2014 BULLDOG SEASON PREVIEW

- Looking ahead to their 37th year of play, the Bulldogs return for their second season under head coach Trisha Ford after a 30-24 mark in 2013 (and second-place tie in the MW (11-7)).

- The squad welcomes back seven of eight starters in the field from 2013 (and last year's top three pitchers).

- All four of the team's 2013 All-MW selections return - Jill Compton, So., C, Paige Gumz (So., C), Brenna Moss (Jr., OF), Vonnie Martin (Sr., IF), while Brooke Ortiz (Sr., IF) was an All-WAC selection in 2011.

- Fresno State paced MW teams in fielding (.971) and stolen bases (1.61 p/g) in 2013, and ranked top 100 nationally in triples (12th, 0.31 p/g), fielding (24th), stolen bases (29th), double plays (71st, 0.33 p/g) and ERA (73rd, 2.66).

- On NCAA individual charts in '13, Brenna Moss led the nation in triples (0.18 per game avg.) and stood 15th in stolen bases (0.67 p/g) and 72nd in the toughest to strike out category (1:16.3 at-bats). Two others hitters stood top 100 - junior infielder Maria Sio (sacrifice hits, fourth, 0.35 p/g) and outfielder Michelle Solomon (triples, 95th, 3) - as well as Compton (shutouts, 35th, 7) and sophomore pitcher Hannah Harris (walks, 92nd, 1.81 p/7 innings).

- Three 'Dogs led MW individual stat categories in 2013 - Moss (stolen bases, 0.67 p/g; triples, 9), Compton (shutouts, 7) and Sio (sacrifice hits, 4).

- Brenna Moss set a new school stolen bases season record in 2013 (34) and her nine triples ranked second-best. Career-wise, she ranks third in stolen bases (45) and seventh in triples (14), and Stesha Brazil stands 10th in career homers (16).

- For their success in the classroom, six players were honored as NFCA Scholar-Athletes in 2013 (Brooke Ortiz, Kelly Megee, Taylor Green, Hannah Harris, Taylor Langdon, Diane Runge) after they sported 3.50 GPA's in 2012-13. Similarly, nine players were Academic All-MW choices (Harris, Langdon, Megee, Ortiz, Runge, Stesha Brazil, Vonnie Martin, Brenna Moss and Whitney Smith), and Runge and Ortiz were Academic All-District selections in 2013 and '12, respectively.

- In 2014, the squad will play 11 returning NCAA tourney qualifiers (including five World Series advancers).

- The 'Dogs have enjoyed 36 straight winning seasons since 1978 (including 21 conference titles and 30 NCAA trips).

Fresno State No-Hitters

Of the 70 no-hitters tossed by 20 different Bulldog pitchers, Fresno State has recorded 14 perfect games by eight different 'Dogs – the most recent by Mackenzie Oakes (Georgetown, March 13, 2010). The most no-hitters tossed in one season were five in 1984 and 1986. Barbara Cambria, who tossed the program's first perfect game, threw three no-hitters in 1984 while Melanie Parrent had three in 1986 and Jamie Southern had three in 2002. Of the 14 perfect games recorded, nine have happened at Bulldog Diamond. Southern holds the distinction of tossing the most no-no's (8) as well as recording the most perfect games (4).
