

## COVID-19 PROTOCOLS PRE-SALE TICKETS ONLY

- There will be **NO WALK-UP SALES** for any games this season. All tickets must be purchased in advance online or over the phone at 936-294-1729.
- Those purchasing **UPPER RESERVED** tickets will receive an **ASSIGNED** seat. Fans will be permitted to sit only in the assigned seat listed on their ticket.
- → All ticket purchases and transactions must be **COMPLETED BY NOON ON GAMEDAY**.
- → BEARKATONE CARDS and FACULTY/STAFF ID will not permit entrance on gameday.

#### **STUDENT & FACULTY/STAFF TICKETS**

- A minimum of 350 tickets will be reserved for students; however, **STUDENT TICKETS MUST BE RESERVED IN ADVANCE**, similar to football.
- → Student tickets will be available from 8:00 AM-5:00 PM in the Student Activities Suite at the LSC (Suite 215).
- → Students can only reserve and claim tickets in person at the Student Activities Suite.
- → Complimentary student and faculty/staff tickets must be claimed by **5:00 PM THE DAY PRIOR TO EACH GAME.**
- → Faculty/Staff can secure their tickets by calling the ticket office at 936-294-1729 or by going to the Bearkat Ticket Office in person (2212 Avenue I, Suite 180).

#### FACIAL COVERING REQUIRED

- → Masks are **REQUIRED** to be worn by each fan at all times inside Johnson Coliseum, in accordance with Sam Houston State University, NCAA and Southland Conference guidelines.
- → For fans who forget to bring a mask, there will be a box of masks at each entrance.

#### **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

- In order to accommodate as many fans as possible in the lower reserved sections, seats will be reallocated to allow for social distancing and will be based on priority point ranking.
- In the event there is not enough room to accommodate all season ticket holders with lower reserved seats, a partial refund will be given and they will be given a general admission seat.



### **COVID-19 PROTOCOLS**

#### **CAPACITY & ENTRY**

- → Capacity inside Johnson Coliseum is limited to 1,218 FANS for all games.
- → Measures will be in place to prevent entry into unauthorized zones of Johnson Coliseum. ONLY TIER 1 personnel who have cleared testing protocol WILL BE ALLOWED ENTRY VIA THE EAST GROUND-LEVEL TUNNEL.
- All other personnel, (i.e. cheerleaders, UPD, table crew, lower reserved season ticket holders, media, etc.) will be required to **ENTER** and **EXIT** the building via their respective gates along the upper concourse of Johnson Coliseum (see Page 3).
- → Measures will be put in place to prevent entrance and exit of non-authorized individuals through tunnel from Lower Sections D-F.

#### PASS LISTS

- → All guests on the pass list will be issued **WRISTBANDS** as opposed to hard tickets. Home and visitor pass list guests will have different colored wristbands which will change each game.
- → **HOME** and **VISITOR** pass lists will be allowed entry **ONLY** through their designated entries (shown on Page 3) and will be required to sit in designated seats and sections during the game.

#### **PARKING**

- → Fans attending games at Johnson Coliseum will have the opportunity to pay to park in the newly-finished parking garage at 820 Bowers Blvd, directly across the street from upper level of the Coliseum. Parking rates are \$2.50 for the first hour and \$1.25 each additional hour.
- Fans can also park free of charge in the lower surface lots to the east and northeast of the Coliseum; however, should fans park in these lower surface lots, they will still be required to enter and exit the Coliseum via their respective upper-level entry doors. - The designated drop-off location is along Bowers Blvd., near the flagpoles.
