What's on Tap for the Bulldogs

Fresno State hosts CSU Bakersfield on Dec. 15 and Pacific on Dec. 17 in the Save Mart Center. The 'Dogs hit the road next week to play UC Riverside on Dec. 21 before the Holiday's begin.

Fresno State vs. CSU Bakersfield

The Bulldogs have never lost to the Roadrunners and are 4-0 against CSUB dating back to 2007. The largest margin over victory of the Runners was 39 points in 2007.

Scouting the Roadrunners

CSU Bakersfield has a 3-8 record after the first six weeks of the season. Last weekend, the Roadrunners were 1-1 after defeating Montana and losing to Weber State. Tyonna Outland leads the team with 14.6 points and 5.9 rebounds per game. The Runners are averaging 75.9 points per game and shooting 41 percent.

Fresno State vs. Pacific

The 'Dogs lead the overall series over Pacific 23-20. Fresno State has won two games in a row over the Tigers. The Bulldogs longest win streak over Pacific was nine games.

Scouting the Tigers

Pacific has an overall mark of 4-4 heading into the sixth week of the season. Erica McKenzie leads the team with 14.5 points and 40 percent from the 3-point line. The Tigers are averaging 68.9 points per game and shooting 38 percent.

The Week That Was

The Bulldogs went 2-0 over the weekend recording wins over No. 23 Oklahoma (69-66) and CSU Northridge (70-61). The 'Dogs win over Oklahoma is the first in program history over the Sooners and first over a ranked opponent since 2008.

Bulldogs Off to Strong Start

Fresno State is off to a strong start in 2011 even with three first-year starters and seven new faces on the roster. The Bulldogs are 7-3, recording impressive wins over No. 23 Oklahoma, Oregon, Santa Clara and Cal Poly. Two of the 'Dogs three losses were to opponents ranked among top 25 in the country, then No. 23 USC and No. 5 Stanford.

And the Winner is...

Sophomore Ki-Ki Moore was named the Verizon Western Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week for Dec. 4-11. She averaged 18.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and 4.0 steals per game as the Bulldogs went 2-0 on the week. Moore opened the week with her second career double-double of 21 points and 10 rebounds to go along with six steals in a win over No. 23 Oklahoma.

It's Gooooood!

The Bulldogs are averaging 74.7 points per game after the first 10 games of the season. The 'Dogs rank No. 39 in the country in scoring offense. North Carolina leads the nation with 87.5 points per game. Fresno State scored 88 points against SMU on Nov. 26, which is the most by the Bulldogs in a game this season.

Bench Marks the Spot

The Bulldog bench has provided an extra spark so far in 2011. Veronica Wilson, Madison Parrish and Bree Farley are the first off the bench for the 'Dogs this season and together are averaging 18.3 points per game. Fresno State's bench has scored in double figures in all but two games this year. The most the bench has scored was 38 points against Tennessee State on No. 25.

Home Court Advantage

The Bulldogs have an impressive home record of 91-27 (.771) at the Save Mart Center in nine seasons. Under head coach Adrian Wiggins, Fresno State is 74-15 at home since 2006. The 'Dogs best home record was 15-1 during the 2005-06 season. The Bulldogs average 11 wins a season at home over the past eight seasons. Fresno State has 14 home games this year and are 3-1 at home so far.

Fresno State Wins by 10 or More

Under head coach Adrian Wiggins, the Bulldogs have won 109 games by double figures. This season, Fresno State has won 4-of-10 games by 10 or more points. Fresno State defeated Oregon by 10, Tennessee State by 17, SMU by 21 and Santa Clara by 12.

'Dogs For 1-2-3

The Bulldogs are averaging 9.8 3-pointers a game this season, which is fourth in the country. Junior Rosie Moulton leads the team with 29 three's so far this year and is 24th in the country in 3-pointers per game with 2.9. Last season, Moulton hit 98 3-pointers, which was second most on the team.

The Bulldogs Against Ranked Opponents

Fresno State played three ranked teams in 2011 and went 1-2. The Bulldogs lost to then No. 23 USC and No. 5 Stanford, but beat No. 23 Oklahoma 69-66. The last time the Bulldogs beat a ranked opponent had been in 2008 against TCU. Fresno State is 5-22 overall against ranked opponents.

Steal of the Game

The 'Dogs are averaging 10.3 steals per game this season. Junior Rosie Moulton leads the team with 26 steals and sophomore Ki-Ki Moore has 20. Moore recorded a season-high six steal against Oklahoma on Dec. 8.

New Faces, Same Dream

Fresno State has built a tradition of winning WAC titles and making appearances in the NCAA Tournament. With seven new players in 2011-12, the dream of playing in the postseason remains the same. Head coach Adrian Wiggins added five freshmen and two transfers to the roster this season. Another new face is sophomore guard Ki-Ki Moore, who is able to play this season after sitting out last year.

On The Road Again

The Bulldogs play 17 games on the road this season and are 3-2 so far away from the Save Mart Center. Fresno State is also 1-0 in neutral territory. The 'Dogs' next hit the road on Dec. 21 to face UC Riverside. Last season, the Bulldogs compiled a road record of 11-3.

'Dogs Picked Second, Third in Preseason WAC Polls

Fresno State was picked to finish the conference season in second place by the WAC media and third by the league coaches. Louisiana Tech was picked as the league favorite by both the coaches and media.

This is Our House

Fresno State is entering its ninth season in the SMC, which has been a site for the NCAA Tournament in 2005 and 2007. This season, the Save Mart Center will host the Fresno Regional with the Sweet 16 and Elite 8 rounds in Fresno, Calif.

Where is Wayne?

Since the 2009 season, the Fresno State women's basketball team has put performer Wayne Newton on the pass list for all conference road games. It has been three seasons and he has yet to show up. This tradition originally started when the Bulldogs played at UNLV and the team decided to put his name on the list. Along with Wayne Newton a famous person from that state or city usually ends up on the pass list. Here is a look at who has been on the pass list so far. **USC:** Wayne Newton and Jessica Simpson, **SMU:** Newton and Ryan Reynolds.

Moult & Thompson Earn Preseason Honors

After a strong 2010-11 campaign, junior Rosie Moult and sophomore Taylor Thompson were selected by the coaches and media as Preseason All-WAC honorees. Moult was named first-team, while Thompson garnered second-team recognition.

We Want Some Moore

Sophomore Ki-Ki Moore is having a breakout season in her first year with the Bulldogs. Moore is averaging 18.0 points per game, which is second best in the WAC. She has twice scored 28 points in a single game. She has scored double figures in all but one game this season. Moore has a team-high 60 rebounds this season. She also has 30 assists and 20 steals. She recorded a double-double against Oregon and No. 23 Oklahoma.

Parrish Heats Up

Freshman Madison Parrish scored a career-high 15 points against Tennessee State on Nov. 25, beating her previous mark of 10 points set against Cal Poly a week earlier. Parrish is one of the first Bulldogs off the bench and is averaging 7.2 points and 23.6 minutes per game. She has scored in double figures in 5-of-10 games.

Moult Ahead of the Pack

Junior Rosie Moult leads the team and WAC in several statistical categories 10 games into the season. She leads team in 3-pointers (29) and steals (26). Moult is second in the WAC in steals with 2.6 per game, 3-pointers made with 3.1 per game and is 10th in the conference in scoring with an average of 12.4 points per game.

Sheedy Double Trouble

Freshman Alex Sheedy recorded the first double-double of the season for the Bulldogs. She scored a career-high 16 points and 10 rebounds against Cal Poly. Sheedy's 10 rebounds was a team-high for the game. The 'Dogs beat Cal Poly 79-76 on the road on Nov. 20, 2011.

Thompson Lends a Hand

Sophomore Taylor Thompson leads the team with 46 assists. She has 122 career assists and needs 160 more to break into the top 10 in Bulldog history. Lindsay Logan holds the record for most assists in a season with 192. Thompson recorded a season-high eight assists against Oregon on Dec. 1.

HEAD COACH ADRIAN WIGGINS

Adrian Wiggins has set a new standard of success for the women's basketball program. He is the only Fresno State coach in the 45-year history to not have a losing season and he is averaging 24.5 wins per season in his six full-seasons and he has been named the WAC Coach of the Year in two of the last four seasons.

Since his first full-season (2005-06) as head coach, the Bulldogs have the most wins in the WAC (140). Wiggins has amassed a 147-60 record in his five plus seasons as head coach and his WAC record of 79-17 (.823) is the best winning percentage among current WAC coaches.

Under the guidance of Wiggins, the Bulldogs have had the program's three most successful seasons in school history. His teams have also turned into one of the most prolific offensive teams in the country and one of the best defensive and rebounding teams in the WAC.

Academics are a high priority for coach Wiggins. Since taking over the head coaching duties, Wiggins has coached 28 student-athletes who have earned Academic All-WAC honors. His team has represented the University with integrity as the Bulldogs have posted a 3.0 team GPA in eight of 12 semesters during his tenure. In addition, Bulldog student-athletes continue to maintain a strong presence in the community, serving as role models to Valley youth while participating in various service functions, camps and clinics.

Wiggins' style of play has paved the way for his players to play professionally. In just under seven years, Wiggins has coached nine players who have gone on to play professionally. As the head coach at Cameron, he had two players sign professional contracts.

Prior to Fresno State, Wiggins served as the head coach at Cameron University, a Division II school in Lawton, Okla., from 2000-2002. Cameron went 15-12, in his first year at the helm, and qualified for the Lone Star Conference postseason tournament.

A 1995 graduate of Cameron, Wiggins received his bachelor's degree in psychology and was a four-year member of the Aggie baseball squad. He also received a Master of Science degree in Alternative Studies from CU in 2001. He and his wife, Heather, have a daughter, Aubrey, and a son, William.

Wiggins' Quick Hits

- Wiggins is the eighth head coach in Fresno State women's basketball history.
- He guided the 'Dogs to their first NCAA Tournament appearance and has made four-straight NCAA appearances (2008, '09, '10, '11).
- In 2010, he earned his second WAC Coach of the Year honor. Wiggins was also named the WBCA Region 7 Coach of the Year and was one of eight finalists for National Coach of the Year honors.
