AROUND THE ACC

- **BOSTON COLLEGE:** With the win at UNC Saturday, BC snapped a 12-game losing streak versus the Tar Heels, which dated back eight years to the day.
- **CLEMSON:** After hitting on just four field goals over the past three games, junior forward Aamir Simms went 6-for-16 Saturday at Wake Forest, leading the Tigers in scoring with 14 points. He also added a team-best eight rebounds.
- **DUKE:** Duke has held the opponent's leading scorer to below his season scoring average 14 times, including in 12 of the last 14 games. In ACC play, Duke has faced nine of the conference's 15 leading scorers (12 games), and held all but one (SU's Elijah Hughes) to below his season average.
- **FLORIDA STATE:** FSU's defense clamped down and held North Carolina without a field goal for nearly 11 minutes in the second half as the Seminoles earned their 19th consecutive home wins. The Noles are the ACC's only remaining undefeated team at home this season.
- **GEORGIA TECH:** The Yellow Jackets' last five ACC games have been decided by a total of 27 points. Tech went 1-4 in those games. In GT's last six games with Virginia Tech, four were decided in the final minute.
- **LOUISVILLE:** Senior guard Ryan McMahon was on fire Saturday at NC State, scoring a season-high 23 points and missing his career high by one point. He knocked down a career-high seven 3-pointers and attempted a career-high 10. He finished the game 8-of-12 from the field.
- **MIAMI:** Junior center Rodney Miller Jr. scored 16 points Sunday at Pitt and is averaging 12.1 ppg and 7.5 rpg over the last six games, shooting 29-of-43 (67.4%) from the field and 15-of-17 (88.2%) at the free-throw line.
- **NORTH CAROLINA:** Christian Keeling had his best night as a Tar Heel on Monday at FSU, scoring a season-best 14 points in 18 minutes. A grad transfer guard from Charleston Southern, he went 5-for-10 from the field.
- **NC STATE:** After slumping offensively in recent games, senior guard C.J. Bryce broke out with a team-high 15 points Saturday against Louisville.
- **NOTRE DAME:** Senior guard Rex Pflueger needs one more rebound to reach 400 in his career. That would make him the 28th active NCAA player and eighth major conference player to score 700 points with 400 rebounds, 300 assists and 130 steals in a career.
- **PITT:** Sophomore G/F Au'Diese Toney recorded his first career double-double Sunday (15p/10r). He has scored in double figures three times in the last four games and is averaging a team-high 16.3 ppg in that span.
- **SYRACUSE:** Freshman guard Joseph Girard III scored 17 points Saturday against Duke, the most points by a Syracuse freshman since Tyus Battle put up 18 in the 2016-17 season.
- **VIRGINIA:** With its Tuesday win over No. 5 FSU, UVA posted its first top-five since a 65-63 win at No. 4 Duke on Jan. 27, 2018. The top-5 win was also UVA's first as an unranked team since a 73-68 win over No. 3 Duke on Feb. 28, 2013.
- **VIRGINIA TECH:** Redshirt freshman guard Tyrece Radford scored a team-high 18 points Saturday against FSU, leading the team in scoring for the second straight game. He averaged 21.0 ppg in his two games last week.
- **WAKE FOREST:** With five assists Saturday against Clemson, senior guard Brandon Childress moved into 10th place in Wake basketball history in career assists, passing Chris Paul with 399.

ACC QUICK HITS

- Three ACC teams are ranked nationally in the Associated Press poll this week: Louisville (5), Duke (7) and Florida State (8). Duke has been ranked for 76 consecutive weeks in the AP poll, the second-longest active streak.
- The ACC has the most teams in the AP Top 10 of any conference this week.
- Florida State sophomore guard Devin Vassell matched an ACC record for most made 3-pointers without a miss in one game Saturday, going 7-for-7 at Virginia Tech. It was just the second time that a player went 7-for-7 from 3-point range in conference play (NC State's Allerik Freeman at UNC, Jan. 27, 2018).
- 47 of the 81 conference games have been determined by single digits (58.0%), including 29 by five points or fewer (35.8%).
- Road teams are now 38-43 (46.9%) this season in ACC play. The best win percentage for road teams for a full ACC season is 47.3% (26-29), set in 1955 during the second season of ACC Men's Basketball.
- There have been eight overtime games in league play this year, with seven won by the road team (Virginia Tech on Jan. 22 vs. UNC is the lone exception).
- Virginia leads the nation in scoring defense (50.7 ppg). UVA also tops the nation in opponent field goal percentage (35.8%), while Louisville is fifth (37.0).
- Duke is second nationally in scoring offense (83.4) and scoring margin (+18.2 ppg).
- Notre Dame's John Mooney is second nationally in rebounding and double-doubles (17). He is the only player averaging a double-double in the ACC (16.5 ppg, 13.2 rpg).
- Three ACC men's basketball players are on the Wooden Award Late Season Top 20 List, announced Monday: Vernon Carey Jr. (Duke), Tre Jones (Duke) and Jordan Nwora (Louisville).
- Duke freshman center Vernon Carey Jr. was named the ACC Player and Freshman of the Week on Monday after averaging 26.0 ppg and 15.0 rpg in games against Pitt and Syracuse last week.

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- Carey shot 64.5% from the field in two wins last week. He scored 26 points in both victories. He grabbed 13 rebounds against Pitt and a career-best 17 boards at Syracuse, tying the most for an opposing player in Carrier Dome history.

- Four ACC teams rank among the top 10 teams nationally in committing the fewest fouls per game: Notre Dame (1st, 12.3), Virginia (4th, 13.4), Virginia Tech (8th, 13.8) and Miami (9th, 14.0).

- While the 3-point line moved to 22'1-3/4" this season, there has been virtually no change in ACC shooting. ACC teams have combined to shoot 33.32 percent from behind the arc this season after hitting 33.84 percent of their 3-point attempts from 20'9" last year.

- Duke sophomore guard Tre Jones is one of 10 remaining candidates for the 2020 Bob Cousy Award (nation's top point guard).

- Miami senior guard DJ Vasiljevic is one of 30 candidates for the 2019-20 Men's Basketball Senior CLASS Award, presented annually to student-athletes with notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

- ACC teams earned four wins against top-10 ranked non-league opponents: Duke vs. No. 3 Kansas (68-66, Nov. 5) at Madison Square Garden, Florida State at No. 6 Florida (63-51, Nov. 10), Virginia Tech vs. No. 3 Michigan State (71-66, Nov. 25) and Louisville vs. No. 4 Michigan (58-43, Dec. 3).

- ACC teams claimed six MTE titles this season: Duke (Empire Classic), Florida State (Emerald Coast Classic), Louisville (Global Sports Shootout), Pitt (Fort Myers Tip-Off), Notre Dame (MABC Invitational) and Virginia (Air Force Reserve Tip-Off).

- Ten of the current ACC men's basketball head coaches have 300 or more career wins.

- Georgia Tech's Jose Alvarado had nine steals Jan. 25 against NC State, the most by an ACC player since FSU's Chris Singleton had 10 against UNC Greensboro on Nov. 14, 2010.

- With 11 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists on Dec. 22 against The Citadel, NC State's Markell Johnson registered the 33rd triple-double in ACC history from 27 players and the first since Duke's R.J. Barrett on Feb. 16, 2019. He is third player in school history to record a triple-double (four total triple-doubles in school history).

- Louisville junior forward Jordan Nwora was picked as a 2019-20 Associated Press Preseason All-American. He also was named the ACC's Preseason Player of the Year.

- Jordan Nwora and John Mooney (Notre Dame) are the lone returning members of the 2019 All-ACC Team. Both were third-team honorees.

- The ACC unveiled a 20-game conference schedule this season, including conference games to open the regular season. As part of this schedule, each team plays six opponents twice each as well as eight teams once apiece (four home only/four road only).

- ACC programs this season welcomed eight recruits in the top 50 in the 2019 ESPN Top 100, highlighted by No. 2-ranked Cole Anthony of North Carolina. The rest of the ACC's top 50 recruits: Vernon Carey (6, Duke), Matthew Hurt (11, Duke), Armando Bacot (18, North Carolina), Wendell Moore (22, Duke), Samuel William-son (24, Louisville), Patrick Williams (28, Florida State), Cassius Stanley (32, Duke).

- ACC Network (ACCN), the new, 24/7 national platform, is slated to air 110 men's basketball games this season, including 68 conference games. Nothing But Net, ACCN's signature basketball show, airs on Sunday evenings throughout the basketball season.

NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

All-Time Success

- Entering the regular season, current league members had won 24,324 games and have had 782 NBA Draft picks, including 264 first-round selections.
- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

NCAA Tournament Success

- With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
- The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.
- Over the last five seasons, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

Elite Coaches

- Entering the 2019-20 season, the ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 6,769 career victories and 10 national championships.
- Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1).
- The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.
- Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

Top of the Polls

- For the first time ever, three teams from the same conference finished atop the AP poll – Duke (1), Virginia (2) and North Carolina (3). The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 59 consecutive seasons.

All-Americans

- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 48 consensus All-Americans - 18 more than any other conference - and has accounted for 24 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (48 of 199).

ACC and the NBA

- There were 85 players from ACC schools on 2019 NBA Opening Night rosters, by far the most of any conference (Pac-12 was second with 67).
- In the 2019 NBA Draft, the ACC led all conferences with a record-tying 10 first-round picks and with 13 selections overall. The ACC also had a record six lottery picks last season.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had at least four first-round picks in each of the past 11 NBA Drafts.
