NOW IT'S TIME FOR THE BREAKDOWN

Coastal Carolina football returns off the first of two byes this season to face Old Dominion on the road at Ballard Stadium on Saturday, Oct. 4, 2025. The Chants and Monarchs will kick things off at 6 p.m. ET in Norfolk, Virginia. Coverage will air on ESPN+, the Chanticleer Radio Network and Chanticleer Mobile App.

THE SERIES

Saturday will be the fifth meeting all-time series between the schools. The teams have split the all-time head-to-head series 2-2, with Coastal Carolina winning a pair of one-possession games in 2023 and 2024. Old Dominion is looking for a win to match its best start since 2012, when it opened 5-0 and finished 11-2.

THE COACHES

TIM BECK – the fourth football head coach in Coastal Carolina's 23-year history – joined the Chanticleers in Dec. 2022 and is in his third season leading the program. An experienced leader with 36 years of coaching experience, Beck brought with him 18 years of Power 5 coaching experience to CCU, including spending the 12 years as an offensive coordinator at Nebraska, Ohio State, Texas and NC State. He has led Coastal to a pair of bowl game appearances, including a win in the 2023 Hawai'i Bowl. As a collegiate coach, he has totaled 18 postseason bowl games.

ODU Head Coach **RICKY RAHNE** (*pronounced ronnie*) is in his sixth season overall and fifth on the field with a 23-31 mark. He had to hire just one new full-time coach during that span, cornerbacks coach Kresean Reed. The Monarchs led the Sun Belt Conference in rushing offense, field goal percentage and red zone offense in 2024, while leading the country in red zone offense. He made previous coaching stops at Penn State, Vanderbilt, Kansas State, Holy Cross and his alma mater, Cornell.

STREAKS, STORYLINES, SIDEBARS

- Coastal Carolina is playing its 23rd season of football with an all-time record of 174-97 (.644).
- CCU is a debutante in the college football world – playing its first football in 2003 and transitioning to the FBS in 2016. The Chants joined the Sun Belt Conference in 2017 and have since played in five-straight bowl games from 2020-24, spanning the globe from Hawai'i to Myrtle Beach.
- The Chanticleers are 16-14 in two seasons under Head Coach Tim Beck with a pair of bowl appearances.
- Since 2003, its first year of football, Coastal Carolina is 20-4 in home openers. With the win at South Alabama, CCU is 6-3 all time in Sun Belt Conference lid lifters.
- The Chants have a different look entering the season with new coordinators on both sides of the ball and seven new coaches overall. Drew Hollingshead will call the offensive plays while Jeremiah Johnson handles the defensive side of things. Hollingshead is a Mike Leach disciple who coached at Western Kentucky last season while Johnson has found success at every spot, most recently at Louisiana Tech.
- Coastal welcomed 61 new players in this offseason – 31 on defense and 30 on offense.
- Coastal will be looking for the offense to continue rolling as it posted 38 against in its league opener at South Alabama after scoring only 20 points over the first three games.
- Shane Bruce has a pair of takeaways on defense and leads the squad with 29 tackles. Myles Mooyoung is on his heels with 23 stops and a forced fumble. The Chants have forced seven takeaways thus far in 2025.
- Tad Hudson has emerged as QB1, throwing for two TDs and rushing for another at South Alabama.

BROOKS STADIUM

- Brooks Stadium opened on Sept. 6, 2003, for the inaugural home game of the Chanticleer football program. Scoring a touchdown with just seconds left on the clock, the Chanticleers defeated Newberry College 21-14.
- With a gift from the late businessman Bob Brooks, the stadium was named in honor of Brooks' children Coby Garrett and Boni Belle.
- Brooks, who grew up on a farm in Loris, S.C., was the CEO and founder of Eastern Foods, Inc., creators of the Naturally Fresh line of products, and chairman of Hooters of America, Inc.
- Brooks Stadium was designed and built with the capability to expand from its inception. That original design came to fruition as Coastal embarked on another two-phase expansion in the spring of 2017 that brought the capacity to approximately 20,000.
- The first phase boosted the seating capacity to 15,000 and included adding seats to both corners of the end zone nearest the field house, expanding the sections closest to the field on both sides toward the scoreboard, and expanded the upper deck on the east side.
- The infamous Surf Turf was added in the Spring of 2015 marking the transition from natural grass to artificial teal turf.
- Prior to the 2019 season, a second level and premium suites were completed on the west side to increase the capacity to 20,000. The cost of the two-phase project was \$31.8 million.

Media seating is limited. Priority is given to daily newspapers, television stations, and radio stations that program sports for more than half of their daily broadcast schedules. A credential does not guarantee a seat and access to the team bench area is prohibited at all times. Press credentials will **NOT** be issued to spouses, friends, or children.

All practices are closed to the public and members of the media. Only the first 15-20 minutes of selected workouts may be open for members of accredited media outlets. Contact the athletics communications staff for details and access.

Coastal Carolina conducts a weekly press conference on Tuesday's in the Norman Field House team room. Head coach Tim Beck addresses the media promptly at noon with players following him. Player requests should be made to the athletics communications office no later than 11 a.m. on Sunday. This is the preferred time for all interviews to occur.

MEDIA WILL CALL

Media members can claim credentials 90 minutes before each game at the Media/Staff Entrance Gate next to Gate 1 (next to the entrance of the Marrio & Josh Norman Field House). A photo ID is required.

PRESS BOX

The main area for working press and photographers is now located inside the football team room on the third floor of Norman Field House. Game operations, TV and radio are still housed on the fourth floor of the east side of the stadium. In accordance with the working code of the Football Writers Association of America (FWAA), the press box is a working area and cheering will be grounds for removal.

To access Norman Field House, exit Gate 1 in the northeast corner of the stadium, follow the path to the weight room entrance to the building. Take the elevator on your right to the third floor, exit left and the team room will be on your left at the end of the hallway. Signage will be placed to assist in your travels.

SIDELINES

Photographers and videographers are NOT permitted to use tripods, but monopods may be used. Photographers must shoot solely for the affiliation for which they are credentialed. All media on the sidelines MUST have their credential in full display, stay within the designated dotted lines, and are restricted from the team bench areas.

POSTGAME

At home games, post game interviews with Coastal Carolina players and Head Coach Tim Beck are conducted in the third floor football team room of Norman Field House located in the northeast corner of the stadium. Both locker rooms are closed to the media before, during and following the game.

SIMPLY RED — ZONE

- The league's two best red-zone defenses meet this weekend. The Monarchs own the nation's No. 8 red zone defense (.643), with the Chanticleers not far behind at No. 16 in the country (.722).
- The Chanticleers defense will look to slow down a Monarch offense that leads the Sun Belt and ranks No. 22 in the country in total offense at 468.3 yards per game. The Old Dominion defense will face a Coastal Carolina offense at the other end of the Sun Belt spectrum, averaging 292.8 yards per game.

A TURNAROUND IN MOBILE

- Coastal Carolina opened Sun Belt play with a 38-20 road win at South Alabama powered by complimentary football in all three phases.
- The Chanticleers forced three turnovers, including a fourth-quarter strip sack by defensive end Noah Arinze that was recovered and returned 13 yards for a touchdown by linebacker Tray Brown to seal the win. Arinze notched two of Coastal's four sacks on the night.
- RB Ja'Vin Simpkins led the ground game with a team-high 84 rushing yards, including a 24-yard TD. Jevon Edwards chipped in with 51 yards on five carries, helping Coastal rack up 190 yards on the ground.
- QB Tad Hudson protected the ball and accounted for three total TDs. He threw for two scores and added a seven-yard rushing score in the third quarter, finishing with 130 of Coastal's 294 total yards of offense.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- QB Tad Hudson connected with seven different wideouts at South Alabama, with Bryson Graves leading the team with five receptions for 35 yards.
- Of note, he had a 19-yard throw to Malick Meiga and a 17-yard score to Robby Washington in the second quarter.

ARINZE BEST IN THE BELT

- DE Noah Arinze earned Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Week honors following the win at South Alabama.
- The St. Louis, Missouri, native recorded four total tackles, including a career-high two sacks. On his second sack of the night, the 6-foot-6, 253-pound defender forced a fumble that was scooped up by linebacker Tray Brown and returned 13 yards for a touchdown. It marked Coastal's first defensive touchdown since Tobias Fletcher's 39-yard interception return against Georgia State on Nov. 30 of last season.
- Through four games, Arinze leads the Chanticleers in tackles for loss (3.5) and is tied for seventh in the Sun Belt in that category. He

also co-leads the team in sacks (2.0), along with fellow defensive end Zeke Campbell.

GROUND GAME KEY

- Coastal is 2-0 when rushing for 180+ yards and 0-2 when under 100 yards.
- Three Chants with 10 or more carriers — Ja'Vin Simpkins (5.7), Dominic Knicely (6.2) and Jevon Edwards (6.6) — average over 5.5 yards per carry.
- Simpkins and QB Tad Hudson have two rushing TDs apiece.

DEFENSIVE IDENTITY

- Despite being outgained overall, the Chants have produced 6 takeaways in 4 games.

SOMETIMES, A CHANGE OF SCENERY ...

- CB Ja'Marion Wayne came to Conway in the offseason after playing three seasons at Missouri, where he registered eight tackles, two PBUs and one fumble recovery.
- In four 2025 starts, Wayne has posted 22 tackles, a team-best five PBUs and a blocked kick.

CHANTS FANS DELIVERING

- The 21,634 fans vs. ECU is the third-largest home crowd in history. Combined with the stadium-record 22,217, Coastal has hosted two Top-3 attendances in back-to-back games.

TAKING ON SOME WATER

- The Chants were their own worst enemy at times against ECU, committing five turnovers — three fumbles lost and two interceptions — going 0-for-1 in the red zone.

ADDRESSING THE ZEROES

- Prior to the ECU loss, Coastal hadn't been blanked since a 42-0 defeat at Stony Brook on Oct. 29, 2011, and had not been shut out at home since Nov. 22, 2008, vs. Charleston Southern (24-0).

DEFENSIVE POSITIVES

- Shane Bruce, Xamarion Gordon and Tray Brown each made seven tackles to pace the Coastal defense vs. ECU. Bruce had his second interception of the season and fourth for his career.

REVERSAL OF FORTUNE

- In 2024, CCU scored nearly a third of its points (27%/100 of 373) in the first quarter while this year, the Chants have yet to score in the first 15.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- The iconic Surf Turf — newly installed for 2025 — at Brooks Stadium has become a difficult places for opponents to win.

TURN UP THE RADIO

- The Chanticleer Sports Network, in association with Van Wagner, is growing thanks to a new partnership with iHeart Media.
- WRXZ, Rock 107.1 in Myrtle Beach, will serve as the flagship station. Additionally, CSN broadcasts will air on WWRK, 970 AM out of Florence and WRZE FM, Rock 94.1 and 97.9 out of Kingstree.
- All live broadcasts will simulcast to the Chanticleer Mobile App and online via iHeartMedia.
- The partnership features live game coverage of football, men's and women's basketball and baseball with more than 100 broadcasts planned for the 2025-26 campaign.

FREE CONCESSIONS!

- The CCU Kickoff Meal Deal — Every Football Game, Every Fan, Always Free.
- Coastal Carolina Athletics and Aramark partnered to allow fans to eat free at Chanticleers Football games inside Brooks Stadium.
- Ticket-purchasing patrons visiting the concession stands will be able to acquire four items per concession stand visit from a selection of hot dogs, nachos, popcorn and fountain drinks.
- There is no limit to the number of in-game visits, but fans must scan each trip through the line with the Chanticleer Mobile App.
- Specialty items, food from outside vendors and alcoholic beverages are available for purchase.

- SBC Football 365 — the Sun Belt's around-the-clock source for all things football will promote the conference's 14 football programs year-round through video and written content.

WHAT IS A CHANTICLEER?

- A Chanticleer (SHON-tuh-cleer) gives Coastal Carolina one of the most unique nicknames in all of sports. Chanticleer comes from Chaucer's Canterbury Tales and came to the University when it was a member of the USC system. A Chanticleer is a rooster who rules the barnyard with cunning and wit. His competitiveness never wanes as he battles to the end, using his brains to come out on top every time.

- Since 2020, Coastal boasts a remarkable 26-9 (.742) record in home games.
- From 2020-24, the Chants have won as many home games as App State, BYU and Texas.
- Coastal has hosted six of the Top 11 crowds in school history over the last two seasons.

POSTING A SHUTOUT

- Coastal Carolina leaned on its defense and a grinding rushing attack to blank Charleston Southern 13-0 before a Brooks Stadium-record crowd of 22,217 on Sept. 6.
- Coastal posted its first shutout since a 51-0 blanking of Georgia State on October 31, 2020.
- It was the first home shutout since 2015 and sixth overall shutout in program history.

DRONE-ING ON

- The halftime show vs. CSU doubled as a showcase event for Coastal. A drone show lit up the sky with teal-and-black imagery ranging from the Chanticleer logo to nods to Conway and Myrtle Beach landmarks, drawing raucous cheers from the sellout crowd.

FREE IS FOR REAL!

- Fans also experienced the debut of the school's new free concessions initiative, with select items available at no charge throughout the stadium. Lines were steady but moved quickly as the initiative was rolled out for the first time.

GROUND & POUND AGAINST THE BUCS

- The Chant put up 245 rushing yards vs. CSU.
- Dominic Knicely set the tone with 92 yards on nine carries, including a 52-yard burst in the third quarter that flipped field position.
- Ja'Vin Simpkins added 58 yards on the ground, while Jalen John chipped in 51.
- QB Tad Hudson provided the game's only touchdown, capping a 16-play, 83-yard drive with a 4-yard keeper early in the fourth quarter.

CSU BY THE NUMBERS

- Coastal finished with 384 total yards to Charleston Southern's 153.
- The Chants owned a 35:35 to 24:25 edge in time of possession.
- CSU went 0-for-11 on third downs and did not make it to the red zone.
- Coastal posted its first shutout since a 51-0 blanking of Georgia State on October 31, 2020.

SPECIALISTS STAND OUT VS CSU

- Kicker Kian Afrookhteh hit field goals from 21 and 29 yards, giving the Chants all the points they would need vs. CSU.
- Punter Emile Sebafundi averaged 51.0 yards on two kicks, including a 61-yarder.

ROCKING THE SHIP

- The 22,217 fans in attendance against CSU broke the 2024 mark set against Virginia (22,104).
- Coastal improved to 6-2 all-time against Charleston Southern at Brooks Stadium.

OH CAPTAIN MY CAPTAIN

- Head Coach Tim Beck named four permanent captains — LB Shane Bruce, OL Nick Del Grande, OL Zac Elam and S Dre Pinckney.

ELAM RETURNS!

- Center Zac Elam returned to action in the opener at Virginia after missing the entire 2024 season due to injury. He started eight games and played in 12 during the 2023 campaign.

BREAKING DOWN THE LINEUP

- Despite welcoming 61 new players during the offseason, only six transfers broke into the starting lineup at Virginia, 2 on offense and 4 on defense.
- WR Malcolm Gillie (Ball State) and QB MJ Morris (Maryland) were among the starting 11 on offense while Zeke Campbell (Louisiana Tech), Ja'Marion Wayne (Missouri), Luke Murphy (Eastern Michigan) and Noah Arinze (New Mexico State) joined the defense.
- Overall, 29 newcomers saw playing time in Charlottesville as the Chants played 63 student-athletes in the opener.

BERRONG OUT FOR THE SEASON

- TE Cane Berrong will miss the season after being injured in training camp. He caught 12 balls for 145 yards and a TD last year.

BACK FOR THE FUTURE

- QB Emmett Brown, a transfer from San Jose State, suffered a lower body injury in training camp and will miss the 2025 season.

A LOOK BACK AND AHEAD

- The Chanticleers were picked fourth in the Sun Belt East Division, while earning 1-of-14 first-place votes in last month's 2025 Sun Belt Conference Football Preseason Coaches Poll.
- Third-year head coach Tim Beck will guide a roster that returns a pair of All-Sun Belt honorees from 2024 and had three players named to the 2025 Preseason All-Sun Belt teams.
- Coastal Carolina went 6-7 in 2024, its first losing season since 2019. The Chanticleers were part of the Sun Belt's eight-team Bowl Season contingent that paced the non-autonomy conferences for the third-straight year, making their fifth-straight bowl appearance.

THUNDER FROM DOWN UNDER

- P Emile Sebaundi averaged 41.2 yards per punt on 54 boots last season, dropping 20 inside the 20 with five sailing 50 yards or more.
- He was part of a group of players who hosted NASCAR driver Shane Van Gisbergen on campus this summer as part of a dual promotion with Coastal Football and Darlington Speedway.

THERE'S A NEW GM IN TOWN

- Scott Aligo joined the program in the off season and serves as its first-ever general manager.
- Aligo, who brings both college and NFL experi-

ence, joins Teal Nation after a four-year stint as director of scouting for Kansas.

- He will oversee roster management, personnel and scouting for the Chanticleers, helping lead the way into a new era of college football.

YOU LOOK FAMILIAR

- A pair of Coastal Carolina legends joined the staff this season as analysts, former OL Trey Carter and QB Grayson McCall.
- Carter, a five-time All-Sun Belt honoree, closed out his career going 22-3 from 2020-21 with two bowl games and a No. 12 final College Football Playoff ranking in 2020.
- McCall threw for 10,523 yards and 91 TDs as a collegian. He is the only player to earn Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year honors three times and still holds CCU school records with 106 total touchdowns responsible, 88 touchdown passes and 10,005 passing yards.

AN INDOOR OPTION

- Coastal Carolina football moved into its new Indoor Practice Facility this summer.
- The \$20 million indoor practice facility covers 93,000-square feet, accommodate all aspects of practice and includes a regulation-size football field featuring artificial teal turf.
- The facility also will include two filming platforms, restrooms, storage rooms, and an athletic training space that will be accessible from the interior and exterior practice areas.

START ME UP

- Coastal Carolina scored nearly a third of its 2024 points (27%/100 of 373) in the first quarter.
- Coastal's defense also held up, surrendering only 61 points in the opening 15 minutes, its lowest mark of any quarter.

- Nineteen team members possess at least one degree entering the 2025 season.
- Two, Shane Bruce and Luke Murphy, hold both undergraduate and master's degrees.

- BAM has nothing to do with gender. It has everything to do with being a great leader. A great leader has respect for others and cares about other people in his or her charge. Everybody on our team is somebody's son or brother, and there is a responsibility associated with that.
- Our mission at Coastal Carolina is that we're going to put a team on the field that anyone associated with Coastal is going to be proud of. While winning is an important part of that, it also means that you never, ever, ever take a play off. You always give 100 percent of everything you have. This is not just football. We expect that in every endeavor our players undertake.

LIFE AFTER FOOTBALL

- Coastal is the **ONLY** program in the country to take 30 minutes a week out of practice to talk to our players about current events and topics that help them prepare for life after football.

AHEAD OF THEIR TIME

- Led by then-head coach Joe Moglia, the 2016 Coastal Carolina football team all voted in the 2016 United States Presidential Election.
- The Chants, who took practice time to participate and observe in mock debates and openly discuss the impact that the election has on our country, were the first NCAA football program to have the entire team vote on that first Tuesday in November.

YOU GIVETH, WE TAKETH

- CCU tallied five defensive scores a year ago, tied for third in the NCAA FBS and one behind national leaders Notre Dame and Tulane (6).
- The Chants picked up three fumble return scores and snagged a pair of pick sixes.
- Overall, Coastal was 27th in the country in turnovers gained and second in the Sun Belt, with 11 fumbles and 11 interceptions.

NUMBER CRUNCHING ...

- Football hosted five of the top-10 crowds in Brooks Stadium history in 2024, including the 1st, 4th, and 5th largest of all-time.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- The iconic “Surf Turf” at Brooks Stadium has become one of the most difficult places in the nation for opponents to win.
- Since 2020, Coastal boasts a remarkable 25-8 (.758) record in home games.
- From 2020-24, the Chants have won as many home games as App State, BYU and Texas.
- The turf at Brooks Stadium was replaced and will give Coastal a fast surface to play on.

“Soul Collector is a culture,” Johnson said. “It’s a brand. We are trying to teach young men to impose their will on any situation in their life.”

It was on display the last time out as the Chants forced three turnovers, including a fourth-quarter strip sack which was returned for a score by LB Tray Brown. Brown ran to a specific sideline spot on the bench, donned a skull

mask, was draped in a black cape and handed a sword, which had three skulls impaled on it, one for each turnover forced.

“The sword, the mask and the cape gives us juice and is a sign of us making plays as a family. The kids have bought into it, gravitated to it and it’s turned into a lot of fun for us.”

Johnson’s defense is based off a fast-attack philosophy.

“Attack in our family means execute with violence together,” Johnson said. “The key to the defense is our guys play really, really fast. When you get hats to the ball, good things will happen. It allows us to create splash plays, create takeaways and gives us momentum. We play defense. It’s supposed to be dark. It’s supposed to be violent. That’s what we do.”

HEAD COACH TIM BECK

THIRD SEASON — UCF '88



Tim Beck – the fourth football head coach in Coastal Carolina's 20-year history – joined the Chanticleers in Dec. 2022 and is in his third season leading the program.

An experienced leader with 36 years of coaching experience, Beck brought with him 18 years of Power 5 coaching experience to CCU, including spending the 12 years as an offensive coordinator at Nebraska, Ohio State, Texas and NC State.

He has led Coastal to a pair of bowl game appearances, including a win in the 2023 Hawai'i Bowl. As a collegiate coach, he has helped guide teams to 18 postseason bowl games, including this season. Beck has also coached in a postseason bowl game in every year since 2007, including helping Ohio State compete in the College Football Playoff in 2016.

Coastal finished 6-7 in 2024, playing in the Myrtle Beach Bowl. The team battled late in the season to pick up a pair of wins to earn bowl eligibility. The Chants' offense averaged near five yards per carry a year ago (4.6) while covering 2,242 yards on the ground, 2,616 yards through the air with 41 scores. Six players earned all-league honors including first teamers Clev Lubin and Matthew McDoom.

In his first season in Conway, Beck led the Chanticleers to an 8-5 record and the second bowl victory in program history. Coastal reeled off five consecutive wins, including the program's first win ever at Appalachian State, while starting three different quarterbacks. The Chanticleers won five consecutive Sun Belt Conference games for the first time since 2020 and notched eight wins for the fourth consecutive season.

Wide receiver Sam Pinckney became the Sun Belt's all-time leader in receiving yards while also setting an NCAA record with 58 consecutive games.

The offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at NC State from 2020-22, Beck helped lead the Wolfpack to three-consecutive eight-plus win seasons, three-straight bowl appearances, and a combined record of 25-11.

Recognized as the nation's eighth-best recruiter by 247Sports.com in 2020, Beck has been a three-time nominee for the Broyles Award, an award given to the nation's top assistant coach in all of FBS.

Beck's NC State offense ranked in the top half of the highly-touted Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) in scoring offense, total offense, and passing offense, while continuing to set program records along the way.

Under Beck's tutelage, Leary set a new NC State school record for most touchdown passes in a single season in 2021 with 35. He became one of just three quarterbacks in ACC history to post a 3,400-yard and 35-touchdown regular season. He also passed for 27 touchdowns in ACC play, a mark that led the conference, and he became the first Pack quarterback to throw for four or more touchdowns against five ACC opponents.

Prior to joining the Wolfpack in 2020, Beck coached for three years as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Texas from 2017-19.

Before joining the Longhorns, Beck was at the offensive coordinator at Ohio State from 2015-16 where his offenses helped lead the Buckeyes to back-to-back double-digit win seasons, going 12-1 in 2015 and 11-2 in 2016.

Between 2011-14, Beck's Nebraska offenses ranked among the best in the Big Ten Conference and his passing attack amassed more than 10,000 yards during that time with 86 touchdowns. In his four seasons as coordinator, the Huskers averaged 33.5 points per game. The Huskers broke more than 50 individual records, including career marks for passing yards, completions, passing touchdowns, yards from scrimmage, and total offense.

Prior to Nebraska, Beck was at Kansas where he was the Jayhawks' receivers coach in each of his three seasons (2005-07). He was promoted to passing game coordinator in 2007.

Beck came to KU as one of the most respected high school coaches in the state of Texas, serving three seasons at Summit High in Mansfield. He was the 2003 District Coach of the Year, and a season later, Summit High advanced to the quarterfinals of the state playoffs with a 9-4 record.

Beck was head coach at R.L. Turner High in Carrollton, Texas, from 1999-2001, leading the school to back-to-back playoff appearances and consecutive winning seasons for the first time in 25 years. Beck was named the district coach of the year in 2000.

Prior to coaching in the Texas prep ranks, Beck worked at Missouri State for three seasons from 1996-98, including one season as the offensive coordinator.

Beck started his coaching career as an assistant at Miramar (Fla.) High School in 1988-89 and then moved to Illinois State as outside linebackers and punters coach in 1990. He spent two seasons on Bill Snyder's Kansas State staff (1991-92) as a graduate assistant.

An Ohio native, Beck played one year of football at Central Florida (1985), and he graduated from there in 1988 with a degree in liberal studies. He also has a master's in counseling and guidance from Kansas State University (1992).

Beck and his wife, Tamara, have two children – a son, Jordan, and a daughter, Haylie Marie. Haylie is a 2021 graduate of Coastal Carolina and was a member of the volleyball team from 2017-19 and the beach volleyball team from 2018-19.
