ANN ARBOR, Mich. – Driving late, looking to cut its deficit at No. 9 Michigan to one score, a pick six ended Fresno State's season opener. The Bulldogs fell 30-10 to the reigning national champions on Saturday night at Michigan Stadium.

The final score of the game wasn't completely telling of the Bulldogs' performance as Fresno State's defense held Michigan to only 16 points through 54 minutes of play.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Mikey Keene was intercepted on his second pass attempt of the game on a high ball off the hands of Chedon James. Five plays and 31 yards later, Michigan led 7-0 four minutes into the game.

Following the touchdown, Fresno State's defense held Michigan to just 12 plays during its next four drives, the final three ending in an interception by Cam Lockridge at the 1-yard line, a stop on third-and-inches and a sack by Ezra Christensen on 3-and-11.

The Bulldogs turned the second of the three-and-outs into three points with a 41-yard field goal by Dylan Lynch with 7:35 remaining in the half. The Wolverines pushed their advantage back to seven at 10-3 with an 11-play drive which resulted in a 45-yard field goal for Dominic Zvada just before halftime.

Michigan's lead stood at 16-3 with 12 minutes left in the game behind two more field goals from Zvada (53, 55). Fresno State answered in less than three minutes after Zvada's 55-yarder, finding the end zone. Keene linked up with Raylen Sharpe for a pitch-and-catch outside the left hash and the newcomer used his legs to get the final 13 yards of the 19-yard score.

The Wolverines responded with a 7-play, 75-yard touchdown drive to extend their advantage back to 13 at 23-10 with 5:43 on the clock. The Bulldogs looked to answer right back, moving the ball to the Michigan 10-yard line following a plethora of Wolverine penalties, but on first-and-10, Keene was intercepted for the second time and saw it returned for an 86-yard touchdown by Will Johnson.

UP NEXT

Fresno State will host Sacramento State next Saturday in its home opener. Kickoff is set for 7 p.m. PT at Valley Children's Stadium.

FRESNO, Calif. – With four different players finding the end zone, Fresno State defeated Sacramento State 46-30 in its home opener on Saturday night in front of a sold out crowd at Valley Children's Stadium.

Mikey Keene threw for the third-most passing yards in his career with 358 yards on 24-of-35 attempts, throwing two touchdowns. Mac Dalena accounted for 235 of those yards, a career high for the senior wide receiver. He had a team-high seven receptions.

Tuasiva Nomura racked up a career-high 11 tackles, 2.5 for loss, on the defensive side of the ball to go along with a fumble recovery. The Bulldogs forced three turnovers on the night.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Fresno State wasted no time, scoring on its first play of the game. Mikey Keene dropped back from his own 25-yard line, hitting Mac Dalena in stride over the top at the Sacramento State 36-yard line. The senior walked into the end zone. Fresno State converted the two-point conversion on a keeper by quarterback Jayden Mandal to go up 8-0 10 seconds into the game.

Three minutes later, a muffed punt by Jalen Moss set up the Hornets at the Bulldogs' 19-yard line. Sacramento State managed just three yards, settling for a 34-yard field goal.

Following back-to-back three-and-outs, Moss went right on his second punt return of the night and found a crease to the sideline, racing in for a 85-yard score to put the Bulldogs up 15-3.

On the next play from scrimmage, Corey Foreman forced a fumble that Tuasivi Nomura jumped on at the 20-yard line. The turnover resulted in a 32-yard field goal for Dylan Lynch.

The Bulldogs made it 25-3 with 12:49 on the clock in the second. Malik Sherrod capped off an 8-play, 80-yard drive with a 2-yard touchdown run. Sacramento State got on the board again, but this time by touchdown following a 78-yard pass by Kaiden Bennett to make it a 25-10 game in favor of the Bulldogs. Fresno State got its second takeaway of the night off a forced fumble by Kosi Agina and the pickup by Cam Lockridge at the Fresno State seven-yard line. The Bulldogs quickly gave up possession as Keene threw an interception that would bring the defense back out to the field, but the defense responded just two plays later as Camry Bracha picked off Bennett in the end zone.

Fresno State led 25-10 at halftime, but the Hornets scored on their first possession of the second half to cut the Bulldogs' lead to 25-17 less than three minutes into the third quarter.

Fresno State extended its lead back to 15 with 3:32 remaining in the third quarter. A 13-play, 75-yard drive culminated in a fourth-and-1 touchdown pass to linebacker Tyler Mello, who was in as a fullback. That started a string of three-straight possessions with a touchdown. Sherrod scored his second of the night from one yard out and Joshua Wood ran in a 10-yard score that put the 'Dogs up 46-23 with 8:06 left in the game.

Sacramento State added another score just over a minute later behind a three-play, 75-yard scoring drive.

FRESNO, Calif. - In front of a crowd of 39,079, Fresno State recorded its first shutout in 364 days, defeating New Mexico State 48-0 on Saturday night at Valley Children's Stadium. The Bulldogs held the Aggies to 138 total yards.

The Bulldogs' defense grabbed three interceptions and forced the Aggies to 12 drives of four plays or less. Cam Lockridge had two of Fresno State's interceptions.

Offensively, Mikey Keene was 12-of-22 passing for 221 yards and two touchdowns, with both going to Mac Dalena. The Bulldogs totaled 281 yards on the ground with 131 coming from Malik Sherrod. Joshua Wood rushed for two scores while Sherrod and Elijah Gilliam each had one.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Fresno State opened the game scoring 14 points on its first four plays. On the second play from scrimmage, Mikey Keene connected with Mac Dalena for a 69-yard touchdown to open up the scoring with 12:04 on the clock.

Following a three-and-out, Elijah Gilliam rushed 10 yards up the middle but fumbled. Raylen Sharpe picked up the loose ball and ran 56 yards down to the 4-yard line. Gilliam finished the drive with a rush on the next play.

A minute into the second quarter, Fresno State started with the ball at its own 32-yard line. Six rushes later, Malik Sherrod was in the end zone from seven yards out. The running back set up his score with a 48-yard yard burst down the right sideline.

It didn't take long for the Bulldogs to regain possession as Cam Lockridge had two big plays on the Aggies' next drive. On the first play of the drive, Lockridge forced a fumble, but the ball was recovered by the Aggies. Two plays later, on third-and-7, Lockridge picked off a pass attempt to halt the momentum and give the Bulldogs back possession. The offense was unable to capitalize on that following possession.

With 6:35 remaining in the half, Fresno State got the ball back on its own 19. A 22-yard catch from Sharpe and a 32-yard run from Sherrod set the 'Dogs up at the 27-yard line. Four plays later, Keene lofted a 13-yard pass to Dalena in the back of the end zone to extend the lead to 28-0.

Fresno State tacked on a 36-yard field goal from Dylan Lynch with 59 seconds on the clock to take a 31-0 lead going into the half.

Receiving the opening kick of the second half, the Bulldogs scored on their first drive of the half. A 49-yard toss over the middle saw Jalen Moss come up with an acrobatic catch from his back at the NMSU 4-yard line. Three plays later, Joshua Wood rushed in from a yard out.

Two plays later, Lockridge intercepted his second pass of the night. That led to a 40-yard field goal from Lynch.

After forcing a three-and-out, an 8-play, 45-yard drive ended in a 2-yard touchdown run from Wood with 5:15 remaining in the third. That was the fifth straight possession the Bulldogs scored.

The fourth quarter saw just two possessions by New Mexico State and one by the Bulldogs. As the Aggies strung together their longest drive of the night at 14 plays, approaching the red zone, Justin Houston intercepted a pass by the Aggies in the end zone to keep the shutout hopes alive.

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. - For the fourth time in the last four seasons, Fresno State left University Stadium with a win, defeating New Mexico 38-21 on Saturday evening. The Bulldogs forced three turnovers, turning them into 15 points.

Mikey Keene passed for 226 yards and a touchdown on 26-of-33 attempts. Elijah Gilliam added a season-high 18 carries for 54 yards and a score.

Tuasivi Nomura racked up a career-high 16 tackles on the defensive side, the most by a Bulldog since Jeff Allison on Oct. 6, 2018. Al'zillion Hamilton and Julian Neal each grabbed an interception.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Fresno State didn't do much with its first opportunity, going three-and-out to start the game, but the Bulldogs' defense got the offense the ball back just three plays later off a fumble recovery by Jahzon Jacks at the UNM 34-yard line. Fresno State would cash that in for points as the 'Dogs used 10 plays to punch it in off the five-yard pass from Mikey Keene to Josiah Freeman. Fresno State opted for two, and converted off the pass from Jayden Mandal to Brock Lium.

New Mexico answered with a 14-play, 73-yard drive that resulted in a 20-yard field goal. The Bulldogs responded with a drive over 70 yards of their own. An 11-play 75-yard drive ended with a 1-yard touchdown rush on third-and-goal for Bryson Donelson, the first of the freshman's career.

Holding the Lobos to just four plays on their next drive, the 'Dogs turned the stop into points for the third consecutive possession. Moving the ball down to the UNM 18-yard line, Dylan Lynch converted from 36 yards out.

With a drive starting at 5:03 left in the second quarter, New Mexico worked its way downfield, but after back-to-back penalties Al'zillion Hamilton halted all progress with his first interception of the season at the Fresno State 38-yard line. Fresno State quickly turned Hamilton's pick into points just five plays later as the 'Dogs pulled out the trick play that saw Raylen Sharpe complete a 26-yard touchdown pass to Kamron Beachem to put Fresno State up 25-3 with 1:25 left in the first half.

With five plays of 10 yards or more, New Mexico quickly worked the ball down the field, cutting its deficit to 25-10 at halftime.

Fresno State's defense held the Lobos off the board in their first drive of the second half. The Bulldogs used 14 plays to move down field, and tacked on another field goal by Lynch from 42-yards out.

New Mexico pulled back to within two scores at 28-13 with a 20-yard field goal with just over 12 minutes to play.

After a punt by Clay Lawrence that put New Mexico at its own 3-yard line, Fresno State's defense picked up a big fourth-and-1 stop by Malachi Langley at the New Mexico 12-yard line, putting the Bulldog offense in good field position. The 'Dogs capitalized, scoring seven plays later on a one-yard punch-in by Elijah Gilliam.

The Lobos put together a successful scoring drive of their own, going nine plays and 75 yards for a one-yard run for the score and Fresno State responded with a 31-yarder from the leg of Lynch to make it 38-21 in favor of the Bulldogs.

LAS VEGAS – Allowing its most points since 2015, Fresno State lost its first Mountain West game of the season 59-14 at No. 23 UNLV on Saturday afternoon at Allegiant Stadium. It was the Bulldogs' first loss in the series since 2017.

HOW IT HAPPENED

On its second play of the game, Fresno State attempted a deep pass by Joshua Wood that was picked off by UNLV's Cameron Oliver at the 5-yard line. The Bulldogs' defense forced a three-and-out following the turnover, stalling the Rebels' offense on its first drive.

UNLV scored the first points of the game. After pinning the Bulldogs at their own 3-yard line on their third drive, the Rebels started their possession in Fresno State territory after the 'Dogs were forced to punt from their own end zone. UNLV went 29 yards in three plays, ending with a 6-yard touchdown run from Hajj-Malik Williams.

Forced to punt on its third straight possession, UNLV's Rashod Tanner blocked the ball off Clay Lawrence's foot and Ricky White III returned it into the end zone to give the Rebels a 14-0 lead with 27 seconds remaining in the first quarter.

Fresno State carried momentum into the second quarter, but was stopped at the UNLV 40-yard line, and forced to punt. The Bulldog defense came up with a fourth-down stop at the 1-yard line, and the offense took over but an interception by Mikey Keene at midfield dashed the hopes of a run. Seven plays later, UNLV scored from 12 yards out to extend its lead to 21-0 with 1:57 remaining in the half.

Keene hit Raylen Sharpe for a 28-yard completion but three plays later, the Rebels picked off Keene again at the UNLV 1-yard line. Fresno State trailed 21-0 at the half.

UNLV wasted no time in the second half, scoring on the opening drive with just five plays to extend its lead to 28-0. The Rebels tacked on a field goal from 45 yards out to extend the lead to 31.

The Bulldogs were finally able to get on the board with a 6-yard touchdown run by Malik Sherrod with two-and-a-half minutes remaining in the third. Fresno State used 10 plays to move downfield. The 'Dogs trailed 31-7 heading into the fourth.

First play of the fourth, and the Rebels added another score off a 15-yard pass from Williams to White III. Fresno State was unable to move the ball on its next drive, but the Rebels did so on their next possession using five plays to take a 45-7 lead with 11:04 left on the clock.

Keene connected with four different receivers to move the ball downfield with a drive that was capped by a touchdown pass to Mac Dalena. On the following kickoff, UNLV's Jai'Den Thomas returned the kickoff 90 yards for a touchdown.

The Bulldogs switched up quarterbacks and saw Jayden Mandal come in on the next drive. On his first pass attempt, he was picked off by Jeremiah Vessel and the Rebels took over on the Fresno State 25-yard line. UNLV again cashed in for points, scoring just six plays later for the final score of the game.

FRESNO, Calif. – The Fresno State football team fell 25-17 to Washington State at Valley Children's Stadium on Saturday evening, moving to 3-3 on the season.

The Bulldogs, who were ahead on three separate occasions on the night, had two interceptions and 12 penalties in the loss. Fresno State forced two turnovers itself, but were unable to capitalize on either opportunity.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Washington State scored on the opening possession of the game, using a 13-play, 75-yard drive, ending in a 1-yard rushing touchdown by John Mateer. The Cougars attempted for a 2-point conversion but failed off the interception by RL Miller. Fresno State answered right back with a 77-yard drive of its own. Mikey Keene went 7-of-8 passing, ending the drive with a 34-yard touchdown toss to Josiah Freeman and a 7-6 lead.

WSU responded with another 75-yard drive to take a 13-7 lead just before the end of the first quarter. Despite causing a pair of turnovers in the second, forced fumble by Corey Foreman recovered by Jakari Embry and an interception from Dean Clark in the endzone, the Bulldogs were unable to capitalize as the Cougars took a six-point lead into the half.

Receiving the ball to start the third, the Bulldogs were forced to punt. Mac Dalena pinned the Cougars at the 3-yard line, catching Clay Lawrence's punt. The Bulldog defense forced a three-and-out, then Jalen Moss returned the punt 19 yards to set Fresno State up at the WSU 33-yard line. Five plays later, four of those rushes from Elijah Gilliam resulted in a six-yard score for the senior.

As WSU drove into the red zone, on the ensuing possession, Jacob Holmes sacked Mateer for a 12-yard loss on second-and-goal, pushing the Cougars back to the 20-yard line. The Bulldogs held WSU to a 34-yard field goal.

The Bulldogs answered with a 27-yard field goal from Dylan Lynch with 10:13 remaining in the game.

Fresno State forced a three-and-out and proceeded to move the ball to the WSU 43-yard line. The drive stalled there as Keene threw an interception that Ethan O'Connor returned 60 yards into the end zone. A failed 2-point conversion resulted in a 22-17 lead for the visitors.

The Cougars tacked on a 23-yard field goal with 1:50 on the clock after forcing the Bulldogs' to a three-and-out inside their own five. Fresno State moved down to the Washington State 41-yard line, but saw time expire to dash hopes at a comeback.

RENO, Nev. - Fresno State defeated Nevada 24-21 at Mackay Stadium on Friday night, allowing zero points to the Wolf Pack in the second half. It was the Bulldogs' first win when trailing at the half since defeating the Pack's Silver State rival last October.

The Bulldogs saw another game with a heavy workload for Elijah Gilliam as the senior finished the night with 140 yards from scrimmage (74 receiving and 66 rushing) and two touchdowns. Quarterback Mikey Keene went 13-of-20 for 190 yards in the win.

Defensively, senior linebacker Malachi Langley had the game of his career with 13 tackles, 2.0 tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks.

Special teams played a significant role with the Bulldogs twice stopping Nevada's punt unit from getting punts off. Punter Clay Lawrence also pinned the Wolf Pack inside its own 10 three times.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Fresno State surrendered a touchdown to Nevada on the opening drive. Getting Nevada to a third-and-11, the Bulldogs gave up a 55-yard pass to set the Pack up at the Fresno State 9-yard line. Nevada punched it in three plays later to take a 7-0 lead.

Fresno State used 10 plays to move 49 yards, but settled for a 44-yard field goal by the leg of Dylan Lynch to get on the board.

Getting Nevada pushed back to a first-and-15 situation, Fresno State had back-to-back pass breakups by Al'zillion Hamilton and Julian Neal to force the Wolf Pack to punt for the first time on the night. The Bulldogs went 86 yards on 12 plays, capped by a 10-yard touchdown run by Elijah Gilliam. The Bulldog running backs accounted for 53 yards gained on the scoring drive.

After just crossing midfield, Nevada regained the lead with a 46-yard touchdown pass over the top.

Fresno State was forced to punt on its next possession but followed with a three-and-out. Nearly blocking Nevada's previous punt, Dean Clark forced Guy Gillispe to pull back his attempt. Kosi Agina tackled the punter at the 28-yard line. Three plays later, Gilliam was back in the end zone after a 4-yard run up the middle to give the 'Dogs a 17-14 lead with 5:46 on the clock.

The Wolf Pack used up all but 10 seconds of the remaining time with a 14-play, 83-yard drive. A 2-yard touchdown run gave Nevada a 21-17 lead at the half.

After both sides were forced to punt on their first possessions out of the half, the Pack pinned Fresno State at its own 5-yard line. On third-and-3, Mikey Keene dumped a screen off to Gilliam who found a gash through the middle of the field and ran for 71 yards down to the Nevada 17-yard line. Following a 10-yard pass from Keene to Raylen Sharpe on second down, Joshua Wood entered the game and got to the outside and into the end zone along the sideline.

Fresno State forced a three-and-out and got the ball back near midfield, but on the first play Keene was picked off. The Bulldogs' defense came up with another stop. Again, the special teams unit got to Gillispe. This time Agina forced the punter to pull back his attempt while RL Miller made the tackle at the 17-yard line.

Fresno State moved the ball to the 6-yard line but turned the ball over on downs after back-to-back incompletions. Nevada managed one first down after the stop, but a sack by Malachi Langley on first-and-10 from the 17-yard line put the Pack behind the sticks.

The Bulldogs were held to three-and-out on back-to-back possessions in the final minutes, but Clay Lawrence and Cam Lockridge twice pinned the Wolf Pack inside its own six.

FRESNO, Calif. - Fresno State reclaimed the Valley Trophy on Homecoming Saturday evening, defeating San Jose State 33-10 at Valley Children's Stadium. The Bulldogs held the Spartans to just three points during the final 59 minutes of the game.

Fresno State's secondary came away with four interceptions on the night, two from Cam Lockridge. Al'zillion Hamilton and Julian Neal added the other two.

Mikey Keene threw for 275 yards on 30-of-41 attempts to go with three touchdowns. Jalen Moss had two of those scores. The sophomore had eight receptions for 85 yards, his most since week one at then-No. 9 Michigan.

HOW IT HAPPENED

After Fresno State forced San Jose State into a third-and-10 on the opening drive of the game, the Spartans connected on back-to-back passes of 40 and 35 yards to take a 7-0 lead. The Bulldogs marched into the red zone on their first drive but that's where it stalled. Dylan Lynch put the 'Dogs on the board with a 33-yard field goal.

Following nine combined plays, Fresno State's offense got going to the tune of a 13-play drive. A 29-yard pass from Mikey Keene to Mac Dalena set the Bulldogs up on the doorstep as the game moved into the second quarter. Elijah Gilliam gave the 'Dogs their first lead with a 1-yard touchdown plunge.

Fresno State's defense followed up with its third straight three-and-out. It took the 'Dogs just three plays to extend the lead. After back-to-back 2-yard runs, Keene hit Jalen Moss across the middle. The sophomore cut across the field to the left side, outrunning the Spartan secondary to the end zone for a 43-yard touchdown.

San Jose State began moving the ball on its next possession, getting to the Bulldogs' 26-yard line. Julian Neal ended the threat with an interception in the end zone. Beginning at their own 9-yard line, the 'Dogs chewed up just over six minutes before Lynch extended Fresno State's advantage to 13 with a 48-yard field goal.

With less than a minute left in the half, the Spartans managed to move the ball down to the Fresno State 25-yard line. Their 42-yard field goal attempt came up short as time expired, keeping the game at 20-7.

Receiving the opening kickoff of the second half, Fresno State put together a 10-play, 75-drive. Keene found Dalena in the corner of the end zone from 35-yards out.

The Spartans moved the ball into the red zone on their next possession. Al'zillion Hamilton ended the threat though, intercepting Emmett Brown's pass on the sideline and returning it 69 yards down to the 26. The pick started a stretch of three consecutive defensive possessions with an interception for the Bulldogs. Cam Lockridge grabbed the second and third INTs of that stretch.

Lockridge returned the first of his interceptions 35 yards to the SJSU 20-yard line. Four plays later, Moss caught his second touchdown of the evening on a 6-yard pass from Keene with 14:35 remaining in the game.

With 5:08 left, Kyler Halvorsen tacked on a 37-yard field goal for San Jose State. After receiving the kickoff, Fresno State ran out the clock.

Fresno State was outgained 346-176.

HOW IT HAPPENED

After receiving the opening kickoff, Hawai'i used up nearly eight minutes during a 14-play, 75-yard drive. A 5-yard touchdown pass from Brayden Schager to Pofele Ashlock on third-and-goal put the Rainbow Warriors up 7-0.

Fresno State responded with a 12-play drive. With the drive appearing to stall, Mikey Keene found Raylen Sharp for a 21-yard completion on third-and-11 at the UH 43-yard line. Two plays later, a Hawai'i personal foul negated a fumble by the 'Dogs. Elijah Gilliam took the hand-off 10 yards up the middle into the end zone to tie the game.

With Hawai'i attempting a fourth-and-1 for the second time on the drive on their own side of the field, Malachi Langley stripped Schager of the ball to force a turnover on downs at its 28-yard line. It took Fresno State seven plays before Keene found Sharpe in the end zone for a 5-yard score. The Bulldogs' lead stood at 13-7 with 10:21 on the clock after the PAT was blocked.

Following the early scores, the game turned to the defenses as seven consecutive punts were forced.

As Hawai'i put together the longest drive since the first two drives of the game, the Bulldogs defense stood tall when it mattered. After a false start pushed UH into a third-and-11 from the 25-yard line, Schager's pass attempt was tipped up in the air by Tuasivi Nomura. Phoenix Jackson pulled it out of the air and took it 89 yards for a touchdown to give the Bulldogs a 20-3 lead with 3:58 remaining in the third quarter.

Early in the fourth quarter, Hawai'i got its offense going once again. But on fourth-and-9, Fresno State appeared to end the drive. A pass breakup by Cam Lockridge though was deemed to be targeting, extending the drive. Three plays later, Schager made it 20-14 with a 9-yard touchdown pass to Nick Cenacle with nine minutes remaining.

The Bulldogs were forced to punt from their own 43-yard line on the next drive. Hawai'i moved the ball into Fresno State's end but just after the two-minute timeout, Jackson punched the ball loose and Jadyen Davis recovered the fumble.

Following two rushes, a sack on third-and-5 left the 'Dogs punting for the seventh consecutive drive, this time from its own end zone.

UH started their final drive at the Fresno State 47-yard line. On fourth-and-10 at the 18, Nomura was whistled for pass interference in the end zone, moving the ball to the 3-yard line. Three plays later, Schager hit Cenacle for the go-ahead touchdown with 15 seconds left.

USAF ACADEMY, Colo. – Facing the most rushing attempts in a game in the FBS this season (80), Fresno State's offense rarely saw the field on Saturday night in a 36-28 defeat to Air Force at Falcon Stadium. Air Force possessed the ball for 45:08.

When the Bulldogs' offense was on the field, Mikey Keene passed for 289 yards and three touchdowns on 23-of-26 attempts. Mac Dalena caught two of those scores as he totaled 89 yards on four receptions.

Tuasivi Nomura made a career-high 18 tackles, the most by a Bulldog since Derron Smith had 18 against USC in 2014.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Jalen Moss gave Fresno State good field position to start the game after a 41-yard return on the opening kickoff. The Bulldogs picked up 31 yards on its first play from scrimmage after Richie Anderson picked up a 16-yard reception. An additional 15 was tacked on for a horse collar penalty. The Bulldogs went to the ground on five of the next seven plays (19 yards), finishing with Elijah Gilliam punching it in from a yard out.

Air Force proceeded to chew up nearly 11 minutes on a 19-play drive that resulted in a 1-yard touchdown run by Dylan Carson with just 11 seconds remaining in the first quarter.

Following a three-and-out by the Bulldogs, the Falcons put together a 14-play drive that took more than eight minutes off the clock. A 3-yard pass from Quentin Hayes to Cade Harris gave Air Force a 14-7 lead.

Facing a quick third-and-8 on its next possession, Mikey Keene found Mac Dalena along the sideline and the senior receiver did the rest, racing into the end zone for a 73-yard score with 3:47 on the clock.

Just over a minute later, the Falcons elected to go for it on fourth-and-1 from their own 34-yard line. Hayes looked to go up the middle but the Bulldogs' interior did not budge and Tuasivi Nomura stopped the Air Force quarterback for no gain.

Three plays later, the 'Dogs were back in the end zone. An 18-yard pass from Keene to Anderson set up a 19-yard touchdown pass to Moss along the sideline.

Working with just 1:42 on the clock, Air Force moved the ball down to Fresno State's 17-yard line. Matthew Dapore converted a 35-yard field as time expired to cut the Bulldogs lead to 21-17 at the half.

On the opening possession of the second half, Dapore made the score 21-20 following a nine-play, 56-yard drive by the Falcons.

On the Bulldogs' second play of the half, Keene's first incompleteness of the night went the other way after his pass was tipped into the hands of Blake Fletcher. Air Force turned the interception into points with Hayes rushing in from two yards out on fourth-and-goal to end an 11-play drive. The Bulldogs held on the two-point conversion attempt, leaving the game at 26-21.

A 32-yard reception for Moss began Fresno State's next possession. But four plays later, the 'Dogs were unable to convert on fourth-and-5 at the Air Force 38-yard line. The Falcons moved the ball 64 yards in 12 plays to extend their lead to 33-21.

Keene was sacked on fourth-and-11 on the Bulldogs' next possession at their own 25-yard line. It set Dapore up for a 36-yard field goal for the Falcons.

Fresno State moved the ball 75 yards in just over a minute to cut its deficit to 36-28. Dalena caught his second touchdown of the night on a 6-yard pass over the middle with 38 seconds remaining in the game.

The Bulldogs were unable to come up with the onside kick and Air Force ran out the clock.

FRESNO, Calif. – Behind 28-unanswered points in the first half, Fresno State defeated Colorado State 28-22 on Senior Night at Valley Children's Stadium. The Bulldogs handed the Rams their first Mountain West loss of the season.

With the win, Fresno State became bowl eligible for the fourth straight season.

Freshman Bryson Donelson rushed for 140 yards and a touchdown on 12 carries. Mikey Keene passed for 186 yards and two touchdowns on 21-of-29 attempts.

Korey Foreman, Kosi Agina, Dean Clark and Jakari Embry paced the team with six tackles each. Phoenix Jackson had four tackles to go with an interception and pass breakup which both ended Colorado State drives in the fourth quarter.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Colorado State used 12 plays to move 77 yards down the field, and eat up 6:26 off the clock to take a 7-0 lead on its opening possession. The Bulldogs, however, answered with a quick scoring drive of their own, going 80 yards on just four plays. The legs of freshman running back Bryson Donelson moved the 'Dogs 37 total yards in the drive, which included a 16-yard touchdown score to tie the game with seven minutes left in the first quarter. Raylen Sharpe set up the score with a 38-yard catch-and-run to put the 'Dogs in the red zone.

Fresno State forced Colorado State to punt on the following drive behind two big stops by Devo Bridges and Jakari Embry. The punt from Paddy Turner rolled out of bounds at the Fresno State 43-yard line. Fresno State was then forced to punt for the first time on the night on its ensuing drive, and the teams were tied 7-7 at the end of the first quarter.

Following the stop to begin the second quarter, Donelson broke a 43-yard run up the middle down to the CSU 15-yard line. Four plays later, Joshua Wood punched it in from four yards out to give the Bulldogs their first lead of the night.

After forcing a three-and-out, the Bulldogs' offense once again started moving the ball. In six plays, Fresno State got to the 1-yard line. Facing a fourth-and-goal, Mikey Keene saw the ball knocked loose and into the end zone. CSU recovered the fumble for a touchback.

The Bulldogs, however, forced another three-and-out. Following a 33-yard punt to their own 46, Fresno State was back in the end zone in just over two minutes. Working the ball down to the 28-yard line, Keene lofted a ball to Mac Dalena at the goal line on the third-and-9.

The Rams used just 1:17 on its next possession. Forced to punt for the third time in the second quarter, a 21-yard punt set Fresno State up at its 42-yard line. A quick 10-play drive resulted in a 15-yard touchdown pass from Keene to Jalen Moss with 17 seconds remaining in the half.

The Bulldogs led by 21 at the half following 28 unanswered points.

Out of the half, the Bulldogs came out flat with a three-and-out but the defense forced a turnover on downs after Colorado State opted to go for it on fourth-and-5 at the Fresno State 6-yard line.

The Rams cut their deficit to 14 late in the third quarter. Taking advantage of a short field, a 9-yard rushing touchdown with 3:25 on the clock capped off a six-play, 35-yard drive.

CSU regained the ball at the beginning of the fourth quarter following a Fresno State punt. The Rams used up more than seven minutes but the 16-play drive ended just across midfield. Phoenix Jackson knocked away a fourth-down pass attempt.

Colorado State got the ball back with 5:03 remaining after the Bulldogs were held to their fourth three-and-out of the second half. The Rams moved the ball to the Fresno State 34-yard line, but that's where Jackson ended another drive, grabbing his second interception of the season.

The Rams would score on its final possession of the game on a 5-yard touchdown pass with 17 seconds remaining. CSU made it a 28-22 game with a two-point conversion.

Dalena ended the game by recovering Colorado State's inside kick attempt.

PASADENA, Calif. – Outscored by 11 in the second half, Fresno State saw its four-game win streak against UCLA snapped on Saturday with a 20-13 defeat at the Rose Bowl.

Fresno State was held to 281 yards of offense, its third-fewest in 2024. Mikey Keene had the bulk of that with 219 yards through the air, going 30-of-43 with one touchdown.

The 20 points were just the third-fewest allowed to a Bulldog opponent this season.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Fresno State forced UCLA to punt on its opening possession, following four penalties for the Bruins in the drive. UCLA got into a third-and-13 situation, and Phoenix Jackson batted down the pass attempt to bring out the punt team. The Bruins picked up their fifth penalty of the game with a facemask on the Bulldogs' first play. Despite the penalty to open the drive, Fresno State wasn't able to move the ball and was forced to punt.

UCLA got on the board first with a 23-yard field goal in the first quarter.

Held to a three-and-out, Fresno State was forced to give the ball back to the Bruins. The Bulldogs held UCLA to just six yards on the drive. But the Bruins regained possession, forcing a fumble on the punt, setting themselves up at the Bulldogs' 12-yard line. Fresno State's defense stood tall and on third-and-10, Jackson sacked Ethan Garbers for a 10-yard loss. UCLA settled for a 40-yard field goal to take a 6-0 lead with 12:51 on the clock.

Appearing that its next possession would end at its own 44-yard line, Fresno State's drive was extended on a facemask penalty that followed a blocked punt. Seeing new life, the Bulldogs moved the ball down to the 28 before an end around saw Mac Dalena pick up 20 yards and get the 'Dogs inside the 10. On third-and-goal, Mikey Keene found Raylen Sharpe in the back of the end zone to give the Bulldogs their first lead at 7-6.

Fresno State extended its lead to 10-6 going into halftime. With 1:18 remaining on the clock, and sitting at its own 10-yard line, Bryson Donelson got the Bulldogs' drive going with a 24-yard run on first down. A third-down conversion on a 5-yard pass to Donelson was followed by an 11-yard reception from the freshman running back. Four plays later, an 8-yard pass over the middle to Sharpe on fourth-and-4 set up a field goal attempt with four seconds left. Dylan Lynch converted the 48-yard field goal, his longest of the season.

UCLA struck first in the second half. In less than two minutes, the Bruins used four plays to find the end zone, scoring on a 5-yard run from T.J. Harden to regain the lead at 13-10.

The game turned to the defenses with five straight drives resulting without points. Needing a stop with UCLA holding the ball late in the fourth, the Bulldogs had the Bruins on a third-and-6 just beyond midfield. Garbers' pass came up short of his intended target but a roughing the passer penalty was assessed to extend the drive. UCLA scored three minutes later to take a 10-point advantage.

Fresno State moved the ball 51 yards in just over a minute to set up a field goal. Lynch converted from 42 yards to make it a one score game with 31 seconds remaining.

On the ensuing inside kick attempt, Lynch's attempt fell out of bounds.

BOISE, Idaho – Leading 13-3 at halftime, Fresno State fell in double overtime to Northern Illinois, 28-20, on Monday afternoon in the Famous Idaho Potato Bowl at Albertsons Stadium. It was the Bulldogs' first defeat in a bowl game since 2014.

Bryson Donelson totaled 110 all-purpose yards (82 rushing, 28 receiving) and two scores. Joshua Wood finished with 180 yards passing on 16-of-23 attempts. Mac Dalena had six catches for 118 yards.

Tuasivi Nomura led the defense with a game-high 13 tackles.

HOW IT HAPPENED

After Jayden Mandal came up just short on a third-down scramble on the Bulldogs' opening possession, a snap infraction on fourth-and-short forced Fresno State to punt. On the next play, Jayden Davis picked off Huskie quarterback Josh Holst, returning the ball 26 yards to the NIU 25-yard line.

Following the sudden change, Mandal connected with Mac Dalena along the sideline for 21 yards. Two plays later, Bryson Donelson punched it into the end zone. The two-point conversion was unsuccessful, leaving the score at 6-0 with 11:29 on the clock.

NIU answered with a 29-yard field goal from Kanon Woodill following a 16-play drive that chewed up nearly nine minutes.

Fresno State struck quickly, going 90 yards in just four plays. A 54-yard strike over the top from Joshua Wood to Dalena set up a 13-yard touchdown run up the middle for Wood to put the 'Dogs up 13-3.

Aided by two fourth-down conversions, the Huskies put together a 20-play, 85-yard drive that used up almost 12 minutes. But with a first down inside the five, Fresno State's defense dug in after allowing three yards on first-and-goal. Devo Bridges forced Holst to throw the ball away on second down, and came up with a stop at the 1-yard line on third down. Malachi Langley stopped Telly Johnson Jr.'s final attempt to get into the end zone, leaving the Huskie running back a half-yard short.

Following a blocked punt by Kosi Agina with six seconds remaining in the half, Fresno State had an opportunity to add to its lead. Dylan Lynch's 42-yard attempt was wide right as the Bulldogs took a 13-3 lead into the locker room.

NIU started the second half with 10 unanswered points to tie the game at 13-13 less than eight minutes into the third quarter.

Early in the fourth quarter, the Bulldogs worked the ball down to the NIU 23-yard line. Facing a fourth-and-2, the 'Dogs elected to go for it but Wood's pass was just out of the reach for Richie Anderson. The Huskies followed with a near eight-minute drive to set up a 35-yard field goal. Woodill's attempt was pushed right, leaving the game tied.

Starting its drive with 3:02 remaining, Fresno State fed Donelson as the freshman piled up 45 yards on the drive to set up a 32-yard field goal. Lynch pulled his attempt left of the upright, forcing the game into overtime.

It took Fresno State just three plays to find the end zone in the first overtime period. On second-and-5, Wood found Donelson open on the left side for a 9-yard touchdown reception.

A defensive holding call on third-and-2 from the 6-yard line set up a first-and-goal from the 2 for the Huskies. Holst found Grayson Barnes to tie the game up at 20-20.

NIU scored on its next play and converted the two-point conversion to go up 28-20 in the second overtime.

A pair of incompletions and a one-yard run left the Bulldogs needing to convert a four-and-9. Wood was sacked to end the game.
