THIS WEEK

The North Dakota State (9-26, 5-10 Summit) baseball team is set to begin a seven-game homestand hosting South Dakota State (16-25, 7-10 Summit) for a three-game series beginning on Friday. First pitch is set for 6:30 p.m., at Newman Outdoor Field.

COVERAGE

All three games will feature live statistics and be available on Summit League Network for subscribers, while the Friday night game will also broadcast on WDAY Xtra. Fans can listen to all three games on Bison 1660 with free streaming available on GoBison.com/allaccess and the NDSU Athletics mobile app. Live statistics and video links are available on GoBison.com/coverage.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bison totaled a season-high 16 hits in the 13-6 win at Creighton on Tuesday. NDSU had five players post multiple hits with **Tyman Long** going 2-of-5 at the plate with two doubles, two runs and four RBI. **Garrett Shupe** earned the win with two strikeouts, one walk and one hit over 3.0 innings.

THE SERIES VS. SOUTH DAKOTA STATE

This will be the 226th all-time meeting between NDSU and South Dakota State dating back to 1956 with the Jackrabbits leading the series, 136-89. Earlier this season, SDSU won the final two games of the three-game series in Brookings, including an 11-1 win eight innings in the series finale on March 21.

LIFE ON THE ROAD

The Bison were originally scheduled to play their first 24 games away from home, but weather forced schedule changes after each of the first two home series were adjusted. NDSU played 27 straight on the road before opening its home schedule with a doubleheader against Omaha on April 19.

POWER FOUR WINS

The Bison have faced opponents from three of the four power conferences this season. NDSU has taken on teams from the ACC (Virginia), SEC (Missouri, Vanderbilt) and Big Ten (Nebraska, Minnesota) across 10 games, including a 5-2 win at Vanderbilt and a 7-4 extra-inning win at Minnesota.

HOMERUN BALL

After only hitting eight home runs over the first 19 games, the Bison have erupted for 24 home runs over the last 16 games. NDSU assembled a streak of 12 straight games with a homer from March 17 at Minnesota to April 24 at Oral Roberts, which was the longest streak since at least the 2000 season. **Colten Becker** leads the Bison with a team-best six over the 16-game stretch. He is currently tied for first in Summit League play with five home runs.

NEWMAN OUTDOOR FIELD

North Dakota State baseball has played and practiced on campus at Newman Outdoor Field since 1997. The Bison share the facility with the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks of the independent American Association.

Completed in June 1996 at an original cost of \$5.5 million, the stadium's permanent seating capacity is 4,419 fans. Naming rights were awarded to Harold Newman, founder of Newman Outdoor Advertising, for \$1.5 million in 1998.

Dimensions are 318 feet to left field, 399 feet to left-center field, 408 to center field, 365 to right-center, and 314 down the right-field line. The surface is natural grass.



THE ROAD WARRIORS

The Bison were originally scheduled to play their first 24 games away from home, but weather forced schedule changes after each of the first two home series were adjusted. NDSU went on to play its first 27 straight games on the road to start this season.

Last season, NDSU played 43 games away from home across nine different states.

BISON STREAKS AND MULTI-HIT GAMES

- **Caleb Corbin** has totaled a team-high eight multiple hit games.
- **Colten Becker** assembled a team-high 10-game hit streak earlier this season, which was the longest of any player on the roster.
- **Colten Becker** is on a team-best and season-high 16-game reached base streak.

TIDBITS FROM THE LAST FIVE GAMES

- The Bison are 3-2 over their last five games.
- NDSU has totaled 10 or more hits in each of its last two games.
- **Chase Womack** has appeared in four games with a team-best .429 batting average, including six hits, five runs and two RBI.
- **Tyman Long** has also notched a .417 batting average over the five game stretch. He has appeared in four games and has totaled a team-best nine RBI with five hits and five runs.

WORKING OUT OF THE BULLPEN

Sheamus Ryan has made 10 relief appearances out of the bullpen in his freshman season. The Calgary, Alberta native has tossed 18 strikeouts over 31.1 innings. Ryan also hasn't allowed a run in each of his last five appearances (16.1 innings).

YEAR FIVE UNDER OAKES

Head coach **Tyler Oakes** enters his fifth season as the head coach and 13th season overall at NDSU. He recently surpassed the 100 career wins mark in the 4-3 win at Northern Colorado with a 104-139-1 overall record. Oakes joins **Mitch McLeod** (347 wins), **Tod Brown** (341 wins) and **Jim Pattersen** (131 wins) as the only coaches in Bison history to reach the mark. Oakes led the Bison to their first-ever Summit League regular season title in his first season in 2022 and their third Summit League Tournament championship last season.

WALKER TABBED PEAK PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Jonah Walker was named the Summit League Peak Pitcher of the Week and helped the Bison to an 11-3 win at Oral Roberts in the series finale. The Lincoln, Neb., native tossed two strikeouts with three walks and one run across 5.0 innings. Walker also registered a 1.80 ERA and held the Golden Eagles to a .263 batting average. He became the third different Bison pitcher to earn the award this season, joining **Zak Szabo** and **Parker Puetz**.

THE CHALLENGING SCHEDULE AHEAD

The Bison are set to play 51 games and will take on 11 different opponents across 21 total non-conference games. The non-conference portion of the schedule features four opponents that qualified for the NCAA Tournament last season, including Stetson, Vanderbilt, Nebraska and Creighton.

BISON RETURN TO THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Bison returned to the NCAA Tournament for the third time in the NDSU Division I era last season and first time since 2021. It marked their second straight appearance winning at least one game after upending then-ranked No. 23 Kansas, 4-3, in an elimination game in the Fayetteville regional. NDSU clinched its spot in the NCAA Tournament after winning the Summit League Tournament for the third time in program history.

SUMMIT LEAGUE PLAYERS TO WATCH

Dante Smith and **Parker Puetz** were named to the Summit League Players and Pitchers to Watch List. Smith is the only returning All-Summit League player on the roster from last season after posting a .375 batting average with 17 runs and 11 RBI in league play. Puetz made five starts on the mound last season after working himself back from injury for a majority of the season. He earned a spot on the 2023 D1Baseball Freshman All-America Second Team and 2023 All-Summit League Second Team.

WHO'S BACK?

NDSU returns four players that started in at least 50 percent of the games last season, including **Dante Smith**, **Colten Becker**, **Noah Gordon** and **Tommy Simon**. **Matt Sargeant** and **Garrett Shupe** are the only two pitchers on the roster to have appeared in at least 10.0 innings last season. The roster also features nine seniors: **Caleb Corbin**, **Diego Trujillo**, **Colten Becker**, **Bennett Freiter**, **Tyman Long**, **Jonah Walker**, **Brayden Marks**, **Hudson Hart** and **Braden Gluth**.

WELCOME TO THE SQUAD

The Bison welcome 23 newcomers this season, including six true freshman: **Landon Sandy, Sheamus Ryan, Easton Reimers, Austin Boylan, Kaden Connor and Sam Anderson.**

JUCO ROOTS

The Bison have added roster depth through junior colleges with the roster featuring seven players having played at the junior college level prior to NDSU, including six newcomers: **Lathan Van Ausdall, Chase Womack, AJ Doll, Chris Billings, Connor McCaleb and Jack Surdey.**

BUILDING THROUGH THE PORTAL

NDSU has used the transfer portal to add 17 of its 23 newcomers entering this season. The Bison added five players and 12 pitchers. Of that group, eight were Division I and three played at the Division II or NAIA level prior to NDSU.

SUMMIT LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

The Bison were picked fifth in the Summit League Preseason Poll with 11 total points. Oral Roberts earned the top spot with 24 points and four first-place votes.

BISON PLAY IN BIG TIME VENUES

Under fifth-year head coach **Tyler Oakes**, the Bison have made a habit of scheduling a challenging non-conference schedule in preparation of Summit League play and have done it in some of the best venues in college baseball. Over the last four seasons, the Bison have played in front of five of the largest road crowds in program history since 1977. Last season, the Bison played in front of 10,446 fans at LSU on March 5, 2025, the highest road attendance in program history.

30TH SEASON AT NEWMAN OUTDOOR FIELD

This season will mark the 30th season of Bison baseball at Newman Outdoor Field dating back to 1997. NDSU has amassed a 265-153-1 overall record over that span at home.

BISON TAKE ON REDHAWKS IN EXHIBITION PLAY

For the second straight season, NDSU will take on the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks in exhibition play at Newman Outdoor Field on May 6 at 6:00 p.m. The RedHawks edged the Bison last season in front of 1,908 fans. The RedHawks are members of the American Association and also play home games at Newman Outdoor Field.

#PROBISON

NDSU has had nine incoming or current players selected in the MLB Draft since 2013. **Joey Danielson** became the 14th NDSU player selected in the MLB Draft dating back to 1968 after the Texas Rangers picked him in the 17th round in 2024. It marked the second straight season NDSU had a current pitcher selected in the draft after **Cade Feeney** was picked by the Boston Red Sox in the 13th round in 2023. **Bennett Hostetler** was also selected in the 18th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Miami Marlins. He was recently activated to the roster for the Triple-A Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp on April 9.

BELZER JOINS COACHING STAFF

Nick Belzer joined the NDSU coaching staff this offseason as an assistant coach. He started his college career at DMACC before playing two seasons at Minnesota State from 2017-18. Belzer also spent time within the Milwaukee Brewers organization until 2022 and was a pitching coach with the Willmar Stingers in the Northwoods League last summer.

AS A HEAD COACH

Tyler Oakes was named the head baseball coach on June 22, 2021. Oakes first joined the Bison staff as the team's pitching coach in December 2013. He was appointed as the recruiting coordinator for the Bison in the summer of 2016, and elevated to associate head coach in the summer of 2018.

In 2025, Oakes helped the Bison navigate through the No. 1 non-conference schedule in the nation on their way to their third Summit League Tournament championship in program history. NDSU went on to make its third appearance in the NCAA Tournament in the Fayetteville Regional. The Bison picked up their second win in program history in the NCAA Tournament after upending Kansas, 4-3, in an elimination game. NDSU earned seven All-Summit League selections in the 2025 season, including Jake Schaffner, who became the first player in program history to be named the Summit League Defensive Player of the Year. Nolan Johnson was also named the Summit League Pitcher of the Year for the first time in program history.

In 2023, Oakes helped lead NDSU to a second place finish in the Summit League to go along with nine All-Summit League selections. It was the most all-conference selections in a single-season since the Bison joined the Summit League in 2008. Peter Brookshaw, Drew Sackett, Cade Feeney and Tristen Roehrich were named to the 2023 All-Summit League First Team.

Feeney went on to be selected by the Boston Redsox in the 13th round of the MLB Draft. Additionally, Carson Jacobs went on to sign with the Chicago White Sox as a free agent following the conclusion of the MLB Draft. Parker Puetz rounded out the group of pitchers in 2023 after he was named to the All-Summit League Second Team and D1Baseball Freshman All-America Second Team. The Bison followed it up in 2024 after Joey Danielson was picked by the Texas Rangers in the 17th round of the MLB Draft. It marked the second straight season NDSU had a pitcher selected in the draft.

In his first season as head coach in 2022, Oakes guided NDSU to its first Summit League regular season title in program history after assembling a 30-17 (17-5 Summit) overall record. It marked only the seventh time in program history the Bison have reached the 30-win mark. NDSU began the season playing each of its first 37 games on the road and were the last Division I team to play a home game. Oakes became the first coach in NDSU baseball history to earn Summit League Coach of the Year honors.

SUMMIT LEAGUE SUCCESS UNDER OAKES

Under head coach **Tyler Oakes**, the Bison have made a habit of playing a challenging non-conference schedule in preparation of Summit League play each season. Over the last four seasons, the Bison are a combined 60-39-1 in conference play with 33 of those victories coming on the road. NDSU has reached the 15-win mark in three of the last five seasons and seven total times in Summit League play since joining the league in 2008. The Bison also boast a 24-16-1 record in home Summit League games since 2022. In Oakes' first season as head coach in 2022, the Bison secured their first Summit League regular season title in program history. He also helped the Bison to their third Summit League Tournament Championship in 2025.
