No. 2 North Dakota State at South Dakota State Saturday for Dakota Marker Game

THIS WEEK: The No. 2-ranked North Dakota State football team is on the road for its next two games beginning this weekend when the firstplace Bison (8-0, 5-0 MVFC) travel to face ninthranked South Dakota State (6-2, 3-2 MVFC). Game time is 2 p.m. at Dana J. Dykhouse Stadium (19,300) in Brookings, S.D.

TELEVISION: The statewide ABC network of WDAY (Fargo), WDAZ (Grand Forks), KBMY (Bismarck/Dickinson) and KMCY (Minot/Williston) will have live coverage beginning at 2 p.m. with Dom Izzo calling the play-by-play, Kyle Emanuel as color analyst, and Logan Campbell reporting.

THE SERIES: This is the 112th meeting between North Dakota State and South Dakota State dating back to 1903. NDSU leads the all-time series 63-43-5 and the Bison have won 14 of 21 matchups as Division I opponents since 2004, including four NCAA playoff games. SDSU snapped a three-game losing streak in the series with last spring's 27-17 win in Fargo, which cut NDSU's lead in the Dakota Marker series to 10-7.

DAKOTA MARKER: North Dakota State and South Dakota State have played for the Dakota Marker annually since 2004 when the two teams began NCAA Division I competition. The trophy is a 75-pound model replica of the original quartzite monuments that were placed at half-mile intervals along the state border in the summers of 1891 and 1892. It is inscribed with N.D. and S.D. on opposite sides and 190 M, the number of miles between the two schools. NDSU has won 10 of 17 meetings for the marker. Postseason games are not included in the trophy series.

THE LAST MEETING: South Dakota State snapped North Dakota State's 32-game home winning streak with a 27-17 victory in Fargo last April, which clinched SDSU's automatic qualifier to the FCS playoffs. SDSU freshman quarterback Mark Gronowski was 10 of 14 passing for 149 yards and rushed for 126 yards, and Pierre Strong added 95 yards on the ground as the Jackrabbits ran 46 times for 305 yards, the most rushing yards against a Bison team since 2008. NDSU quarterback Cam Miller rushed for a pair of third-quarter TDs to tie the game 10-10 and 17-17 before the Jacks went ahead for good with Cole Frahm's 24-yard field goal with 7:55 to play. SDSU held the Bison to 97 rushing yards, which was the first time since 2014 NDSU finished under 100 rushing yards.

BISON LEVEL SYCAMORES IN TREES BOWL: Kobe Johnson rushed for a career-high 155 yards including a school-record 97-yard touchdown run as North Dakota State beat Indiana State 44-2 in the annual Trees Bowl game. Six players scored touchdowns as the Bison rolled up 477 yards of total offense. NDSU scored on its first five possessions to build a 30-0 halftime lead. Indiana State scored its only points on a blocked punt out of the end zone in the fourth quarter. Cordell Volson was named MVFC Offensive Lineman of the Week for his performance in the win.

DEFENSE RISES TO THE OCCASION: North Dakota State's defense held its opponent out of the end zone for the third time this season against Indiana State. Michael Tutsie led the Bison in tackles for the third straight week with a game-high eight stops. Tutsie assisted a tackle for loss on a fourthand-1, stuffed another run for zero yards on third-and-1, and made a solo tackle on third-and-goal from the 1. Jackson Hankey followed that with a fourth-down stop at the 1. Marques Sigle recorded his first career interception and the Bison held Indiana State to 3 of 15 on third down.

EIGHT IN A ROW: NDSU, the only 8-0 team in FCS, is off to an 8-0 start for the eighth time in 18 years of Division I play. Coincidentally, the last time the Bison lost their ninth game of the season after an 8-0 start was NDSU's first trip to Dana J. Dykhouse Stadium in 2017, which South Dakota State won 33-21. The Bison are 5-0 in MVFC play for the seventh time since joining the league.

THE GREAT OUTDOORS: NDSU has a 12-2 record in outdoor games during the month of November since joining the Missouri Valley Football Conference in 2008 with the only losses coming in 2017 at South Dakota State (33-21) and 2010 at Missouri State (3-0). This is NDSU's second trip to SDSU for a November game in MVFC play. NDSU is 13-3 in November MVFC road games including a 2016 win at South Dakota (28-21) and 2015 loss at Northern Iowa (23-3) both played indoors.

OCTOBER SUCCESS: Counting the lone game of the fall last October against Central Arkansas, North Dakota State's 5-0 start in the Missouri Valley Football Conference extended NDSU's winning streak to 20 straight games in the month of October since the 19-17 home loss to South Dakota State on the 15th of October 2016.

VOLSON APPROACHING 60: Sixth-year senior offensive lineman Cordell Volson this week will become the 19th NDSU football player to appear in his 59th career game. Volson and defensive end Logan McCormick (52nd game) are NDSU's active leaders in games played. Appalachian State's Pierre Banks played in an NCAA-record 62 games from 2004-08, and NDSU defensive back Christian Dudzik is the NCAA record holder starting all 61 games of his NDSU career from 2011-14. Offensive tackle **Joe Haeg** is second with 60 starts from 2012-15. Only six players have participated in 60 or more games in Bison football history.

WATSON IN TOP 10: Senior wide receiver **Christian Watson** is closing in on the 2,000-yard mark, which only seven other NDSU players have reached in program history. Watson currently ranks ninth all-time at NDSU with 1,845 career receiving yards and needs 71 yards to pass **Len Kretchman** (1985-88) for eighth on the list.

HISTORIC PACE: North Dakota State has allowed an FCS-low seven touchdowns this year and leads the FCS in scoring defense allowing 8.1 points per game. That is the best scoring defense in NDSU's 18 seasons as a Division I program, topping the 11.3 ppg by the 2013 national championship team. Only Georgia is allowing fewer points (6.6 ppg) this year in Division I.

IN THE ZONE: North Dakota State leads the FCS in red-zone defense (.500) allowing four rushing touchdowns and two field goals in 12 opportunities inside the 20-yard line. NDSU opponents have four turnovers on downs, one interception and one fumble in the red zone. Only James Madison has allowed fewer trips inside the red zone this season (11). NDSU's offense was a season-best 5-for-5 with five touchdowns in the red zone against Indiana State.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK: North Dakota State has had three players earn five Player of the Week awards in the Missouri Valley Football Conference this season:

- **Cordell Volson**, Offensive Line (9/13, 10/18, 11/1)...Played all 23 offensive snaps in the first half at right tackle and right guard in the 64-0 win over Valparaiso...Graded 95% with zero missed assignments or QB pressures...NDSU rushed 18 times for 285 yards while building a 43-0 halftime lead...Graded 92% with no sacks or tackles for loss allowed in a 20-0 win at Illinois State...Helped the Bison rush for 201 yards, convert 9 of 16 third downs and control the ball for more than 37 minutes...Led impressive first half against Indiana State playing tackle and guard as the Bison scored on their first five possessions and built a 30-0 halftime lead.
- Jake Reinholz, Special Teams (10/3)...Kicked three field goals and one extra point in the 16-10 win at North Dakota...Made FGs from a career-long 45 yards, 34 and 30 yards.
- **Quincy Patterson**, Newcomer (10/17)...Rushed 18 times for 100 yards and 5.6 yards per carry in the 20-0 win at Illinois State...Went 13 of 22 passing for 124 yards and one touchdown.

BISON PICKED SECOND: North Dakota State was picked to finish second in the Missouri Valley Football Conference behind South Dakota State in a preseason poll of the league's media, head coaches and sports information directors. SDSU had 24 first-place votes and NDSU had 18. North Dakota was picked third, Southern Illinois fourth and Northern Iowa fifth with one first-place vote.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE: The Bison took 10 spots on the Preseason All-MVFC team highlighted by senior wide receiver Christian Watson, who was named to the first team as a wide receiver and return specialist. Six other NDSU first team picks included fullback Hunter Luepke, offensive linemen Cordell Volson and Cody Mauch, defensive end Spencer Waege, linebacker James Kaczor and safety Michael Tutsie. Bison tight end Noah Gindorff and defensive tackle Eli Mostaert were named to the preseason second team. Tight end Josh Babicz was honorable mention.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS: NDSU has seven preseason All-Americans including fullback Hunter Luepke and offensive lineman Cordell Volson, who were both named to the Stats Perform and HERO Sports first teams. Christian Watson was listed as first team kick returner by Stats Perform, and second team returner and third team wide receiver by HERO Sports. Tight end Noah Gindorff was second team by HERO Sports and Stats Perform. Defensive end Spencer Waege and linebacker James Kaczor were second team picks by Stats Perform, and safety Michael Tutsie was a third team selection by HERO Sports.

SENIOR BOWL WATCH LIST: NDSU wide receiver Christian Watson and offensive lineman Cordell Volson were named to the preseason watch list for the Reese's Senior Bowl, the nation's most prestigious college all-star game. NDSU has had 10 Senior Bowl participants and seven in the past eight years including 2021 offensive lineman Dillon Radunz and linebacker Jabril Cox.

BUTKUS AWARD WATCH LIST: Bison linebacker **Jackson Hankey** was on the preseason watch list for the Butkus Award, presented annually to the top linebacker in college football. Hankey was the only nominee from the Football Championship Subdivision and one of only five mid-major players on the list. Former NDSU linebacker **Nick DeLuca** was named to the preseason watch list in 2016.

BISON AT HOME: The Bison have a 172-27 record in the Fargodome, 29-5 at home against FCS Top 10 ranked teams, and winners of 72 of the last 74 home games over non-conference opponents. North Dakota State has a 28-1 record in the Fargodome during the NCAA playoffs since 2010 with the only loss coming to eventual national champion James Madison in the 2016 semifinals. NDSU's 32-game home winning streak in the Fargodome from September 2017 through April 2021 was the fourth longest in NCAA FCS history. The Bison have gone unbeaten at home in 12 of 28 seasons played in the Fargodome.

NDSU In The Polls

- NDSU in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 for the 155th consecutive week dating back to Nov. 1, 2010, when the Bison moved back into the poll at No. 23 after a bye week. NDSU had been unranked for two weeks following a 34-24 loss at Illinois State.
- NDSU is ranked in the FCS Coaches Poll for the 159th consecutive week dating back to Sept. 6, 2010, following NDSU's 6-3 win at Kansas.
- The Bison went wire-to-wire in the No. 1 spot in 2013. 2018 and 2019.
- NDSU was ranked No. 1 in one or both polls for 31 straight weeks during its FCS-record 33-game winning streak from November 2012 through November 2014.
- NDSU was ranked No. 1 for 32 straight weeks during its FCS-record 39-game winning streak from the final 2017 poll through the spring 2021 loss at Southern Illinois.
- NDSU garnered votes in the AP Top 25 eight straight weeks after its 2019 ESPN College GameDay win at South Dakota State. NDSU has received votes 25 weeks in the AP Top 25 after each of NDSU's first three FCS national championships, 10 straight weeks after beating lowa State in the 2014 opener, and four weeks in 2016 after beating 11th-ranked lowa.
- NDSU's 74 poll points (27th overall) after the lowa win were the most for an FCS team in the AP Top 25.
- NDSU made its debut in the FCS national rankings in its first year as a Division I program Nov. 16, 2004, when the Bison were 21st in the USA Today/ESPN Top 25 and 24th in the Sports Network/CSTV Top 25 following a 25-7 road win over No. 20/21 UC Davis.

ON THE ROAD: North Dakota State has a 46-5 record in true road games since 2011, and that record is 56-5 including 10 neutral site games over the same span. NDSU's 2-2 road record in the spring season of 2020-21 was the first time since 2010 the Bison have lost multiple road games.

BISON RETURNING TO TWIN CITIES: North Dakota State will host Eastern Washington on the opening weekend of the 2023 season at U.S. Bank Stadium, home of the Minnesota Vikings. NDSU drew a crowd of 34,544 fans to the 2019 season opener against Butler at Target Field, home of the Minnesota Twins.

NEW INDOOR FACILITY: Construction began in mid-September on the Nodak Insurance Company Football Performance Complex, the new indoor practice facility for NDSU athletic teams. The entire cost of the estimated \$37.2 million building project is being privately funded. The complex will have two artificial turf football fields. The indoor field will be a full 120 yards long and 60 yards wide with a roof clearance of 72 feet at the peak. Seven overhead doors will open from the indoor facility onto the outdoor practice field, scoreboards and play clocks will be provided on both fields, and LED lighting systems will be installed indoors and outdoors.

#PROBISON: NDSU had 12 former players in the pros this year including Packers OL **Billy Turner** (8th year), Colts QB **Carson Wentz** (6th), Steelers OL **Joe Haeg** (6th), Ravens LB **Chris Board** (4th), Chargers QB **Easton Stick** (3rd), Vikings TE **Ben Ellefson** (2nd), Steelers LB **Derrek Tuszka** (2nd), 49ers QB **Trey Lance** (1st), Titans OL **Dillon Radunz** (1st) and Cowboys LB **Jabril Cox** (1st). OL **Zack Johnson** (2nd) was activated to the Cardinals' active roster from the practice squad in late October before being released, and RB **Bruce Anderson** (3rd year) is in the Canadian Football League on the Edmonton Elks practice squad.

16-TIME NATIONAL CHAMPIONS: North Dakota State has won 16 football national championships. NDSU claimed three College Division national championships in 1965, 1968 and 1969 via the national polls, five Division II playoff titles in 1983, 1985, 1986, 1988 and 1990, and was the first team in college football history to win five straight national titles with FCS crowns in 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015 before winning again in 2017, 2018 and 2019.

SUCCESS VS. THE FBS: NDSU has a 9-3 record against Football Bowl Subdivision opponents and has won six in a row against FBS foes since 2010 with wins at Kansas (6-3), Minnesota (37-24), Colorado State (22-7), Kansas State (24-21), Iowa State (34-14) and 11th-ranked Iowa (23-21). NDSU's first three FBS wins were against Ball State (2006), Central Michigan (2007) and Minnesota (2007). North Dakota State has three future FBS games against Arizona (2022), Colorado (2024) and Oregon (2028).

NDSU Head Coach Matt Entz

Matt Entz was named head football coach at North Dakota State for the 2019 season after spending five seasons as the NDSU's defensive coordinator. He is the 31st head coach in program history.

Entz became the first Division I head football coach to go 16-0 in his first full season at the helm, and the 2019 Bison became the first modern-era college football team in any division to finish a season 16-0, joining the 1894 Yale Bulldogs as the only 16-0 teams in college football history.

Following the departure of 24 seniors, and with five new assistant coaches, North Dakota State completed the 2019 season with an FCS-record 37-game winning streak (eventually ended at 39 games), the third longest in Division I football history. NDSU won its ninth consecutive Missouri Valley Football Conference title and the program's eighth NCAA national championship in nine seasons.

This is the first head coaching job for Entz, who was an assistant coach for more than 20 years including 15 years of experience as a defensive coordinator and eight as an associate head coach in two programs. At NDSU, he's been part of six Missouri Valley Football Conference championships and five NCAA national championships with the Bison.

Entz, who was named the 2018 FCS Coordinator of the Year in his third time as a finalist for the award, has led a Bison defense that allowed less than 14 points per game over his five seasons as the defensive coordinator and consistently ranked in the top five of FCS in scoring defense and total defense.

NDSU had eight FCS All-America honorees on defense, and two of Entz's former linebackers, Nick DeLuca and Chris Board, went on to play in the NFL.

The Missouri Valley Football Conference is familiar territory for Entz. He came to NDSU in 2014 under head coach Chris Klieman after one season as the associate head coach, co-defensive coordinator and defensive line coach at Western Illinois in 2013, and spent three previous years at Northern Iowa.

He was named defensive line coach in 2010 at Northern Iowa and assumed defensive coordinator duties at UNI in 2012 after Klieman departed for NDSU.

Entz was defensive coordinator from 2002 to 2009 at Winona State, where he was promoted to associate head coach in 2003 and coached defensive line for three years and linebackers for five years.

Prior to that, Entz was the assistant head football coach and linebackers coach at Wayne (Neb.) State from 1999 to 2001 and the defensive coordinator at Illinois College in 1998. He holds certification from the National Strength and Conditioning Association and served as an assistant strength and conditioning coach during his time at Wayne State.

Entz earned a bachelor's degree in biology from Wartburg College in 1995 and a master's degree in education and exercise science from Wayne (Neb.) State College in 1998. He and his wife, Brenda, have two sons, Kellen and Konner.
