FLYERS' QUICK HITS

• Dayton entered the 2025 season under the direction of third-year head coach Trevor Andrews, who has guided the Flyers to a 15-14 record so far and looks to improve on its win total once again this fall.

• The Flyers return a veteran group on offense including their top passer, rusher, and receiver. Juniors Drew VanVleet, Mason Hackett, and Gavin Lochow will power the offensive attack for Dayton while seniors and team captains Ryan Iiams and Ben Huefner will anchor the offensive line.

• The defense will see a lot of new faces however in the starting line-up, but has a talented group of newcomers to mix with the returning players with expectations still high for the Flyers. UD held opposing teams to just 17.0 points per game in 2024 while limiting opponents to just 242.9 yards per outing.

• The special teams unit stayed mostly intact with seniors Robby Smart and David Maurer handling placekicking duties while junior Logan Forcum will be the main punter. Breakout returnmen Gavin Lochow and Paul Kelly will join junior transfer Michael Musari on kick and punt return responsibilities.

• Dayton was picked to finish to fifth in the Pioneer Football League poll behind preseason favorites San Diego, Drake, St. Thomas, and Butler. The Flyers were tabbed to finish ahead of the likes of Morehead St., Presbyterian, and Davidson.

• The PFL Preseason All-Conference teams were announced as well with three Flyers recognized on offense and one on defense. Running back Mason Hackett, all-purpose player Gavin Lochow, and offensive lineman Ryan Iiams were chosen on the offensive side of the ball while cornerback Cam Cope was selected on the defensive side.

The University of Dayton football team will remain at home to host No. 16/19 Presbyterian Saturday, Oct. 25 at 12 p.m. It will be Military Appreciation Day at Welcome Stadium.

Dayton is coming off a tough loss at home last outing, but is still 3-1 in Pioneer Football League play and 5-2 on the season. The Flyers are tied for third place and with a win over the Blue Hose Saturday would move into a tie for second.

Nationally-ranked Presbyterian enters the contest undefeated on the year at 7-0 and is 3-0 in conference play. The Blue Hose are 3-0 on the road this season and tied for first place in the league with Drake.

SERIES HISTORY

Dayton and Presbyterian are meeting for the fifth time in program history with the series tied at two wins apiece. The Blue Hose have won the last two match-ups, including last year’s contest, 28-7, at Presbyterian.

NEXT UP

The Flyers head back out on the road to take on San Diego Saturday, Nov. 1 at 4 p.m. ET at Torero Stadium in California.

LAST OUTING

- Dayton ended its five-game winning streak in a tough 23-17 home loss to Butler this past Saturday. The Flyers trailed early and were just unable to complete the comeback as UD lost just its second game of the season.
- Presbyterian cruised to a 42-7 win over Stetson at home last weekend, scoring in every quarter and not giving up any points until late in the fourth.

LEADING THE WAY

- The Flyers currently lead the PFL in numerous categories across all three phases of the game including blocked punts, blocked punts allowed, fumbles lost, passes had intercepted, turnover margin, turnovers gained, and turnovers lost.
- Dayton also ranks top five nationally in blocked punts allowed (1st), passes had intercepted (1st), turnover margin (2nd), turnovers gained (5th), and turnovers lost (1st).

MAKING THEIR MARK

- Dayton has multiple student-athletes ranking in the top three individually among PFL players:
- Gavin Lochow - Ranks first in receiving touchdowns (4th nationally), second in receptions per game (16th nationally), and second in total touchdowns (25th nationally).
- Bryce Schondelmyer - Ranks second in passing efficiency (6th nationally), passing touchdowns (8th nationally), second in passing yards, third in passing yards per completion (19th nationally), second in points responsible for (20th nationally), and third in yards per attempt (13th nationally).
- Michael Mussari - Ranks second in yards per reception (23rd nationally).
- Josh Williams - Ranks second in interceptions per game (14th nationally).
- Vincent Firenze - Ranks second in passes defended (10th nationally).
- Brandon Martin - Ranks third in tackles for loss.
- Luke Hansen - Ranks third in rushing touchdowns and second in total touchdowns.
- Logan Forcum - Ranks first in punting.

TWO MORE PFL ACCOLADES FOR DAYTON

- Redshirt sophomores Bryce Schondelmyer and Brandon Martin were named PFL Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week respectively on Oct. 12. Schondelmyer had three touchdowns in the first half while Martin had three tackles for loss in the 48-10 win at Valparaiso.

SCHONDELMYER MAKES IT THREE-STRAIGHT PFL HONOREES

• Redshirt sophomore Bryce Schondelmyer threw for five touchdowns in the first half, only the second Flyer in program to do so, en route to PFL Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 28. The Brookville native finished the game 19-of-23 for 333 yards and no turnovers.

SMART’S GAME-WINNER EARNS HIM PFL ACCOLADES

• Redshirt junior Robby hit the game-winning, 21-yard field goal in the fourth quarter to power the Flyers to a 17-14 comeback victory at Robert Morris on Sept. 20, earning PFL Special Teams Player of the Week.

FIRENZE EARNS PFL HONORS

• Redshirt sophomore Vincent Firenze was named Pioneer Football League Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 7 after leading the Flyers with six tackles, an interception, and a pass break-up in the win over Thomas More.

GOING FOR A THOUSAND

• Dayton had not one, but two players go over 1,000 yards in their careers in the home victory over Thomas More on Sept. 6. The junior duo of Luke Hansen and Mason Hackett both carried the ball past the 1,000 yard mark in their careers while combining for 187 yards in the effort.

CAPTAINS, MY CAPTAINS

- The Flyer co-captains for the 2025 season are linemen Ryan Iiams and Ben Huefner, as well as defensive back Cam Cope.
- Iiams is a senior lineman in his third season at UD after transferring over from Robert Morris. The Springboro, Ohio native earned preseason all-conference accolades and was named to the PFL Academic Honor Roll the past two seasons.
- Huefner is a redshirt junior out of Powell, Ohio and is coming off his most productive season in 2024, making three starts in 11 games while earning PFL Academic Honor Roll for the third time.
- Cope is also a redshirt junior and the lone defensive captain on the team. The Cincinnati native was a preseason all-conference selection as well and started all 10 games he appeared in last season.

PRESEASON PFL

- Multiple Flyers were named to the 2025 Preseason All-Pioneer Football League, as chosen by the PFL. Dayton’s selections were junior Mason Hackett, junior Gavin Lochow, senior Ryan Iiams, and redshirt junior Cam Cope.
- Hackett and Lochow earned Second Team All-PFL accolades in 2024 while Iiams and Cope received Honorable Mention last season.
- Phil Steele’s College Football Magazine named five Flyers to six positions on its Preseason All-Pioneer Football League Team. On the first team were Mason Hackett (running back), Logan Forcum (punter), Paul Kelly (punt return), and Gavin Lochow (all-purpose). Ryan Iiams (offensive line) was the lone Flyer on the Preseason Second Team.

700 CLUB

The Flyers are one of 11 FCS teams to win 700 games. The first eight members of the FCS 700 Win Club were Yale, Harvard, Penn, Princeton, North Dakota State, Dartmouth, Delaware and Lehigh. Dayton was the ninth. Northern Iowa and Lafayette joined the 700 win club last season.

PFL POWER

- The Pioneer Football League is in its 32nd season. The original (and now the only) Division I strictly need-based football league began with charter members Butler, Dayton, Drake, Evansville, San Diego and Valparaiso.
- The Flyers' 148-60 record is the best in PFL history.
- UD's 12 league championships are tied with San Diego for the most in PFL history.

FLYER AT THE HELM

- Trevor Andrews was named the University of Dayton's head football coach on Dec. 12, 2022.
- A 1998 Dayton graduate, he brought 25 years of college coaching experience back home to his alma mater.
- Andrews was a three-year letterwinner at defensive back for the Flyers.
- He was a member of three Pioneer Football League championship teams that had Mike Kelly as the head coach, and Andrews' predecessor at Dayton, Rick Chamberlin, as the then-defensive coordinator.
- The Flyers were a combined 37-5 over Andrews' four years. That includes Dayton's undefeated (11-0) team in 1996.
- He brings a wealth of college coaching successes back to The Hilltop.
- Andrews returned to Dayton from Western Michigan, where he coached the Bronco linebackers for four seasons.
- Prior to that, he was at William & Mary for 18 years, including six as Associate Head Coach, five as defensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for nine years.
- He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Illinois Wesleyan in 1999 and coached one season at Randolph-Macon before moving to William & Mary.
- Over his coaching career, Andrews has coached 31 all-conference players, three league defensive players of the year and six NFL players.
- The Nappanee, Ind. native is the 24th head football coach at UD since the program began in 1905. He is the second of the 11 modern era coaches to have lettered for the Flyers (his immediate predecessor, Rick Chamberlin, was the first), and the third to be a graduate of the University of Dayton.

OFF TO A GREAT START

- Redshirt sophomore quarterback Bryce Schondelmyer made his collegiate debut in the road contest at Eastern Illinois to start the year.
- A transfer from Youngstown State, Schondelmyer earned the start and was 17-of-31 passing with two touchdowns and no interceptions.

GET GAVIN THE BALL

- Redshirt junior Gavin Lochow started off the 2025 season with a bang, hauling in six catches for 124 yards and a touchdown, including a pair of 48-yard receptions in the season opener at Eastern Illinois.
- Lochow's 59 receptions last season were 21 more than the next closest Flyers (38)

USING THE SKILL SET YOU HAVE

- Running back Mason Hackett is a physical runner, thanks in large part to being an outstanding junior hockey player. He was second in the PFL last season in rushing attempts (185), fourth in yards (806), and fourth in yards per game (73.3).

TO SERVE AND PROTECT

- Dayton returns two starters on the O-line in 2025.
- Guards Zachary McDowell and guard Ryan Iiams are the veteran returners assigned to protect the quarterbacks this year.
- Senior captain Ben Huefner will take the lead at center this season after appearing in 11 games with three starts in 2024.

HITTING THE BOOKS

- The Flyers had 79 players on the 2024 PFL Academic Honor Roll, the fourth-most in the PFL, behind Davidson's tying record of 85, joining UD in 2019.
- It was the 13th time that the Flyers have had 70 or more honorees. No other school has had 70 more than five times.
- UD had been first or second every year since the league started in 1993. That includes having the most in 27 of 31 times.
- The 1,551 Flyers honored over the years are over 300 more than the next league team.

GETTING IT DONE IN THE CLASSROOM

- Dayton had 22 student-athletes named to the University of Dayton Dean's List last semester while the team recorded a cumulative GPA of 3.26 for the spring of 2025.

WELCOME MAT

- UD moved to Welcome Stadium in 1974.
- The word "Welcome" implies hospitality, but UD has been anything but to its opponents, where it is 253-62-2 (.805).
- The "Welcome" is not a greeting, but an homage to the late Percival Welcome, longtime AD for the Dayton Public Schools.

DAYTON AND THE CAMPBELL TROPHY

- Among D-I schools, UD is one of just two institutions with a semifinalist for the Campbell Trophy in the last 18 years. The other school is Bucknell.
- Jake Chisholm was a finalist in 2022
- In 2016, Flyer LB Christopher Beaschler was a national finalist for the Campbell Trophy.
- In 2007, safety Brandon Cramer was one of 15 finalists for the trophy.
- As finalists, Chisholm, Beaschler and Cramer earned an \$18,000 post-graduate scholarship.
- Dylan DeMaison was named a semifinalist for the NFF Campbell Trophy on Sept. 25, 2024.
- This year's nominee: Ryan Iiams, Senior, OL, Springboro, Ohio** - was named one of the 44 semifinalists on Sept. 24, 2025.

DAYTON AND THE HAMPSHIRE SOCIETY

- The National Football Foundation has an initiative that honors seniors who complete their college careers with a minimum GPA of 3.2. It is known as the Hampshire Society.
- Dayton had 14 players named last spring to the Hampshire Society.
- The Flyers are one of just 18 Division I institutions (and 23 overall) to have at least one senior qualify for membership in all 19 classes of the Hampshire Society. UD is also the only PFL member.

GOOD NEWS WORTH REPEATING

The Flyers entered the 2025 season with the fifth-best winning percentage (.705, 187-78) in FCS football since 2000 AND have produced the most football Academic All-Americans (36) in Division I in the same time frame. The top five in winning percentage are North Dakota State (.807), Montana (.761), Harvard (.753), San Diego (.713) and Dayton (.705).

FLYER FAMILY

- 11 current Flyers have a direct relative who played for UD in the past (or present). They are Gavin Lochow (dad Steve), Pat McLaughlin (dad), Ben Meehan (brother Danny), Jack and Zane Plattner (brothers currently on the roster), Sam Schmesing (brother), Owen Trick (aunt), Drew VanVleet (dad Brad), Dominic and Andrew Vrbancic (brothers currently on the team), and Jack Yenichek (dad).

- Adam Trautman is the second-string tight end for the Denver Broncos.
- Michael Niese, a former Flyer who played at Temple in 2021 as a grad transfer, is on the Detroit Lions 53-man roster.
- The New York Giants are celebrating the 100th year of their franchise, and 1956 Dayton grad Jim Katcavage was selected as one of the top 100 players in Giants’ history.
- An interesting note is that the first NFL game was played between the Dayton Triangles and the Columbus Panhandles at Triangle Park, just four miles from the UD campus.
- Two UD football alums (Norm Sacksteder and Red Werder) played in that game.
- Former Flyer head coach and later Director of Athletics John McVay, who was the head coach of the New York Giants and then the GM of the great Bill Walsh-coached San Francisco 49er teams, died on Nov. 1, 2023 at the age of 91.
- 1953 Dayton grad Chuck Noll is a member of the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

SUPER STAT

- When Jon Gruden coached the Tampa Bay Bucs to the 2003 Super Bowl win, he became the second UD grad to coach a Super Bowl winner. Former UD co-captain Chuck Noll won four as coach of the Pittsburgh Steelers.
- UD became only the third school (now there are four) to have two alumni coach Super Bowl winners. The others are San Jose State (Bill Walsh and Dick Vermeil), Arkansas (Jimmy Johnson and Barry Switzer), and Eastern Illinois (Mike Shanahan and Sean Payton).
- UD has ties to 24 Super Bowl rings. In addition to Chuck Noll’s four with the Steelers and Jon Gruden’s one with the Buccaneers, seven former members of the Dayton coaching staff own a total of 18 Super Bowl rings between them. They are the late Len Fontes (New York Giants, Super Bowl XXI), Jon’s father Jim Gruden (San Francisco 49ers, Super Bowls XXII & XXIV), the late John McVay (49ers, XVI, XIX, XXII, & XXIV), Tom Moore (Pittsburgh Steelers, XIII & XIV, Indianapolis Colts, XLI and Tampa Bay Buccaneers, LV), George Perles (Steelers, IX, X, XII & XIV), Joe Lombardi (New Orleans Saints, XLIV) and Scott Boyer (New England Patriots, XLIX, LI, LIII). McVay was the Flyers’ head coach from 1965-72.

HEAD COACH TREVOR ANDREWS' COMMENTS ON POSITION GROUPS

OFFENSE QUARTERBACKS

• Drew VanVleet and Bryce Schondelmyer have really been pushing each other even since last spring. They both have great attitudes and have been quite supportive of each other. Just like iron sharpens iron, it has been good for both of their growth and development at QB. Liam Poronsky was last year's backup and is a real competitor and will enter the season at No. 3 on the depth chart. Both freshmen Luke Pennington and Pat McLaughlin have been impressive so far. They pick up things quickly in the meeting rooms and have been able to translate it to the field.

RUNNING BACKS

• Mason Hackett and Luke Hansen have both been No. 1-type running backs for us. They compliment each other well. Hackett is shifty, but he's gotten more powerful. Hansen has always been our power guy, running through tackles. They are a good one-two punch. After that, we have a hodge-podge of guys behind them and the dark-horse to me has been Levi Moell. He has been consistent as a blocker and with his assignments in the passing game. Sophomores Dillon Fitzpatrick and Tyler Brown have both played in games last year while Hansen was out with an injury. Freshman Mikey Hess has emerged as a potential contributor for 2025 as well.

RECEIVERS

• Dominic Vrbancic coming back as the oldest and had some big plays for us a year ago. Gavin Lochow has been a do-everything guy for us since he's been here and he had a great summer, came in great shape. He was No. 1 on the team in skills tests, pound-for-pound. He's ready. Then you bring in the transfer from Cincinnati Michael Mussari, who had a strong camp. He does a lot of things well and he's very consistent. Then the next line, the guys are pushing like crazy. Ethan Thulin, Leroy Lewis, Jack Tess. It's a deep group, competitive group, and we have some young guys that are super talented. They all love to catch the ball, make big plays, and score touchdowns, but they have to be able to block too.

TIGHT ENDS

• We graduated two guys that took the lion's share of the reps. Carson Lebensky though had a great spring and was our most improved player on offense. The game started to slow down in his second spring with us, but now he's going into his third year. He's more your prototypical tight end. Donnie Weatherly is more of an off-the-ball tight end that you can shift around in motion. He began his career here in 2023 as a receiver. We began to transition him into this role last season. He has position flexibility and has the ability to do a lot of different things for us offensively. Sophomore Bryce Cowgill, true freshman Harrison Forestal, and sophomore Austin Cline will also be viable options for us at tight end. They are all athletic and exciting versatile athletes.

OFFENSIVE LINE

• It's a good group led by our two captains Ryan Iiams and Ben Huefner. Those guys have done a great job leadership-wise. They are vocal, confident leaders that have well-thought out ideas that aren't afraid to speak up. You have guys along the offensive line that have had a significant number of in-game reps. Zachary McDowell and Iiams provide us with flexibility and can play tackle or guard. Jack Plattner started several games last year and has taken the next step. Matt Barnes is probably the most athletic out of the group and has put his time in. I've been really impressed with our second group too. Charlie Olds, Brady Courtney, Alex Walton, Lucas Shallal. Those guys come out to work every day.

DEFENSE DEFENSIVE ENDS

• We don't have as much experience coming back on our defensive line. Collin Ansel played significant reps at defensive end, but he's the only one. We brought in Andrew Yanoshak from Notre Dame and he has come in and picked up the scheme. He has a chance to help us this year. The other defensive end Brandon Martin out of Cincinnati put on some good weight. This off-season he started to become an every down type of guy. We expect to see Josh Grambo and Martin Wantong with increased roles this year as well. Senior defensive tackle Elliott Braun can also slide out to end and give us some real length out there on the edge.

DEFENSIVE TACKLE

• Elliott Braun and redshirt sophomore Mirko Jaksic will headline the group early on this season. We have really been bringing along some younger guys who will provide some quality length and size on the interior. Gus Stamman, Vito Paonessa, and Zane Plattner are improving on a daily basis. All three will push for playing time this year.

LINEBACKERS

• With the inside linebacker position, Sam Schmiesing has significant in-game experience. Joe Kingsbury has really taken some great strides over the last nine months and is gaining confidence daily. Sam Mitchell, the younger brother of safety Luke will be counted on this fall. We are expecting him to earn some game reps. David Curl made some splash plays in camp. He will contribute on special teams early in the season and could eventually earn game reps at LB if he continues to progress. Sophomore Jack Yenichek has really improved after moving over from fullback in the spring.

SAFETIES

OLB/Nickel - It has turned into more of a speed game in modern day-day football so we have moved two safeties down to the outside linebacker/nickel position in Eli Kirk and Bennett Lawrence. Both have seen significant reps with the first unit in camp and they should be a good one-two punch for us.

Deep Safeties - I feel good about the two deep. Luke Mitchell played significant reps last year, started almost every game, while Vincent Firenze rotated in there. The two guys behind them Mac Grant, a senior, I've seen him come alive this season. Javawn Brooks just makes plays. I feel like every time someone comes down with an interception he has something to do with it. He's got great range.

CORNERBACKS

• Cam Cope has been steady and in his third year starting. He's returned punts for us, he's a veteran leader, and he can line up on either side for us. Josh Williams and Tehron Spencer have been competing like crazy since last spring for that other starting position. Both are expected to play a lot of reps for us this year. Steve McCalmont is working to push all of those guys. He came in this fall to camp and has really improved here in his second year.

SPECIAL TEAMS

PLACE KICKERS

• I put a lot of emphasis on kicking. We spend practice time, we spend meeting time. The kickers are a big part of that, but all the other guys are a big part of that too. David Maurer is back to can kick-off and Robby Smart can kick off. You put the ball in the end zone consistently, that is a big boost. For field goals, Smart has been the most consistent throughout, but Trevor Henkle has pushed him and Maurer has the big leg. Kicking in practice is one thing, but you have to be able to do it in the game.

SPECIALISTS

• It starts with the holder and snapper. We are fortunate we have Austin Yeager back to snap for us again after taking them all a year ago. Thomas Thakady is the other guy snapping on punts and field goals for us. Logan Forcum was our most improved player from two years ago to last year. It wasn't even close. He's now a guy we can count on to be consistent. Ben Lavelle is back in uniform and his now healthy. He endured a physically, mentally, and emotionally tough year in 2024. I've seen him improve each week throughout fall camp. He has gotten better as he has started to get his strength and flexibility back. He could very well prove to be a contributor this year.

PUNT RETURNERS

• Paul Kelly was a Freshman All-American a year ago, and he is back for his second season as a Flyer. Michael Mussari and Cam Cope also have experience as punt returners and we have confidence in both of them to do a great job.

KICKOFF RETURNERS

• In 2023, Gavin Lochow was really good for us and we need to get him going again on that. He can provide a spark back there. LeRoy Lewis IV also flashed throughout training camp as a kickoff returner. Running backs Mason Hackett and Mikey Hess could also see kickoff return action as well this fall.
