NDSU 133 **Cam Sykora**, 149 **Jaden Van Maanen**, and 174 **Lorenzo De La Riva** also had pins in the lopsided win.

### NDSU Rolls Northern Colorado 30-7

North Dakota State claimed eight of 10 bouts including the last six in a row to defeat Northern Colorado 30-7 in a Big12 Conference dual before 583 in Scheels Center on Jan. 27. The dual started at 285 pounds ... NDSU 133 **Cam Sykora** and 165 **Andrew Fogarty** each had tech falls, while 149 **Jaden Van Maanen** and 174 **Lorenzo De La Riva** both logged major decisions.

### Bison Wrestlers Claim Two Titles at North Country Open

Unattached 141-pounder **Dylan Droegemueller** and unattached 157 **Jared Franek** both claimed North Country Open titles and North Dakota State had 11 place-winners overall in event hosted by the College of Saint John's on Jan. 26, in Sexton Arena ... Unattached 133 **McGwire Midkiff** was runner-up, 149 **Gavin Sutton**, 174 **Jesse Shearer** and unattached 197 **Noah Cressell** were third.

### NDSU Earns 23-15 Win at Central Michigan

North Dakota State 165 **Andrew Fogarty**, 133 **Cam Sykora** and 125 **Brent Fleetwood** each had bonus point wins and 157 **Luke Weber** came up with a last-second decision as the Bison defeated host Central Michigan 24-15 in a non-conference dual at McGuirk Arena on Jan. 24.

### No. 18 Pitt Wins Close Ones, Beats No. 23 NDSU 22-11

No. 18-ranked Pitt won 7 of 10 bouts including 5 of 6 decided by 2 or less points during a 22-11 win over No. 23 North Dakota State in a non-conference dual on Jan. 12, before 554 spectators in the Scheels Center ... Newcomer at 157 pounds, **Luke Weber** made his home debut in dramatic fashion with a 10-4 decision over Pitt's No. 10 Taleb Rahmani ... NDSU 125 **Brent Fleetwood** won by tech fall, while 165 **Andrew Fogarty** won by decision.

### No. 21 Iowa State Beats No. 23 NDSU 29-7

No. 21 Iowa State won eight of 10 bouts including a pair of one-point decisions and three bonus point wins in defeating No. 23 North Dakota State 29-7 in a Big 12 Conference dual on Jan. 9, before season-high 792 spectators in the Scheels Center ... NDSU No. 21 165 **Andrew Fogarty** and No. 8 125 **Brent Fleetwood** were the lone winners for the Bison.

### No. 20 NDSU Rebounds with 33-9 Win Over Indiana to Go 1-2 at South Beach

No. 20-ranked North Dakota State dropped a pair of close decisions to West Virginia 19-17 on the final bout and No. 12 North Carolina 20-19 on criteria, but rebounded by bouncing Indiana 33-9 South Beach Duals on Dec. 30 in the Fort Lauderdale Convention Center ... Travel issues forced the Bison to reschedule after missing Saturday's two duals, including a date with No. 8-ranked Cornell, and hit the mat for three matches ... Five North Dakota State wrestlers won a pair of matches led by the 2-0 efforts by No. 9-ranked 125 **Brent Fleetwood** and 174 **Lorenzo De La Riva** ... De La Riva recorded a tech fall and a major decision against North Carolina and Indiana, while Fleetwood picked up a forfeit and major decision.

## ROGER KISH

### Head Coach

### Eighth Season

### (Minnesota, 2008)

Roger Kish is in his eighth season as head coach of the North Dakota State wrestling team. He is the fourth head coach in the 61-year history of the Bison wrestling program. He has a 70-54 overall record including 28-19 in Big 12 Conference (11-15) and Western Wrestling Conference (17-4) duals. He spent two years as an assistant wrestling coach at NDSU prior to taking the head coaching position for the 2011-12 season.

Kish led the Bison to a fifth place finish at the Big 12 Championships last season. Clay Ream was the Big 12 runner-up at 157 pounds and Andrew Fogarty placed second at 165 pounds. Ream was NCAA Elite 90 Award winner for the third year in a row at the 2018 NCAA Wrestling Championships in Cleveland.

Kish has directed the Bison to a pair of NCAA West Regional/Western Wrestling Conference championships (2014, 2015) and two WWC regular season titles (2013, 2015). Kish is a three-time WWC Coach of the Year award and the Bison have produced 17 NCAA West Region/WWC individual champions. Four wrestlers, Trent Sprenkle (2013, 125/5th), Steven Monk (2014, 165/3rd), Kurtis Julson (2015, 174/8th) and Hayden Zillmer (2015, 184/6th) have earned All-American honors.

Kish joined the NDSU program after a successful wrestling career at the University of Minnesota. Kish was a graduate assistant for the Gophers in 2008-09. A Lapeer, Mich. native, he was a two-time All-American and two-time NCAA runner-up for the Gophers at 184 pounds. He had a career record of 117-27 for the Gophers. As a sophomore, he went 35-7 en route to a Big Ten title and an NCAA runner-up finish. In his junior season, Kish was 37-3 and was the Big Ten and national runner-up. He was also a team captain.

Kish graduated from Minnesota in May 2008 with a bachelor's degree in business and marketing education.

He was also a two-time cadet national champion and also captured a USA Wrestling junior national title. At Lapeer West High School, he was a four-time Michigan state champion. Kish is the son of Roger and Brenda Kish. His older brother, James, wrestled at North Carolina.
