What to know:

- Fresno State enters 2019 coming off a historic 12-win season in 2018. It was the first 12-win season in the 97-year history of the program.
- Since Jeff Tedford took over the program at Fresno State, the Bulldogs are 22-6 (.786). Tedford's winning percentage is currently the best in school history among all coaches with more than 20 wins in their respective Fresno State careers.
- Fresno State is the first team in FBS history to secure back-to-back double-digit winning seasons following a double-digit loss season (2016: 1-11, 2017: 10-4, 2018: 12-2).
- In 2019, the Bulldogs will seek their third-straight double-digit winning season, a feat that has never happened before in school history.
- The 2017-18 Bulldog teams joined the 1988-89 squads as the only teams in Fresno State history to earn back-to-back double-digit winning seasons.
- Fresno State captured its third Mountain West Championship in 2018 by defeating Boise State on the road in overtime, 19-16. The Bulldogs have won three league championships and four division titles since joining the MW in 2012.
- Fresno State finished the season nationally ranked for the first time since 2004. The Bulldogs finished ranked No. 18 in both the AP Top 25 and Coaches poll in 2018. It was the best finish in

the AP Top 25 in program history, besting No. 22 in 2004. The Bulldogs' best finish in an end of season poll remains No. 16 in the 1985 Coaches poll, which was known as the United Press International poll before USA Today took over in 1991.

- The Bulldogs lost juniors Jeff Allison (linebacker) and Mike Bell (safety) as early entrants to the NFL Draft.
• Jeff Allison (linebacker), Mike Bell (safety) and KeeSean Johnson (wide receiver) represented Fresno State at the 2019 NFL Scouting Combine. The Bulldogs shared the league lead with San Diego State for the most invites (3). The Mountain West had a total of 14 players representing the conference.
• The Bulldogs will look to repeat as outright MW Champions for the first time returning 35 lettermen (lost 29). The Bulldogs shared the MW title in 2012 (the last season there was not a league championship game) before winning the inaugural championship game in 2013.
• Fresno State returns 12 starters and lost 13. The offense took the biggest hit as eight were lost from that group.
• Position changes of note: Mykal Walker (DE>LB); Matt Kjeldgaard (DL>OL).
• The Bulldogs will have three returners that own at least 20 career starts. Safety Juju Hughes leads the trio with 28 while cornerback Jaron Bryant owns 27 and tight end Jared Rice has 20.
• The Bulldogs' offensive line coach the past two seasons, Ryan Grubb, was promoted to offensive coordinator/associate head coach on Feb. 18. He will still lead the offensive line group in his new role.
• On February 18, Fresno State introduced the additions of three assistant coaches: Danny Langsdorf (quarterbacks coach/passing game coordinator), Will Plemons (defensive line coach) and Roman Sapolu (assistant offensive line coach). The Bulldogs lost the services of Kalen DeBoer, Jamar Cain and Lucus Gingold to fill those roles.
• The Bulldogs gain 2018 recruiting class signees Rodney Wright III (wide receiver) and Deshawn Ruffin (defensive back) for spring football in 2019. The duo grey-shirted.
• The Bulldogs tallied 15 National Letters of Intent for their 2019 recruiting class; two of those signees will be on the 2019 spring roster in tight ends Raymond Pauwels and Juan Rodriguez, both junior college transfers.
• Fresno State collected 15 All-Mountain West honors last season. Of those that got the nod that return in 2019 are: first-team defensive end Mykal Walker (now linebacker for 2019), second-team punter Blake Cusick, second-team defensive back Juju Hughes, second-team tight end Jared Rice, honorable mention selection defensive back Jaron Bryant and honorable mention selection defensive lineman Jasad Haynes.

What to know offensively:

- Fresno State returns three starters on offense.
• Though not deemed a returning starter, the 'Dogs will regain the services of offensive lineman Netane Muti. He started all 14 games at left guard as a redshirt freshman in 2017 and the first two games of 2018 before suffering a season-ending injury on Sept. 8 at Minnesota.
• In spite of the number of starters lost, the run game returns 81 percent of the rushing yards gained a season ago. Starting running back Ronnie Rivers (743) returns for his junior season as well as junior Jordan Mims (436) and senior Josh Hokit (260). That trio has combined for 3,129 yards over the last two seasons.
• Incoming quarterbacks coach Danny Langsdorf inherits a group that shares zero starts among them. Marcus McMaryion departed with a 21-4 record as a starter over the last two seasons. Now-senior Jorge Reyna, Jeff Tedford's first recruit and a junior college transfer from West Los Angeles College, returns with the most experience under Tedford's system.
• A total of eight seniors were lost from the wide receiver group (lettermen and non-lettermen).
• Tight end Jared Rice returns as the Bulldogs' active leader in career receptions (81) and receiving yards (1,058).

What to know defensively:

- Fresno State returns six starters on defense, including the Mountain West Championship game MVP, defensive end Mykal Walker.
• Walker led the team in TFLs in 2018 with 14.0 and tied for the second-most tackles (87).
• While last season the 'Dogs lost all four members of the defensive line, all four of 2018's starters return to the 2019 team. A position group was again depleted to zero, however, as all three linebackers were lost to graduation or the NFL Draft.
• Fresno State lost four of its top five tacklers from 2018 as all three linebacker ranked in the top five in that category - No. 1 Jeff Allison (126), No. 2 George Helmuth (87) and No. 5 James Bailey (80).
• Fresno State ranked fourth in the FBS in 2018 in passes intercepted with 19. Ten Bulldogs chipped in for that total last season and six of those individuals return in 2019, including one of two team-leaders that posted four, Juju Hughes.

SIGNING DAY NOTES

- Fresno State received 15 total National Letters of Intent for the 2019 Signing Class – 13 in the early signing period in December of last year and two on National Signing Day in February.
- 10 of the 15 signees are from California. The other five are from five different states – Nevada, Texas, Washington, Arizona, and Arkansas.
- Three are from the Central Valley, including two from the immediate Fresno area.
- Fresno State signed 12 high school players and three Juco players.
- Fresno State signed eight offensive players, and seven defensive players.
- Fresno State's largest position group signed was a tie, four wide receivers and four defensive backs, making up eight of the 15 signees.

JEFF TEDFORD

HEAD COACH

3RD SEASON | FRESNO STATE (1992)

Jeff Tedford, 57, inherited a 1-11 football program when he took over the reins of his alma mater and in two seasons all he's done as the 19th head football coach in Fresno State history is lead the program to a 22-6 record, a 2018 Mountain West Championship, two MW West division titles and two bowl wins.

In 2018, in addition to defeating Boise State on the road in overtime, 19-16, for Fresno State's first conference championship since 2013, the Bulldogs capped the season with a 31-20 triumph over Arizona State to win the Mitsubishi Motors Las Vegas Bowl. The bowl win left the Bulldogs with their first 12-win season in the 97-year history of the program. This, one season after engineering one of the greatest turnarounds in FBS history guiding the Bulldogs to a 10-4 record, an appearance in the MW title game and a Hawai'i Bowl win over Houston.

The renaissance under Tedford has led to FBS history being made as Fresno State became the first team to secure back-to-back double-digit winning seasons following a double-digit loss season.

The 2018 Bulldogs finished nationally ranked in the final rankings of the season for the first time since 2004. Fresno State finished ranked No. 18 in both the AP Top 25 and Coaches poll, announced Jan. 8, 2019. It was the best finish in the AP Top 25 in program history, besting No. 22 in 2004. The 'Dogs also held a No. 21 ranking in the final College Football Playoff poll released on Dec. 2, 2018.

Individual accolades in 2018 included Tedford being named an Eddie Robinson Award finalist and a Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award finalist. Fresno State sported 15 all-conference honorees in 2018, including the league's Defensive Player of the Year in linebacker Jeff Allison. In addition, 19 student-athletes were named to the Fall Academic All-Mountain West team.

With a 10-4 record in his first season, Fresno State became the third team in FBS history to turn a double-digit loss season (2016) into a double-digit win season (2017) the following year. The season included an appearance in the nation's top 25, clinching the Mountain West's West Division crown and leading the 'Dogs to their first appearance in the MW Championship game since 2014. He also guided the 'Dogs to the program's first bowl victory since 2007 with their win at the Hawai'i Bowl.

Great success brought great notoriety as Tedford was named the 2017 Mountain West Coach of the Year, was a semifinalist for the George Munger College Coach of the Year Award presented by the Maxwell Football Club, a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award, and the AFCA Region-5 Coach of the Year.

While Tedford was honored as the league's coach of the year, the team had 16 student-athletes recognized with MW postseason honors - the most for the Bulldogs in a single-season since joining the conference in 2012. In the classroom, the 'Dogs also set a team-best number since joining the conference as they had 24 named to the Fall Academic All-Mountain West team.

Tedford, a former Bulldog quarterback and Fresno State assistant coach,

returned to the Valley after holding the position of offensive consultant for the Washington Huskies – a 2016 College Football Playoff team.

Tedford assumed the role of acting head coach on Nov. 27, 2016, following the conclusion of the 2016 season as Eric Kiesau carried out interim head coaching duties for the remaining two games on the 2016 schedule following Tedford's introductory press conference. Tedford was officially hired on Nov. 10, 2016.

Tedford, who was an already proven winner on the West Coast, came to the Valley with 11 years of head coaching experience at the Division I level – having led the California Golden Bears to 82 wins from 2002-2012. He left as the school's all-time winningest coach.

Tedford's ties to the Valley and Fresno State run deep. He played quarterback at Fresno State in 1981-82 under Jim Sweeney and coached at Fresno State under Sweeney from 1987-88 and 1992-96, and under a then-first-year head coach Pat Hill in 1997.

Tedford's coaching career started at Fresno State, volunteering as an assistant for the 1987-88 seasons. From there he picked up his first full-time position as an assistant for the Calgary Stampeders of the Canadian Football League – a familiar league in which he played quarterback for six seasons after his collegiate career at Fresno State.

He returned to Fresno State in 1992 as the quarterbacks coach and served as the offensive coordinator for the Bulldogs over the ensuing five seasons.

Tedford held the same position at Oregon (1998-2001) before he became the head coach at Cal. He was named the Pac-10 Coach of the Year twice, leading the Golden Bears to a school record seven consecutive bowl games and to a conference title in 2006.

Following Tedford's stint at Cal, he moved on to the NFL in 2014 as the Tampa Bay Buccaneers' offensive coordinator. The stop did not last long due to health issues during the preseason that evolved into an indefinite leave of absence, which resulted in the two sides mutually agreeing to part ways.

Tedford made his return to the CFL in 2015 as he was named the head coach of the B.C. Lions. At the conclusion of the season, Tedford elected to exercise an option in his contract to resign and pursue opportunities in college football.

Tedford made his return to college football as an offensive consultant for the Washington Huskies under head coach Chris Peterson in 2016. A relationship rekindled after their time together as assistants at Oregon under then-coach Mike Belotti. Washington's staff also included associate head coach Bob Gregory, who served as Tedford's defensive coordinator at Cal for eight seasons.

Tedford graduated from Warren High School in Downey, California and attended Cerritos Junior College for two seasons before becoming the Bulldogs' quarterback in 1981.

He and his wife Donna have two children, Taylor and Quinn.

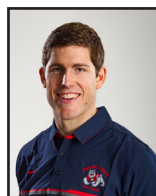
