THE MATCH-UP: Marist concludes the 2025 season at Presbyterian, with kickoff set for 1 p.m.

HOW TO FOLLOW: **Geoff Brault** (play-by-play) and **Mike Duda** (analyst) will have the call on the Red Fox Network and Varsity Network app. The pre-game show will begin at 12:45. In-game updates will be available on X via Marist Football (@Marist_FB). The game will be shown on ESPN+, with **Gabriel Schray** (play-by-play) and **Tim Webb** (analyst) on the call.

60 SEASONS OF FOOTBALL: The 2025 season marks the Red Foxes' 60th of competition. Marist began play as a club program (Vikings) from 1965-77. The Red Foxes began varsity play as a Division III program in 1978, and moved up to Division I-AA (now Football Championship Subdivision) in 1993. This is the 61st year of Marist football but 60th season of play, as the Red Foxes did not compete in the 2020-21 school year due to Covid-19 restrictions.

OUR LEADERS: Marist has four captains: red-shirt junior QB **Sonny Mannino**, red-shirt junior DL **Joey Patierno**, graduate OL **Dominic Perricone**, sophomore DB **Nate Robinson Jr.** All four are in their first year as captains.

MARIST IN THE NFL: **Jason Myers**, who played at Marist from 2009-12 and graduated in 2013, is in his seventh season as the Seattle Seahawks' placekicker and 11th in the NFL. Myers has earned two Pro Bowl selections in his career (2018, 2022). This season, he set the Seahawks' franchise record for field goals (now at 180) and points (now at 813).

ABOUT PRESBYTERIAN: The Blue Hose won their first seven games this season - including a season-opening win at #11 Mercer - and were ranked as high as #16 in the AFCA Coaches Poll & #19 in the Stats Perform national rankings. Presbyterian can clinch the PFL's autobid to the FCS playoffs with a win plus losses by Drake (to Morehead State) and San Diego (to Stetson). Head coach **Steve Englehart** is in his fourth season.

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Head Coach Mike Willis

Second Season

Princeton/2014

Mike Willis was hired as the fifth head coach in the history of the Marist football program on Dec. 19, 2023. The 2025 season marks his second at Marist, as the program has made gains athletically, academically, and from a fundraising standpoint.

In Willis' first season, Jackson Conners-McCarthy was named an Honorable Mention FCS All-American by The Associated Press. Conners-McCarthy was one of three Marist FCS Freshman All-Americans, as he was joined by James Kratochvil and Nate Robinson Jr. This total was the highest in program history. Kratochvil was named PFL Defensive Rookie of the Year. The Red Foxes has one First Team All-PFL selection (Dominic Perricone) and two Second Team All-PFL selections (Conners-McCarthy, Tristan Shannon). Additionally, he aided in the development of Sonny Mannino, who started the year in a reserve role and ended with an Honorable Mention All-PFL selection at the all-purpose position after tying the single-game school records for passing touchdowns and rushing touchdowns. Mohamed Diawara and Miles Kauderer, who both served as team captains, were selected to play in the Dream Bowl.

The program enjoyed an outstanding 2024-25 school year in the classroom. A program-record 83 Red Foxes were named to the Pioneer Football League Academic Honor Roll. Chris Leonardo was named to the FCS ADA Academic All-Star Team. Both Leonardo and Gannon McCorkle were First Team PFL All-Academic Team selections, while Tristan Shannon was named to the Second Team. Six Red Foxes (Leonardo, McCorkle, Sean Coverdale, David LaFears, Brandon Furey, Kade Werner) were named CSC Academic All-District. The team's Spring 2025 semester GPA of 3.405 was its best in program history, and the program's three best semester GPAs have taken place in Willis's first three semesters at the helm.

Additionally, Willis was instrumental in the formation of the Marist Touchdown Club, Marist's first formal football alumni association. In 2025, the program broke its single-day fundraising record.

Willis came to Marist after having served as Assistant

Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator at his alma mater, Princeton University. He spent nine years on the Tigers' staff after a playing career at Princeton that spanned from 2010-13. Between his time as a player and coach, Willis has been part of four Ivy League championships. His tenure at Princeton has been characterized by outstanding team and individual achievements. The Tigers posted a 40-10 record in Willis' last 50 games on staff.

Willis was Princeton's offensive coordinator for the past three seasons. During that time, the Tigers went 22-8 overall with a 15-6 record in Ivy League play while Willis coached 23 All-Ivy League players. In 2021, Princeton won the Ivy League championship, went 9-1 overall, set a program record with 10 First Team Ivy League selections, and led the Ancient Eight in scoring at 33.4 points per game. The following year, Princeton went 8-2 and was in Ivy League title contention until the season's final week. The Tigers led the Ivy League in scoring offense and ranked second in passing offense in 2022.

Willis was part of current Princeton head coach Bob Surace's first recruiting class for the 2010 season. In Willis' time as a student-athlete at Princeton, the program engineered a dramatic and lasting turnaround, going from a 1-9 record his freshman year to an Ivy League championship his senior year in 2013. In the 2013 season, Princeton set the Ivy League record for total offense. Beginning with the 2013 season, Princeton has won four league championships – with Willis having a hand in all of them – and has finished .500 or better every year since. Willis majored in Sociology at Princeton.

Willis and his wife, Maggie, are the parents of their three-year-old son, Campbell, and daughter, Michaela (born in Feb. 2025).

Marist in the PFL

- Marist's first three PFL games this season were all decided by one score. The Red Foxes last played three straight one-score PFL games in 2015.
- Marist is 62-65 all-time in PFL play, having joined the league in 2009. Marist is 9-14 in September, 33-27 in October, 20-23 in November, and 0-1 in December.
- Marist is 31-34 at home, and 31-31 on the road in PFL play.
- Marist won a share of the PFL championship in 2013.

First Since ...

- Marist has won each of its last two games by 27+ points (37-10 over Davidson, 41-13 over Stetson). The last time Marist won back-to-back games each by at least 27 points was 2013.
- Marist's 38 points in the first half against Stetson were the most by the Red Foxes in a half since scoring 38 in the first half against Canisius in 1998.
- Marist's 41 total points against Stetson were the most for the Red Foxes in a game since scoring 45 at Stetson on Oct. 8, 2022.
- Marist's 56 yards passing allowed at Wagner was the lowest total the Red Foxes permitted in a game since 2007. Marist five interceptions at Wagner were its most in a game since 2021.
- Marist has defeated two full scholarship opponents this year for the first time with its wins over New Haven and Wagner.
- Marist won two non-league games for the first time since 2009.
- Marist's season-opening 31-14 win over New Haven on Aug. 29 was its first since 2012, when the Red Foxes prevailed at Bryant. This was Marist's first non-league home victory since 2015, which occurred against Sacred Heart. It was Marist's first non-league victory at all since 2017, when the Red Foxes won at Georgetown.
- This is Marist's first 12-game regular-season schedule in program history.

National Recognition

- **Chase Hatton** was named to the Watch List for the Jerry Rice Award. Hatton has earned Honorable Mention for Stats Perform FCS Freshman of the Week three times, following Marist's wins against New Haven, Wagner, and Stetson.
- **Nate Furrow** (Defensive Player of the Week) and **Jeremy DeCaro** (Freshman of the Week) both earned Honorable Mention from Stats Perform following Marist's win at San Diego. Furrow had five TFLs and three sacks, while DeCaro amassed 140 all-purpose yards.
- **Nate Robinson Jr.** was named Stats Perform FCS Defensive Player of the Week after a 10-tackle, two-interception performance at Wagner.
- **Ethan Yuska** earned Honorable Mention for Stats Perform FCS Special Teams Player of the Week after averaging 45.8 yards on five punts at Butler.

- Marist is tied for second in the FCS in fourth down attempts (32).
- Marist is fourth in the FCS in defensive fourth-down conversion percentage (32.1%, 9-for-28).- Marist has scored six touchdowns this season on fourth down. Four have been over 25 yards (27, 35, 35, 59).

Defense Does It

- **Nate Robinson Jr.** is tied for seventh in the FCS in passes defended per game (1.40) and is tied for fourth in pass break-ups (11). Robinson's four PBUs vs. San Diego were the most by a Red Fox in a game since 2018 (**Ryan Webb**). His 14 passes defended this season are the most in the program in a season since 2002 (**Ike Ibeh, Aubrey Bennett**).
- **Chase Hatton** is tied for eighth in the FCS with four total interceptions. Among freshmen, Hatton is tied for first in the FCS in interceptions, and he is fourth among freshmen in total tackles (81).
- **Tyrell Powell** is tied for eighth in the FCS with two fumble recoveries.
- As a team, Marist is tied for 10th in the FCS in turnovers forced (19) and tied for 11th in interceptions (12).
- **Nate Furrow's** five TFLs vs. San Diego were the most by a Red Fox since 2013 (**Landon Moore**). His three sacks were the most since 2015 (**Alex Spiess**).

Offensive Production

- Among FCS tight ends, **Connor Hulstein** ranks first in receiving yards (579), and second in receiving touchdowns (six), and third in receptions (38). Hulstein's six touchdowns are tied for the single-season program record by a tight end, originally set by **Jon Kanda** in 2018.
- Marist had three receivers with at least 90 yards against Davidson (**Lance Martinez**, 96; **Connor Hulstein**, 92; **Reed Shumpert**, 90).
- Marist had two 100-yard rushers against New Haven (**Sonny Mannino**, 109; **Tristan Shannon**, 104).

Special Special Teams

- **Tristan Shannon's** 99-yard kickoff return for a touchdown at Wagner was Marist's first since **Glenmour Leonard-Osbourne** took one 94 yards for a score at Morehead State in 2022.
- **Samer Layout's** 46-yard field goal against Stetson was the Red Foxes' longest since **Luke Paladino** hit a 46-yarder at Morehead State on Nov. 5, 2022.
- Against New Haven, Marist's special teams generated three turnovers (two muffed punts, one kickoff return fumble), a blocked field goal (**Jalen Carpenter**), and a touchdown (**Rene Barber** off a muffed punt). **Ethan Yuska's** last two punts were both at least 50 yards, with one downed at the New Haven 2, and the other that resulted in Barber's touchdown.

Inside the Two Deep

Quarterbacks: Sonny Mannino (12) set career highs with 21 rushes for 109 yards vs. New Haven in the season opener. His career high for passing yards is 317, set last week against Davidson. He has completed over 20 passes in four games this year. Mannino has thrown for 1,794 yards and 11 touchdowns, and rushed for a 390 yards with a team-high six touchdowns. He accounted for a season-high four touchdowns vs. Stetson (two passing, two rushing). Mannino has not thrown an interception in his last 115 pass attempts, with his last coming on Oct. 4 against San Diego. ... **Will O'Dell (18)** has played in eight games, with two starts. At Wagner, he had a team-high 58 rushing yards and threw his first collegiate touchdown pass. He made his first career start at Penn, throwing for 118 yards and leading the team with 53 rushing yards. ... **Patrick Grusser (19)** threw his first collegiate touchdown pass at Butler, where he was 3-for-3 for 41 yards. Grusser is also the Red Foxes' holder.

Shannon ran for a career-high 104 yards (with a 59-yard touchdown) vs. New Haven. He has five total touchdowns this season, with his first collegiate two-touchdown game against Drake. He leads the team with 429 rushing yards, and is averaging 5.0 yards per carry. His career highs in receiving are five catches and 44 receiving yards. Shannon has amassed 3,050 all-purpose yards in his career. ... **Carter James (9)** ran for a career-high 69 yards vs. Stetson. He has two two-touchdown games this year, and three in his career. Wide Receivers: Lance Martinez (7) is 12th in the FCS in yards per reception (19.8). His career high of 105 receiving yards and two touchdowns against San Diego. His first three career touchdowns came in back-to-back games against Butler and San Diego, with two coming on fourth down (35 yards at Butler, 35 yards vs. San Diego). Martinez had a career-high five receptions against Drake. He is second on the team in receiving yards (496) and receiving touchdowns (four) this season. He has six games with at least 50 yards, including each of his last five games. ... **Reed Shumpert (15)** played his first two seasons at Washington State, and his last two at Cal Poly. His eight receptions against Bucknell are the most by a Red Fox this year, and he had a career-high 90 yards against Davidson. Shumpert is second on the team in receptions (32), and is third in receiving yards (350). He has four games with over 50 yards receiving. ... **Jack Melore (1)** caught 22 passes for 230 yards and two touchdowns as a true freshman last year. His highs were six receptions and 67 yards. Villanova transfer **Irene Ng-abonziza (2)** has six receptions for 58 yards this season.

Tight Ends: Conor Hulstein (84) scored a receiving touchdown in all of Marist's first four games this season, and he has scored in each of Marist's last two games.
