GIST NAMED FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK ... AGAIN

Freshman Asante Gist was voted OVC Freshman of the Week on Dec. 5. The native of East Orange, New Jersey averaged 16.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists-per-game in the two EKU victories last week. It is Gists's second OVC Freshman of the Week honor this season.

HITTING THE BOARDS

After out-rebounding Marshall, 42-35, on Dec. 3, EKU has now out-rebounded its opponent in five consecutive games. The Colonels out-rebounded their opponent only seven times all of last season.

MAYO'S CAREER DAY LEADS EKU OVER MARSHALL

Sophomore Nick Mayo delivered a career game on December 3 as EKU rolled past Marshall, 89-80. Mayo poured in a career-high 30 points and matched a career-high with 10 boards. His performance led the Colonels to their first win over the Thundering Herd since 1977.

MARSHALL RETURNS TO MCBRAYER

On Dec. 3, Marshall will play at McBrayer Arena for the first time since December of 1994. It is the 61st meeting between EKU and Marshall. Eastern leads the all-time series, 22-18; however, Marshall has won four straight, including a 96-72 win over the Colonels last year in Huntington.

CHITTY GETS THE START VS. WKU

Freshman Parker Chitty made his first career start against WKU on Nov. 30 and played 16 minutes a the point guard position for the Colonels, scoring four points and grabbing a rebound.

ISAAC PERFECT FROM THE FIELD

Senior Isaac McGlone matched a career-high with 14 points against WKU on Nov. 30. He was a perfect 5-of-5 from the field and 4-of-4 from behind the arc.

HOW ASANTE GOT HIS GROOVE BACK

After a rough game against Berea, freshman guard Asante Gist ignited late in the game against WKU on Nov. 30. He finished with a game-high 19 points - 17 of which came in the second half - to lead Eastern to a 78-59 win over the Hilltoppers.

RIVALRY REINSTATED

EKU crushed in-state rival WKU, 79-58, on November 30 at McBrayer Arena. It was Eastern's first win over Western since Jan. 7, 1987, and it snapped a 13-game losing streak to the Hilltoppers.

RE-IN-STATE THE RIVALRY

Nov. 30 marks the 157th meeting between EKU and WKU. The Hilltoppers lead the series, 113-43, and have won 13 straight over the Colonels dating back to 1987. It is the first time the Battle of the Bluegrass has visited McBrayer Arena since Dec. 8, 2007.

JBH DOES IT ALL IN WIN

Senior Jaylen Babb-Harrison poured in 20 points against Idaho State on Nov. 22, while also dishing out a career-high seven assists and matching a career-high with seven rebounds.

MAYO DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Sophomore Nick Mayo recorded his first double-double of the season against Idaho State on Nov. 22, notching 21 points and 10 rebounds. He also dished out a career high four assists.

DISRUPTIVE 'D'

EKU forced Idaho State into 30 turnovers on Nov. 22. That is the most turnovers forced by the Colonels since they forced 32 against Warren Wilson College on Nov. 13, 2013 ... a span of over three years. The Colonels broke the Cancun Challenge record for steals in a game with 17.

COLONELS WIN IT OT

EKU defeated Idaho State, 92-81, in overtime on Nov. 22 in Cancun. It was head coach Dan McHale's first overtime win as a head coach, and the Colonels' first overtime win since a 71-69 decision over Towson on Nov. 17, 2012.

AVARE MAKES FIRST CAREER START

With senior Isaac McGlone banged up, junior guard Dillon Avare made his first career start on Nov. 19 at Texas Tech. The transfer from Louisville played a career-high 32 minutes and scored three points.

CHARLES SHINES IN THE LONE STAR STATE

Junior college transfer Zach Charles - a native of Mesquite, Texas - made a triumphant return to his home state on Nov. 19. Charles scored a season-best 13 points and grabbed seven rebounds against Texas Tech in Lubbock. He also knocked down his first career three-pointer.

GIST BOUNCES BACK AT TEXAS TECH

After scoring a season-low three points at Auburn on Nov. 17, freshman guard Asante Gist bounced back in big way two days later at Texas Tech, scoring a game high-21 points and dishing out three assists. He committed only one turnover.

AVARE PROVIDES SPARK AT AUBURN

GIST OVC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Freshman guard Asante Gist was voted OVC Freshman of the Week on Monday after scoring 21 points, grabbing seven rebounds and dishing out five assists in the Colonels' season opener vs. IUPUI on Nov. 11.

MEMORABLE COLONEL DEBUT

Freshman quard Asante Gist scored 21 points, grabbed seven boards and dished out five assists in his Colonel debut on Nov. 11 vs. IUPUI. Sixteen of

his 21 points came from the charity stripe. Gist's 16 free throws were the most by a Colonel since Jarelle Reischel sank 17 in a win at Savannah State on December 5, 2015.

EKU EARNS WIN FROM THE STRIPE

EKU ran out to a 24-point lead and then held on late to defeat IUPUI, 97-87, in its season opener on Nov. 11 at McBraver Arena. The Colonels shot 56 free throws in the game, and made 45 of them. Eight of the nine Colonels who played on Friday shot (and made) a career-high number of free thows. The 45 free throws on Friday were the most by an EKU team since the Colonels hit a school-record 46 free throws against Loyola during the 1954-55 season.

GIST LEADS THE WAY IN EXHIBITION

In its lone exhibtion on Nov. 6, EKU beat Georgetown College - the No. 2 NAIA team in the coun-

try - 83-71. Freshman guard Asante Gist led the Colonels with 22 points and five assists.

MAYO HONORED

Nick Mayo was voted OVC Freshman of the Year and first team All-OVC following the season. Mayo is the fourth different Colonel player to be named OVC Freshman of the Year and first since Adam Leonard shared the award in 2006-07. He is one of only two freshmen in the last five years to be named first team All-OVC, joining former Murray State guard and NBA first round draft pick Cameron Payne (2013-14).




Getting Personal With The Colonels





Dan McHale, a former University of Louisville assistant, was introduced as Eastern Kentucky's new head coach on April 9, 2015.

"We are ecstatic to welcome Coach Dan McHale and his family to the Colonel Family," Eastern Kentucky University President Michael Benson said. "Dan brings years of experience at some top-flight programs to EKU, along with ties to Kentucky and this region. He came to us with the highest recommendations from some of America's best coaches and we have every confidence he will take our basketball program to the next level."

Before being chosen as Eastern Kentucky's 20th head men's basketball coach, McHale completed his second season as an assistant coach at the University of Minnesota where he worked under head coach Richard Pitino. McHale got his coaching start under Hall of Fame coach Rick Pitino as a staff assistant at Louisville from 2001 to 2003.

"I'm extremely excited to be working at Eastern Kentucky University," McHale said. "I want to thank President Benson and Steve Lochmueller for this opportunity. With the leadership of these two, it's an honor to be a part of these exciting times at EKU. We are going to bring excitement to McBrayer Arena with a fast paced style of play. It's going to be fun for our players and our fans."

In his first season at Minnesota, McHale helped the Gophers to a NIT Championship and a 25-13 record that included wins over No. 9 Wisconsin and No. 11 Ohio State. The 25 victories are the second-most in program history. The 2014-15 squad won 18 games, including a victory at Michigan State, a team that would reach the Final Four.

"I am extremely excited and proud of Dan McHale," Richard Pitino said. "Eastern Kentucky is getting a tremendous coach and recruiter, but more importantly a great person. He will represent the Eastern Kentucky program in a first-class manner. There is no doubt in my mind that he will do great things there."

McHale served as a student manager for four seasons (1997-01) at Kentucky. He was part of one national championship team, four NCAA Tournament teams and three Southeastern Conference championships while working with Tubby Smith's Wildcats.

The Cardinals went 25-7, won the 2003 Conference USA Tournament title and reached the NCAA Tournament in McHale's second season as a staff assistant at Louisville. During his first stint he assisted with opponent scouting, game preparation and

on-campus recruiting. After one year as the director of operations at Manhattan College, McHale returned to UofL for two seasons as the director of video operations, overseeing advance scouting video and evaluation video of Cardinal players. In his second two-year stint at Louisville, the Cardinals won 45 games and played in two NCAA Tournaments.

"Dan is one of the hardest working coaches in our profession," Rick Pitino said. "I have great admiration for his dedication to our game. He is a great addition to our state."

In 2007, McHale joined Kevin Willard's first staff at lona College. As an assistant, McHale helped lead the Gaels from two wins the season before the duo arrived to 12 wins their first season and 21 wins in year three at lona. He recruited NBA draft pick and 2012 MAAC Player of the Year Scott Machado to lona.

McHale followed Willard to Seton Hall when he was named head coach in 2010. In their second season, the Pirates won 20 games. While at Seton Hall, McHale was responsible for the Pirates' defensive game planning and spearheaded opponent scouting and game preparation.

Dan has earned the opportunity to lead a basketball program, and with his outstanding knowledge, personality and work ethic, he will make a positive impact at Eastern Kentucky."

McHale will look to add to the success of the Rick Pitino coaching tree that includes Billy Donovan (Florida), Tubby Smith (Texas Tech), Mick Cronin (Cincinnati), Richard Pitino (Minnesota) and former EKU head coach Travis Ford (Oklahoma State).

McHale has caught the eye of one of America's top young college basketball coaches – Memphis head coach Josh Pastner.

"Dan is going to do an outstanding job at Eastern Kentucky University," said Pastner. "He is a tireless worker and will do the job with great principle and great work ethic. Eastern Kentucky got a winner in Dan McHale."

The Chatham, New Jersey native earned a bachelor's degree in business administration and graduated with honors from UK in 2001. McHale and his wife Jackie have two daughters, Lilly and Molly, and a son, Daniel.




