About Louisville:

- The Cardinals bring a 4-1 record into the weekend after opening the 2016 season at the Islanders Invitational hosted by Texas A&M Corpus Christi.
- Junior Maryssa Becker carries a .417 batting average with four runs and three RBIs. She also holds a 1-1 record with a 0.48 ERA and 17 strikeouts in 14.2 innings of work.
- Sophomore Nicole Pufahl belted out two home runs and had six RBIs in the Cards' opening weekend.
- Freshman Megan Hensley is the current ACC Co-Pitcher of the Week. She carries a 3-0 record and a 0.82 ERA while batting .389 with two doubles, a home run and six runs scored.
- Louisville outscored opponents 28-5 in its opening weekend.

- This weekend marks Louisville's first trip to Raleigh, N.C. The Cardinals did not face NC State in 2015 regular season - Louisville's inaugural ACC season - but they did meet in the conference tournament.
- Head coach Sandy Pearsall is in her 17th season at the helm. Since starting the program in 2000, she has led the Cardinals to six conference championships and 12 NCAA appearances. Pearsall has a 623-316 overall record at UofL and an 873-650 tally in her 30th season as a head coach.

Louisville will host the Red & Black Classic in its home-opening weekend when Cleveland State, Kent State and North Dakota State visit Ulmer Stadium Feb. 26-28.

Wisconsin

Series Record: Wisconsin leads 2-1

Last Meeting: March 17, 2014 – Wisconsin defeated Louisville 4-1 at Ulmer Stadium. Then-freshman Maryssa Becker came in relief and hurled 6.2 hitless innings, retiring all 20 batters she faced and striking out six. Brittany Sims drove in the lone run for the Cardinals.

Scouting the Badgers: Wisconsin is coming off a strong opening weekend in which they went 4-1 at the Kajikawa Classic. The Badgers are led offensively by freshman Melanie Cross who has a .375 batting average along with two home runs and four RBIs. Senior Ashley Van Zeeland hit .353 over the weekend with a team-high five runs and four stolen bases. Junior Chloe Miller contributes a .308 average along with a team-high six RBIs. Sophomore Kelsey Jenkins, a 2015 first-team All-Big Ten selection, adds four runs and a home run along with her .308 average.

• In the circle, junior left-hander Kirsten Stevens leads the team with a 2.16 ERA and a 2-1 record, striking out 15 while only allowing one walk in 16 2/3 innings. Senior right-hander Taylor-Paige Stewart has also seen action in the circle, compiling a 2-0 record along with a save. Stewart has a 3.77 ERA and has struck out 13 batters in 14.1 innings.

Series Record: Louisville leads 2-1

Last Meeting: Feb. 23, 2008 – Louisville defeated Nebraska 5-3 as part of the Cardinal Classic at Ulmer Stadium.

Scouting the Huskers: Nebraska kicked off the season with a 5-0 clip at the UNI-Dome Classic last weekend. Junior Marjani Knighten had a strong weekend as she batted .632 with five home runs and 14 RBIs to earn Big Ten Player of the Week honors. Senior outfielder Kiki Stokes, who was a 2015 third-team All-American and was one of the 50 players named to the 2016 USA Softball College Player of the Year watch list, added a .615 average with two home runs and scored eight runs while stealing five bases over the weekend. Junior Cassie McClure hit .429 with three RBIs while going 2-0 on the weekend with two saves in the circle. The Big Ten Pitcher of the Week did not allow a run in 12 innings and added 16 strikeouts while allowing only one walk. Senior Emily Lockman who is a three-time All-Big Ten selection and a two-time, first-team all-region honoree, went 1-0 with a 3.36 ERA on the weekend while junior Kaylan Jablonski added a 2-0 clip and a 3.60 ERA on the weekend.

Hensley Named ACC Co-Pitcher of the Week - Feb. 15

Megan Hensley was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Co-Pitcher of the Week in the leagues' first weekly honors of the season released on February 15.

- Hensley (Ashland, Ky.) posted a 3-0 record on the week – earning a win in each of her appearances. The freshman registered a 0.82 ERA and held opponents to a .136 batting average with six strikeouts in 17.0 innings of work.
- Hensley helped her own cause at the plate with a .389 batting average (7 for 18) on the weekend. She led the Cards with six runs and belted out two doubles while driving in a pair of runs.

Last time out

The Cardinals went 4-1 at Texas A&M Corpus Christi's Islanders Invitational in their season-opening weekend.

Louisville 7 - Sam Houston State 0

- Louisville opened season with a 7-0 win over Sam Houston State, as freshman Megan Hensley went 4-for-4 with two runs as the Cards belted out 11 hits. Hensley also got the win in the circle and combined with junior Maryssa Becker for the shutout.

Iowa 1 - Louisville 0

- Iowa's unearned run in the third inning stood as the only run in the game as the Cards suffered their first loss of the season. The Hawkeyes outhit Louisville 4-3 and Becker had nine strikeouts in the game.

Louisville 7 - Iowa 2

- Becker went 3 for 4 with three RBIs and freshman Lillie Goetz also drove in three runs as the Cards avenged the previous day's loss to Iowa with a 7-2 win over the Hawkeyes. Hensley got the complete game win, scattering five hits and striking out three.

Louisville 8 - Texas A&M Corpus Christi 1

- Sophomore Nicole Pufahl went 3-for-4 with a career-high five RBIs while Hensley and Goetz had two hits apiece as the Cards defeated host Texas A&M Corpus Christi 8-1. Becker allowed five hits and gave up one run in a complete game effort.

Louisville 6 - Sam Houston State 1

- Senior Hailey Smith went 2-for-4 with three RBIs to help lead the Cardinals to a 6-1 win over the Bearkats. Hensley got her third win of the weekend after tossing 5.0 innings of relief and allowing one hit while retiring 15 of the 18 batters she faced.

Stingy pitching

The Cards were impressive in the circle in their first weekend of play. Louisville's pitching staff: Maryssa Becker, Megan Hensley and Madi Norman, posted a combined 0.60 ERA and held opponents to a .163 batting average while striking out 23 in 35.0 innings.

- Becker holds a 0.48 ERA and 17 strikeouts while Hensley boasts a 3-0 record in a team-high 17.0 innings of work.

Homegrown Talent

The Cardinals' roster features 11 (of 22) players from the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Jessica Adell, Morgan Hart, Morgan Meyer, Michala Riggle and Jordan Vorbrink all hail from Louisville. Lillie Goetz (Owensboro), Megan Hensley (Ashland), Sarah Lopesilvero (Simpsonville), Jordan McNary (Madisonville), Ashley Nikolao (Flaherty), Brittany Sims (Lexington) round out the other players from the commonwealth.

Fountain of Youth

With seven underclassmen in its most recent starting lineup and only three seniors on the team, it is safe to say that the 2016 Cardinals are a young team. Three of the four pitchers are underclassmen with junior Maryssa Becker serving as the veteran on the staff.

Louisville Picked to Finish Third in ACC Preseason Coaches Poll

The Louisville softball team was picked to finish third in the Atlantic Coast Conference in a as voted by the league's 11 head coaches.

- Two-time defending conference champion Florida State was picked to win the league with nine first place votes after finishing the 2015 season with a 48-12 overall record and a 20-3 mark in ACC play. Notre Dame received 92 points and two first-place votes to stand at second in the preseason poll. The Irish are coming off of a 42-15 campaign and went 17-6 in the conference last season and finished third in the ACC.
- Louisville and North Carolina State tied for third with 74 points each. The Cardinals finished the 2015 season with a 30-19 overall record and went 16-7 to finish fourth in the ACC. The Cardinals went on to make their 12th consecutive NCAA regional appearance.

Becker Earns College Sports Madness Preseason ACC honors

Junior Maryssa Becker was named to the College Sports Madness 2016 Preseason All-ACC Team. Head Coach Sandy Pearsall 17th Season Oregon State, '84

Sandy Pearsall is in her 17th season as the head coach of the University of Louisville softball program. After building the program from scratch in 2000, Pearsall has guided the Cardinals to six conference championships, 12 consecutive NCAA regional appearances and served as a host site in 2009, 2011, 2012 and 2013.

In 2015, Louisville earned its 12th straight NCAA tournament bid after posting a 30-19 overall record. Pearsall also led the Cardinals to a 16-7 mark in their inaugural season in the Atlantic Coast Conference. Maryssa Becker notched her second straight All-Central Region honors and joined seniors Whitney Arion and Kelsi Jones on the All-ACC first team.

The University of Louisville softball team was one of four UofL teams to be recognized among the nation's Academic Progress Rate (APR) leaders in the latest multi-year report released in 2015. The report honors programs ranked among the top 10 percent in their respective sports in the latest APR which measures academic eligibility, retention and graduation for student-athletes.

The Cardinals posted a program-best combined 3.382 GPA during the 2014-15 academic year, including a record 3.425 GPA for the 2015 spring semester with 20 players named to the Athletic Director's Honor Roll by achieving a 3.0 or higher GPA. Additionally, 15 softball players were named Red & Black Scholars after producing a GPA of 3.25 or higher.

Pearsall's Cardinals accomplishments include capturing the 2014 American Athletic Conference tournament title and securing the program's 11th straight NCAA tournament bid. Also in 2014, Maryssa Becker was named to the 2014 NFCA All-Central Region second team as a pitcher/utility player, becoming the first Louisville freshman to earn all-region honors since Keola Calderon was named to the South Region second team in 2000, the program's inaugural season. Becker was named one of the top 25 finalists for the inaugural NFCA National Freshman of the Year trophy.

In the 2013 season, Pearsall led the Cardinals to a 47-13 overall record, marking the eighth time Louisville recorded 40 or more wins. The Cards reached several milestones in 2013 including setting new single season records for runs (390) and home runs (63). Louisville also tied program highs in the national coaches polls, appearing at No. 7 in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll and No. 8 in the USA Today/NFCA poll - they went on to spend four weeks among the nation's top 10. Louisville also posted its first win over a top-ranked team when it defeated No. 1 Oklahoma 5-1 in Norman and remained one of only four teams to beat the eventual national champion.

On April 28, 2013, the Cardinals defeated Georgetown 10-1 to mark head coach Sandy Pearsall's 800th career victory.

Taking the Cards to New Heights

Pearsall helped guide the 2012 Cards to a program-best 55-5 record while capturing the BIG EAST regular season and tournament titles. UofL spent the majority of the season ranked in the top 10 of the ESPN.com/USA Softball and USA Today/National Fastpitch Coaches Association coaches' polls, appearing as high as Nos. 7 and 9 respectively. The season culminated with the Cards earning a No. 15 overall seed in the NCAA tournament and serving as host for the NCAA Regionals.

With the team's success came individual accolades. Taner Fowler and Tori Collins earned NFCA All-America honors, while five Cardinals were selected to the All-Great Lake Region teams and a program-best nine players earned All-BIG EAST honors. Pearsall and

her coaching staff were voted the 2012 BIG EAST Coaching Staff of the Year and the NFCA Great Lakes Region Coaching Staff of the Year. On May 5, 2012, the Cards posted an 8-4 win over St. John's to mark the University of Louisville's 500th win under head coach Sandy Pearsall since its inaugural season in 2000.

Building Blocks of Success...

The 2012 season's success came on the heels of an injury-plagued 2011 campaign in which the Cards posted a 38-20 record. In that year, Louisville finished runner-up in the BIG EAST Conference tournament and hosted an NCAA regional for the second time in three years. The Cardinals accomplished those feats with four freshmen and seven underclassmen in the starting lineup after an injury-plagued season.

In 2010, the Cards posted a 41-19 overall record and advanced to the finals of their seventh NCAA regional but fell to eventual WCWS participant Tennessee in Knoxville. Louisville was runner-up in the 2010 BIG EAST Conference championship behind performances from 2010 BIG EAST Player of the Year Chelsea Bemis and two-time All-America selection Melissa Roth.

The 2009 season brought a record-setting 48-11 overall record and was a mainstay in the top 25 rankings, reaching as high as No. 14 in the NFCA and USA Softball polls. The Cards also notched their sixth straight NCAA regional appearance and were selected to host a regional for the first time in school history.

The Cardinals added two more players to All-America status when catcher Melissa Roth was named to the NFCA second team and pitcher Kristen Wadwell earned third team honors. Roth was also named BIG EAST Player of the Year and was selected to the USA Softball Pan American Qualifier team.

Success at Louisville has continued to build under Pearsall's watch. In 2007, the Cardinals won the BIG EAST Conference tournament and earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament as Louisville made its fourth straight NCAA appearance.

In 2006, the Cards had a breakout season, earning an NCAA at-large bid and advanced to the regional finals for the first time in school history. UofL also made its first appearance in the national rankings and finished the season at No. 17 in the NFCA poll. UofL also posted a program-best 45-11 overall record and won the BIG EAST regular season with a 19-3 record while winning BIG EAST Coaching Staff of the Year.

Pearsall posted her 500th career win on May 6, 2006 when the Cardinals defeated Rutgers 3-0.

In 2005, the Cardinals set a new school record with 43 overall wins. They closed their stay in Conference USA with a 20-4 league tally and the regular season title. Louisville earned its second consecutive at-large bid to the NCAA tournament. The 2005 success improved upon the Cards' 2004 breakout season in which they had set a record with 41 overall wins and earned an at-large bid to the NCAA tournament in only their fifth year as a program.

In the beginning...

Pearsall was tabbed to start the softball program at the University of Louisville and brought with her both head coaching experience and program building expertise. She helped christen UofL's Ulmer Stadium with a winning season and earned 2000 Conference USA Coach of the Year honors along the way. Louisville followed with a 40-26 campaign in 2001.

Before her time at UofL...

Pearsall came to UofL after a six-year stint as head coach at Miami University (Ohio). At Miami, she collected her 250th career win and mentored nine All-MAC selections and 16 Academic All-MAC honorees in addition to seven academic all-district selections. In 2012, she was inducted into the Miami University Cradle of Coaches Association, joining Randy Ayers, Thad Matta, Joe Novak and Sue Ramsey to comprise the Cradle of Coaches Class of 2012-13.

Before her stint in Oxford, Ohio, Pearsall spent three seasons as head coach at Colorado State, where

she posted a 78-68 mark. While at CSU, she was successful in developing the Rams into an annual contender for the Western Athletic Conference championship. Her 1990 squad captured the league title and earned Pearsall Conference Coach of the Year honors.

This was not the first time Pearsall had been asked to build a program from the ground up. In 1988, she headed the newly-formed Florida A&M team and led the squad to 36 wins in two seasons. Prior to FAMU, she took the University of San Francisco softball team from the cellar of the conference to second place in just three years. Her efforts did not go unnoticed as she earned NorPac Conference Coach of the Year honors.

Pearsall remains active in her sport at a national level as well. She has served on the All-America Selection Committee, the NCAA West Regional Ranking Committee, the Mid-America Softball Executive Committee as well as her membership in the National Softball Coaches Association and the ASA Northern California Umpire Association. She has coached at NCAA YES Clinics and various camps helping to develop the sport of fastpitch. In 2003, she worked for CSTV, serving as the color analyst for the C-USA Championship game.

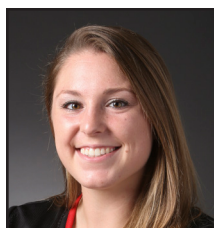

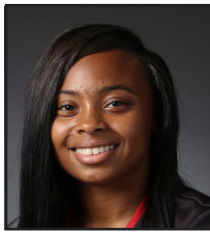
