OPENING DRIVE

• The ULM football team (3-2, 1-0 SBC) will return to conference play, traveling to face Coastal Carolina (2-3, 1-1 SBC) on Saturday (Oct. 11) at 6 p.m. CT/7p.m. ET in Brooks Stadium. The Warhawks are looking to build off the success of a strong conference start, winning against Arkansas State for the first time since 2009. This will be the first conference road test for ULM.

• The Warhawks defeated Arkansas State in their first conference game of the season, a 28-16 homecoming victory. This is the first win over the Red Wolves since 2009 to get to an early 1-0 start in Sun Belt play. After a 10-0 deficit early, the Warhawks scored 21 unanswered points to capture the lead. ULM's defense held Arkansas State to 12 rushing yards, posting six sacks, an interception and a fumble recovery in the win.

• Saturday's game marks the sixth meeting between the Warhawks and the Chanticleers, the first in Conway since 2021. ULM leads the series 3-2, finding three-straight wins over Coastal in the first three meetings before falling in the final two. The first meeting came in 2017, a high-scoring 51-43 victory at Malone Stadium for the Warhawks. With both coaches entering their second and third seasons, ULM head coach Bryant Vincent and Coastal Carolina head coach Tim Beck will be facing each other for the first time.

• The Warhawks open Sun Belt competition 1-0 for the second-consecutive season, defeating Troy last season to get to a 1-0 start. The last seasons that ULM opened Sun Belt play 1-0 twice in a row were the 2021 and 2022 seasons.

In conference road openers, ULM is 9-15 since joining the Sun Belt conference, holding a one-game win streak after defeating Troy in the first Sun Belt road test of 2024.

• On the road against UTEP, the Warhawks defeated their first nonconference opponent on the road since 2018. The victory also marks the team's third road win since 2020, also finding victory in 2024 at Troy and in 2022 against Georgia State.

• In the season opener against Saint Francis, ULM claimed a 29-0 shutout win. This is the first shutout win in over a decade for the Warhawks, the last coming against Nicholls in 2015 (47-0). Nine other teams in FBS secured a shutout in Week 1, including local foe Louisiana Tech.

• Defensive back **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** sits at second in the Sun Belt in passes defended (1.20), ranking 17th in FBS. Defensive lineman **Dylan Howell** also leads the conference, in sacks (0.80), sitting at 16th in FBS.

• ULM's 12-game football schedule features five home games, four being conference opponents. According to ESPN, the Warhawks have the second-toughest schedule in the Sun Belt and the eighth toughest in the Group of Five.

• ULM's 2025 opponents went a combined 69-81 (.460) in 2024, with five opponents going over .500. In addition, six foes also participated in postseason bowl games a year ago: Alabama (ReliaQuest

Bowl), Coastal Carolina (Myrtle Beach Bowl), South Alabama (IS4S Salute to Veterans Bowl), Arkansas State (68 Ventures Bowl), the Ragin' Cajuns (Isleta New Mexico Bowl) and Texas State (Servpro First Responder Bowl).

- ULM defensive back **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** was voted Sun Belt Conference Defensive Player of the Week after a media member panel vote on August 31. Perkins-McAllister played lights out for the Warhawks in week one, leading the defense in the team's first shutout in a decade. His two sacks are second in the Sun Belt Conference. The Nashville, Tenn., native claimed five solo tackles on the evening and three assists in a game where the opponent only crossed the 50-yard line once.

- The Warhawks saw multiple ULM debuts on October 4 at Northwestern, as several ULM players logged their first snaps. Zy Jackson made his defensive debut, collecting three tackles. Receiver Trujillo also caught a few passes in his debut.

- **Aidan Armenta** remains the starting quarterback for the Warhawks, completing 55 of 96 passes for 573 yards and six touchdowns. The redshirt sophomore tied his career high with 17 completions against Arkansas State (Sept. 27).

- Monroe native **Landon Graves** has also seen action at quarterback this season, throwing five-for-nine across three games and collecting a touchdown in his first career drive. Graves also posted a 16-yard quarterback keeper against Northwestern (Oct. 4), a career high. **Hunter Herring** has also seen action in a unique position, appearing in multiple positions on the field to push the Warhawks ahead. Herring scored the first touchdown of the season for the Warhawks and posted another against UTEP.

- The running back room in Monroe has proven to be deep, as five RBs have seen action so far this season. **Braylon McReynolds** has claimed four starts thus far, leading the team with 358 yards from 56 attempts and two touchdowns. McReynolds notched his first touchdown as a Warhawk against Saint Francis, a 13-yard reception into the end zone.

Four other running backs contributed to the 940 rushing yards this season, the team averaging 5.3 yards per rush. **Dorian Lewis** has posted 131 yards on 15 carries, including a 72-yard rush to get to the red zone at UTEP (Sept. 20). Freshman **D'Shaun Ford** has seen 12 carries and 41 yards and **Zach Palmer-Smith** has recorded 129 yards off 27 carries, including his first ULM rushing touchdown against Arkansas State (Sept. 27). **Tyrell Reed Jr.** has collected 62 yards, averaging 3.9 yards per carry.

- **Tyler Griffin** leads receivers, claiming 150 yards from 10 receptions, including a touchdown reception from quarterback Graves in the season opener. Veteran **Jake Godfrey** has notched 136 yards off nine receptions, getting a touchdown reception from Armenta into the end zone at UTEP (Sept. 20) and his fourth career touchdown reception vs. Arkansas State (Sept. 27). **JP Coulter** sits at third so far this season, posting 56 yards off eight receptions.

Receiver **Nic Trujillo** made the return to the field against Northwestern (Oct. 4), sidelined for the first four games due to injury. In making his first catch as a Warhawk, Trujillo caught a 34-yard pass from Armenta to score an early touchdown against the Wildcats.

- Tight end **Julian Nixon** has also seen action, registering 43 yards off five receptions and scoring the first touchdown against Arkansas State. The touchdown was the tight end's second of his career and first of the season.

- **Noah Flemmings** leads the team defense with 31 tackles, logging four tackles for loss through five games. A career-high stat line of 2.0 TFLs, a sack, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery came for Flemmings against Arkansas State (Sept. 27). **Carl Fauntroy** follows closely behind with 28 tackles (14 UA, 14 A), along with a tackle for loss and a pass breakup.

Former Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Week **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** continues finding success with the Warhawks, posting 21 tackles, three tackles for loss and three sacks across five games. Perkins-McAllister also blocked a field goal against Arkansas State, ULM's first blocked field goal since 2023.

David Godsey Jr. and **Lynard Harris** are credited with two of the four interceptions on the season, both coming in the final two minutes against UTEP to prevent a last-minute comeback from the Miners. **Kristopher Robinson** also got in on the action, recording an interception against the Red Wolves. Robinson also logged a career-high eight tackles and a tackle for loss in the contest. **Cliff Mosley** also contributed to the defensive effort, catching his first career interception against the Red Flash to force another turnover.

A few Warhawks saw career games against the Red Wolves, especially on the defensive side. **Jaeden Calender** posted his first career sack, one of six against Arkansas State. Godsey Jr. notched a career-high two pass breakups and **Kelbee Holmes** saw his first career quarterback hurry. **Dylan Howell** saw two sacks on the day, a career high for the ULM veteran. Newcomer **Tae Woody** also posted a career game with four tackles, 1.0 TFL and a quarterback hurry.

- Offensive lineman **Elijah Fisher** was recognized on multiple preseason watch lists, including the All State Wuerffel Trophy Watchlist and the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Trophy Watchlist. The Wuerffel Trophy recognizes college football players who exemplify community service, academic excellence

and athletic achievement. The Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Trophy recognizes the top offensive player who exhibits the enduring characteristics that define Earl Campbell: integrity, performance, teamwork, sportsmanship, drive, community and tenacity.

- Seven Warhawks were named to the Phil Steele Preseason Sun Belt teams. On the Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team were offensive lineman **Elijah Fisher**, defensive lineman **Kevontay Wells**, defensive back **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** and placekicker **Max Larson**. On the fourth team were offensive lineman **Jay Mickle**, linebacker **Billy Pullen** and linebacker **Seidrión Langston**.

- **Kevontay Wells** was also named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt First Team Defense, as voted on by the conference's coaches. In his first season with the Warhawks, Wells led the team with 11.0 tackles for loss, which ranked tied for sixth in the Sun Belt. He added 50 total tackles and three sacks in a breakout junior season. Wells is the first Warhawk to be named to a Preseason All-Sun Belt team since 2020, when ULM placed a trio of players (Josh Johnson, Josh Pederson and Corey Straughter) on the preseason first team.

- ULM added 40 new players to its 2025 roster in the offseason. Head coach **Bryant Vincent** and his staff signed 13 new Warhawks on the first day of the early signing period in December, featuring eight defensive players and five on offense. In total, ULM signed nine junior college transfers, 23 transfers from four-year colleges and six high school recruits. The Warhawks lost six starters on offense and six on defense from the 2024 squad.

- Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team member **Kevontay Wells** returns to ULM after a stellar 2024 campaign, tallying 50 tackles, 11 tackles for loss and three sacks while earning All-Sun Belt Second Team Defense honors. **Dylan Howell** returns for his third Warhawk season, after totaling 23 tackles and two quarterback hurries in 2024. **Billy Pullen** returns for his second season, named to the Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Fourth Team, after starting in all 12 games and awarded All-Sun Belt Third Team last season.

- Newcomers in the defense include **Zy Jackson**, a two-time all-conference defensive back at Copiah-Lincoln CC, totaling 10 tackles, a fumble recovery and 586 return yards in 2024. Defensive back **Kamrin Canterbury** led West Florida with 49 tackles and 4.5 tackles for loss last season before transferring to ULM for the 2025 season.

- The Warhawks return both starting guards from last season. **Elijah Fisher** is set for his sixth season in Monroe and has earned All-SBC Honorable Mention in back-to-back seasons. Fisher was voted Phil Steele All-Sun Belt Preseason Third Team. **Jay Mickle** started all 12 games for ULM last season and is back for his final season. The graduate student from Picayune, Miss., was voted Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Fourth Team. Also returning for the Warhawks' offensive line is **Que McBroom** and **Reese Steele**, both of whom made starts last season.

- Special teams players **Max Larson**, **Makenzie Ryan**, **Andrew Wells** and **Nolan Wilson** are all back on ULM's 2025 roster. Larson went 14-for-17 on field goal attempts and 27-for-28 on PATs in his first season with the Warhawks and was named Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team. Ryan booted 58 punts with an average of 39.2 yards per punt, downing 18 inside the 20-yard line. Wells served as the team's holder and Wilson was the long snapper for all games last season. ULM signed West Monroe native **Peyton Todd** to the roster. Todd appeared in all 13 games last season at LSU and averaged 41.3 yards per punt on 19 punts for the Tigers.

- ULM's coaching staff features four new faces in 2025, including running backs coach and run game coordinator **Hindley Brigham**, wide receivers coach **Kishawn McClain**, defensive ends coach **Jontavius Morris** and offensive assistant coach **Cody Wells**. Brigham arrives after nine seasons at UAB, McClain joins the staff after stops at ETSU and Gardner-Webb and Morris was added after being on staff at Louisville and Purdue. Former ULM quarterback Wells returns to Monroe after a few seasons at Evangel University.

- Family connections on the ULM football coaching staff include **Bryant Vincent's** son, **Brady Vincent**, as the team's Tight Ends Coach. **Bret Vincent** makes it three Vincents featured in the ULM football program, with Bret playing wide receiver for the Warhawks. The Vincent family is not the only family tie for ULM. Defensive Coordinator **Earnest Hill** enters his second season on the staff, with his son **Bryan Hill** working as a defensive assistant coach.

LAST TIME OUT –

Northwestern 42, ULM 7 (Oct. 4, 2025 in Evanston, Ill.) – The ULM football team (3-2, 1-0 Sun Belt) fell on the road in the nonconference finale to Northwestern (3-2, 1-1 B1G) on Saturday afternoon (Oct. 4). After coming out to an early lead, 42 unanswered points gave the Wildcats the edge.

“Obviously disappointed with the loss,” said head coach **Bryant Vincent**. “I thought our kids played really hard. We’re going to put this one behind us. I’m proud of our kid’s effort all the way until the end.”

The Wildcats picked up 515 total yards to the Warhawks’ 273, with the home team logging 64% completion passing and averaging 6.5 yards per rush. ULM went 0-1 in the red zone, 3-10 from third downs and 0-1 from fourth downs. Northwestern went 4-4 in the red zone, 11-16 from third down and 2-2 from fourth down.

“When you’re playing these games, you’ve got to maximize your opportunities,” said Vincent. “We didn’t stay on the field offensively to keep the drives going, that makes all the difference.”

The Warhawks got off to a fast start against the Wildcats, finding first down after first down. On the 34-yard line, Armenta took a shot at **Nic Trujillo**, who scored the touchdown for his first catch as a Warhawk. With an early 7-0 lead, ULM looked to hold Northwestern without a score.

A five-minute drive for the home team had the Wildcats slowly marching down the field. Quarterback **Preston Stone** converted two third downs to keep pushing. After a penalty on the Warhawk defense, **Caleb Komolafe** was able to run three yards into the end zone to tie things up.

ULM looked to keep things going on offense, **Hunter Herring** completing a 48-yard pass to **Tyler Griffin** to set up good field position. A few incomplete passes and loss of yardage placed Luke Stagg on the field to attempt the field goal. **Luke Stagg** was unable to get between the uprights from 45 yards to keep the score tied, 7-7, at the conclusion of the first quarter.

Stone started the second quarter hot, rushing 30 yards to cross midfield and enter ULM territory. A deep 17-yard pass to **Drew Wagner**, following by a 37-yarder to **Hayden Eligon II** gave the Wild-cats the advantage in the game. After a two-point conversion, Northwestern was up, 15-7, with 13:57 remaining in the quarter.

Armenta followed the opposing score with a 14-yard pass to **JP Coulter** and then again to **Julian Nixon** to enter opponent territory. After a seven-yard keeper, two short gains set up fourth down and two, with Herring unable to convert and turning the ball over on downs. A seven-minute drive started for Northwestern, as several flags prevented the Wildcats from getting downfield. The home team settled for a field goal to secure the two-possession lead, 18-7.

Trujillo picked up another long reception of 27 yards, a pass interference call pushing ULM even further. But an incompleting, a rush for no gain and a quarterback sack had **Makenzie Ryan** punting. Northwestern fought the time running down, snagging a few first downs before the half con-cluded with the Wildcats ahead.

The Wildcats got the ball to start the second half, a few completions getting Northwestern back in ULM territory. Komolafe broke free again, rushing for 39 yards to reach the endzone and extend the lead, 25-7, with 12:04 remaining in the quarter. McReynolds and Armenta continued to find success and first downs, but in short spurts that led to another punt from Ryan.

Dashun Reeder began to break through for Northwestern, gaining 13 and 16 yards to build on the strong momentum for the home team. A 49-yard toss from Stone secured another touchdown, this time caught by **Griffin Wilde**. Two incompletes and a sack gave the ball back to the Wildcats. A pass interference call in favor of Northwestern placed the Wildcats back in the red zone, a six-yard pass to Wagner extending the lead further, making it a 39-7 score.

In the fourth quarter, another sack came from the Northwestern defense, sending the punting team back out for ULM and the Northwestern offense back on the field. The Warhawk defense pushed against the home team, holding the Wildcats to a field goal with 8:43 remaining in the contest. Both teams traded punts to conclude the game and secure the 42-7 victory for Northwestern.

Aidan Armenta threw 10-for-19 for 129 yards and a touchdown, posting no interceptions on the night. Northwestern’s Stone threw 20-for-31 for 263 yards and three touchdowns. Herring went 1-of-2 for 48 yards on the evening, with **Landon Graves** also going 1-for-2.

Braylon McReynolds led the rush with 49 yards off eight carries, averaging 6.1 yards per carry. Quarterback Graves had the longest run of the day, with a 16-yard rush in the final two minutes.

Trujillo made his debut against the Wildcats, posting 61 yards across two carries, the first ULM reception being a 34-yard touchdown reception. Griffin also showed out, posting 58 yards across two carries, the long being the 36-yard reception from Herring.

For the defense, **Noah Flemmings** and **Kristopher Robinson** each led with eight tackles apiece. **Seidrión Langston** posted four tackles and a tackle for loss, **Kamrin Canterbury** also recording a TFL. **Lynard Harris** and **Jaden Hamlin** each registered pass breakups, with four different Warhawks recording quarterback hurries.

SECOND SEASON AT ULM (8-9) THIRD SEASON OVERALL (15-15)

Bryant Vincent, known for his strong leadership and expertise in creating powerful offensive schemes in college football, was named the 17th head football coach in University of Louisiana Monroe history on Wednesday, December 6, 2023. Vincent was also named Interim Athletic Director for ULM on August 5, 2025.

In his first season as head coach of ULM football, Coach Vincent began establishing a culture of grit and resilience that propelled the Warhawks to one of their most successful starts in nearly four decades. ULM opened the 2024 season 5-1, the program's best start in 37 years, and Vincent was the only Sun Belt Conference Coach named to the 2024 Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award Watch List.

Vincent secured his first victory as head coach with a 30-14 win over Jackson State on August 29, 2024. In week two, the Warhawks stunned UAB with a dominating 32-6 win after shutting out the Blazers in the second half inside Malone Stadium. After defeating Troy on the road 13-9 in the Sun Belt Conference opener, Vincent led the Warhawks to a signature victory over JMU by a score of 21-19 to give ULM its first 4-1 start in the FBS era. ULM completed the 5-1 start with a 38-21 win over Southern Miss in week six.

Under Vincent's direction, the Warhawks led the SBC in several statistical categories, including passing yards allowed (183.9), blocked kicks (3) and few-

est penalty yards per game (43.25).

He developed 2024 Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year Ahmad Hardy, who led the league with 1,351 rushing yards and 13 rushing touchdowns as a true freshman. Hardy was named ULM's first FWAA Freshman All-American in program history and was also voted Louisiana Freshman of the Year by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

Including Hardy, nine Warhawks garnered SBC post-season honors for the first time in over five seasons including All-Sun Belt Second Team defensive lineman Kevontay Wells and All-Sun Belt Third Team defensive stars Billy Pullen, Carl Glass Jr., and Wydett Williams Jr. Additionally, two of Vincent's players went on to compete at the professional level after senior cornerback Car'lin Vigers signed an undrafted free agent contract with the NFL's Washington Commanders and senior offensive lineman Sam Carson was drafted by the CFL's Ottawa Redblacks.

Off the field, Vincent's leadership produced unprecedented academic results. ULM football recorded the highest term GPA in program history in Fall 2024, and the team's 84% graduation success rate (GSR) led all Sun Belt programs. Additionally, major facility upgrades were completed at Malone Stadium, including renovations to the team room, locker room and main athletics lobby.

Before arriving in Monroe, Vincent served as the Offensive Coordinator at the University of New





Mexico during the 2023 season. Under Vincent's offensive schemes, the Lobos earned national top-20 rankings in red zone offense (14th) and rushing offense (19th). Additionally, Vincent coached running back Jacory Croskey-Merritt to a record-breaking season. The New Mexico running back was the first Lobo to ever have back-to-back 200-yard rushing games and finished with 17 rushing touchdowns, which is third all-time in New Mexico football history.

Prior to New Mexico, Vincent served as the Interim Head Coach at UAB following the retirement of Bill Clark and led the Blazers to a 7-6 season and a win in the 2022 Bahamas Bowl. UAB's offense generated 30.1 points per game and 438.2 yards per game, which was the 33rd highest mark in the country. Vincent spent four seasons as UAB's offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach and was a key figure in elevating the program since its reinstatement in 2017. In all, Vincent helped lead UAB to a pair of Conference USA Championships and bowl game victories.

UAB has been the winningest team in Conference USA since returning to the playing field and collected 42 wins since Vincent returned as OC. The Blazers won the 2018 CUSA title game 27-25 over Middle Tennessee State, winning on the road, and the 2020 CUSA title game, that one 22-13 over Marshall, again on the road.

UAB also made it to the 2019 championship game as champions of their division. Since the reinstatement of the program in 2017, Vincent coached in five bowls games, qualifying for six. UAB won the 2018 Boca Raton Bowl 37-13 over Northern Illinois, the 2021 Independence Bowl 31-28 over BYU and the 2022 Bahamas Bowl. UAB also played in the 2017 Bahamas Bowl against Ohio and the 2019 New Orleans Bowl against App State, and the team qualified for the 2020 Gasparilla Bowl against South Carolina, before being canceled due to COVID-19.

With Vincent at offensive coordinator, the Blazers set FBS-program records for wins in 2018, going 11-3. Vincent never had a losing season with Blazers, going 7-6 as head coach and going 48-27 overall in his six years with UAB. The 2018 Blazers had the best offensive season in program history which resulted in 21 school records, including the aforementioned 11-3 overall record and winning the program's first Conference USA title and

bowl game.

Among the school records that fell in 2018 included total points (418), total touchdowns (53), rushing touchdowns (32), total yards (5,680) and rushing yards (2,818). Additionally, UAB set the single game school record for total yards (668) and rushing yards (419) in a 52-3 victory over UTSA on Nov. 3, 2018.

Vincent is no stranger to the Sun Belt Conference and spent six years in two separate stints with South Alabama. He served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2015-17 and was an assistant coach from 2011-13 for the Jaguars' football program. Vincent helped guide the Jaguars to the 2016 Nova Home Loans Arizona Bowl led by record setting quarterback Dallas Davis. In Vincent's offense, Davis threw for the most yards in school history (2,706) and his 2,951 total yards of offense are second most in program history.

Before entering the collegiate ranks, Vincent was a successful high school football coach in Alabama and tallied a record of 49-16 in five seasons at two different schools. In his first season as a head coach, Vincent led Greenville High School to a 10-3 record and was selected as the Class 5A Coach of the Year in 2006. Vincent was at the helm of Spanish Fort High School football for four seasons and produced a record of 39-13. His team captured the Alabama 5A State Championship in 2010.

Vincent is a native of Glasgow, Kentucky. He and his wife Holli have two sons, Brady, a member of the ULM football coaching staff and Bret, a wide receiver for the Warhawks.
