When Lumberjack Head Coach Colby Carthel was introduced to a raucous crowd at SFA in December 2018, he made a proclamation that any kid with a pine tree in their yard was going to be a Lumberjack. To that end, the Lumberjacks' 20th head coach has made a conscious effort to win the recruiting landscape in SFA's backyard, the Piney Woods of East Texas.

The Friona, Texas native has made an immediate splash in the FCS recruiting world, as the Lumberjacks have compiled a Top-5 recruiting class in the FCS in each of the past two seasons, and nabbed the top FCS commit in each of those seasons. Now Carthel enters his second year at the helm of the Lumberjack football program in 2020, looking to build on the progress made in his first season in Texas' oldest town.

In Carthel's first season in Nacgdoches, the 'Jacks improved their win total by a game and had three athletes garner a total of four Southland All-Conference honors. Placekicker Storm Ruiz finished his superb career as a First Team All-Conference honoree, while Xavier Gipson and Willie Roberts, both freshmen, were named to All-Conference Third Team honors. Gipson also earned a place on the Third Team All-Conference Defensive Team as a kick returner.

Prior to joining SFA, Carthel cut his teeth at Texas A&M Commerce, building that program into a Division II powerhouse. Carthel and the Lions amassed three straight 10+-win seasons, a trio of conference titles and a national title (2017) in his final three campaigns in Commerce. He guided a plethora of Lone Star Conference selections in each of his six seasons at Commerce, including eventual Harlon Hill Trophy Recipient Luis Perez.

LUMBERJACK SPOTLIGHT

XAVIER GIPSON · WR · SO. · DALLAS, TEXAS

- A speedy and shifty receiver once described by Coach Colby Carthel as "hard to cover in a phone booth", Xavier Gipson has been as advertised during his time as a Lumberjack. Through his three seasons in the Purple and White, Gipson has ran his way into the record books and looks to rewrite a few before he's finished.
- After breaking onto the scene with 52 catches for 941 yards as a true freshman, Gipson followed that up with another 52-catch, 841-yard campaign during the 2020 fall season, in which SFA decided to play when few others would. Looking to take another big strike in his true sophomore season, Gipson is on pace to finish with over 60 catches and 1100 yards receiving as well as 10 touchdown passes, all of which would represent personal bests for the Dallas native.
- A virtual shoe-in for the WAC Offensive Player of the Week last week, Gipson earned the award and had a good case to make for Special Teams Player of the Week as well, accounting for two touchdown receptions as well as a punt return touchdown.
- Gipson scored on long catch and runs of 48 and 75 yards while hauling in three total passes for a ruthlessly efficient multi-TD game and 131 receiving yards.
- The effort marked the third multi-TD game of his career as well as the seventh 100+ yard game of his career.
- Gipson's big game against Mississippi Valley State propelled him into the Top 10 at SFA for career receiving yards, as he now has 2,112 entering Saturday's tilt against Lincoln (CA).
- Gipson is also within the program's Top 10 list for receiving touchdowns in a career, having moved intwo a tie for 10th, with 19. With one more touchdown grab, Gipson will move into eighth place in the category, and could move into fifth place all-time with three more receiving scores.

RATING THE MATCHUP

- Gipson suited up but did not play against Lincoln in a matchup that was never in doubt for the 'Jacks, but will be ready to go on Saturday against Sam Houston.
- Sam Houston has allowed 260 yards through the air per game and seven receiving touchdowns to its three opponents thus far.
- In the 2019 BOTPW game, Gipson had six catches for 97 yards for SFA, including a 38-yard haul. He also returned two kicks in the contest.

STORYLINES

- This will be the 95th matchup in the all-time rivalry between SFA and Sam Houston and 11th matchup between the two being played inside NRG Stadium, the home of the NFL's Houston Texans. SHSU has controlled the rivalry all-time as well as in recent history, winning nine of the past ten meetings inside NRG stadium.
- The FCS No.1 on both the FCS StatsPerform and NFCA Coaches Poll, the Bearkats return the bulk of their playmakers from last season's FCS Championship run, which saw them run through a gauntlet of FCS powerhouses on their way to winning the national championship. Head Coach KC Keeler is in his eighth season at the helm of the Bearkats, while Lumberjack head coach Colby Carthel is in his third season at SFA. The 2019 Battle of the Piney Woods serves as the only head-to-head matchup between the two, as the COVID-19 pandemic altered both team's schedules and did not allow for a 2020 iteration of the BOTPW, snapping a 75-year streak of the game being played.
- The matchup features some of the top FCS performers this season on both sides of the ball, as Sam Houston's Ramon Jefferson ranks fifth nationally in rushing yards (400) and third in yards per carry (9.1) and QB Eric Schmid ranks seventh in passing TDs (10) and 10th in yards per completion (14.3). For the 'Jacks, PK Chris Campos ranks fourth in scoring and second in field goals per game, punter Max Quick ranks fourth in punting average (48.3), and BJ Thompson ranks ninth in forced fumbles.
- Both teams enter the matchup with a high-scoring offense, as the Bearkats average 46.3 points per game and SFA averages 40.25. On the defensive end, SHSU allows 22 points per game, while SFA has kept opponents to 16 points per game.
- The Lumberjacks will look to make a difference on defense and special teams, both of which have been dynamic for them up to this point. SFA ranks third nationally in turnovers gained and is 19th in turnover margin, and has scored a total of six special teams or defensive touchdowns this season through four games, representing 32% of SFA's 19 touchdowns scored thus far. Additionally, stellar performances in the kicking game by Quick, Campos and kickoff specialist Dylan Brown have helped SFA win the field position battle time and time again.

LUMBERJACK DUICK HITS

- The 2021 season was one of measured success for the Lumberjack program, as Colby Carthel guided the 'Jacks to their first winning season since 2011. SFA finished 6-4 on the season with a pair of wins against FCS foes and a strong showing in each of its four FBS contests.
- With the oddities of the 2020 schedule behind them, the 'Jacks find themselves in another unique scheduling situation in 2021, as the team will take part in the one-year AQ7 challenge, a merging of members between the Atlantic Sun and the WAC to duke it out for a qualifying bid into the FCS playoffs. The 'Jacks face numerous tough tests along the way, with playoff contenders from a year ago in Central Arkansas and Jacksonville State as well as the defending FCS national champions Sam Houston State to contend with.
- Several players switched jersey numbers from the more conventional numbering system by position into single numbers of their choosing, but only after being voted by their teammates into receiving the honor. These players (Myles Heard, BJ Thompson, Jeremiah Walker, Brevin Randle, Dennis Osagiede, Tkai Lloyd and Aretavious Hendrix) will represent the 'Jacks well both on and off the field.
- SFA's 2021 schedule features three first-time opponents for the Lumberjack program in the form of Mississippi Valley State, Lincoln (CA) and Dixie State, who is now a conference foe for the 'Jacks and will be a regular fiixture on their schedule moving forward.
