagher and assistant coaches Amber Raisner, Mary Sheehan and Janelle Harrison.

Through three games, Army is dishing out 19.7 assists per game, which ranks first in the Patriot League and 25th in the country. Army had 28 assists – T-2 most in program's DI era – against Pace in the season opener at Christl Arena on Nov. 3.

MEDIA INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

The 2025-26 Army West Point Women's Basketball Game Notes are designed to aid members of the media in the coverage of Black Knight basketball, as well as to serve as a tool to learn more about the United States Military Academy and the staff associated with the basketball program. The staff of the Army Athletics Communications office is eager to assist members of the media with all of their needs during the course of the season. Please feel free to contact our office for information regarding the team, player information, interviews, statistics, travel plans, photography, video highlights and press conferences.

The Army Athletics Communications office has certain policies and procedures that we ask you to abide by while covering the Black Knights. These are for the benefit of your needs and those of Army's cadet-athletes and coaches. If additional information or assistance is required, please contact Army Women's Basketball contact Chad Mays or any other member of the Army Athletics Communications staff. We appreciate your coverage of Army basketball and look forward to working with you this season.

COMMUNICATIONS OFFICE

The Army Athletics Communications office is located in the ODIA Building at 639 Howard Road. The Communications offices are located in the suite of offices on the left side of the building on the first floor.

MEDIA CREDENTIALS

All requests for working media, radio, television, or photo credentials should be made in writing by sports editors or sports directors of accredited media outlets to women's basketball contact Chad Mays. Credentials can be requested for either the whole season or for single games. Late credential requests are not guaranteed to be accommodated. All credential requests should be sent via email to chad.mays@westpoint.edu.

UNAUTHORIZED CREDENTIALS USE

Credentials will be issued to working media only. Media credentials are not transferable and use by anyone other than members of the working media is unauthorized. Media credentials used in an unauthorized manner will be revoked immediately. News organizations allowing unauthorized individuals to use credentials will have their credentials revoked for the remainder of the year.

WEBSITES AND NEW MEDIA

Web-based media sponsoring message boards or chat rooms that allow posting of anonymous information or rumors are ineligible for a basketball credential or access to Army media functions. Spots will not be granted to any online agency operating sites that are in any way affiliated with gambling, or to "freelance" or "fan-based" sites that are not affiliated with a legitimate news gathering organization. Live, real-time updates of Army home games are the property of Army West Point Athletics and unauthorized transmission of such is not permitted.

CHRISTL ARENA MEDIA ROOM

Game notes and flip cards for all games will be digital this season and can be found on the women's basketball website under the "more" tab. Each member on the scorer's table and media row will be provided a flip card upon their arrival to the game.

Upon request, paper statistics can be printed at the scorers' table at the conclusion of the event. If this request is desired, please make the request prior to tip-off. Stat links will be provided on social media and in the game preview release. A final stats booklet will be emailed after the game per request.

A meal will be served one hour prior to tip-off in the media room.

MEDIA PARKING

Parking for the media will be located in the A Lot parking lot, just a short walk from Christl Arena. If media plans on parking in that lot, they must notify Chad Mays no later than 5 p.m. on the day prior to a game.

PLAYER AND COACHES INTERVIEWS

Interviews of Army's coaches and cadet-athletes are encouraged and every effort will be made to accommodate media requests. All interviews should be coordinated through the Athletics Communications office.

Players will be made available for one-on-one virtual interviews or phone interviews throughout the week as their class schedule allows. Head coach Katie Kuester is generally accessible to members of the media. All interview requests should be made through the Athletics Communications office and all interviews will be conducted via Microsoft Teams or phone.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Postgame interviews for the 2025-26 season will be held either at press row or in the Christl Arena media room or upon reporter request. Army's locker room is off limits to media at all times. The visiting team sports information director should be consulted for that school's postgame policies.

MEDIA NOTES

Game notes for Army basketball are made available 24-48 hours prior to the game. A copy of the notes will be available on GoArmyWestPoint.com. The release, which will be posted on the website in a portable document format (.pdf), will include notes, statistics and other pertinent information about that week's opponent and contest.

EMAIL SERVICE

Media outlets may request to be included on the email list to receive daily news regarding Army basketball. To be added to the list, contact the Athletics Communications office and provide email addresses to be included.

WIRELESS INTERNET

Wireless internet is available inside Christl Arena free of charge. Please see a communications representative for a user name and password. Also, please make sure your computer is up to date on anti-virus software, otherwise you will be unable to log in to the internet. If you do not have administrator access on your computer (password to install software) contact the Army Athletics Communications office before arriving on game day.

VISITING RADIO

All visiting radio crews will have two allocated spots on media row across from the visiting team's bench. Credential requests should be made by the visiting team's SID. Ethernet ports are available for use. Please contact Chad Mays if there are any issues getting connected.

We ask that all media entities refer to our athletics teams as simply Army or Army West Point.

Please only use the United States Military Academy when referring to us in official capacity. You may call us Army West Point at first reference as well.

If an abbreviation is needed, Army or AWP are the only acceptable choices. Please DO NOT use shortened versions of Army or Army West Point as abbreviations.

Our teams, both male and female, are to be referred to as the Black Knights.

ARMY VS. THE BIG TEN

• The Black Knights are 0-6 all-time when playing teams in the Big Ten.
• Army's last Big Ten game was in the WNIT against Rutgers this past March. Rutgers won 71-60.

HUNTING FOR THE TOP SPOT

• Army was picked to finish second in the Patriot League Preseason Coaches Poll, finishing just three points behind Navy.
• Army recieved two first-place votes, same as Navy, while Loyola Maryland had the most with three.

LAST TIME OUT

• Army defeated Siena on Thursday night, 67-52, at Christl Arena
• The Black Knights didn't shoot the ball well but went 22-23 from the line. It marked the first time in Army's Division I history that it shot over 95 percent from the line with a minimum of 20 attempts. The next best percentage is when Army went 21-23 (91.3 percent) against Albany in 2003.
• Camryn Tade had a career-high 23 points on 7-11 shooting on Thursday night, eclipsing her previous high of 18 which she set against Boston U., this past January.
• Kya Smith recorded her second consecutive double-double of the season with 10 points and 10 rebounds. She now has 11 in her career. Her 10 boards led all players.

FUN IN THE T(WIN) CITIES

• Army West Point staged a double-digit comeback in the second half to beat St. Thomas, 67-61, to pick up a massive road win in the opening of the Lee & Penny Anderson Arena on Nov. 8.
• Army (2-0) used a 17-0 run that spanned from the end of the third quarter and into the fourth to wipe out St. Thomas' (0-2) 10-point third quarter lead. The Black Knights defense put on the clamps in the final quarter, holding the Tommies to 30.8 percent shooting en route to a 19-10 quarter that gave Head Coach Katie Kuester her first win over a Division I opponent.
• Kya Smith led all players with 20 points and 11 rebounds en route to her first double-double of the season and the 10th of her career.

CONTROLLED THE PACE

• The Black Knights kicked off the Katie Kuester era with an 86-50 win over Pace in the season opener at Christl Arena.
• The Black Knights got double-digit scoring from four players, including a career-high 20 points from Taylor Wilson. Reese Ericson (18), Kya Smith (14) and Reganne Reardon (11) also scored 10-plus points.
• The win was highlighted by Army's 28 assists on 35 made baskets. It marked the second-most assists in a game in the Black Knight's Division I history.
• Army is now 4-14 all-time against Pace but 1-0 in its Division I era.
• With its win over Pace, Army won its season opener for the first time since the 2022-23 campaign.
• Last year Army dropped its season opener at home to Cornell.

• The Black Knights are 2-6 in its last eight season openers.
• Army has started its season at home in each of the last four seasons

IT RUNS IN THE FAMILY

• Head Coach Katie Kuester is the daughter of former NBA coach John Kuester.
• Kuester spent over 30 years on the sidelines coaching, including 17-plus seasons in the NBA. Kuester last coached as an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Lakers during the 2011-12 season.
• He was most notably the head coach of the Detroit Pistons from 2009-11.
• Kuester is the only known active women's basketball head coach whose father was an NBA head coach.

RISING STAR – FIONA HASTICK

• Fiona Hastick looks to take another massive leap this season after being voted to the Preseason All-Patriot League Team by the conferences coaches.
• Hastick is coming off an impressive 2024-25 season, in which she started all 33 games and finished second on the team in scoring with 10.9 points per game.
• The junior out of Virginia scored 10 or more points in 20 games last season and two 20-plus point showings.
• She scored a season-high 22 points against Bryant in the opening round of the WNIT on March 20.
• As good as she was on offense, Hastick was equally impressive on the defensive side of the ball. She led the team with 22 blocks last season, which included six multi-block games. Hastick also had 11 games in which she swiped multiple steals.
• Hastick was named to the Third-Team All-Patriot League in recognition of her impressive season.
• Hastick has not played this season due to injury but is expected back soon.

LIMITLESS RANGE – REESE ERICSON

• Reese Ericson enters the 2025-26 season as the lone senior on the team.
• A native of Lake Oswego, Ore., Ericson has developed into one of the premier shooters in not just the conference but also the country.
• Last season, Ericson averaged 10.4 points per game and scored a career-high 332 total points.
• The 5-6 led the Patriot League in made threes with 84 last season. The number also put her 23rd in the country. Her 2.63 3-pointers made per game were also 23rd in the country and first in the conference.
• Ericson was a key reason that Army finished 57th in the country in three's made as a team (7.6).
• She had 18 double-digit scoring games last season. Ericson knocked down a career-high 28 points at Bucknell on Feb. 8.
• In that contest against Bucknell, Ericson buried eight shots from distance, which tied a program single-game high.
• It's not just her shooting ability that is so impressive, as she is one of the best distributors on the team. Her 73 assists are second-highest among returners for the Black Knights this season.
• Through two games, Ericson leads Army in 3FGM with eight. She had six in Army's season-opening win over Pace.
• She is averaging 12.7 points per game in 2025-26.
• Ericson will have a homecoming when Army travels to the Pacific Northwest to take on Oregon on Nov. 16.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE – KYA SMITH

- Kya Smith figures to be a major contributors for the Black Knights this season.
- Smith started 30 of the 31 games she appeared in last season and was a force in the paint.
- She finished the season leading the team in defensive rebounds (136) and total rebounds (230).
- Smith's strong rebounding and efficient scoring allowed her to record five double-doubles last season, including two double-doubles in which she had 15 rebounds.
- The junior forward scored a career-high 22 points against Colgate on 8-10 shooting on Jan. 29, 2025.
- Smith is already off to a strong start this season, leading the team in scoring with 14.7 points per game and rebounding with 9.7.
- Smith has recorded double-doubles in back-to-back games (St. Thomas and Siena).

THE SPARK PLUG – CAMRYN TADE

- Camryn Tade is coming off an impressive sophomore campaign in which she started all 33 games and played the second-most minutes among all Black Knights (1,072).
- She also finished second on the team last season with 48 steals. Tade had 15 multi-steal games last season.
- Against Siena, Tade had a career-high 23 points on 7-11 shooting on Thursday night, eclipsing her previous high of 18 which she set against Boston U., this past January.
- She was also 8-8 from the line, which marked a career best.

ONE LAST RIDE – SOLEIL MONTROSE

- Soleil Montrose enters her final year of athletic eligibility this season and looks to continue being a key contributor for the Black Knights.
- A transfer from UTEP three years ago, Montrose has been a consistent contributor off the bench for the Black Knights.
- Last season the California native averaged 13.9 minutes and 3.9 points per game.
- Her best collegiate performance to date came against Air Force on Nov. 15, as she scored a career-high 15 points while grabbing six rebounds to help Army secure the Silver Star.

THE SISTERS – TAYLOR AND BROOKE WILSON

- After strong 2024-25 seasons, the Brooke and Taylor Wilson look to take the next step in their games.
- Taylor played in 32 games last season – one start – while finishing third in blocked shots (16).
- Taylor had three 10-plus point showins, including a season-high 13 points against Saint Peter's on Nov. 9.
- Taylor has been the suprise of the season thus far, sitting second on the team in scoring at 13.3 points per game.
- She opened the season with a career-high 20-point showing against Pace on 8-14 shooting. She followed that strong performance with 11 points against St. Thomas.
- The opening two games were just the second time in her career that she has scored 10-plus points in consecutive games.
- She has opened the season 7-11 from distance.
- Brooke is coming off a strong freshman campaign that saw her appear in all 33 games.
- Brooke scored a career-high 11 points against Holy Cross on Jan. 22.

- Brooke has gotten off to a tremendous start to the season, leading Army in assists (17) and steals (7), while sitting second in rebounds (21).

FRESHMAN PHENOM – REGANNE REARDON

- Reganne Reardon hasn't skipped a beat in the opening two games of her collegiate career.
- The freshman from Chicago, scored 11 points in her debut against Pace and followed it with seven against St. Thomas last Saturday.
- Reardon also grabbed eight boards in her debut while dishing out a pair of assists.
- Against St. Thomas, she was the first substitution off the bench.

THE YUK'S – AUDREY ANNEE / STELLA CHARTRAND

- For Audrey Annee and Stella Chartrand, they have made it through arguably the hardest year at West Point, the freshman year and are now YUK's (sophomore's).
- Both players appeared in limited action last season, but look to build off strong fall practices and carry it into the 2025-26 campaign.
- Both players have seen rotational minutes in both the Pace and St. Thomas games.

THE NEWCOMERS

- The Black Knights welcome four freshman to this year's team – Reaganne Reardon, Kelly Cramer, Jane Preston and Landry Sherrer.
- The four freshman have had strong fall camps, especially Reardon, who looks like she will be a key contributor to the team from the opening game on.
- One of the unique aspects of being a freshman at the United States Military Academy, is that before they can hit the court with their teammates, they must first complete Beast Barracks, which is a grueling six-week military training that is intended to help cadets make the transition from civilian life to military life.

ALL EYES ON US

- Army will appear on national television at least twice this season. Both of its games against Navy will air on the CBS Sports Network.
- Last season Army appeared on CBSN three times – the two Navy games and against Lehigh in the Patriot League Tournament Championship game.

SUNG SECOND... THREE TIMES

- Last season Army defeated Navy in both matchups to not only secure the Star but continue to display its dominance on the hardware against Navy.
- The Black Knights have won the last seven matchups against the Midshipmen.
- Army also took down Air Force at home in mid-November.



HEAD COACH KATIE KUESTER

Army West Point Director of Athletics Tom Theodorakis announced on May 22, 2025, the hiring of Katie Kuester as the new head coach of the Army West Point Women's Basketball program.

Kuester (CUE-sterr) becomes the 10th head coach in Army women's basketball program history.

A rising star in collegiate coaching and a proven developer of talent, Kuester joins the Black Knights after a decade-long tenure (2015-25) on the coaching staff at Saint Joseph's University.

"We're excited to welcome Katie Kuester to the West Point family," said Theodorakis. "Katie brings exceptional leadership, a high basketball IQ, and an unmatched work ethic. Her proven ability to develop student-athletes both on and off the court is impressive. Her track record speaks volumes, and we're eager to see where she takes Army Women's Basketball."

While at Saint Joseph's, Kuester began her tenure working with the guards as a shooting coach before transitioning to coaching the post players. She also led the program's domestic and international recruiting efforts. Under her guidance, the Hawks reached new heights during the 2023-24 season, setting a school record with 28 wins and advancing to the quarterfinals of the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament (WBIT).

"I am incredibly honored and grateful for the opportunity to lead the Army West Point Women's Basketball program," said Kuester. "West Point represents the very best in leadership, discipline, and service. I look forward to building a championship culture that reflects those values and developing strong, confident leaders both on and off the court."

Kuester played a critical role in the development of standout forwards Laura Ziegler and Talya Brugler, both of whom earned Atlantic 10 All-Conference honors and First Team All-Big 5 recognition. Brugler became the 29th player in program history to score 1,000 career points, while Ziegler nearly averaged a double-double on the season.

Promoted to assistant coach in 2018 and to recruiting coordinator in 2021, Kuester helped Saint Joseph's land back-to-back A-10 Rookies of the Year in Brugler and Ziegler—further evidence of her ability to identify and cultivate elite talent.

Prior to returning to her alma mater, Kuester served as a staff member at Loyola (Md.), Lehigh, and North Carolina, where she contributed to the Tar Heels' run to the 2014 NCAA Elite Eight.

A former standout guard at Saint Joseph's, Kuester finished her career in the program's top 10 for three-pointers (167) and free throw percentage (.861). She was named to the All-Big 5 Second Team in 2010-11, and she was also a standout off the court, earning Atlantic 10 Commissioner's Honor Roll and Saint Joseph's Athletic Director's Honor Roll recognition.

She earned a bachelor's degree in elementary education from SJU in 2012 and then a master's in educational leadership from Lehigh. She is the daughter of longtime NBA coach John Kuester, who spent 20 years in the league with teams including the Detroit Pistons, Philadelphia 76ers, and Los Angeles Lakers. Kuester is a native of Media, Pa.
