THE SERIES:

The Bears and Bearkats will be meeting for the 15th time on Saturday, with the series deadlocked at 7-7. The series began in 2006, with UCA winning 38-30 on the road in Huntsville, Texas. In fact, the Bears won their first two trips to Huntsville but have lost their past five games at Bowers Stadium.

However, UCA is 5-2 in games played in Conway, including the last meeting in 2019, which UCA won 29-25. For most of the series, one or both teams have been ranked in the FCS Top 25, including again this season.

LAST MEETING:

In the last meeting between the Bears and Bearkats in 2019, UCA won 29-25, scoring the game-winning touchdown on a 15-yard pass from Breylin Smith to Tyler Hudson with 3:57 to play.

UCA overcame a 16-0 halftime deficit and outscored SHSU 29-9 in the second half, with Smith tossing four touchdown passes to Joe Hampton (40 and 53 yards), Carlos Blackman (28) and Hudson. Smith completed 24 of 43 for 405 yards and a career-high four TDs, accounting for most of UCA's 450 yards of total offense.

Hudson, a true freshman from Spring, Texas, caught 10 passes for 140 yards, while Hampton caught five for 149 yards. UCA transfer linebacker T.J. Campbell had a career-high 14 tackles. The Bearkats rushed for 239 yards (161 and 2 TDs by Donovan Williams) and threw for 216.

LAST GAME:

UCA scored 14 fourth-quarter points last Saturday to pull away to a 45-23 in-state victory over Arkansas-Pine Bluff in the home opener for the Bears.

UCA rolled up 456 yards of total offense and held UAPB to just 308. Junior QB Breylin Smith completed his first 15 passes of the game and finished 31 of 42 for 329 yards and four touchdowns, including TD passes on UCA's first three possessions of the game.

UCA controlled the clock throughout, finishing with 37:38 time of possession, including 13:24 of the first quarter.

Smith threw touchdown passes to four different receivers, including Chris Richmond (7 yards), Sam Camargo (3), Tobias Enlow (7) and Tyler Hudson (19). True freshman Darius Hale led the ground attack with 76 yards rushing and a pair of touchdowns. Defensively, senior LB Trenton Dunn had a career-high 13 tackles (10 solos) while junior DB Deandre Lamont had 5 tackles, an interception, a fumble recovery and a blocked PAT.

NEXT GAME:

UCA will head back on the road next Saturday for a trip to Abilene, Texas, to take on the ACU Wildcats, a former Southland Conference foe and part of this year's ASUN-WAC/AQ7 affiliation.

Game time is 6 p.m. at Anthony Field at Wildcat Stadium.

ASUN PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:

UCA claimed three more ASUN Player of the Week honors on Monday.

Junior QB Breylin Smith was named the ASUN Offensive Player of the Week, junior defensive back Deandre Lamont was the co-Defensive Player of the Week and tailback Darius Hale was the Freshman of the Week.

UCA has now earned six awards in three weeks of action, including two for Lamont, one for Smith, one for Hale, one for DE Logan Jessup and one for freshman RB Trysten Smith.

ASUN-WAC / AQ7:

UCA will compete in a new conference for the first time since 2006-07 as the program has joined the ASUN Conference in all sports for 2021-22. UCA spent the past 15 years in the Southland Conference.

Ironically, the Bears will play four of their former SLC programs this year in Sam Houston, Lamar, Stephen F. Austin and Abilene Christian, who are now in the WAC. The new ASUN football conference, for this season, will consist of newcomers UCA, Eastern Kentucky and Jacksonville State. They will be joined next season by Kennesaw State and North Alabama, with possible further expansion in the near future.

The ASUN and WAC formed a one-year scheduling alliance (AQ7) for this season to have enough teams to assure an automatic qualification for the FCS Playoffs. Each team will play three home and three road games.

SHSU won the FCS national championship last season and Jacksonville, ECU and UCA have been perennial playoff teams over the past 10 years.

The WAC which will feature football, albeit at the FCS level, for the first time in nine years.

RED ALERT:

The Bears are a perfect 13 of 13 in red-zone trips through three games this season. UCA has scored 12 touchdowns in those 13 red-zone trips.

UCA's opponents are nearly as efficient at 12 of 13 this season but just seven of those have been touchdowns.

BROKEN UP:

Two Bears have broken bones in games vs. Sam Houston in recent years.

Quarterback Breylin Smith broke his ankle in UCA's 34-31 overtime loss in Huntsville in 2018 and missed the remainder of the season. Smith passed for 1,009 and six touchdowns and completed 68.8 percent of his passes in his four games that season.

Wide receiver Lujan Winningham broke his arm vs. the Bearkats in the 2019 game at Estes Stadium and missed four Southland Conference games before returning for the Bears' playoff game against Illinois State to close the season. Winningham caught 50 passes for 814 yards in the injury shortened season (9 games).

NATIONAL RANKINGS:

Several Bears are ranked in the Top 15 in the FCS national rankings. QB Breylin Smith is fifth in passing yards (957), sixth in passing TDs (9) and 9th in completions per game (26.3).

Christian Richmond is 2nd in combined return yards (KO, P) with 297. Lujan Winningham is 6th in receiving yards (324) and Tyler Hudson is 8th (307). Winningham is also 10th in receptions per game (7.3). Logan Jessup is 14th in sacks per game (1.17).

NATIONAL CHAMPS:

The 1991 NAIA national championship team will be celebrating its 30-year reunion this weekend and will be recognized during a pregame ceremony on "The Stripes."

The Bears, under the direction of head coach Mike Isom, went on the road and beat Northeastern State (Okla.) 30-14 in the first round of the NAIA Playoffs, then hosted Moorhead State and won 38-18 in the semifinals in Conway.

UCA then traveled to Wilberforce, Ohio and beat Central State 19-16 for its third NAIA championship in an eight-year span (1984 & 1985 co-champions).

The quarterback for the Bears in that championship run was freshman Ken Collums, who is now UCA's offensive coordinator. UCA's current associate head coach Brooks Hollingsworth was the offensive backfield coach on the title team.

ALL-CONFERENCE:

The Bears had a league-high 13 players named to the 2021 preseason All-ASUN team, including the Offensive Player of the Year in sophomore wide receiver Tyler Hudson.

The preseason honorees included: Hudson, TE Sam Camargo, QB Breylin Smith, WR Lujan Winningham, OL Jaylin Hendrix, OL Toby Sanderson, DL J.W. Jones, DL Logan Jessup, LB T.J. Campbell, DB Cameron Godfrey, DB Deandre Lamont, PK Hayden Ray, KR Cameron Myers.

The Bears were picked 2nd in the combined ASUN/WAC preseason poll, trailing only the defending FCS national champion Sam Houston.

FCS POLLS:

The UCA Bears were picked in the Top 20 in every FCS preseason poll this season, with a high of 11th in the Hero Sports poll. UCA was 13th in the FCS Coaches' poll and the Athlon poll, and 14th in the Stats Perform FCS poll.

UCA was not ranked in the 2020-21 final polls because it did not compete in the spring season.

The Bears are currently 25th in both the AFCA Coaches Poll and the Stats Perform poll. Sam Houston is No. 1 in every poll.

SUPER SENIORS:

As do most teams around the country, the Bears have their share of "Super Seniors," those who were seniors last season but were awarded an extra year due to covid-19.

UCA has nine seniors who returned for another go 'round, including center Toby Sanderson who has started 33 consecutive games at center and played in 38 in a UCA uniform.

The Super Seniors include: JW Jones, Tobias Enlow, Sam Camargo, Justin Morris, Trenton Dunn, Toby Sanderson, Jack Short, AJavius Brown and Nathan Grant.

UCA also has 16 players who already have at least one college degree, including: Breylin Smith, Nathan Grant, TJ Campbell, Lujan Winningham, Kylan Stribling, Willie Langham, Davon Wright, JW Jones, Toby Sanderson, Mitchell Perkinson, Jack Short, Jarrod Barnes, Tobias Enlow, Jaden Salley, Sam Camargo and Trenton Dunn.

According to a poll by the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame, there are 3,284 college football players in 2021 who have already earned their undergraduate degrees (279 schools responded). That is up from 1,452 in 2019, and up from just 971 in 2017.

WATCH LISTS:

Junior quarterback Breylin Smith and sophomore wide receiver Tyler Hudson were two of the 35 FCS players named to the 2021 Walter Payton Watch List. Hudson was a finalist for the award in 2020-21.

The award, named for Hall of Fame running back Walter Payton (Jackson State), goes to the national offensive player of the year at the FCS level and is presented by Stats Perform.

NEW STAFF:

UCA has five newcomers on the coaching staff for 2021, along with a couple of title changes. Matt Kitchens returns to UCA as defensive coordinator. Keith

Scott returns as passing game coordinator/defensive backs coach. Kristen Trammel comes in as assistant defensive backs coach and Jamar Johnson is the new receivers coach.

Taylor Polk added the title of special teams coordinator to go along with his linebacker duties. Bayley Novak is an offensive graduate assistant working with quarterbacks, while Deairus Whitney is a defensive graduate assistant and video coordinator.

Zach Brady takes over as director of player personnel/equipment manager.

RETURNEES:

UCA returns 60 lettermen and 23 starters from last year's 5-4 squad. The Bears have nine starters back on the defensive side and 10 on offense, along with both their top two punters and placekickers and both return specialists.

The biggest losses were All-American cornerback Robert Rochell, who was drafted in the fourth round by the Los Angeles Rams, linebacker Dre Matthews (UCA's No. 2 tackler) and running back Kierre Crossley (UCA's leading rusher). Matthews missed the final two games of 2020 with injury and did not return to the team.

Crossley is a graduate transfer at Arkansas-Pine Bluff this season.

THE SCHEDULE:

UCA has another tough schedule in 2021, including facing four conference champions and one national champion.

The Sam Houston Bearkats won the FCS championship last spring with a 23-21 victory over South Dakota State.

The other conference champions were ECU in the Ohio Valley Conference, Missouri State in the Missouri Valley Football Conference and Arkansas-Pine Bluff in the SWAC West Division.

Ironically, UCA swept Missouri State in a rare home-and-home series last fall before the maroon Bears went 5-1 in the spring regular season to win the league crown. UCA also split a pair of games with ECU, winning at home and losing on the road.

DYNAMIC DUO:

UCA has one of the top wide receiver duos in the nation in junior Lujan Winningham and sophomore Tyler Hudson. Both have racked up numerous All-Conference and All-American honors in their short careers at UCA.

The duo has combined for 241 receptions and 3,958 yards, along with a combined 44 touchdown catches. Ironically, the pair grew up near each other in the Houston area. Winningham went to Atascocita HS in Humble, Texas, and Hudson played at Klein Oak HS in Spring, Texas.

For his career, Hudson has 120 catches for 2,140 yards and 21 touchdowns. Winningham also has 121 catches for 1,818 yards and 23 touchdowns, meaning he finds the end zone every 5.2 receptions.

Hudson ranks 8th in career receiving yards at UCA (in two+ seasons), trailing No. 7 Jatavious Wilson (2,251, 2013-16) by 111 yards. He passed Draylon Galloway (2,053) vs. Missouri State. He is just the ninth Bear to top 2,000 receiving yards.

Winningham's 23 career TDs ranks fourth all-time, trailing No. 3 Dezmin Lewis, a former Senior Bowl player, by just one. The overall mark is 30 held by Ronnie Mallett (1978-81). Hudson's 19 TDs is tied for seventh place with UCA Hall of Famer John Cameron (1984-87) and Croom (2009-12).

Winningham's 12 touchdowns a year ago is tied with Aaron Fairouz (2005) for second most in a single season. Mallett had 14 TD catches in 1979.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS:

Junior QB Breylin Smith (Conway, Ark.) is inching closer to several school passing records that are ironically held by his head coach Nathan Brown.

Smith has 7,609 career passing yards, which puts him third behind Brown

(10,558, 2005-08) and Hayden Hildebrand (8,025, 2013-17) and just in front of Randy Huffstickler (7,360, 1978-81). Smith would have to pass for 2,950 yards to take over the No. 1 spot.

Smith has 67 touchdown passes, which is second in school history behind Brown (100), ahead of Hildebrand (62) and Huffstickler (61). Smith would need 38 TD passes to pass Brown.

Smith is just the fourth quarterback in UCA history to surpass 7,000 yards. He is also second in career pass attempts (1,041) and second in career completions (649).

Smith set a new school single-season passing mark in 2019 with 3,704 yards and tied the school record with 32 touchdown passes. He completed 316 of 490 passes (64.5 percent) and averaged 284.9 passing yards per game with a 143.01 efficiency rate.

Smith broke the mark of 3,275 held by Nathan Dick (2011). Brown is third (3,206) and seventh (3,084) on that list, and is UCA's career leader with 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns. He is also third in career total offense (7,305 yards).

Smith also set school marks for single-season attempts (490) and completions (316).

SENIOR BOWL:

Senior CB Robert Rochell became the third UCA Bear since 2009 to receive an invitation to the Reese's Senior Bowl last season, joining his head coach Nathan Brown (2009) and wide receiver Dezmin Lewis (2015).

Rochelle, a 6-foot-2, 185-pounder from Shreveport, La. (Fair Park HS), was an All-American and first-team All-Southland Conference selection and was a three-year starter for the Bears. He had 10 career interceptions, 28 career pass breakups and 101 career tackles.

openers. North Dakota holds the top mark with 33 straight home opener wins. UCA's win over UAPB last week was No. 23. Ironically, NDSU's 22nd win was over UCA last year.

In overall season openers since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006, the Bears have a 9-7 record. Six of those seven losses were to FBS teams.

PRO BEARS:

Three former UCA Bears made the 53-man rosters on their respective NFL teams on Aug. 31.

Cornerback/return specialist Tremon Smith (Anniston, Ala.) is on the Houston Texan's roster for his first full season after signing with the team in March 2021. Smith has also played for the Indianapolis Colts (2020), the Philadelphia Eagles (2019-20), the Green Bay Packers (2019) and the Kansas City Chiefs (2018 draftee in the sixth round, No. 196). He totaled 886 yards on 33 kickoff returns in 2018 (26.8 yards per return) and was named to the All-Rookie team.

Safety George Odum (Millington, Tenn.) is on the Indianapolis Colts' roster after signing with the team as an undrafted free agent on May 1, 2018. He was a first-team All-Pro selection in 2020 when he led the NFL in special teams tackles. For his career, Odum has 95 tackles, 3 forced fumbles, 1 fumble recovery and 1 interception entering the 2021 season.

Cornerback Robert Rochell was drafted in the fourth round (highest in UCA history) by the Los Angeles Rams in 2021 and made his first 53-man roster.

Rochell, from Shreveport, La., was an All-American cornerback for the Bears. Former UCA defensive end Jonathan Woodard signed with the Saskatchewan Roughriders on May 20, 2021 after playing for four different NFL teams since being drafted by the Jacksonville Jaguars (7th round) in 2016. He played for the Jaguars, Atlanta Falcons, Miami Dolphins and Buffalo Bills.

There are 97 former FCS players on the current NFL 53-man rosters, with just three teams (Bengals, Dolphins, Cowboys) without at least one. The 49ers and Lions lead the league with seven FCS players each.

DEFENSIVE NUMBERS:

UCA's defensive unit recovered 14 fumbles last season, which tied Sam Houston for the national FCS lead. UCA played one less game than SHSU.

The Bears also recorded 72 tackles for loss (-343 yards), which ranked 10th in the nation. UCA had 26 sacks (-182 yards), intercepted nine passes and had 29 pass breakups.

The nine interceptions was the lowest by a UCA secondary since 2009 when the Bears had just six. UCA had 10 straight seasons with double figures interceptions until last season.

KICKING IT:

UCA returns all of its specialists, with the exception of holder Will Siler. Junior placekicker Hayden Ray returns, along with sophomore punter Seren Hughes-Ford, sophomore snapper Justin Keijers, sophomore punt returner Tyler Hudson and sophomore kick returner Cameron Myers.

Sophomore Chandler Caughron will take over the holding duties as well as serve as backup punter and kicker for the second straight year.

Ray has made 30 of 37 career field goals, with a long of 47 yards, and is 90 of 92 on point-after attempts for his career. He has scored 180 career points. His 30 career field goals ranks seven in UCA history, trailing No. 6 Justin Smith (31). The career best is Hall of Famer Curtis Burrow with 43.

LAST SEASON:

The Bears played a complete season in the fall of 2020, unlike numerous other programs, finishing 5-4 overall. The Bears played the first college football game in the country, taking on Austin Peay in the Guardian Credit Union FCS Kickoff at the Cramton Bowl in Montgomery, Ala., on Aug. 29. UCA beat APSU 24-17, outscoring the Governors 18-7 in the second half to overcome a 10-6 halftime deficit.

UCA then turned around five days later (Thursday) and played the first FBS game in the nation against UAB at historic Legion Field, falling 45-35 to the Blazers. The Bears almost completed that comeback as well, scoring two touchdowns in the final 5:43 to get within 10.

UCA athletic director Dr. Brad Teague had to piece together a schedule on the fly when the Southland Conference moved all football competition to the spring and Missouri canceled the UCA game because of SEC rules allowing only league games. UCA added Arkansas State a year earlier than was scheduled and also played rare home-and-home series with both Missouri State and Eastern Kentucky.

Austin Peay was actually the only game on the Bears' original schedule. The Bears put together a 10-game schedule and played nine of them, with FBS Louisiana canceling the final game on Nov. 21 due to covid-19 issues.

UCA had no SLC record since the majority of the league competed in the spring. Only UCA, Stephen F. Austin, Abilene Christian and Houston Baptist competed in the fall. The remainder of the SLC's seven teams played six games (three home, three away) in the spring from Feb. 20 to April 10.

IN THE CLASSROOM:

In May 2021, for the second consecutive year, UCA's athletic department won the Southland Conference Academic Performance Award, which is presented annually to the member institution compiling the highest APR average (academic progress rate) based on a seven-point scale and percentage calculation.

UCA captured 63 percent of the maximum accumulated points the institution could receive, based on the number of conference sports in which UCA participates. This award included the four-year APR average from 2016-17 through 2019-20.

UCA also totaled more than 200 student-athletes named to the SLC Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll, encompassing 18 of its 18 sports, with men's soccer competing in the Sun Belt Conference due to no league sponsorship of the sport by the SLC.

UCA's more than 420 student-athletes continued to maintain a combined 3.20 overall grade-point average, with the spring 2021 semester being the 17th consecutive semester over a 3.0. Sixteen of UCA's 18 sports had a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00.

UCA senior Will Siler was awarded the prestigious one of the Southland's two F.L. McDonald Postgraduate Scholarships, the league's top academic awards honoring graduating student-athletes. Siler (Searcy, Ark.) had a perfect 4.0 grade-point average over his UCA career, was awarded a \$5,000 scholarship and will use it to attend medical school in Little Rock.

Siler, Cameron Myers, Hayden Ray, Logan Jessup and JW Jones were all named to the SLC All-Academic team.

ALL SOUTHLAND TEAM:

The Bears had 12 players named to the Fall All-Southland team, including WR Tyler Hudson as the Offensive Player of the Year. Those include: Hudson, WR Lujan Winningham, C Toby Sanderson, OL Jaylin Hendrix, PK Hayden Ray, DE JW Jones, DE Logan Jessup, LB Dre Matthews, DB Robert Rochell, DB Cameron Godfrey, KR Cameron Myers and PR Tyler Hudson.

Head coach Nathan Brown was named the Fall SLC Coach of the Year.

AFFILIATIONS:

The timeline for the Bears ascension to NCAA Division I FCS began at the NAIA level. UCA competed in the NAIA until 1993 when it left the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference and moved to NCAA Division II and into the Gulf South Conference.

UCA remained there until 2006-07 when it made the move to D-I and into the Southland Conference in July 2006. The Bears spent 15 years in the SLC before making the move to the ASUN in on July 1, 2021.

UCA finished its run in the SLC with an impressive 73-29-0 conference record, a .716 winning percentage. That includes an 9-0 record in 2017, 8-1 mark in 2016, 6-1 records in 2008, 2011 and 2012 and a 7-2 mark in 2015 and 2019.

vs. FBS:

UCA was one of just three FCS programs to record a victory over an FBS team in 2019 (in 111 matchups), and was also the first to accomplish it. UCA went on the road and beat Western Kentucky 35-28 _ thanks to a 21-0 fourth quarter _ in Week 1 in Bowling Green, Ky.

After a pair of FBS losses last season (UAB, ASU) and a loss at ASU in Week 1 of 2021, the Bears are now 3-15 against FBS teams. UCA beat in-state rival Arkansas State 28-23 in Jonesboro in 2016 for its second win. UCA's first win over an FBS opponent was against the same Western Kentucky team in 2009.

UCA has had close calls over the years, losing 25-20 to Hawaii in 2009 after leading with two minutes remaining, 48-42 in overtime to Louisiana Tech in 2011, 38-24 at Colorado in 2013 and 42-35 at Texas Tech in 2014. The Bears also trailed Oklahoma State 17-8 late in the third quarter of a 32-8 loss in 2015. UCA also led Ole Miss 20-14 at halftime of a 49-27 loss in 2012 in Oxford, Miss.

FCS PLAYOFF HISTORY:

UCA has made five appearances in the NCAA Division I FCS Playoffs since moving up in 2006-07. UCA beat Tennessee Tech in the first round in 2011 (34-14 in Cookeville, Tenn.), then lost to Montana 41-14 in Missoula.

In 2012, the Bears lost their opening game at Georgia Southern 24-16 in Statesboro, Ga. UCA hosted Illinois State in 2016 in the first round and won 31-24 before losing 31-14 at Eastern Washington in Cheney, Wash.

UCA was also nationally seeded in 2017 and hosted New Hampshire in the second round but lost 21-15. In 2018, UCA earned a No. 8 national seed and drew a bye before losing 24-14 to Illinois State in the second round on "The Stripes" in Conway.

BRAND NEW STRIPES:

The Bears will host five regular-season games this season at First Security Field at Estes Stadium, also know as "The Stripes". A brand new turf will await the Bears when they finally play at home in Week 3 against Arkansas-Pine Bluff. UCA's "new" Stripes were finished in time for fall camp to open in August.

The Bears went 3-0 at home last season and 4-2 the previous year. UCA, which was 5-1 at home in 2016 and 2017 and 3-2 in 2018, is entering its 11th season on "The Stripes" and has a 43-11 record since the installation of the unique purple and gray striped playing surface.

Through two+ seasons on the turf, the Bears were a perfect 11-0 on "The Stripes." Losses to McNeese State and Southeastern Louisiana in 2013 were th first two since the turf went down in 2011. The Bears did close out that season at home with a rousing 49-31 victory over No. 9 Sam Houston.

Over the past 12 seasons since moving to Division I, UCA's home record is 65-17, including 7-0 in 2008, 5-0 in 2011 and 6-0 in 2012. The 65 home victories was the most of any SLC team over that time period.

WINNING WAYS:

UCA enters 2021 as the winningest college football program in the state of Arkansas since 2000.

The Bears had their 10th winning season in the past 11 in 2020. UCA's last losing season was 2009 (under head coach Clint Conque) when the Bears went 5-7, losing their last five games of the year after starting out 5-2. That was just one year after a 10-2 season in 2008, the best record in the Division I era. UCA was .500 (6-6) in 2014.

UCA has recorded 40 winning seasons in the past 46 years, dating back to 1973. UCA tied the school record with 11 victories in 2005, and won 10 games in both 2016 and 2017.

SCORING STREAK:

The Bears had a streak of 274 games in which they scored broken with the shutout loss to Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 9, 2019. The last shutout overall prior to that was when UCA lost 19-0 at Delta State in 1995. The last shutout at home prior to that was 1986 against East Central Oklahoma in the NAIA days.

The Bears have now scored in 395 of their last 397 games since 1986.

BEING OFFENSIVE:

The Bears' offense has been consistently prolific during their time in the Southland, averaging close to 5,000 yards per season since joining the league in 2006. The high was 5,584 in 2017. They topped 5,000 yards of total offense six times, including four of the past six years.

UCA has averaged nearly 3,100 passing yards per season, with a high of 3,979 in 2013. The Bears have averaged 26 passing touchdowns over that time period (high of 34 in 2011) and have topped the 3,000-yard passing mark nine times in 14 seasons.

COMEBACK KIDS:

The Bears have recorded 13 come-from-behind victories over the past three seasons, including all five victories last season and seven of their nine victories in 2019.

In 2019, the Bears outscored their opponents 217-130 in the second half. The difference was 152-116 a year ago.

The numbers are even more impressive in the fourth quarter, with UCA winning that period 134-70 two years ago and 95-63 in 2020.

BEAR TRACKS...

- Breylin Smith's 4 TD passes vs. UAPB tied his career high, which he has done three times.
- Deandre Lamont's blocked PAT vs. UAPB was the first since Nathan Grant vs. UIW (11/11/17).
- With the win over UAPB on Sept. 18, UCA has now won 11 straight in the series.
- Two UCA running backs scored their first career TDs vs. Missouri State. Darius Hail actually scored twice (1 & 3 yards), while Trysten Smith had a 19-yarder.
- UCA was just 4 of 23 (17%) on third-down conversions through two games but went 12 of 17 vs. UAPB to get to 40% (16 of 40) for the season. Last season, the Bears were 45 of 131 (34%).
- UCA has four players with more than 100 career tackles, including Cameron Godfrey with 119, TJ Campbell with 112, Nathan Grant with 111 and Deandre Lamont with 108.
- In two games vs. Arkansas State over the past two seasons, WR Lujan Winningham has amassed 10 catches for 177 yards and five touchdowns. Tyler Hudson has 19 receptions for 272 yards vs. the Red Wolves.
- In three games against Missouri State over the past year, UCA recorded a combined 35 tackles for loss for a combined 172 yards. UCA also had 20 sacks for a combined 128 lost yards.
- Six FCS programs registered victories over FBS programs on opening weekend, and two more in Week 2, including Jacksonville State's upset of Florida State. Those include: Montana over No. 20 Washington (13-7); UC Davis over Tulsa (19-17); Eastern Washington over UNLV (35-33, 2OT); South Dakota State over Colorado State (42-23); Holy Cross over UConn (38-28) and East Tennessee State over Vanderbilt (23-3) in Week 1. Two weeks ago, JSU won, along with Duquesne over Ohio, and Northern Arizona beat Arizona on Sept. 18.
- UCA's victory over Western Kentucky in 2019 was the 100th since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006. The Bears are 114-61 (65.1%) in the FCS era.
- There are 51 Bears from Arkansas on the roster, the most of any state and more than double No. 2 Texas (24).
- UCA QB Breylin Smith has thrown at least one TD pass in 18 of the 21 games he has started at UCA, with a high of 5 vs. Incarnate Word in 2019.
- The Bears played six of their first seven games on the road in 2020.
- Lujan Winningham's three TD receptions vs. ASU last season was the most since Tyler Hudson caught 3 vs. Incarnate Word last season (Nov. 22), and tied his own career best of 3 vs. Western Kentucky last season (Aug. 29).
- The Bears had a 23-day break last season between their game at UAB (Sept. 3) and at home with Missouri State (Sept. 26) due to an open date and Covid-19 issues at Arkansas State.

FAMOUS ALUMS:

UCA's most famous football alumnus is Monte Coleman, who played 16 seasons (1979-94) with the Washington Redskins and won three Super Bowl titles. Coleman, from Pine Bluff, Ark., was a linebacker and safety at UCA from 1975-78 and is the former head football coach at Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

UCA's most famous non-football alum is Scottie Pippen, a six-time NBA champion and two-time Olympic Dream Teamer. Pippen grew up in tiny Hamburg, Ark. in the SE Arkansas delta region and played at UCA from 1983-87 as a walk-on before becoming a two-time first-team NAIA All-American and then going 5th in the 1987 NBA Draft.

The court at the Farris Center was named for Pippen in the summer of 2021, with his signature added to midcourt.

OVER THE AIRWAVES:

The UCA Radio Network returns for the 15th year in the capable hands of Justin Acri (play by play), along with Chris Kane (color) and R.J. Hawk (sideline) on 103.7 The Buzz and The Bear 91.3.

The UCA games will be carried live on The Point 94.1, a 100,000-watt classic rock station based out of Little Rock, and KUCA 91.3 The Bear.

Acri, the general manager and midday talk show host at KABZ 103.7 The Buzz, will handle the play-by-play duties this season, his sixth in that role after nine years of color commentary. Kane, the morning co-host of KATV's Daybreak, assumed the color commentary role five years ago. R.J. Hawk, also on staff at 103.7 The Buzz, will handle sideline duties for the fourth season.

RADIO SHOW:

The Nathan Brown Show will be heard every Monday night at 7 p.m. on 103.7 The Buzz with Justin Acri, live from Walk-Ons Conway.

The hour-long show will feature head coach Nathan Brown, his coaching staff and selected players throughout the season, along with Acri, who is UCA's game day play-by-play radio announcer.

HEAD COACH NATHAN BROWN

The most prolific quarterback in University of Central Arkansas history became the 20th head coach of the program in December 2017 when Nathan Brown was hired to replace Steve Campbell.

Brown, a 2016 inductee in the UCA Sports Hall of Fame in his first year of eligibility, spent the previous four years (2014-17) as the Bears' offensive coordinator on teams that went 33-15 (.688), including 20-5 (.800) in 2016-17 and had the most efficient passing offense in the FCS in 2017.

Brown, a native of Russellville, Ark., led the Bears to a 6-5 mark in his first season as head coach. Of the five losses by the Bears, two were by three or less points, including one in overtime. UCA finished 5-4 in Southland Conference play.

The Bears had the No. 4 scoring offense in the league, the No. 2 rushing defense and the No. 3 scoring defense.

In Year 2, the Bears finished 9-4 overall and went 7-2 in conference play (co-champions), earning a No. 8 national seeding in the FCS Playoffs and a bye in the first round before hosting Illinois State at First Security Field at Estes Stadium. The playoff appearance was the fifth overall and third in the previous four years.

UCA survived the pandemic 2020 season and played a full fall schedule when many programs set out the season. UCA, which played the first college football game in the nation (FCS Kickoff Classic), finished 5-4 against one of the toughest schedules in school history, with a pair of FBS opponents and the



eight-time FCS champion North Dakota State, all on the road.

Brown's offenses totaled 20,969 yards and averaged 437 yards per game during his years as offensive coordinator, while having three different quarterbacks being named first-team All-Southland Conference (Hayden Hildebrand 2017, Wynrick Smothers 2012, Nathan Dick 2011). Hildebrand was the SLC Player of the Year while Smothers was the SLC Offensive Player of the Year.

During his years as quarterbacks coach at UCA, the Bears' quarterbacks averaged 3,211 passing yards per season, eclipsing the 3,000-yard yard plateau six times, for a total of 25,691 yards. With Brown as the Bears' offensive coordinator, UCA had 17 All-SLC offensive first or second team selections, including a Freshman, Player and two Offensive Linemen of the Year selections. The Bears ranked in the Top 10 in FCS scoring three times in four years, and ranked seventh in the country in total offense in 2017.

Brown coached four of the top six total offense seasons in school history, and he was the starting quarterback for the other two seasons. He also played or coached in seven of the top 10 passing offensive seasons in program history. Brown has been a part of three Southland Conference championships, one as player in 2008 and two as an assistant coach in 2012 and 2017.

Brown has been a part of all four of UCA's NCAA postseason playoff victories, two as a player (Division II) and two as a coach (FCS).

Equally as impressive as his coaching credentials are his numbers from his playing days at UCA. Brown was a three-time All-American who threw for 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns in his career, both records for a collegiate quarterback in the state of Arkansas. The Bears went 30-10 with Brown as the starting quar-

terback.

He was the SLC Offensive Player of the Year in 2007 and the SLC Player of the Year in 2008, when he was also a Walter Payton Award finalist. Brown also owns school records for touchdown passes in a game (7) and most yards of total offense (490).

Before UCA moved to Division I in 2006, Brown was named the Gulf South Conference Freshman of the year in 2005.

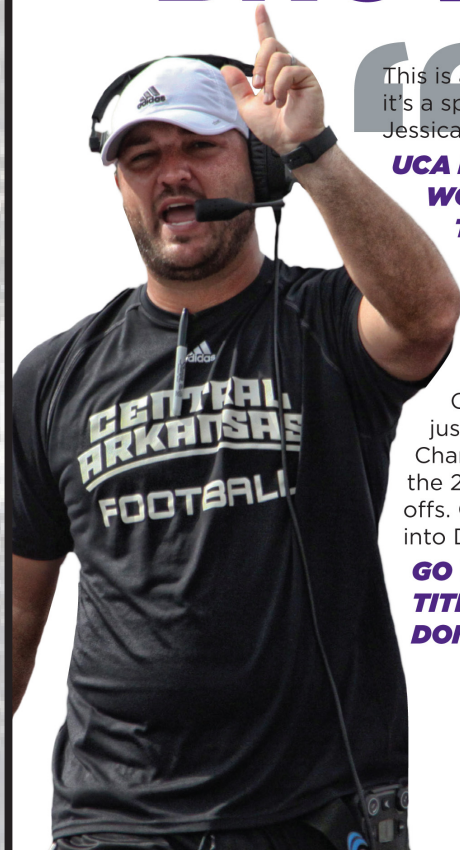
Brown was UCA's first player to receive an invitation to the Senior Bowl All-Star game in the NCAA Division I era and was the leading passer in the 2009 game. He was also selected for the East-West Shrine Game that same year. He was a free-agent signee of both the Jacksonville Jaguars and New Orleans Saints.

Brown received his bachelor's degree in business education from the University of Central Arkansas in 2009 after graduating from Russellville High School in 2004.

He has a wife, Jessica (also a UCA graduate), daughter Rylee and son Luke.

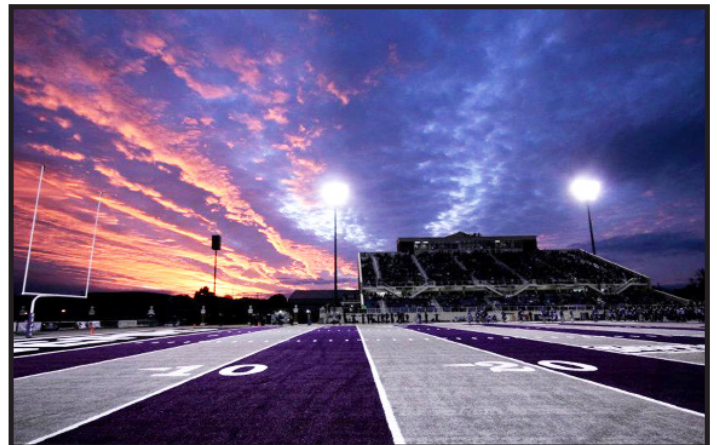
