### OPENING KICK

► Mercer will kick off its 51st season of intercollegiate football tonight when the Bears host a rare Thursday evening tilt against Pioneer Football League foe Presbyterian. Tonight's game will be broadcasted live on both ESPN+ and Nexstar affiliates as the Southern Conference Game of the Week. Pete Yanity and Jared Singleton will handle the duties in the booth with kickoff scheduled for 7 p.m. EDT at Five Star Stadium.

► Thursday's matchup will mark the 16th meeting between the Bears and Presbyterian in a series that dates all the way back to the 1927 season, but it is just the second meeting between the two squads since the 1941 campaign. The Bears racked up nearly 550 yards of total offense on the way to a 45-7 rout of Presbyterian on Sept. 7, 2019, in Clinton, S.C. Mercer leads the all-time series, 10-5, including a 6-3 record against the Blue Hose in Macon.

► Thursday's game will mark the Mercer debut for Mike Jacobs who was named the program's 21st head coach on January 18. Jacobs, who has compiled a 74-17 (.813) record across head coaching stops at both Notre Dame (Ohio) and Lenoir-Rhyne, boasts the nation's sixth-best winning percentage among active coaches at the NCAA Divisions I and II levels.

► Mercer is 43-20 (.683) all-time in Five Star Stadium, including a 17-4 (.810) clip over the last four seasons. The Bears have turned in at least four wins inside their home stadium in each of the last four seasons, and have now captured 10 of their last 12 home games following the late-November win over Gardner-Webb in the opening round of the NCAA Playoffs.

► The Orange & Black is 8-3 in home openers since football returned to campus in 2013. That includes a current three-game win streak in such outings heading into tonight's matchup with Presbyterian. The Bears have averaged 44.2 points per game in their home lid-lifters since 2013, and have outscored opponents by an average of 23.5 points per game in those contests. Head coach Mike Jacobs posted a perfect 4-0 mark in home openers in previous stops at both Notre Dame (Ohio) and Lenoir-Rhyne.

SCOUTING PRESBYTERIAN	
► Presbyterian returns 17 starters from last season's 4-7 club, including all 11 starters on the defensive side of the ball. A total of 11 players nabbed preseason all-conference or honorable mention accolades from the Pioneer Football League, including wide receiver Dominic Kibby, tight end Worth Warner and linebacker Alex Herriott who were all decorated with first team preseason all-league honors. Herriott ranked 8th among NCAA FCS leaders with 118 tackles during the 2023 campaign.	
PERMANENT CAPTAINS NAMED	
► Offensive lineman Israel Mukwiza, as well as defensive standouts Ken Standley, Isaac Dowling and TJ Moore, will serve as the permanent team captains for the 2024 season. Standley was the leading vote getter for the team's highest honor, and will serve as a team captain for the second time in his 5+-year career in Macon. Dowling will serve as team captain for the second-straight year, while Moore and Mukwiza are captains for the first time in their illustrious collegiate careers.	
THE HOUSE THAT FIVE STAR BUILT	
► More than 600,000 fans have walked through the gates of Mercer's home stadium since its opening in 2013. The Bears have averaged 9,394 (92% of capacity) fans across 63 games in the facility. MU has ranked among NCAA FCS's top-30 leaders in total attendance nine times over the last 12 years, including a pandemic-riddled 2020-Spring 2021 season that saw the Orange & Black rank 12th, nationally, in total attendance.	
THE BEARS IN AUGUST	
► Mercer has captured all six of its previous matchups played in the month of August, including last season's 17-7 win over North Alabama in the FCS Kickoff Classic held at the historic Cramton Bowl in Montgomery, Ala. Tonight's contest will mark the earliest home game for the Orange & Black since it bested visiting Jacksonville, 48-7, on Aug. 31, 2017.	
MERCER PICKED FOURTH IN PRESEASON SOCON POLL	
► A share of runner-up honors in last season's final Southern Conference regular season standings translated to a fourth-place prediction in the coaches SoCon Preseason Poll. The Orange & Black nestled in behind league favorite Chattanooga, as well as defending SoCon regular season champion Furman and Western Carolina.
