- Fresno State opened its 91st season as a program over the weekend winning two of three games at home over Utah Valley.
- The Diamond 'Dogs won their 11th consecutive season opener and home opener on Saturday afternoon with a 6-3 win over the Wolverines.
- Head Coach Mike Batesole, now in his 17th season leading the Diamond 'Dogs, earned his 800th career win with the Bulldogs' season-opening win over UVU.
- The 'Dogs closed out the series with a Monday doubleheader losing game one, 4-3 before winning game two, 8-3.
- This weekend's Tony Gwynn Legacy Tournament will be the Bulldogs' first regular season neutral site tournament since 2010 when they also went to San Diego to participate in the Aztec Invitational posting a 3-1 record with wins over Fullerton, San Francisco and San Diego State and lost to San Diego.
- Senior second baseman Nolan Dempsey hit .455 in the series with a double, home run, six RBI and nine total bases.

A look at the Kansas State Wildcats

The Wildcats enter Friday afternoon's game with a 2-3 overall record after splitting a four-game series last weekend at CSUN and then fell 7-6 at California Baptist on Wednesday.

Meeting for only the third time ever, Kansas State is coming off a 23-31 record in 2018 and a ninth place finish in the Big 12. KSU welcomes in veteran head coach Pete Hughes into the program this season who brings a career record of 654-495-3 (.569) over 22 years to Manhattan.

The Wildcats return leading hitter, junior outfielder Will Brennan, who earned First-Team All-Big 12 honors after hitting .359 a year ago leading the team in hits (79), runs (49), doubles, (13) and on-base percentage (.454). Brennan continues to hit at a high clip so far this season starting the season off with 11 hits in 20 at-bats for a .550 batting average.

On the mound, the Wildcats had a 5.85 team ERA a year ago, and through five games this season are sitting at 5.57. Junior right-hander Tyler Eckberg gets the start on Friday and comes in with one start under his belt, Kansas State's season opener, where he threw five innings and allowed eight hits, four earned runs and struck out nine.

A look at the No. 25 Cal State Fullerton Titans

Ranked No. 25 by D1Baseball.com, the Titans opened up the season with last weekend at the MLB4 Tournament with a pair of wins defeating then-No. 19 TCU, 2-0 and Virginia, 6-5 and fell to No. 1 Vanderbilt, 14-9.

Coming off a 36-win season in 2018, a Big West conference regular season title and an appearance in a Super Regional, the Titans look were picked to repeat as Big West champions in 2019 with leading hitter, senior infielder Hank LoForte, returning after hitting .339 a year ago. Of the seven position players who started 53 or more games a year ago, six return this spring

On the mound, the Titans did lose the services of Fresno native Colton Eastman who won 10 games a season, as Fullerton has a young staff with only five wins back on the mound from a year ago.

This will be the 'Dogs first game against Fullerton since 2014 and 94th meeting overall as the teams played annually between 1980-99 missing only the 1993 season.

A look at the Missouri State Bears

Missouri State is off to a 1-2 start to the season after playing at the Texas State Tournament last weekend in San Marcos, Texas. The Bears defeated Utah, 6-2 on Saturday and fell to MW foe Nevada, 16-4 on Friday and host Texas State, 10-0 on Sunday.

ing off a 40-17 season in 2018 that saw them win both the Missouri Valley Conference regular and tournament championships. The Bears advanced to the Ole Miss Regional posting a 1-2 mark.

Meeting the 'Dogs for the first time ever, the Bears return junior catcher Drew Millas, a 2018 NCBWA Second-Team All-American, who led the team with a .321

average a year ago and led the team in hits (68), RBI (61). On the mound, junior right-hander Logan Wiley will get the start for the Bears on Sunday after starting the season opener against Nevada where he lasted 4.1 innings allowing six hits and five earned with a pair of strikeouts.

Bulldogs vs. opponents from the Big 12, Big West & Missouri Valley Conferences

Fresno State will see its first opponent from the Big 12 since 2016 when they host Oklahoma and are 17-13 all-time against the league. Very familiar with all the teams in the Big West, the 'Dogs have played eight of the nine opponents hailing from California numerous times. The 'Dogs are 458-313-1 (.594) all-time and will also see Cal Poly later this season after playing UCSB, CSUN, Hawai'i, UC Riverside and Long Beach State in 2018. Finally, the Bulldogs are 16-9 all-time against opponents from the Missouri Valley with 14 of those contests coming against Dallas Baptist, most recently in 2010.

Batesole reaches 800 career win milestone

Head coach Mike Batesole reached career win number 800 on Saturday in the Bulldogs' 6-3 season-opening win over Utah Valley at Bob Bennett Stadium. Beginning his 17th season at the helm of the Bulldogs, Batesole has won 545 games at Fresno State and 256 at CSUN from 1996-2002.

In his career, Batesole has won at least 30 games in 19 of his 23 years as a Division I head coach and in 13 of his 16 seasons at Fresno State.

Dempsey off to hot start

Now in his second season as a Bulldog, senior second baseman Nolan Dempsey has gotten off to a hot start going 5-for-11 in the Utah Valley series with three singles, a double, home run and led the team with six RBIs and nine total bases.

The San Carlos, Calif., native ranks second in the Mountain West with a .818 slugging percentage and has added a stolen bases and sacrifice bunt so far this season.

New 'Dogs in action

Five Bulldogs made their debuts over the weekend against the Wolverines with redshirt freshman pitcher Kevin Larson and outfielder Dylan Johnson saw action in two games apiece.

Three true freshman also saw action with infielders Ryan Higgins and Jeff Jamison pinch-running and outfielder EJ Andrews, Jr. saw action in all three games playing while also playing left field.

Ashford a hard one to strike out

Senior center fielder Zach Ashford has been one of the toughest Bulldogs to strike out over his four-year career and has yet to do it in 11 at-bats this year. In 502 career at-bats, Ashford has only been sent down on strikes 73 times, or 14.5 percent, of the time.

Ashford & Bins selected to Mountain West Preseason All-Conference Team

A Second-Team All-Mountain West selection as a junior, Ashford started all 52 games he appeared in 2018 leading the team and ranking sixth in the MW with a .352 average from the plate. The 2017 Mountain West Co-Freshman of the Year, Bins had a stellar sophomore season hitting .301 from the plate with 52 hits while smacking 18 doubles to rank tied for sixth in the MW and was one of three 'Dogs to lead the team with 39 RBIs which tied for the 15th-most in the league.

Mike Batesole, a two-time National Coach of the Year, enters his 17th season as the head coach of the Fresno State Bulldogs.

Under Batesole, the Bulldogs were put on stage in front of the nation and captured America's hearts as he took the Bulldogs from underdogs to wonderdogs in 2008 to claim the school's first Division I national championship for any men's team sport. His Bulldogs won seven-straight conference titles from 2005-12 and made six NCAA appearances in that time, advancing to the regional title game three times before winning the National Championship.

Most recently, Fresno State had its fourth-straight 30-win season in 2018 compiling a 30-24 overall record with a fifth-place finish in the Mountain West going 13-17 in the conference.

Three Bulldogs earned All-Mountain West honors as junior right-handed pitcher Edgar Gonzalez earned First-Team All-MW honors while junior outfielder Zach Ashford and senior shortstop Kody Batesole garnered second-team accolades. Fresno State has now had 27 All-MW selections in its first six years in the MW. Freshman left-handed pitcher Jaime Arias was named a Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Freshman All-American going 5-1 with a 3.69 ERA and 62 strikeouts in 68.1 innings.

Gonzalez, Jeremiah Burks and Batesole each went on to be selected in the 2018 MLB Draft to extend the Diamond 'Dogs streak of 15 straight seasons with multiple Bulldogs being selected in the MLB Draft.

The 'Dogs finished 35-25 overall in 2017 winning 17 of its final 22 games on the season on its way to runner-up honors at the 2017 Mountain West Tournament. The Bulldogs, who finished third in the conference with a 18-12 overall mark, had six Bulldogs earn All-MW honors as Ricky Tyler Thomas, Aaron Arruda and Jesse Medrano earned First-Team All-Mountain West honors while Jake Stone, Scott Silva and Edgar Gonzalez earned Second-Team All-MW honors.

Eight Bulldogs were selected in the 2017 MLB Draft as Thomas, Arruda, Akins, Fred Schlichtholz, Rickey Ramirez, Ryan Dobson, Austin Guibor and Medrano tied for the third-most players drafted in a single draft in program history and was the sixth-most players selected in the country behind Texas (11), Michigan (11), Stanford (10), Florida State (9) and Clemson (9). Stone signed a free agent deal with the Tampa Bay Rays to give the 'Dogs nine players entering the pro ranks in 2017.

In 2016, Batesole's Bulldogs won the Mountain West regular season championship with a 21-9 mark in the conference and finished 36-22 overall for its most wins in a season since 2011. Batesole picked up his first career Mountain West Coach of the Year honor in 2016 as eight 'Dogs earned All-MW honors with four being named First-Team and four picking up Second-Team honors.

Jimmy Lambert, who was named the Mountain West Co-Pitcher of the Year, Ricky Tyler Thomas, Brody Russell and Aaron Arruda gave the 'Dogs their most First-Team selections since 2011, while Jake Stone, Rickey Ramirez, Tim Borst and Scott Silva were selected to the Second-Team.

The Bulldogs had a player drafted in the MLB Draft for the 40th consecutive season with a pair of 'Dogs being selected as Lambert was a fifth-round selection of the Chicago White Sox and Dylan Lee was taken in the 10th round by the Miami Marlins.

In Batesole's 16-year tenure, the skipper has produced a total of 77 players who have been selected in the annual Major League Baseball Draft.

Dedicated not only to excellence on the diamond but in the classroom as well, Batesole saw 16 Bulldogs earn academic all-conference honors in 2015. Additionally, four Diamond Dogs were celebrated with the Mountain West Scholar-Athlete honor, which recognizes student-athletes that maintain a 3.5 cumulative grade point average or better. Overall, Batesole has had 152 student athletes receive all-academic selections at Fresno State.

Batesole led the Bulldogs to a historical 2008 season after defying the odds and beating six ranked teams and facing six elimination games to win the program's first-ever National Championship. Six 'Dogs off that team were drafted to Major League Baseball.

Batesole earned three additional National Coach of the Year accolades that year from the American Baseball Coaches Association, FieldTurf and the National College Baseball Writers Association. The Bulldogs captured their third-consecutive WAC championship in 2008 and finished the postseason run with an overall record of 47-31. Fresno State saw five players earn first-team All-WAC honors in 2008. The 2008 postseason run was the 'Dogs fourth appearance at the College World Series and first National Championship.

A native of Anaheim, Calif., Batesole played shortstop for Garden Grove High School where he earned All-Garden Grove Conference and All-Orange County honors. Batesole then was a standout player at Oral Roberts where he finished his tenure ranked third in school history in career home runs. He would go on to be drafted in the 14th round of the 1985 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Dodgers and play within its affiliate organizations for four years.

Batesole lives in Fresno with his wife Susie and they have four children - Kassy, Kally, Kody and Korby.

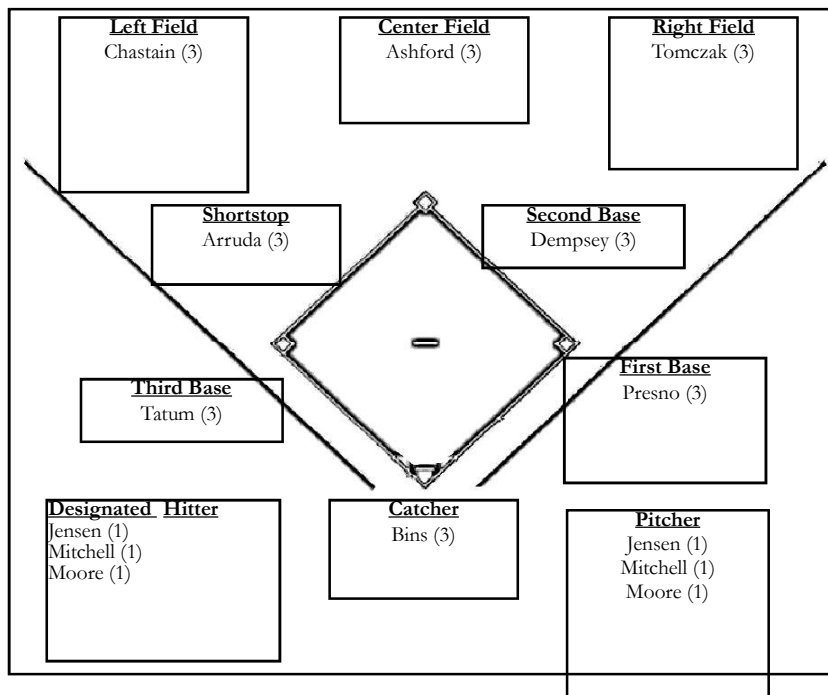
