North Dakota State remained No. 23 in the USA Today/National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA) Coaches Top 25 Poll on Jan. 31 ... The Bison were 21st in the tournament and 23rd in the dual rankings compiled by InterMat.com, tied for 18th in the Track Wrestling rankings and 19th in WIN Wrestling Magazine's Tournament Power Index and 20th on the dual charts.

Ream, a junior from Wentzville, Mo., picked up three wins against top 15 opponents at the Virginia Duals with decisions over Virginia's No. 8 Andrew Atkinson, Virginia Tech's No. 14 Sal Mastriani and Arizona State's No. 13 Josh Shields.

Rodriguez Named Big 12 Conference Co-Wrestler of the Week

North Dakota State 125-pounder **Josh Rodriguez** was named Big 12 Conference Co-Wrestler of the Week on Dec. 12 ... He earned the honor for the first time in his career ... Rodriguez, a senior from Guadalupe, Calif. (Righetti H.S.), won a pair of matches including a 24-9 tech fall over Maryland's Michael Beck and his third pin of the season against Trevor Mello of George Mason.

Pair of NCAA Qualifiers Return for North Dakota State

North Dakota State returns a pair of two-time NCAA qualifiers in 125-pounder **Josh Rodriguez** and 157-pounder **Clay Ream** ... Rodriguez and Ream are two-time NCAA national qualifiers ... Ream moves from 149 to 157 this season ... Rodriguez, a redshirt senior from Guadalupe, Calif. (Righetti H.S.), has compiled an 17-0 record this season including 14-1 in duals with eight tech falls and four pins ... His updated record (thru Jan. 28) is 95-34 including 42-14 in duals with 14 pins ... Rodriguez placed third at the Big 12 Championships and was a win away from earning All-America honors last season ... He is 5-4 in two NCAA appearances ... Ream, a redshirt junior from Wentzville, Mo. (Holt H.S.), was the 2016 NCAA Division I Wrestling Elite 90 Award winner ... Ream has grinded to an 18-3 record including 13-1 in duals with five pins and five major decisions ... His updated record (thru Jan. 28) is 65-35 overall, 27-10 in duals with 15 pins ... He placed third at the Big 12 Championships ... Ream has a 3-4 record in two NCAA appearances ... He was also named to the NWCA All-Academic and Academic All-Big 12 Conference Wrestling Team.

Roger Kish

Head Coach

Sixth Season

(Minnesota, 2008)

Roger Kish is in his sixth season as head coach of the North Dakota State wrestling team. He is the fourth head coach in the 59-year history of the Bison wrestling program. He has a 52-37 overall record including 22-7 in the Big 12 Conference (5-3) and Western Wrestling Conference (17-4) duals. He spent two years as an assistant wrestling coach at NDSU prior to taking the head coaching position for the 2011-12 season.

Kish led the Bison to a seventh place finish in their first appearance at the Big 12 Championships last season. Hayden Zillmer was Big 12 runner-up at 184 pounds, while Josh Rodriguez (125) and Clay Ream (149) both placed third. Zillmer landed a spot on the U.S. National Greco-Roman team over the summer, while Ream was the NCAA Elite 90 Award winner at the 2016 NCAA Wrestling Championships in New York City.

Kish has directed the Bison to a pair of NCAA West Regional/Western Wrestling Conference championships (2014, 2015) and two WWC regular season titles (2013, 2015). Kish is a three-time WWC Coach of the Year award and the Bison have produced 17 NCAA West Region/WWC individual champions. Four wrestlers, Trent Sprenkle (2013, 125/5th), Steven Monk (2014, 165/3rd), Kurtis Julson (2015, 174/8th) and Hayden Zillmer (2015, 184/6th) have earned All-American honors.

Kish joined the NDSU program after a successful wrestling career at the University of Minnesota. Kish was a graduate assistant for the Gophers in 2008-09. A Lapeer, Mich. native, he was a two-time All-American and two-time NCAA runner-up for the Gophers at 184 pounds. He had a career record of 117-27 for the Gophers. As a sophomore, he went 35-7 en route to a Big Ten title and an NCAA runner-up finish. In his junior season, Kish was 37-3 and was the Big Ten and national runner-up. He was also a team captain.

Kish graduated from Minnesota in May 2008 with a bachelor's degree in business and marketing education. He was also a two-time cadet national champion and also captured a USA Wrestling junior national title. At Lapeer West High School, he was a four-time Michigan state champion. Kish is the son of Roger and Brenda Kish. His older brother, James, wrestled at North Carolina.
