Larry Ireland - Offensive Line Coach

Larry will be beginning his second year on the Augustana football staff, where he will be in charge of the offensive line. He will also serve as an instructor in physical education.

Larry, a graduate of Scotland High School, earned a BA degree from Yankton College in physical education in 1968. He then obtained his MA degree from the University of South Dakota at Vermillion the following year.

The Viking assistant had served as the head coach at Mitchell, Hot Springs, and Gregory High Schools before coming to Augustana.

Dennis Van Berkum - Defensive Coordinator and Linebacker Coach

Denny will be beginning his second year as a Viking assistant coach with the added assignment of being named Defensive coordinator along with coaching the linebackers. He had served the first year as the defensive secondary coach. He came to Augustana from Jamestown College where he was an instructor in physical education and served as the defensive coordinator in football. He is also serving as admissions counselor at Augustana.

Denny attended Rock Valley, Iowa High School and then played as a defensive back while enrolled at Northwestern College, Orange City, Iowa, where he earned a BS in physical education. He then served as a graduate assistant in football at South Dakota State while completing requirements for an MS in physical education.

Denny and his wife, Jenny, have one child, Jessica.

Don Johnson - Offensive Coordinator and Backfield Coach

Don will be beginning his fifth year as an Augustana assistant coach. He will be offensive coordinator this season after spending the past four on defense.

Don was graduated from South Dakota State University in 1974. While at State he started in the defensive secondary and was a member of the all-conference honorable mention team in 1974.

Following his undergraduate degree, Don returned to South Dakota State to earn his master's degree in physical education in 1975.

Don played his high school ball at Madison Central, where he earned all-state honors at linebacker during the 1968-69 season.

A. Richard Petersen - Defensive Line Coach

A. Richard (Pete) Petersen has joined the Augustana coaching staff for the sixth year. He is assisting with the defensive line coaching duties.

THE DEFENSIVE TEAM

The Backfield

The returnees in the defensive secondary consist of seven lettermen, all of whom have seen a considerable amount of playing time. Starting assignment in this group is led by Mike Galle, an All-Conference honorable mention selection, who also led the team in interceptions with 3 last season. Others returning include Matt de Regnier, Bob Wilber, Scott Flolid, Joe Van Hooreweghe, and Tim Donohue.

The Linebackers

This group returns five lettermen, led by defensive captain, Frank Mello, along with Jeff Queck, Dan Burgmeier, Bill Timmons, and Gary Sebo. This group saw extensive playing time last season, and this should help in making the defensive unit one of the best in recent years.

The Defensive Line

The defensive line of the Vikings is where the overall strength of the team lies. All-Conference performer, Dale Beutel returns at one tackle slot along with John Krolikowski, who also is in that category. There is also adequate reserve strength as lettermen Adam Kurzejski and Mark Schwede return. At the defensive end, Dave Porter is the only veteran returning at the defensive end position. The leading candidate for the other spot appear to be the talented sophomore letterman Karl Mecklenberg.

OVERALL OUTLOOK

The Viking's offensive unit will lack some experience in the backfield and at the tackle positions. However, the team hopes to become more evenly balanced in the running and passing game. The defensive unit will be the strength of the team with a veteran unit returning. This helps the overall outlook to be one of optimism. There were some outstanding freshmen recruited and they could develop into being some of the needed depth before the conference season.
