TWO IN THE SEMIS

For the second time in Valley Football history, two league teams reached the playoff semifinals in the same season. The previous time was in 1999. That year Illinois State fell to Georgia Southern and Youngstown State beat Florida A&M in the round of four.

RECORD-SETTING SEASON

Valley Football teams combined for a 23-1 non-conference regular-season slate against FCS teams. The 23 wins are a record, and the winning percentage of .958 (23-1) is also a record. The previous records were 18 wins (18-4 in 1999) and .867 (13-2 record in 2003). **Including a 7-1 record in the playoffs, the MVFC is 30-2 vs. non-conference FCS teams.**

MVFC vs. MVFC in the PLAYOFFS

Including two previous games this year, league members have faced one another in the playoffs five times. In the three previous meetings, the winner advanced to the title game and won it two times.

By The Numbers

6 It's the number of league teams ranked in the Top 25 in the final regular-season rankings. This year, the league has had 7 or more ranked teams for eight weeks.

30 Happy Birthday to us. The league is celebrating its 30th season this year, having started in 1985 as the Gateway Conference.

30 It's the number of FCS non-league wins for the MVFC this year, against just two losses.

5 It's the number of national championships for the MVFC in its first 29 seasons -- the league has three-straight titles (all by North Dakota State).

13 North Dakota State has a 13-0 record in the playoffs at home. NDSU has lost just one playoff game in its history (17-1 in four previous trips).

5 Valley Football schools have defeated the No. 1 tournament seed five times in its history (1997-Villanova, 2002-McNeese State, 2005-New Hampshire, 2011-Sam Houston State, and 2014-New Hampshire).

19 Including this year, an MVFC school has reached the playoff semifinals 16 times in the past 19 years and 19 times overall. The last time the league did not have a semifinalist was in 2010.

9 It's the number of wins by MVFC schools in this year's playoff field. The previous record in one season for any conference was eight. The MVFC is guaranteed a 10th win.

15 NDSU has won 15-straight playoff games, dating back to Dec. 6, 2010. Included in that streak is a 12-0 record at home and three neutral-site games.

Illinois State and North Dakota State did not play each other this year and shared the MVFC title with identical 7-1 league records (both teams lost at UNI). The teams (ISU, NDSU) were declared co-champions and NDSU earned the league's automatic bid designation to the playoffs by virtue of a better national GPI rating (NDSU-1, ILS-2 in that rating).

Four-Straight

No FCS team has won four-straight title games. The last FCS team to play in four-straight title games was Youngstown State (1991-94), doing so as an independent. The Penguins joined the MVFC in 1997. Appalachian State is the only other FCS team with three-straight titles (2005-06-07). North Dakota State won the past three titles.

Title Contenders

The 2014 season will mark the eighth/ninth title appearances for a league team. The MVFC, founded in 1985, did not exist for the first seven years (1978-1984) of the FCS championship. The league is 5-2 in title games, although Youngstown State and Southern Illinois both played in the championship prior to joining the league.

“Final Four” Teams

League members Illinois State (1999, 2014), North Dakota State (2011, 2012, 2013, 2014), UNI (1985, 1987, 1992, 1996, 2001, 2005, and 2008), Southern Illinois (2007), Western Illinois (1998), Western Kentucky (2002), and Youngstown State (1997, 1999, and 2006) have each advanced to the semifinals in the league's 30-year history.

Top-Rated FCS Conference

Including this year, Valley Football has been ranked No. 1 by the Gridiron Power Index (GPI) in each of the past four seasons. The league also ranks No. 1 among FCS leagues in the Sagarin Ratings. Notably, the MVFC ranks ahead of five FBS conferences.

5 Playoff Bids for MVFC

The MVFC has earned five playoff bids for the first time in its history, matching an all-time FCS mark previously established by CAA Football (2007, 2008 and 2011).

MVFC Playoff Success

The league is 64-37 during the past 17+ years in the playoffs, and the MVFC has had two playoff teams every season since 1995. The league owns five national crowns. North Dakota State is the three-time defending FCS champion.

25-7 in Last Four Tournaments

The MVFC's record of 42-23 in the past 10+ years (since 2004) is better than any other conference, while the MVFC is an incredible 25-7 in the past 3+ tournaments. Three of those seven losses have included intra-conference playoff games.

5 In the Round of 16

Valley Football is the second league to have 5 teams reach the Round of 16 in the FCS Playoffs. CAA Football did it three times.

Missouri Valley Football Conference All-Newcomer Team; ISU's Roberson / SDSU's Wieneke Earn Top Honors

ST. LOUIS — **QB Tre Roberson** of Illinois State has been named the Missouri Valley Football Conference Newcomer of the Year, while **WR Jake Wieneke** of South Dakota State has earned MVFC Freshman of the Year honors. They head a list of 22 student-athletes named to the 2014 Missouri Valley Football Conference All-Newcomer Team. League coaches, sports information directors and a media panel selected the team.

Roberson led the MVFC in total offense (261.1 ypg) and with a pass efficiency rating of 150.8. He accounted for 29 total touchdowns (21 pass, 8 run) and finished the season with 2,198 passing yards and 21 touchdowns through the air. A three-time MVFC Newcomer of the Week selection, Roberson also rushed for 674 yards and eight scores on the ground to lead the way for a dangerous ISU offensive attack that led the conference in total offense (451.5 ypg), rushing offense (241.4 ypg) and scoring offense (38.7 ppg).

Wieneke became the first freshman in league history to top 1,000 receiving yards in a season, entering this weekend with 1,375 yards on 70 receptions with 15 TDs. The Maple Grove, Minn., native recorded seven 100-yard games during the regular season and caught a touchdown pass in all eight league games. His 15 TD receptions are a single-season school record and one shy of the MVFC record. He is a Jerry Rice Award finalist.
