Game 1: Augustana Vikings at Northern State Wolves

Sept. 6 * 7 p.m. * Swisher Field * Aberdeen, S.D.

THIS WEEK: The Augustana College football team kicks off the 2003 season on Saturday as the Vikings travel to Aberdeen, S.D., to take on intrastate rival Northern State University. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Swisher Field.

RADIO: All Viking football games can be heard on KXRB Radio (AM-1000). The game can also be heard on the internet at: www.kxrb.com. Veteran broadcaster **Jeff Fylling** will call all of the action, while **John Schultz**, a former All-NCC quarterback with the Vikings, provides color commentary. The broadcast begins with a pre-game show 30 minutes prior to kickoff.

THE SERIES: Saturday will be the 25th meeting between Augustana and Northern State, with the Vikings holding a 19-4-1 lead in the series. Augustana has won the past nine encounters, with Northern State's last win being a 26-19 triumph in 1952. The Vikings and Wolves have met annually since 1998.

VIKING HEAD COACH JIM HEINITZ: Jim Heinitz begins his 16th season as the Augustana Vikings' head football coach. He is the longest serving head coach in Augustana's history, surpassing the legendary LA "Lefty" Olson last year. Heinitz was named head coach late in 1984 and served for eight years. He resigned after the 1992 season to enter private business and then returned to Augustana in December of 1995 to resume his coaching career. The 1988 and 1992 North Central Conference Coach of the Year, Heinitz enters the 2003 season with an overall record of 73-89-1.

HEINITZ NEARS MARK: Augustana head coach **Jim Heinitz** is close to becoming the winningest coach in Viking football history. Heinitz enters the 2003 season with a 73-89-1 record in 15 previous seasons. He needs five wins to surpass LA "Lefty" Olson. Olson compiled a 77-32-2 record in 14 seasons with the Vikings. (see chart on page 2)

NSU HEAD COACH KEN HEUPEL: **Ken Heupel** is in his sixth season at the helm of Northern State. He enters the 2003 season with a 31-24 record in five previous seasons with the Wolves. He was named the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Coach of the Year in 1999 after leading NSU to the NSIC championship. However, the Wolves are coming off two straight 4-7 campaigns.

HOME TURF: Augustana has a new playing surface to call "home" this season. This summer a new artificial turf called Field Turf was installed at Howard Wood Field, making it the first outdoor stadium in South Dakota to have this type of artificial surface. Field Turf, which has a life

expectancy of 10-14 years, is a welcome addition to Howard Wood Field due to the large number of high school and college games played at the stadium. Other teams that play their home games on Field Turf include the University of Nebraska, the University of Michigan, the Atlanta Falcons and the Seattle Seahawks.

VIKINGS PICKED FOURTH, SIXTH IN THE NCC: The North Central Conference head coaches and the members of the media covering the NCC figured Augustana will finish in the middle of the league in 2003. The head coaches picked the Vikings to finish sixth, while the media tabbed Augie to finish fourth. In both polls, the Vikings were locked in close races with North Dakota State and South Dakota State. *(see polls on page 3)*

NON-CONFERENCE STREAK: Augustana enters Saturday's game at Northern State riding a 14-game non-conference winning streak, dating back to the 1996. The Vikings' last non-conference loss was a 12-8 setback to Central Missouri State to open the 1996 season. The following week, Augie defeated Southwest State 38-6 to begin its current winning streak. *(see winning streak on page 3)*

TEAM CAPTAINS: The team captains this fall will be senior strong safety **Ben Nauman** and junior quarterback **Ryan DeGraff**.

2003 SENIORS: The Vikings have 11 seniors on the roster this season. They include wide receiver **Adam Brinkman**, defensive end **Austin Flyger**, wide receiver **Eric Haugland**, linebacker **Bryce Jones**, guard **Scott Karlson**, safety **Dave Kroll**, safety **Ben Nauman**, defensive back **Justin Noteboom**, defensive end **Kyle Pfeifer**, center **Casey Phillips** and tackle **Derek Venenga**.

ABOUT THE 2003 VIKINGS: Augustana returns 36 letterwinners, including 11 starters, from a team that went 7-4 in 2002 and tied for fourth place in the North Central Conference with a 4-4 record. It marked the fourth straight season the Vikings have finished .500 or better. Augie's overall record for the last four seasons is 24-17.

The Vikings have four starters back on offense, including quarterback **Ryan DeGraff**. A junior, DeGraff missed all but two quarters of last season after suffering a season-ending injury in the opening game against Northern State. DeGraff has his top receiver back in senior **Eric Haugland**, who had 32 catches for 426 yards and two touchdowns last year. However, the Vikings must replace four starters along the offensive line. Only senior tackle **Derek Venenga** returns up front.

All-North Central Conference safety **Ben Nauman** spearheads a defensive unit featuring seven returning starters. Nauman, a senior, led the squad with 67 tackles in 2002. He also intercepted three passes. Also back are junior safety **Mike Stotz** and junior linebacker **Brett Scherschligt**, both of whom were honorable mention all-conference performers in 2002. The Vikings return three of their four defensive linemen from 2002. Seniors **Austin Flyger** and **Kyle Pfeifer** anchor the end positions, while junior **Gabe Garcia** occupies one of the tackle spots. The final starter is sophomore linebacker **Lucas Smith**, who registered a team-high six sacks last season.

Senior **Adam Brinkman** is also back to handle the placekicking duties. He connected on 22 of 25 extra points and 12 of 17 field goals last year.

THE TIME IS NAUMAN: Senior strong safety **Ben Nauman** has a chance to etch his name in the Augustana record book. Nauman enters the 2003 season with 13 career interceptions. He is eight picks shy of Viking career record holder **Pete Jaros** (1986-89), who had 21

interceptions. Nauman, a two-time All-North Central Conference first team selection, has led the Vikings in tackles the past two seasons. He intercepted nine passes in 2001 as a junior, but picked off only three passes last season.

Nauman is a threat on special teams. He was third in the NCC last season in kickoff returns, averaging 23.6 yards per return.

YOUTH IS SERVED: The Vikings will have a youthful appearance in 2003. In this week's two-deep chart, 21 of the 47 players (13 offense and 8 defense) are either freshmen or redshirt freshmen. That total does not include redshirt freshman **Luke Biondi**, who will handle the punting duties. Conversely, 8 seniors (4 offense, 4 defense), plus placekicker **Adam Brinkman**, are listed on the depth chart.

BROTHERLY LOVE: The Viking roster is filled with four sets of brothers. The brothers include:

Austin Flyger (Sr., DE) and **Tommy Flyger** (So., QB)
Ryan Ovenden (Jr., RB) and **Nick Ovenden** (R-Fr., LB)
Daren Randall (Fr., DB) and **Dustin Randall** (Fr., DB)
Eric Rice (Jr., WR) and **Dustin Rice** (Fr., DB)

NCC STATS: In the 2002 North Central Conference stats, Augie finished the season with one of the top defenses in the NCC. The effect of losing starting quarterback **Ryan DeGraff** was also felt in the offensive statistics. Here's a list of where the Vikings ranked in the NCC (stats are for NCC games only):

ABOUT THE WOLVES: Northern State also opens the 2003 season on Saturday. The Wolves return 33 letterwinners, including 15 starters, from a team that went 4-7 overall and 4-5 in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. NSU was picked to finish fifth in the NSIC in the league's preseason coaches' poll.

The Wolves figure to be an explosive offensive squad in 2003 as nine starters return, including all of the running backs and wide receivers, in addition to four offensive linemen. However, one spot with a new face is at quarterback, where redshirt freshman **Toby Korrodi** takes over as signal caller. Among the weapons at his disposal are senior running back **Ronnie Cruz** and receivers **Charlie Johnston**, **Josh Martin** and **Travis Heitmann**.

Defensively, six starters are back for the Wolves. Leading the pack is senior linebacker **Jason Carson**, an all-region second team selection in 2002. He had 79 tackles, including 15 for loss, along with 9 pass breakups and 5 forced fumbles.

LAST YEAR'S GAME: Augustana and Northern State accounted for a lot of yards, but not a lot of points as the Vikings edged the Wolves 14-6 at Howard Wood Field. The Vikings amassed 340 yards of total offense, while the Wolves had 222 total yards.

Augustana got on the scoreboard first when Ryan DeGraff hooked up with Casey Meile for a 5-yard touchdown with 6:37 left in the first quarter. Northern State answered three minutes later on a 75-yard scoring pass from Jake Paten to Matt Pinto. The PAT though was blocked. Augie's Nathan Walter accounted for the final points of the day with an 8-yard touchdown run in the second quarter.

The Vikings were dealt a severe blow late in the first half when DeGraff broke his leg. He completed 13 of 18 passes for 85 yards before the injury.
