The 2016 ACC/Big Ten Challenge continues for the next two evenings with six games slated both Tuesday and Wednesday in the 18th annual event ... the leagues split the first two games on Monday night, including Florida State's 75-67 win over visiting Minnesota ... the ACC holds a 10-5-2 edge in the previous 17 Challenges and a 101-84 record in all games played ... Duke owns the best collective record of any team from either conference in Challenge competition at 15-2, including wins each of the previous four years ... No. 3 North Carolina, No. 5 Duke and No. 6 Virginia all move up in this week's AP national rankings ... five ACC teams remain in the Top 25 with Louisville at No. 14 and Syracuse at No. 22 ... Maui Invitational MVP Joel Berry II of North Carolina earns his second ACC Player of the Week honor of the young season, while Georgia Tech's Josh Okogie is the ACC Freshman of the Week ... Okogie's 38 points in Saturday night's win over Tulane are a school freshman record and the most scored by any ACC player so far this season ... it marks the fourth-most points ever by an ACC freshman and the most since Boston College's Olivier Hanlan scored 41 (the ACC freshman record) vs. Georgia Tech in the 2013 ACC Tournament.

By the Numbers

1 - With five teams in the top 10 - Duke (1), Virginia (2), North Carolina (3), Louisville (7), Syracuse (9) - and 13 in the top 65, the ACC is the top-ranked conference by kempom.com.

1 - Notre Dame's T.J. Gibbs (6.00:1) ranks second in the ACC in assists-to-turnover margin while teammate Matt Ferrell (4.47:1) is fifth ... as a team the Irish lead the nation in fewest turnovers per game (7.5).

1 - Syracuse sophomore Frank Howard leads the ACC and ranks 19th nationally in assists per game (6.4) ... Howard has three games with six-or-more-assists and has only eight turnovers in 111 minutes played.

1 - Georgia Tech junior Ben Lammers has blocked four-or-more shots in each of his five games and leads the nation in blocked shots per game (5.6).

4 - Pitt senior Michael Young has scored 20-or-more-points in each of his last four games, five times overall, leads the ACC in scoring (23.3) and ranks 10th in rebounding (8.2) ... Young is bidding to become the first Panther to lead a conference in scoring since Clyde Vaughan led the Big East with 22.0 ppg in 1982-83.

4 - NC State guard Dennis Smith, Jr., has scored 21-or-more points in each of his last four games, including a 30-point effort against Loyola (Chicago) Saturday and ranks second in the ACC in scoring (19.8) and third in assists (5.5).

4 - Over his last four games, Duke's Amile Jefferson has three double-doubles and is averaging 15.8 points, 11.5 rebounds and has hit on 25-of-38 (.659) from the field ... Jefferson is second among active ACC players with 717 career rebounds.
