BEARKATS TO MAKE FBS BOWL DEBUT IN R+L CARRIERS NEW ORLEANS BOWL

- The Sam Houston Bearkats will make their first bowl appearance as a member of the FBS when they take on Georgia Southern from the Sun Belt Conference in the 24th R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl
- The Kats became the first CUSA team in 2024 to secure bowl eligibility with its win at FIU. Sam Houston is the fourth consecutive program in NCAA to make the transition up and become bowl eligible within the first 2 seasons of being at the FBS (Jax State 2023, James Madison 2023, Liberty 2018)
- The Bearkats have won 12 of their last 16 games after starting their venture into FBS with an 0-8 start in 2023
- Sam Houston is seeking to get to 10 wins just a season after starting 0-8. The last time an FBS team started a year with at least straight 8 losses and then post double-digit wins a year later was when Georgia Southern did just that, starting the 2017 season 0-9 before going 10-3 a year later and winning the Camelia Bowl
- Sam Houston will be playing in the New Orleans Bowl under the direction of acting head coach and offensive coordinator Brad Cornelsen following former head coach KC Keeler's departure at season's end to accept the head coaching position at Temple
- The Kats have 5 players on the roster who have played in bowl games previously: Jaylon Jimmerson (Liberty), Jay Ducker (NIU/Memphis) and Austin Smith (Memphis), CJ Johnson (Memphis) and Ouincy Wright (Oregon State)
- Although it is Sam Houston's first bowl appearance as a member of the FBS, it is not the program's first postseason bowl appearance. The Kats played in 4 postseason bowls as a member of the Lone Star Conference (NAIA) in the early years of the program, taking part in the Shrimp Bowl (1952), Refrigerator Bowl (1953 & 1956) and the Christmas Bowl (1958). Each of those appearances came under head coach Paul Pierce who also led the Kats to an NAIA co-national championship in 1964

BY THE NUMBERS

SHSU will be after its 10th win of the season, which would be the 12th season in program history with double-digit victories.

The first 10-win season for the program came in 1956 when the Kats went 10-0 and won the Refrigerator Bowl. The program did not post a 10-win season again until 2001

The Bearkats put together the largest comeback in school history in its win over Texas State

Sam Houston erased a 22-0 firstquarter deficit to come out with a 40-39 win over the Bobcats at NRG Stadium

The age of first-year defensive coordinator Skyler Cassity

His age makes Cassity the youngest defensive coordinator in the FBS. He joined the Kats after being the defensive coordinator at Abilene Christian the past 2 seasons

SERIES HISTORY

- The Bearkats and Eagles have a combined 7 national titles at the FCS/1-AA level; however, the programs have never previously squared off on the gridiron
- Georgia Southern will be the second Sun Belt Conference opponent the Kats have battled this year, having already beaten Texas State at NRG Stadium on September 28. The Bobcats are not a common opponent for the teams as GS did not take on Texas State in SBC play in 2024

SAM HOUSTON → GEORGIA SOUTHERN CONNECTIONS

- The Bearkats and Eagles share a former head coach as current Houston head coach Willie Fritz coached in both Huntsville and Statesboro. Fritz's first Division I head job was at SHSU where he posted a 40-15 record from 2010-13, leading the Bearkats to consecutive FCS National Championship games in 2011 and 2012. Fritz left Huntsville after the 2013 season to take over at Georgia Southern where he spent the 2014 and 2015 seasons, posting a 17-7 record before moving on to Tulane
- The lone Texan on the GS roster is defensive back Caimon Mathis, a DeSoto native. He was a part of the 2022 DeSoto squad who won a Class 6A state title in 2022, a team quarterbacked by current Bearkat true freshman DJ Bailey who will be suiting out for the first time this season in the New Orleans Bowl as the team's third QB on the depth chart.. Caimon is the son of DeSoto HS head coach Claude Mathis, who led Bailey and the DHS Eagles to another state title in the 2023 season

- With Sam Houston's participation in the New Orleans Bowl, the Kats have reached postseason play in 10 of the last 12 seasons in which it was eligible at the FBS and FCS levels
- Sam Houston's 9 wins secured its first winning season at the FBS level and 14th in the last 15 seasons overall. The Kats only season with a losing record since 2009 came in 2023, its first full year at the FBS level. The Kats finished their run at the FCS level with 13 consecutive winning seasons
- Sam Houston's 18-day layoff prior to its game at Kennesaw State was the longest layoff in the regular season of any team in the nation in 2024
- The Kats won games vs FIU and LA Tech despite scoring just 19 total points. The 10 points vs FIU and the 9 points vs LA Tech are the lowest winning scores in single games in the nation this season
- Those scores held up in large part thanks to the Bearkat defense which held those opponents to 10 total points in those games. The wins marked the first time the Kats have held consecutive opponents to single digits since 2021 and is the least amount of total points allowed in consecutive games since allowing just 7 points in wins over Lamar and Southeastern Louisiana in 2012
- Sam Houston has done a great job of mining homegrown talent from the Lone Star State with 96 of the 116 players listed on its roster being from the State of Texas. Per research from Dave Campbell's Texas Football, the 83-percent homegrown roster is the highest percentage of players from the Lone Star State on the roster for any of the 13 FBS programs in Texas
- Sam Houston averaged 282.0 yards per game on the ground in its 4-game win streak earlier this year before falling to WKU, becoming the first team in CUSA to rush for 250+ yards in 4 straight games since FAU did so during the 2018 season
- After finishing 2023 last in Conference USA in rushing, the ground game has been the strength of the offense for the Bearkats in 2024. Despite attempting a season-high 33 passes in the regular season finale vs Liberty, the Kats still have yet to throw for 250 yards in a game this year. They are currently 1 of 4 teams in the FBS with at least 9 wins to their credit to not have a single game with at 250 passing yards. The other teams to do so include Army, Navy and UNLV

QUICK RUN TO THE TOP

Over the past 25 years (since 2000) there have been 22 programs to make the transition from the FCS/1-AA to the FBS level with the Kats being 1 of 6 programs in that span to post a season of 9+ wins within the first 2 years of the move up

KEELER ERA COMES TO A CLOSE

KC Keeler's 11-year tenure at Sam Houston came to an end following th conclusion of the regular season when he left to take the head coaching job at Temple. Keeler was hired prior to the 2014 season after stops at Rowan and Delaware and went on to post a 97-39 record in Huntsville, leaving with the highest win percentage of any head coach in program history and the second-most wins, only behind longtime head man Ron Randleman. Keeler moves on to Philadelphia carrying a total of 270 career head coaching wins, second among active head coaches (Brian Kelly) and third among active head coaches at all

LAST ONES STANDING

The move by Sam Houston to the FBS level following the 2021 season is arguably the most transcendent decision made in the history of Bearkat Athletics. Much of that was due to the Kats claiming the FCS national title in the Spring of 2021.

There are still 10 players still remaining from that team. Those players are: Ife Adeyi, Noah Smith, Trey Fields, Ethan Hagler, Ysidro Mascorro, Jevón Leon, Jaylen Phillips, Seth Kohlscheen, Richard Outland Jr. and Briceon Haves.

Smith, Adeyi and Leon have all been on the team since 2019 and enter their final collegiate game having been a part of 45 Bearkat wińs in 6 years. That run also includes a streak of 22 straight victories, including 21 wins in the 2021 calendar year

A LOOK BACK AT THE GREATEST YEAR IN COLLEGE FOOTBALL HISTORY - 2021

The 2021 calendar year was not only unique, but historic in college football. Following the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, a number of teams in the FCS chose to move their seasons to the spring, including the Kats. Sam Houston went on to post a 10-0 mark in the spring season, culminating in an FCS National Championship with a win over South Dakota State on May

Less than 3 months later, on August 2, the Kats began defense of that title and started the season by reeling off 11 straight wins before falling to Montana State in the playoff quarterfinals. The 21st and final victory of that run came over 2024 Heisman Finalist Cameron Ward's UIW team in the second round of the FCS playoffs. The 21 consecutive victories in the 2021 calendar year are the most in the history of college football for a team in a single calendar year. Second most on that list is just 16 wins, done by Yale (1894 & 1889), Chicago (1899) and North Dakota State (2019)



During Sam Houston's 110th season of football in 2024, the Bearkats are playing their 38th year at Elliott T. Bowers Stadium in their second year at the FBS level.

Sam Houston owns a 162-56-1 record on the turf at Bowers. The Bearkats have gone 73-12 in their last 85 appearances at home and went 17-0 all-time in FCS playoff games at Bowers before falling to Montana State in 2021 FCS Playoffs.

Known as Bearkat Stadium when the facility opened on Sept. 13, 1986, with a 24-6 vicotry over Montana State, the name was changed in 1989 to honor Dr. Elliott T. Bowers upon his retirement as Sam Houston State University President.

The Kats won their first 13 games at Bowers and have posted undefeated home seasons in 1986, 1987, 1990, 1992, 2001, 2004, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2016, 2017 and 2020.

CHANGES COMING TO BOWERS STADIUM

Bowers Stadium has been the home of the Bearkats since the program moved to the Division I level for the 1986 season, but it has not received a major renovation since it's inception.

That will not be the case for much longer as the Texas State University System's Board of Regents approved plans for major renovations to the west side of Bowers Stadium beginning at the conclusion of the 2024 season.

The primary piece of the upgrades is the demolishment of the current press box and the construction of a new facility.

The box will span approximately 47,000 gross square feet, boasting an additional 13,000 square feet of covered exterior space and culminating in a total of approximately 60,000 square feet.

At a price tag of approximately \$60 million, it will include updated concessions and restrooms, premium seating options and suites with access to outdoor balcony seating.

A state-of-the-art media center will also be integrated, elevating coverage for TV, radio, digital and print platforms.

Beginning in 2024, NCAA rules now allow for in-helmet communication from coaches to one player on the field until 15 seconds left on the play clock. A green dot on the helmet indicates which player on the field carrying the communication equipment.



KAT TO WATCH

Smith had 7 catches in the regular-season finale vs Liberty, the most by a Bearkat in a single game in 2024. He has already surpassed 3,000 career all-purpose yards, but also has a chance to make Bearkat history in the New Orleans Bowl. Smith needs just 11 more yards rushing to reach 1,000 rushing yards for his career and join Richard Sincere and Tony January as the only Bearkats in program history with 1,000 career receving yards and 1,000 career rushing yards.

OFFENSIVE QUICK HITTERS

- Hunter Watson has gone over 100 yards rushing from the QB spot 3 times this season, most recently when he went for 105 yards at Jax State. He is the first Bearkat QB in program history to have three 100-yard rushing games in the same season
- Watson's 623 yards rushing yards this year are the most rushing yards for a Bearkat QB since Jared Johnson set the program's QB rushing record with 999 yards in 2014
- The 2014 team was also the last time the Bearkats had at least 3 players surpass 500 yards rushing in a single season with 4 players Keshawn Hill, Jared Johnson, Jalen Overstreet and Donavan Williams doing so. The Kats already have 2 players over the mark in Jay Ducker and Hunter Watson, while DJ McKinney needs just 21 more yards to reach the mark
- Noah Smith went over 3,000 all-purpose yards for his career in the game at Jax State to become the 15th Bearkat in program history to surpass 3K in all-purpose yards
- Smith needs just 11 more rushing yards to surpass 1,000 career rushing yards and join Richard Sincere and Tony January as the only 3 Kats in program history with 1,000 career receiving yards and 1,000 career rushing yards; however, with 67 receiving yards and 11 rushing yards he would become the only player in program history with 2,000 receiving yards and 1,000 rushing yards in a career
- Sam Houston averaged 25.4 passing attempts per game through the first 9 games of the year, but has taken more to the air in the final 3 games of the year with an average of 31.0 pass attempts in games vs Kennesaw State, Jax State and Liberty

Noah Smith and Ife Adeyi have been tormenting defenses for the Kats since 2019 and will close their final season for the Kats in the New Orleans Bowl. An early season injury forced Adeyi out of the 2023 season after just 3 games but, each has moved up the Bearkat record books. Smith needs 67 more receiving yards to reach 2,000 for his career. Should he reach that mark, the pair of Smith and Adeyi would mark just the third time the Kats have had multiple players with 2,000 career receiving yards on the roster at the same time

RUNNING BY COMMITTEE

Balance is the name of the game when it comes to the Bearkat offense, but it's the rushing attack which has garnered the most attention. The Kats have had 4 different players - Hunter Watson, Jase Bauer, Jay Ducker and DJ McKinney - all lead in rushing in games this year

NEED TO KNOWS

BEARKAT ATHLETICS

→ The Bearkats won the 2014 NCAA Women's Bowling national championship. The Bearkat football team played in the FCS National Championship game in both January of 2012 and 2013 before finally breaking through and claiming the program's first FCS championship in 2021.

WHY THE K?

- → Bearkats is spelled with a K to denote a creature that is more mythical than real. The name came from a popular local saying from the 1920s "tough as a Bearkat!"
- Sam Houston's teams have been nicknamed Bearkats since 1923. Prior to that the sports teams were called "The Normals" since the Sam Houston was then a teacher's schools.

ABOUT SAM HOUSTON

- ► Sam Houston State University is located in Huntsville, Texas, with the 316-acre campus approximately 65 miles north of downtown Houston.
- ► It was founded in 1879 and stands today as the third-oldest public university in Texas. Created to train school teachers, today's Sam Houston offers a broad range of academic programs leading to bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees.
- → The university's namesake, Sam Houston, was the first and third president of the Republic of Texas. Houston was an American politician and soldier. His victory at the Battle of San Jacinto secured the independence of Texas from Mexico in one of the shortest decisive battles in modern history, lasting only 18 minutes.
- ► Sam Houston is buried in Huntsville not far from the campus of the University which is named in his honor. He was the only man in United States history to be governor of two states (Texas and Tennessee).
- The university, which is the 12th largest in Texas, passed the 20,000 student mark in enrollment in the spring of 2015 and currently boasts 20,477 enrollees.
- → Sam Houston's most recognizable alumnus is Dan Rather -- American journalist and former news anchor for CBS Evening News. The university named its mass communications building after Rather in 1994.

KAT TO WATCH

Jimmerson is 1 of 5 Bearkats on the roster to have previously played in a bowl game, having played in the 2021 Boca Raton Bowl and the 2023 Fiesta Bowl, both with Liberty. He finished the season strong vs his former team with 7 tackles and an interception in the regular-season finale victory over Liberty.

DEFENSIVE QUICK HITTERS

- Bearkat opponents are just 4-for-18 on 4th-down conversions over the past 7 games. In all, the Kats have stopped 19 of 29 4th-down tries this season and rank seventh nationally in 4th-down defense
- The Kats had 2 interceptions in the regular-season finale vs Liberty, snapping a 30-game streak by the Flames that dated back to October 2022 in which they had not thrown multiple interceptions
- Those turnovers extended SHSU's streak to 18 total games with a takeaway
- Sam Houston ranks 16th nationally and is tied for tops in CUSA with 22 total takeaways in 2024
- It has been difficult to pass against the Bearkats this season, and the numbers show just that. SHSU ranks 10th nationally with only 174.1 yards passing allowed per game this season. Only Texas State (326) has surpassed 300 yards in the air vs the Bearkat secondary in 2024 with 4 opponents being held under 100 yards (NM State, FIU, Jax State and Liberty)
- Sam Houston has held 4 opponents (NM State, FIU, Jax State and Liberty) under 100 yards in the air this season. The Kats are 1 of 4 teams nationally with 4 such games, joined by Tulane (5), Notre Dame (4) and WKU (4)

RED ZONE, OUR ZONE

The Bearkats sporting one of the top red zone defensive units in the nation in 2024 ranking eighth nationally in that category, holding opponents without points in 10 of 37 trips this year. Sam Houtson has stopped opponents on 5 of 13 red-zone tries over its past 5 games

GAITHER HEADLINES BEARKAT ALL-CUSA AWARDS

Kavian Gaither was named to the all-Conference USA first team at the end of the season, joined by defensive back Caleb Weaver and defensive end Chris Murray. Gaither has been a key piece of the Bearkat defense since 2021 and will close his collegiate career in the New Orleans Bowl. He racked up a career-high 17 tackles late in the season at Jax State, upping his career total to 250, which put him 14th all-time in career tackles at SHSU

COACH CASSITY AND THE BEARKAT KIDS

Anchored by defensive coordinator Skyler Cassity, who at age 30 is the youngest defensive coordinator in the FBS, the Kats boasted one of the youngest group of assistant coaches in the land coming into 2024. The average age of the 10 Bearkat full-time assistants at the start of the season was 38.9 years old, which was the fifth youngest in the nation. Only Georgia Southern (33.2), Old Dominion (34.5), UTEP (34.7) and Indiana (38.2) were younger
