Zillmer Dual Streak at 23, Closing on 100 Career Wins

North Dakota State University 184-pound senior **Hayden Zillmer** (Crosby, Minn./Crosby-Ironton H.S.) extended his consecutive dual winning streak to 23 matches with a major decision last Sunday against Wyoming ... Zillmer's last loss in dual competition came on Feb. 2, 2014 against Scott Liegel of Wisconsin ... He is 38-7 in dual competition during his career ... Zillmer has a career record of 99-27 with 20 pins and is tied for 10th on the Bison career charts.

20-20 For NDSU 125 Rodriguez, 184 Zillmer

Entering this weekend, North Dakota State University has a pair of 20-match winners in 125-pound junior **Josh Rodriguez** (Guadalupe, Calif./Righetti H.S.), who has put together a 27-7 record including 6-1 in duals ... The 27 wins are a career-high ... The other is 184-pound senior Hayden Zillmer (Crosby, Minn./Crosby-Ironton H.S.), who is 25-3 and 7-0 in duals ... Zillmer leads the Bison with eight pins, Rodriguez is second with five ... Zillmer has a team-high seven major decisions and Rodriguez has a team best five tech falls.

NDSU 184 Hayden Zillmer Earns Big 12 Wrestler of the Week Honors

North Dakota State University 184-pounder Hayden Zillmer was the Big 12 Wrestler of the Week on Jan. 6 following a third place showing at the 53rd Midlands Championships on Dec. 29-30 ... The Bison senior tallied a 6-1 overall record at the competition, with victories over two ranked opponents. ... This marks Zillmer's first Big 12 weekly honor and NDSU's first weekly award as an affiliate member of the conference.

In *TheOpen-Mat.com* (Feb. 2) rankings, **Josh Rodriguez** was No. 13 at 125 and **Hayden Zillmer** is No. 8 at 184 pounds ... In *WIN Magazine*'s Feb. 1) rankings, **Josh Rodriguez** is No. 15 at 125 pounds and **Hayden Zillmer** is No. 7 at 184 pounds ... In the *Amateur Wrestling News* (Feb. 2), 125 **Josh Rodriguez** is No. 16 and 184 **Hayden Zillmer** is No. 5.

Zillmer Places Third, Rodriguez Fourth at Midlands Championships

North Dakota State University 184-pounder **Hayden Zillmer** stormed through the consolation bracket to finish third and 125-pounder **Josh Rodriguez** placed fourth Dec. 30, at the Midlands Championships hosted by Northwestern University in McGaw Hall ... The Bison finished 16th in the team standings with 37.5 points.

Rodriguez' Third Place Finish Highlights NDSU Run at Reno Tournament of Champions North Dakota State 125-pounder **Josh Rodriguez** won six of seven matches to place third and highlight the Bison run at the 2015 Reno Tournament of Champions on Dec. 20 ... Three other NDSU wrestlers placed in the top six at the event ... The Bison had 57.5 points and finished ninth in the team standings ... **Clay Ream**, finished fifth at 149 at the Reno TOC, while 149 **Kyle**

Gliva and 141 **Mitch Bengtson** each placed sixth.

Zillmer Seventh, Ream Eighth at Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational

North Dakota State 184-pounder **Hayden Zillmer** placed seventh and 149-pound **Clay Ream** finished eighth during the final day of action Saturday, Dec. 5, at the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational held in the Cashman Center ... NDSU was 22nd in the team standings with 37.5 points.

Big 12 Adds North Dakota State to Wrestling Membership

North Dakota State along with Air Force, Northern Colorado, South Dakota State, Utah Valley and Wyoming have joined Iowa State, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State and West Virginia in the Big 12 Conference ... NDSU and the other affiliate members are eligible immediately ... The 10-team Big 12 wrestling championship has shifted to a neutral site and has expanded to a two-day event with the 2016 championship set for March 5-6 at Sprint Center in Kansas City, Mo.
