What to know:

- The 2021 football season will be the 100th season of competition in program history.
- Fresno State had 14 players opt to utilize the blanket waiver for all 2020 fall sports student-athletes to retain a year of eligibility due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Those entering their extra years are: Keric Wheatfall (WR), Arron Mosby (DE), Deonte Perry (DB), Ronnie Rivers (RB), Cesar Silva (K), Kenny Gagnon (DB), Kwami Jones (DE), Jason Diaz Jr. (DB), Jacob Westberry (LS), Matt Smith (OL), Alex Akingbulu (OL), Nick Abbs (OL), Juan Rodriguez (TE) and Kevin Atkins (DT).
- The Bulldogs added six players to their 2021 spring roster. Four transfers, and two incoming first-year players. Fresno State transfers included defensive back DaRon Bland (Sacramento State), running back Jordan Wilmore (Utah), linebacker Tyson Maeva (Florida International) and kicker Abraham Montano (Hartnell College). The first-year players were two Los Angeles based players in running back Josh Barbarin (Lawndale HS) and Anthony Berry (Narbonne HS).

What to know (cont.):

- Fresno State transfer Tyson Maeva, is also another player utilizing the additional year of eligibility provided by the waiver as a result of the pandemic. Maeva began his collegiate career at Boise State before transferring to Florida International in 2019.
- While 14 players opted to return for the 2021 season, the Bulldogs lost one entry to the 2021 NFL Draft - offensive lineman Syrus Tuitiele. He made 26 starts at right tackle over the past three seasons for the Bulldogs.
- Fresno State played in six of its eight scheduled games during the unprecedented 2020 season terrorized by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Bulldogs dropped their season opener, won three-straight, and then dropped its last two. The Bulldogs' program paused after its three-game win streak, losing back-to-back games to San Jose State and San Diego State, before being cleared to play the final two games.
- The Bulldogs defied the odds all together in 2020 to play their six games given the team did not meet or hold any organized training in person until Sept. 25. Prior to then, the last team meeting was on March 12. The Bulldogs missed the entirety of spring football, there were no traditional summer workouts, and due to local county rules and restrictions, Fresno State was unable to bring its student-athletes back to campus until late September while the NCAA allowed involuntary workouts to begin June 1, and mandatory workouts to begin July 17.
- Fresno State will return 20 of its 22 position starters. Those 20 returning starters own a collective 204 career games started between them (89 offense/115 defense). Defensive tackle Kevin Atkins leads the team, and defense, with 32 career starts while Ronnie Rivers leads the offense with 30 career starts.
- Fresno State returns nine of its 10 all-conference selections from the 2020 season.
- The Bulldogs have five, sixth-year players, who started their respective careers at Fresno State in 2016 (Deonte Perry, Kenny Gagnon, Jacob Westberry, Matt Smith & Kevin Atkins).

- After the Bulldogs' Oct. 16 game at Wyoming, their regular season schedule does not ask them to leave the state of California for the remainder of it.

What to know offensively:

- Fresno State returns nine of 11 starters on offense.
- Three of the Bulldogs nine returning starters on offense are "Super Seniors" as RB Ronnie Rivers WR Keric Wheatfall and OL Matt Smith each elected to utilize an extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA.
- QB Jake Haener was tabbed by Athlon Sports as one of the nation's top quarterbacks on the rise in 2021.
- Fresno State set the program's record for most plays (105) in a single-game in 2020 versus Nevada.
- Fresno State set the program's record for most passing first downs (23) in a single-game in 2020 versus Nevada.
- Jake Haener had four 300-yard passing games - in six scheduled games. It was the most in a season by a Bulldog since 2014.
- Fresno State had four 100-yard receiving performances in 2020, after zero in 2019.
- WR Jalen Cropper finished the 2020 season with three-straight 100-yard receiving games.
- In 2020, QB Jake Haener, RB Ronnie Rivers and WR Jalen Cropper became the first trio since 2014 to each respectively surpass 300-yards passing, 100-yards rushing and 100-yards receiving in a single game (Nov. 14).
- RB Jordan Mims logged the 10th longest run in program history with a 84-yard scamper in the 2020 season finale against New Mexico.
- Ronnie Rivers moved from No. 14 to No. 7 in all-time career rushing yards at Fresno State with 507 yards rushing in 2020.
- Ronnie Rivers moved from T-No. 7 to T-No. 3 in all-time career rushing TDs at Fresno State with seven TDs in 2020.
- Ronnie Rivers is tied for the all-time lead in career touchdowns with 44. He need one TD in 2021 to break Anthony Daigle's (1991-93) program record.
- Ronnie Rivers moved from No. 19 to No. 7 in career all-purpose yards at Fresno State with 818 all-purpose yards in 2020.
- Ronnie Rivers is one of seven Bulldogs to ever reach 4,000 all-purpose yards.

Calvin Turner Jr. (Hawaii) is listed on stats.ncaa.org in the FBS record column for statistics generated at FCS program Jacksonville State (2017-19) for FBS Active All-Purpose Yardage Leaders (4,359), FBS Active Rushing Yardage Leaders (3,117), and FBS Active Touchdown Leaders (44).*

- QB Jake Haener placed himself in the program's all-time Top 50 best single game passing performances, slotting in at No. 8 (485 yards at Nevada), No. 16 (422 yards at Utah State) and No. 47 (350 vs. New Mexico).
- WR Jalen Cropper set a career-high for single game receptions with 12 in the season finale against New Mexico. It was one of 23 all-time performances in program history with 12+ catches in a single game.
- WR Jalen Cropper's 202-yard receiving game at Utah State in 2020 was the 16th-most yards in a single game by a Bulldog in program history.
- Ronnie Rivers enters the 2021 season with 116 career receptions. He is tied for the most receptions in program history by a running back with former Bulldog Jamie Kimbrough (1995-98).
- Rivers enters the 2021 season as the active FBS leader in touchdowns (44), ranks second in active all-purpose yardage (4,021) and seventh in active rushing yards (2,629) - *Calvin Turner Jr. (Hawaii) statistics omitted - see left-hand column*

What to know defensively:

- Fresno State returns all 11 starters on defense.
- Three of the Bulldogs 11 returning starters are "Super Seniors" as DE Kwami Jones, DT Kevin Atkins and DB Deonte Perry each elected to utilize an extra year of eligibility granted by the NCAA.
- Arron Mosby, also a "Super Senior", is second in active games played (45), and has started 12 career games.
- Kevin Atkins leads all Bulldogs in both active career games started (32) and career games played (46).
- The Bulldogs return five postseason all-conference honorees on defense – David Perales (second-team), Kevin Atkins (HM), Levelle Bailey (LB), Kwami Jones (DE) and Evan Williams (DB).
- Three defensive linemen that attributed greatly to pressuring the quarterback, was the force that made Fresno State a national leader in sacks. Twelve different 'Dogs found their way into the stat column for sacks, resulting in 25 sacks in six games for an average of 4.17 per game – a mark that ranked No. 3 in the nation.
- It wasn't just the quarterback pressured behind the line of scrimmage in 2020, as 46 tackles for loss were recorded by the defense. Their 7.5 TFLs per game placed the Bulldogs in the top 20 nationally.
- Second-team All-MW defensive end David Perales returns on the edge after a 2020 season ranking No. 3 in the NCAA in forced fumbles and No. 12 in fumbles recovered. He had a stretch of four-straight games forcing a fumble - the first Bulldogs to do so in at least 20 years.
- Sophomore Levelle Bailey started the first three games of the season as the "husky" in Fresno State's new 4-2-5 defensive scheme before shifting back to linebacker to give way to the 6-5, 195 lb. true freshman Justin Houston who emerged as an impact player in the role. Houston led the team in total tackles over the final three games of the six-game season with 18 stops. He also chipped in 2.0 TFLs and one sack during that three-game stretch.
- The 2020 starting cornerback duo of Wylan Free and Bralyn Lux both return to the 2021 squad. It was an unlikely but steady presence for the Bulldogs' defense in 2020. Lux, a walk-on, was a Burlsworth Trophy nominee that started all six games. He led the team with 30 tackles and secured his first career interception on Dec. 5 facing Nevada's Carson Strong. Strong entered that game with just two interceptions in 2020. Free, who had history at cornerback, but was transitioning back to it from safety was the other constant that also started all six games. He had 18 tackles, one interception, and a team-high four broken up passes. Those two combined to have the same amount of plays made on the ball as first downs allowed (10).

Extra:

- Prior to Spring Football beginning on March 20; a community service initiative in collaboration with the City of Fresno - Beautify Fresno, had every member of the football team participate on a given Saturday. The QBs, TEs and OL picked up trash near the corner of Cedar and Shaw on Feb. 13. The DL, LBs and specialist painted addresses in front of residential homes on Feb. 20. The WR and RB cleaned up a stretch of road on the west side of Fresno on Feb. 27 and another cleanup effort was completed by the CBs, safeties and huskies on March 13 to complete the spring project.

KALEN DEBOER

HEAD COACH

2ND SEASON | SIOUX FALLS (1998)

The 2021 season marks Kalen DeBoer's (pronounced duh-BOR) second season as head coach for the Fresno State Football program. He was named the 20th head coach in Fresno State history on Dec. 17, 2019, succeeding Jeff Tedford.

While he embarked on his first season at the helm of the program a year ago, he is no stranger to the Valley as he first arrived in 2017 with Tedford, hired as his offensive coordinator. DeBoer coached the Bulldogs for two seasons before departing for a one-year stint in 2019 at Indiana in the same capacity.

DeBoer earned his first career Division I victory as a head coach on Oct. 29, 2020 at Bulldog Stadium in a 38-17 win against Colorado State following one of the most challenging offseasons in recent memory, for any program, due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Unflappable throughout, the team bonded together under DeBoer's leadership, and his coaching staff's, despite no spring football or traditional summer workouts leading into the 2020 season.

Fresno State finished with a 3-3 record in 2020, playing its first two games at home and final four on the road in an unprecedented year. The team sported 10 postseason All-Mountain West selections, highlighted by first-team running back Ronnie Rivers. The Bulldogs' offense shined in 2020 producing a conference-best 479.3 yards total offense per game. The Bulldogs' defense showed growth in a new 4-2-5 scheme, utilizing a large contingent of underclassmen and newcomers that caused havoc for opposing quarterbacks. Fresno State finished tops in the Mountain West, and third in the NCAA in sacks per game (4.17). The 'Dogs scored an average of 32.8 points per game in 2020 while allowing 30.0.

IU sported an 8-5 record in 2019 with DeBoer as its offensive coordinator, a resurrection season said by some in the Midwest, as it was the Hoosiers' best regular season in 26 years. The eight wins tied for the third most in school history, trailing only the 1945 and 1967 Big Ten Championships teams who each won nine games. Indiana posted a winning conference record for the first time since 1993 (5-3) and was nationally ranked for the first time in 25 years, breaking the oldest such drought in the country.

The Hoosiers' offense, a catalyst of the success, excelled under DeBoer ranking inside the top five in the 14-team Big Ten conference in passing offense (302.4, second), first downs (23.4, second), time of possession (33:43, third) turnovers lost (15, third), total offense (432.8, third), passing efficiency (150.6, fourth), third down conversion percentage (.469, fourth) and scoring offense (31.8, fifth).

DeBoer's two years as the Bulldogs' offensive coordinator was one for the ages that concluded with a Mountain West Championship and Las Vegas Bowl win to cap a 22-6 run during the 2017-18 seasons. Those two seasons included double-digit winning seasons each year, coming off a 1-11 campaign by the 2016 team. That feat led to Fresno State becoming the first program in FBS history to secure back-to-back double-digit winning seasons following a double-digit loss season.

Prior to joining the Bulldogs' staff, DeBoer spent three seasons as the offensive coordinator at Eastern Michigan where he helped guide the Eagles to their first bowl bid since 1987 following a 7-5 regular season. It was EMU's first season above .500 since 1995.

EMU tied the Football Bowl Subdivision mark for biggest turnarounds in 2016, improving on its win total from one win in 2015. His offense shattered the school record for total yards with 5,917 yards, breaking the previous record of 5,010. School records were also set for points scored (385), passing yards (3,849), touchdown passes (25), first downs (303), pass completions (309), plays (999) as well single-game plays (99). His squad racked up the second-most touchdowns (47) and rushing TDs (21) in a season and the second-most single-game touchdown (8) and first downs (35).

Prior to his three-year stint at Eastern Michigan, DeBoer spent four seasons as the offensive coordinator at Southern Illinois (2010-13) while also overseeing the wide receiver unit. In total, the Salukis beat 10 Top-25 opponents during DeBoer's tenure. In 2013, the Saluki offense led the Missouri Valley Football Conference (FCS) with 231.8 passing yards per game, the fourth highest total in school history. SIU's 25 passing touchdowns on the season tied for the third highest total in school history. Under DeBoer's tutelage, tight end MyCole Pruitt was named to the 2013 American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) FCS All-America team while John Lantz developed into an All-MVFC receiver.

During the 2011 campaign, the Salukis ranked third in the nation with an average of 183.1 rushing yards a contest. Bryan Boemer also developed into the Rimington Award winner, which is presented to the nation's premier center.

Before leading Eastern Michigan and Southern Illinois to prolific offensive numbers, DeBoer served as the head coach at the University of Sioux Falls, where he led one of the most dominant NAIA programs in the nation.

DeBoer was named a three-time NAIA National Coach of the Year and compiled an astonishing 67-3 (.957) record while guiding USF to three national championships in five seasons. He won four Great Plains Athletic Conference Championships, 50-straight home games and 29-straight games overall in his final two seasons. He also boasted a 17-2 record in the playoffs. His teams won back-to-back NAIA National Championships in 2008 and 2009, and adding in his 2006 national championship, DeBoer had as many national championships as games lost during his five-year tenure as USF's head coach.

DeBoer coached three NAIA National Players of the Year winners in quarterbacks Lorenzo Brown (2009) and Chad Cavender (2007) and running back Nick Kortan (2002). During his time at USF, he helped develop 25 first-team All-Americans.

A graduate of USF, DeBoer played for the Cougars from 1993-96, where he was an All-American wide receiver. He set school records for receptions (234), receiving yards (3,400) and touchdown catches (33).

Following his playing days, he became a student assistant for Sioux Falls under coach Bob Young in 1997. From 2000-04, he served as USF's offensive coordinator and succeeded Young as head coach in 2005.

He and his wife, Nicole, have two daughters, Alexis and Avery.

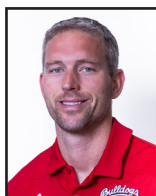

FRESNO, Calif. – The Bulldogs' long-awaited 2020 season opener was met with disappointment Saturday night as Fresno State fell 34-19 to Hawai'i at Bulldog Stadium. The Rainbow Warriors took advantage of four Bulldog turnovers with an offense that was primed to fire, racking up 552 yards.



Fresno State's offense was not stagnant by any means. They registered 409 yards, but turnovers and drives cut short in the red zone that resulted in three points instead of six points was too much to overcome.

In his first start for Fresno State, quarterback Jake Haener passed for 289 yards, one touchdown and three interceptions while running back Ronnie Rivers led the Bulldogs' offense with 124 all-purpose yards. Chevan Cordeiro, the Warriors' signal-caller, had 229 yards passing and was one of two Hawai'i players to have 100-plus yards rushing. Cordeiro added two rushing scores.

How It Happened

Fresno State opened up the game on the front foot as Bralyn Lux jarred the ball loose from the Warriors' kick returner Lincoln Victor on the opening kickoff. Mac Dalena pounced on the ball at the 26-yard line to set things up for the 'Dogs offense to score first. Facing a third-and-13, Haener hooked up with Josh Kelly across the middle for 26 yards to extend the drive. Rivers would later find a lane to the end zone for the Bulldogs' first touchdown of the 2020 season.

The Hawai'i offense countered as it went on to score 10 straight points to take a 10-7 lead with four minutes left in the half.

After pinning UH at the 1-yard line, an ensuing three-and-out by UH and a 23-yard Rivers' punt return set Fresno State up for another short scoring drive, inside the 35-yard line, again. A 15-yard run from Jordan Mims, in his first action since 2018, was followed by Haener connecting down the middle with Juan Rodriguez for an 18-yard score to put the 'Dogs back ahead 13-10 with 1:50 left in the half. The PAT was no good.

The Bulldogs' short scoring drive that put them on top, ended not the way they would of liked as Hawai'i responded quickly to take a 17-13 lead into the break. It took Cordeiro and his offense just over a minute to move the ball 72 yards for the touchdown and the lead.

Fresno State opened the second half with the ball, but committed their third turnover of the game which resulted in the 'Dogs falling behind 11 points as Hawai'i methodically drove the ball 14 plays for 76 yards.

Haener got the Bulldogs right back in business, airing it out on the first play on the following drive, connecting with Kerik Wheatfall for 46 yards. On third-and-6 from the Warriors' 25-yard line, UH's Kai Kaneshiro was tagged with a pair of penalties that put the 'Dogs inside the 10-yard line. Unable to score six points, Cesar Silva pulled the 'Dogs within eight, 24-16.

Fresno State quickly threatened again following a 49-yard missed field, but a Haener throw in UH territory ricocheted off the facemask of Wheatfall and it found the hands of the wrong team. The Warriors continued to strike, scoring again, but this time a 24-yard field goal, to extend the lead to 27-16.

The 'Dogs were again able to move the ball quick, Haener leading off the drive with a 51-yard pitch and catch to Chris Coleman. The drive again stalled inside the red zone, and the 'Dogs would settle for a 25-yard field goal from Silva to pull back within eight, 27-19, with 10:13 on the clock.

Hawai'i scored once more with 4:52 on the clock to close the game with a final result of 34-19.

FRESNO, Calif. – Kalen DeBoer earned career win No. 1 as head coach at Fresno State on Thursday night behind an emphatic 38-17 thumping of Colorado State. The Bulldogs racked up 432 yards of offense with 164 of those, and three touchdowns, coming from senior Ronnie Rivers.



Jake Haener notched his first-career 300-yard passing game, throwing for 311 yards on 22-of-32 attempts, for three touchdowns with zero interceptions. The junior quarterback spread the ball around, connecting with seven different receivers on the night. Rivers and fellow senior Kerik Wheatfall led the receivers with five receptions apiece with Wheatfall totaling a game-high 87 yards. Rivers also collected 95 yards on the ground, and eight punt return yards, to lead the team with 172 all-purpose yards.

Fresno State's defense allowed the Rams to register 381 yards offense, and limited their starting quarterback to 141 yards on 10-of-23 passing. Sophomore Evan Williams led the Bulldogs with eight tackles and redshirt freshman Bralyn Lux added six.

The Bulldogs' biggest swings in the five days since they played last came in two crucial areas, third downs and turnovers. Fresno State held the Rams to 4-of-15 on third downs versus Hawai'i going 11-of-17. The 'Dogs also protected the ball, not committing a turnover rather than four in the first outing.

How It Happened

For the second week in a row, Fresno State jumped out in front first. The Bulldogs worked the ball 86 yards on their opening drive, twice converting on third down. Haener went 4-of-4 on the possession, finishing it off with a 13-yard pass to Rivers in the back of the end zone.

Colorado State responded with 10 unanswered points over the next eight minutes to take a 10-7 lead with 13:57 on the clock in the second.

Ben Wooldridge then entered the contest at quarterback, a planned series entering the game, and opened with a 24-yard completion to Jalen Cropper. The drive resulted in a 34-yard field goal, tying the game 10-10, for Cesar Silva following what was first thought a 17-yard touchdown reception for Wheatfall. It was overturned after it was ruled he stepped out of bounds prior to the catch.

After forcing CSU to a three-and-out later in the second quarter, the Bulldogs quickly found themselves facing a fourth down decision near midfield. The 'Dogs opted to go for it on fourth-and-2 and Haener found Rivers for a gain of 14 yards. The senior back then finished the drive with a 32-yard burst down the sideline, breaking a pair of tackles on his way to the end zone to take a 17-10 advantage with 6:32 left in the first half.

With the half winding down, Fresno State doubled its lead with a 10-play, 91-yard drive. Backed up to his own two-yard line after a sack on the first play, Haener twice extended the drive on third down, first with a 34-yard completion to a diving Josh Kelly on third-and-10, and then on a 33-yard catch and run across the middle from Rivers on third-and-19. Haener finished the drive finding Mims in the flat where the back ran untouched down the left sideline for a 15-yard score.

The second half saw the Bulldog defense keep the Rams out the end zone until the final minute. Rivers and Cropper each added a touchdown during the final 30 minutes to give Fresno State the 38-17 win.

LAS VEGAS – In a city filled with shows, Ronnie Rivers was the featured act on Saturday afternoon at the newly minted Allegiant Stadium, piling up 232 all-purpose yards and four touchdowns in Fresno State's 40-27 win over UNLV. The senior running back tallied 133 rushing yards and 99 receiving yards, coming up one yard shy of being the first player to surpass 100 yards in both categories since Dale Messer in 1960.



For the third game in a row the Bulldogs produced more than 400 yards total offense, finishing with 487. The 'Dogs utilized a balanced offensive attack that saw them rush for 243 yards on 36 attempts and pass for 244 yards on 35 attempts. UNLV totaled 402 yards but the Bulldogs' defense forced the Rebels into three turnovers that resulted in 10 points. Fresno State's defense also produced a season-high six sacks.

Jake Haener threw for 164 yards and one touchdown on 15-of-23 passing. The redshirt junior also rushed for 79 yards and a score. Ben Woolldridge led the offense in four respective drives, he went 5-of-12 passing for 80 yards, and produced points on three of his four opportunities on the field.

On the defensive side, Chris Gaston became the first Bulldog in more than a year to record two interceptions in a game while David Perales and Kurtis Brown paired together for the Bulldogs' third forced turnovers. Perales forced the fumble and Brown fell on top of it. For the second game this season, Bralyn Lux led the 'Dogs in tackles, besting his previous high with nine on Saturday. Evan Williams totaled eight for second straight week. Malachi Langley and Perales each totaled seven tackles and a sack.

How It Happened

On the Bulldogs second drive, Haener and Keric Wheatfall connected on back-to-back plays to move the ball 22 yards down field. Two plays later, Haener found an opening and called his own number off an RPO, outrunning the UNLV defense for a 54-yard touchdown to give the Bulldogs an early 6-0 lead after a failed PAT.

The lead was short lived as the Rebels scored 10 unanswered on their next two drives. A touchdown midway through the first quarter and a field goal early in the second.

Fresno State went back on top 13-10 with 9:34 remaining in the first half. Aided by a roughing the passer call on third-and-5 from the Bulldogs' own 32, quarterback Ben Woolldridge followed the penalty by linking up with Rivers for a 35-yard gain to put the 'Dogs in the red zone. A 12-yard pass to Raymond Pauwels Jr. set up a 6-yard touchdown run to the left side for Rivers behind aggressive blocking from Dontae Bull.

UNLV, though, had an answer, following up the Bulldogs' score with one of its own to put them back on top 17-13 at the 6:12 mark in the second frame.

In a seesaw first half, the Bulldogs regained the lead to close out the half. Following an 18-yard scramble from Haener, the signal caller found Rivers in the flat where the back tip-toed 33 yards down the sideline, again led by Bull in space, to put the 'Dogs ahead 20-17 at halftime.

Two plays into the second half, Perales came off the left edge and knocked the ball out of Rebels' quarterback Max Gilliam's hand for his second forced fumble in as many weeks. Brown pounced on the ball to hand possession back to the Bulldogs' offense. It took just three plays for Fresno State to capitalize and take a 27-17 lead as Rivers slipped through the middle of the line, and raced 16 yards for the score.

Behind a 27-yard field goal and a 71-yard quarterback dash by the home team, the game would once again be level, 27-27, with 3:41 left in the third quarter. Although this would be the last time UNLV would score as Fresno State closed the game outscoring the Rebels 13-0 in the fourth quarter.

Rivers scored for the fourth time in the game, capping an 11-play, 79-yard scoring drive. Rivers finished off the possession with a 3-yard run on fourth-and-2 before going 10 yards untouched into the end zone on the very next play on what was the first play of the fourth quarter.

The defense and Cesar Silva helped put the game away as the Bulldog kicker tacked on 31 and 35-yard field goals while Gaston produced a pair of late interceptions.

LOGAN, Utah – One big play after another. That was the story on Saturday afternoon as Fresno State left Maverik Stadium with its third-straight win, a 35-16 victory over Utah State.



The home team may have had two big plays before the Bulldogs got going but Fresno State quarterback Jake Haener wouldn't let those be the last of the game. The redshirt junior quarterback tossed a career-high 422 yards and four touchdowns, passing at a clip of 76.3 percent (29-of-38). It was the most passing yards by a Fresno State quarterback since Derek Carr's 2013 Mountain West championship game performance. Fifteen of Haener's completions were 10 or more yards, including touchdown throws of 44, 59 and 71 yards.

While Josh Kelly may have caught the longest pass from Haener (71 yards), it was Jalen Cropper who Haener looked to time and time again. Cropper hauled in 10 receptions for 202 yards and three touchdowns. It was the most receiving yards by a Bulldog since Davante Adams had 264 yards on Nov. 29, 2013.

Possibly overshadowed by the aerial show was the work of Ronnie Rivers who churned out 183 yards of offense on 31 touches (132 yards rushing, 51 yards receiving). The all-purpose back also scored a touchdown for the 12th straight game, the longest active streak in the NCAA.

Fresno State's defense also locked in following the Aggies' early scores, holding USU to three points and 257 yards over the final 49 minutes of the game. A week after piling up six sacks at UNLV, the 'Dogs racked up six more without the services of Kwami Jones, the league's sack leader. Kevin Atkins led the team with 2.0 on the day.

How It Happened

Utah State became the first team to score before the Bulldogs could this season, scoring one play after an interception using an 86-yard run from Jaylen Warren. Evan Williams blocked the point after try.

The Bulldogs answered with a methodical 13-play drive. Haener capitalized on a fourth-and-4 red zone conversion to tight end Rory Hanson, then found Cropper on the edge for a 9-yard score to go up 7-6. That advantage quickly disappeared behind a 94-yard kickoff return from the Aggies' special teams ace, Savon Scarver.

Fresno State regained the lead, 14-13, early in the second quarter and never trailed again. A 28-yard run from Rivers deep in the Bulldogs' territory gave the 'Dogs some breathing room. Two plays later, Haener connected with Cropper for a 59-yard touchdown to cap a quick four-play, 96-yard drive over just one minute, 27 seconds.

With less than six minutes remaining in the half, Haener bested what was his career-long pass earlier to Cropper, linking up with Josh Kelly along the sideline for 71 yards. The redshirt freshman receiver stayed in bounds and broke free from the defense, racing into the end zone for his first career touchdown.

Utah State countered on the ensuing drive, netting a 38-yard field goal with 1:59 on the clock to cut the Bulldogs' lead to five at 21-16. That was enough time for Fresno State to tack on seven more points as Haener completed five-straight passes to quickly move the 'Dogs 70 yards down the field. Rivers finished off the drive with a 4-yard run up the middle to give the Bulldogs a 28-16 advantage at the half.

After the defenses took over for much of the second half, the Bulldogs' offense could not be contained for the entirety of it like the Aggies were. The big-play connection of Haener and Cropper appeared once again in the fourth quarter as the Bulldogs' signal caller found the receiver in stride over the top of the Aggie defense for his third receiving touchdown of the game, a 44-yard score to give the 'Dogs the final result, 35-16.

RENO, Nev. – Fresno State fought until the clock ran out but it wasn't enough as Nevada won 37-26 on a frigid Saturday night at Mackay Stadium.



Jake Haener had a career night for the 'Dogs, throwing for the third-most pass completions (41) and attempts (65) in program history. The junior quarterback accounted for three touchdowns and totaled 502 yards (485 passing/17 rushing) which tied David Carr for the fifth-most ever by a Bulldog in a single game. Keric Wheatfall (113) and Jalen Cropper (107) each surpassed the 100-yard mark in receiving yards while Zane Pope, in his first game this season, finished four yards shy of the mark with 96. Wheatfall and Pope's marks were both career highs.

Ronnie Rivers' NCAA-best streak of scoring in 12-straight games came to a close. He finished with 69 yards rushing and 38 yards receiving on a career-best nine catches.

Fresno State's defense produced three turnovers compared to Nevada's two. Wylen Free and Bralyn Lux each recorded their first interceptions of the season, and it was the first time this season Nevada quarterback Carson Strong threw multiple picks in a game. He entered the contest with two interceptions on the year.

The Bulldogs outgained the Wolf Pack 599-416 in total offense on 105 total plays to Nevada's 61.

How It Happened

Nevada scored first, on its opening possession, connecting on a 49-yard field goal but the Bulldog offense quickly responded. A 27-yard reception from Cropper and a 17-yard catch from Rivers on Fresno State's first drive moved the ball down inside the 10-yard line. Josh Kelly finished the drive with a 9-yard rushing touchdown to put the 'Dogs up 7-3.

With a depleted special teams unit, the Bulldogs saw miscues on their punt team on their next two possessions. A fumble snap on a punt attempt, followed by a punt blocked, led to two short fields and 14 unanswered points for the Wolf Pack.

Fresno State's offense settled back into the game with a 16-play scoring drive. Twice on the possession it was Haener using his legs to come up with big plays, first on a 12-yard scramble on third-and-7 to get the 'Dogs into the red zone, and then again on fourth-and-goal from the 3-yard line as he dove just inside the pylon to pull Fresno State back to within seven, 17-10.

The Wolf Pack quickly responded going 59 yards in under three minutes to double its lead. With under two-and-a-half minutes left in the half, Haener went back to work under center. The signal caller first found Pope in an open pocket along the sideline for a 31-yard gain. Haener then found Wheatfall down the seam for a 19-yard score to pull within six at the half, 24-20.

The first 16 minutes of the second half saw three turnovers, two claimed by Fresno State, a fourth-down stop by Nevada and Rivers rushing for a long touchdown on third down which was negated by a penalty. It was the last play of the night for the Bulldog back as he left the game with an apparent injury.

Following an interception from Lux late in the third quarter, Haener guided the 'Dogs back into the red zone as time expired on the third quarter. Upon the start of the final frame, Nevada stopped Fresno State's bid to regain the lead on fourth-and-goal from the 4-yard-line to remain ahead 24-20. The Wolf Pack capitalized on the turnover over on downs in just three plays, the last being an 85-yard touchdown reception, and never looked back.

Nevada scored once more through the air to put the game out of reach before the 'Dogs scored once more late.

LAS VEGAS – Once owning a 31-21 lead midway through the third quarter, Fresno State's hopes to leave the desert with a win for a second time were dashed after surrendering 28 unanswered points before tacking on a late score to fall 49-39 to New Mexico on Saturday night at Sam Boyd Stadium.



Fresno State totaled 408 yards of offense with 350 of those coming off the arm of Jake Haener who was 26-of-43 through the air and tossed three touchdowns. Jalen Cropper hauled in a career-high 12 receptions for 134 yards and a touchdown. Fresno State's local receiving trio of Cropper, Josh Kelly (96) and Mac Dalena (88) accounted for 318 yards.

New Mexico's offense totaled 495 yards and went an astounding 12-of-16 on third downs while its defense produced eight sacks. It was the most since their program record nine sacks in 2005.

How It Happened

Fresno State opened up the game by getting into the Lobo's backfield and forcing a quick three-and-out. Kwami Jones finished off the possession with his fifth sack of the season.

Following a botched punt of 21 yards, Fresno State capitalized on solid field position from New Mexico's 44-yard line. Haener twice found Cropper on third down, the first on third-and-8 for a 32-yard gain, and the second to the left corner of the end zone on third-and-goal to put the 'Dogs in front 7-0.

A trend that then started early was the Lobo's answering Fresno State's touchdowns. A 75-yard drive drew the Lobos level with 6:34 left in the first.

Late in the first quarter, the Bulldogs found themselves starting at midfield following a UNM three-and-out. Haener rolled to his right and hit Zane Pope on a crossing route for a 16-yard score to regain the lead just six seconds into the second quarter.

Three minutes and 75 yards later, Nathaniel Jones answered with a 3-yard score for New Mexico to knot the game at 14 a piece.

The Bulldogs then scored 10 unanswered points and took a 24-14 lead midway through the second quarter. Asa Fuller first connected from 30 yards out, and then Jordan Mims broke loose for the longest play from scrimmage this season, an 84-yard touchdown run down the sideline.

The Lobos answered the Bulldogs' touchdown once again through a seven-play, 71-yard drive that cut Fresno State's lead to 24-21 at the half.

Midway through the third quarter and knocking on the doorstep, Haener faked a handoff to Ronnie Rivers, who drew the attention of the defense, and the Bulldog signal caller slipped out to the right and walked untouched into the end zone from three yards out to give the 'Dogs a 10 point advantage once again, 31-21, with 6:43 left in the third quarter. But from that point on, it was all New Mexico. The Lobos increased their defensive pressure and their offense scored 28 unanswered points to put the game out of reach.

Mac Dalena added a 24-yard touchdown reception late in the game, followed by a 2-point conversion, to make the final score 49-39.
