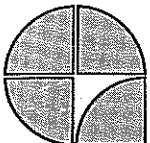
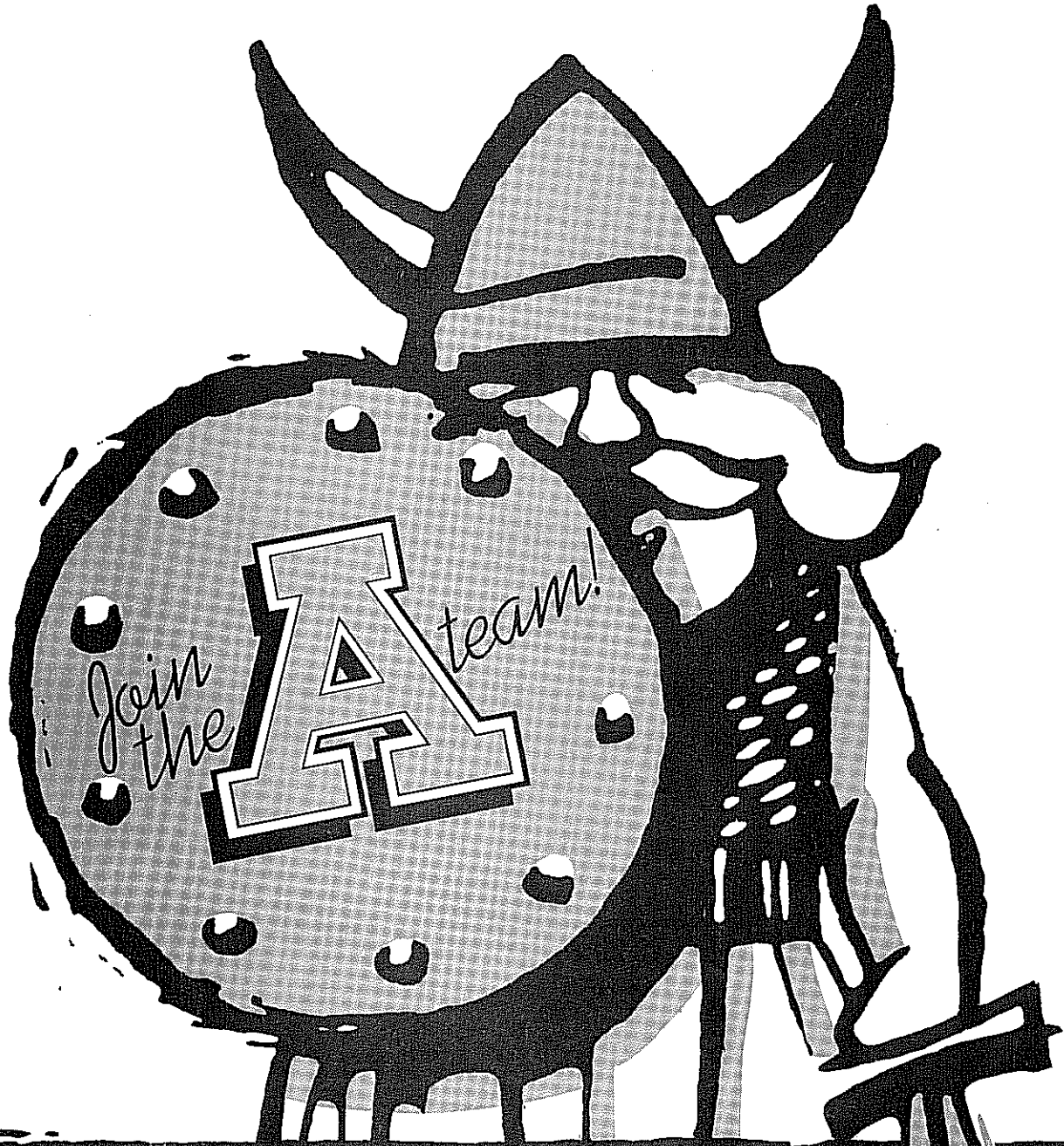

1984 AUGUSTANA OUTLOOK

OFFENSE:

Protecting the quarterback will be the major assignment of the Augustana Vikings as they prepare for the 1984 North Central Conference football season. That means replacing some experienced players in the interior line who graduated, although the center and guards return.

If the offensive line comes around, led by center Scott Bruning and guards Duane Beck and Jay Menzel, it will have a pair of experienced quarterbacks to protect, with a pair of experienced receivers also back. John Schultz started at quarterback last season, and was backed up by Jeff Lauder. Back to catch passes are wide receivers Tom Brown and Troy Schaefer, along with running backs Victor Breakfield and Terry Lehnen, and tight end Keith Larson.

Schultz passed for 1970 yards and 13 touchdowns last year, while Lauder had 297 yards in passing and four touchdowns. Schultz also picked up 129 yards rushing, where Lehnen is the top returnee with 598 yards. Breakfield had 170 yards on the ground. Among returning receivers, Lehnen had 26 catches for 233 yards, Brown 33 for 586 and Larson 10 for 121.

In addition, Robbie Whipple is back at offensive tackle and place kicker Kent Seibel returns after booting nine of 14 field goal tries last fall. Seibel finished the year second in scoring with 48 points.

DEFENSE:

Two defensive backs return along with two of the top tacklers when the Vikings posted a 5-6 record last year. But Augustana will sorely miss its corps of top-notch aerial thieves, Dan Freidel and Brad Coleman. How well the defensive backfield shapes up will determined much about how well the season goes.

Gregg DeSpeigler and Brian Johnson return to the defensive backfield, and on their shoulders rests a lot of the future of the 1984 Vikings.

Up front, linebacker Paul Josephson and end John Winterscheidt hope to make life miserable for opposing running backs and receivers. Josephson was in on 103 tackles and Winterscheidt last year. Josephson had seven stops for losses and another nine quarterback sacks.

Jack Sharkey and Brian Gauer return at ends, Keith Hanson at tackle and Kory Knight will be switched from linebacker to tackle. Joining the linebacker corps is junior-college transfer Jeff Norin.

Seibel handled the punting, too, but struggled at times, and must shore up that part of his game to become effective.

The Vikings expect to have quality people at the skill positions, and hope that the experienced players can lead the charge, with the newcomers picking up the slack. Depth could be a major key if the Vikings hope to pull off an upset or two.

THE COACHING STAFF

C. Lyle Eidsness - Head Football Coach

Lyle Eidsness, a 1963 graduate of Augustana College, is beginning his fourth year as the head football coach of the Vikings. He came to Augustana from Morningside College, where he spent one season coaching the Maroon Chiefs.

His coaching experience includes high school stints at Ponca, Neb.; Thompson, Iowa; Sheldon, Iowa; and St. Peter, Minn. In six seasons at St. Peter, his record was 40-16 and included 11-1 and 12-0 seasons in 1975 and 1976. He was selected Region II Coach of the Year in both of those seasons and was the Minnesota High School Coach of the Year in 1976. Eidsness then accepted the head coaching position at the University of Wisconsin-Stout.

In three seasons at Stout, he turned its program around with records of 2-8, 6-4 and 7-3, the latter the best mark in school history. The winning seasons were the first since 1965.

The Viking head coach was the first recipient of Augustana's "Alumni Coach of the Year" award, in 1977. His career record is 107-82-2, including a 12-20 mark with the Vikings.

He and his wife Jean, the former Jean Sorteberg (Augustana, 1963), are the parents of two sons, Eric and Mark.

R.E. "Rocky" Hager - Defensive Coordinator

Rocky Hager is beginning his fourth year at Augustana, his third as the defensive coordinator, and he also works with the linebackers. He coached the offensive line his first season at Augustana after coming over from Morningside College.

Hager, who graduated from Minot, N.D., State in 1974 with a degree in physical education, coached at Sherwood and Dickinson, N.D., high schools. He also has been a graduate assistant at North Dakota State University when he continued his studies in physical education.

Rocky and his wife Peggy have three children - Joshua, Tiffanee and Rebecca.

Jim Heinitz - Offensive Line Coach

Jim Heinitz begins his third season on the Augustana staff. He graduated from Mountain Lake, Minn., High School in 1968 and then matriculated to South Dakota State University where he was a three-year football letterman and a two-time All North Central Conference Linebacker. He graduated from SDSU in 1972.

Jim began his coaching career at Sioux Falls College where he worked both football and basketball for one season. He then moved to Sioux Falls Washington High for four years, coaching football, basketball and track. That was followed by one year at Rapid City Stevens and three years as an assistant at Sioux Falls Lincoln High.

Jim and his wife Becky have three children - Stacey, Adam and Heather.

A. Richard Petersen - Defensive Line Coach

"Pete" Petersen will begin his 11th year on the Augustana football coaching staff where he will be assisting with the defensive line.

"Pete" graduated from Augsburg College in 1951 and received a Bachelor of Divinity degree from Luther Theological Seminary in 1953. He also has done graduate work in Denver, in 1967-68.

"Pete" joined the Augustana staff in 1969 and has served in the position of campus pastor, Associate Dean of Men and now holds the position of Associate Dean of Students. He also is the "Voice of the Vikings" at all home basketball games and some home wrestling matches.

He and his wife Beverly are the parents of Wendy, AJ, Sara and Wayne.

Dan Mehlbrech - Receiver Coach, Strength Coach

Joining the Augustana coaching staff this fall is Dan Mehlbrech, who will be the Vikings' recruiting coordinator as well as the receiver and strength coach. He comes to Augustana from Northern State College where he was an assistant last season while completing work on his master's degree. He also holds his bachelor's degree from NSC, graduating in 1977.

Dan, who graduated from Bridgewater, S.D., High School in 1971, spent five years as the head football coach at Sibley, Iowa, where his teams won one state championship and finished second another time. He also has assisted at Aberdeen Roncalli High.

Dan and his wife Deb have one daughter - Laura.

Dan Freidel - Defensive Secondary Coach

Dan Freidel and the Augustana defensive secondary are no strangers to Augustana fans. Freidel holds the Viking record for pass interceptions in a single season - with nine - and pass interceptions for a career - with 17. Now, he will work with the defensive backs.

Dan graduated from Armour, S.D., High School in 1980 and then received his bachelor's degree in physical education from Augustana in 1984. In his football career, his 17 interceptions were good for 139 return yards. He also played basketball with the Vikings, and will serve that program as its graduate assistant coach this winter.

Chuck Plummer - Graduate Assistant

A three-year starter for the Vikings, Chuck Plummer will now serve as a graduate assistant and work with the offensive linemen. Chuck was a guard for Coach Eidsness' first three seasons at Augustana.

Jeff Rusk - Graduate Assistant

Jeff Rusk will work with the defensive despite having been named the North Central Conference's Most Valuable Back during the 1983 season. He is a two-time All-NCC pick and holds the Augustana record for passes caught in one season, 65; pass reception yardage for one game, 200; reception yardage in one season, 1063; reception yardage for a career, 2077; touchdown passes in one season, 9; and touchdown passes in a career, 16.

Virg Sandvig - Athletic Director

Virg, who was appointed athletic director at Augustana College in 1980, joined the Vikings' staff in 1960 after spending two years as the head football coach and athletic director at Yankton College. Preceding that, Virg spent nine years coaching and serving as athletic director at Dell Rapids, S.D., High School. Virg has served in the positions of assistant football coach, freshman basketball coach and head track coach while at Augustana.

He is a former Sioux Falls Washington High four-sport letterman. While attending Augustana College, he competed in golf, basketball and football - and was the football team captain in 1948. He graduated from Augustana in 1949 and received a master's degree from the University of Minnesota in 1957. Virg then received his MS in geography from South Dakota State University in 1974.

Virg is a Marine veteran who participated in several South Pacific Island invasions during World War II. He also serves Augustana as an associate professor of geography.

Virg and his wife Jan have three children - Stacey, Scott and Ann.
