Salukis take on third Power Five foe

SIU plays its third Power Five opponent of the season on Wednesday at Louisville. The Salukis previously lost to Arkansas (Nov. 14) by 25 points and Minnesota (Nov. 25) by 12 points. The last time the Salukis beat a Power Five program was in 2008, when they defeated Oklahoma State in the first round of the NIT. Since that game, they have lost nine straight.

Series vs. Louisville

The Salukis are 2-3 lifetime against the Cardinals. The win in Carbondale on Jan. 11, 1967 was especially memorable. SIU was a College Division program at the time, and Louisville was ranked No. 2 in the nation among University Division teams. Dick Garrett had 18 points to lead SIU, while Walt Frazier added 16. The Salukis went 24-2 that season, won the NIT title, and finished ranked No. 1 in the nation among College Division teams.

Louisville was actually a member of the Missouri Valley Conference from 1963 to 1974. Southern Illinois, which moved up to University Division status in 1967-68, joined the league for the 1975-76 season.

Salukis versus ranked opponents

The Salukis are playing a nationally ranked non-conference opponent for the first time since Christmas Day in 2011. On that date, SIU lost to No. 14/15 Xavier, 87-77. The last time SIU beat a nationally ranked non-conference team was on Dec. 11, 2007 when it beat Saint Mary's at home, 71-56. The last road win against a non-conference ranked foe was on Feb. 17, 2007 when it beat Butler, 68-64.

Salukis vs. the ACC

The Salukis are 10-17 all-time against current members of the ACC. The most recent meeting was an overtime loss to Clemson on Dec. 23, 2012. The last win against an ACC team came

against Virginia Tech — a 63-48 victory in the NCAA Tournament on Mar. 18, 2007.

Mike Rodriguez accounts for 36 percent of Saluki offense

PG Mike Rodriguez (5-10, 165, Sr.) has had a hand in 36 percent of SIU's field goals this year, as the team's leader in scoring (14.5) and assists (4.7). He has a 2.61 assist-TO ratio. His ratio last year (1.88) was the ninth-best single-season mark in school history. Rodriguez scored a career-high 29 points in the opener against Wright State, nearly doubling his previous best of 15 versus Air Force on Nov. 13, 2015.

Thik Bol 31st in the nation in blocked shots

F Thik Bol (6-8, 205, Jr.) ranks 31st in the nation in blocked shots per game (2.38). He had a career-high six blocks versus Mount St. Mary's. He is also second on the team in rebounding (7.6).

Rodriguez to Bol connection

The biggest beneficiary of Mike Rodriguez passing prowess has been C Thik Bol. Of Rodriguez' 47 assists this season, 38 percent (18) have led to baskets by Bol. Bol has shown he can finish with authority — 20 of his 37 field goals (54 percent) have been dunks.

Sean O'Brien voted Preseason Second-Team All-MVC

F Sean O'Brien (6-7, 215, Sr.) is SIU's top returning scorer, rebounder and shot blocker from last season. He was also second on the team in assists. The savvy veteran first cracked the lineup early in his freshman campaign, and has started 97 of the last 98 games, including a current streak of 75-consecutive starts.

Dawg Bites

- Rodriguez is 19th in the nation in free throw attempts (49-of-65).
- All five starters are averaging double figures in scoring for SIU.
- SIU is 2-1 in games decided by five points or less this season.
- In the Salukis' five wins, they are a combined +114 in points scored in the paint. In the three losses, they are a combined -4.

Armon Fletcher with the hot hand

Armon Fletcher (6-4, 190, So.) is the team's top 3-point shooter so far, converting 17-of-39 (.436). He has made multiple 3-pointers in six of the eight games.

Senior leadership

The Salukis' senior class (Sean O'Brien, Leo Vincent, Mike Rodriguez, Tyler Smithpeters) has the most returning career points and rebounds of any school in the Missouri Valley Conference. In fact, 25 percent of the returning scoring in the MVC comes from SIU's four seniors.

Leo Vincent smooth transition to starting job

G Leo Vincent (6-1, 192, Sr.) played in all 32 games last year, never started, but was the team's fourth-leading scorer (8.1 points) and was named to the MVC's All-Bench team. This season, he has started all eight games and is the team's third-leading scorer (11.6 points) and is second in 3-point shooting (.343).

Quick hitters

- They haven't taken many, but SIU's two big men off the bench have been deadly from 3-point range this season, making 7-of-11 combined. F Austin Weiher (6-8, 210, So.) is 4-of-8, while C Rudy Stradnieks (6-9, 240, So.) is 3-of-3.
- SIU gave up the most points in a half in the Hinson era in both of its first two games — 54 in the second half versus Wright State and 56 in the first half at Arkansas. In the last four games, however, the most points SIU has allowed in a half is 43.
- Twice this season, the Salukis have surrendered 15-point first-half leads. They led by 15 versus Wright State, before eventually losing. They led by 15 versus Texas Southern, lost the lead, but came back to win, 74-70.

School-record 17 home games at SIU Arena

The Salukis will host a school-record eight non-conference home games for a total of 17 home games this season — the most in school history. The Salukis have a 526-184 (.742) record all-time at SIU Arena, which opened in 1964, including a 12-4 mark last season. The arena underwent a \$29.9 million renovation prior to the 2010-11 season.

Saluki lineup features trio of junior college starters

Three Saluki starters (Mike Rodriguez, Leo Vincent and Thik Bol) came to SIU via the junior college route. The last time Southern started three juco players in a game was on Feb. 22, 2012 when Mamadou Seck, Jeff Early and T.J. Lindsay started at Drake.

Foreign-born Salukis

SIU's roster has three foreign-born players — Rudy Stradnieks (Latvia), Thik Bol (Sudan) and Leo Vincent (Liberia). Since becoming head coach at Southern, Hinson has signed six foreign-born players. The other three were Bola Olaniyan (Nigeria), Ibby Djimde (Mali) and Deng Leek (Sudan).

Tyler Smithpeters out 2-4 weeks

G Tyler Smithpeters (6-4, 198, Sr.) hurt his knee in the season opener against Wright State and is out 2-4 weeks. He ranks sixth all-time in career 3-point shooting percentage at SIU (.395). He is 20th overall in 3-pointers made (98). In his career, 69 percent of his shot attempts have come from 3-point range.

Saluki turnaround

The Salukis won 22 games a year ago, the most wins since 2007. It was the program's first winning season since 2008. Three times last season, the Salukis rallied from double-digit deficits to win. They trailed Air Force (-15) before rallying to win, 77-75. They trailed at Sam Houston State (-18) before winning, 86-81, in OT. They trailed Illinois State (-12) before winning 81-78.

Hinson 14-14 in non-conference road games

The Salukis were 4-0 in non-conference road games last year, winning at Sam Houston State, North Texas, Murray State and Saint Louis. Hinson is 1-2 this season and 14-14 overall in non-conference road games at SIU.

Quick Facts

Carbondale is located in the southern tip of the state — about a five-hour drive south of Chicago and two hours southeast of St. Louis...Many of SIU's alums are concentrated in those two cities... Since moving to Division I in 1968, SIU has been to the NCAA Tournament 10 times, including Sweet 16 appearances in 1977, 2002 and 2007. The Salukis have made nine NIT appearances.

1967 NIT Champions

The Salukis won the NIT in 1967 behind future NBA stars Frazier and Dick Garrett. In addition to beating Marquette for the title, some of the prestigious victories of that season included an upset of No. 2 Louisville, as well as Duke at Madison Square Garden. At that time, the NIT was almost on par with the NCAA Tournament. The NCAA field that season featured 23 teams, while the NIT invited 14 teams.

2002-08 — Seven-Straight Postseason Bids

Southern Illinois advanced to six-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2002-07, including two Sweet 16s (2002, 2007). They added

an NIT appearance in 2008. The 2002 Sweet 16 was a major breakthrough. The team finished the season ranked No. 22 in the nation and won a school-best 28 games. Its biggest wins were against No. 22 Indiana, Texas Tech and No. 23 Georgia. The Salukis were no underdog during their 2007 Sweet 16 run. Seeded No. 4 in the West Region, SIU beat Holy Cross and Virginia Tech before falling to top-seeded Kansas in a 61-58 heartbreaker. The team won 29 games, defeated five NCAA Tournament qualifiers and finished with its highest national ranking in school history (No. 11).

Five at-large NCAA bids

Southern Illinois received four at-large NCAA bids in a row from 2002-05 and one more in 2007.

Sell-Out No. 25

In the Jan. 9 game against Wichita State, SIU recorded its first sell out since Mar. 1, 2014, vs. Illinois State — a span of 24 games. There have been 25 sold-out games in the 51-year history of the facility. A dozen of those

Walt Frazier — The Rest of the Story

Most people know that Southern's most famous basketball alum is Walt Frazier (1964-67). What they don't know is the story of how the Atlanta native ended up in Carbondale.

Basketball was Frazier's second-best sport in high school. He was offered a scholarship to play quarterback at Georgia Tech, but he didn't want to play football. Frazier went on a recruiting visit to SIU in 1963 and met with AD Donald Boydston, who was progressive about recruiting minorities during a time when southern schools rarely recruited them. According to Boydston, Frazier didn't say one word the whole trip, but called shortly after he took the train back to Atlanta to say he was enrolling at SIU.

Frazier was dismissed from the team for academic issues after his sophomore year. He went back to Atlanta and got a job doing manual labor. Frazier called in August of 1965 and asked if he could come back. He was not eligible for a scholarship, so he paid his own way and sat out his junior year, making the Dean's List. He played on the practice team, and sometimes they would beat the varsity. The 1966-67 storybook season saw Frazier lead the team to the NIT National Championship, beating Marquette in the finals. He turned pro after the season.
