Coastal Carolina women's basketball opens the 2025-26 season at the HTC Center with their first-ever meeting with Miami (OH). The Chants and RedHawks tip it off at 6 p.m. ET to begin the campaign. Coverage will be live on ESPN+ and the Chanticleer Sports Network.

COASTAL QUICK HITTERS

- Coastal Carolina is coming off one of the most successful seasons in program history in 2024-25, going 23-9 (12-6 SBC) and reaching the semifinals of the Sun Belt tournament and WNIT for the first time in program history.
- Coastal's 23 wins last season were the second-most in program history behind their 25 wins in 2019-20. The Chants hit 240 3-pointers throughout the campaign, a new program record.
- Leading the 3-point charge last season was Kristin Williams, who led the Sun Belt with 82 made 3-pointers. Williams was named to the preseason All-Sun Belt Second Team.
- After finishing fourth in the Sun Belt last season, the Chants were picked sixth in the preseason coaches poll, their highest preseason ranking since 2020.
- The Chanticleers welcome 10 new players to the team in 2025-26, with three freshmen and seven transfers.

LAST TIME OUT ...

- The Chanticleers finished the 2024-25 season with a loss to Campbell 57-55 in the first round of the WNIT on March 20.
- Returning Chant Kristin Williams capped off her season with an eight-point performance in the final game.
- Coastal's appearance in the WNIT was the first in program history, and the first postseason tournament appearance since the 2019 Women's Basketball Invitational, where the Chants also met Campbell in the first round.
- The 23 wins were the second-most in program history as the Chants reached the semifinals of the Sun Belt tournament for the first time ever.
- Last season, Coastal led the Sun Belt in scoring margin (+9.6), team FG% (.433), and forced turnovers (20.3) while ranking second in scoring offense (74.3) and steals per game (10.88).

SERIES HISTORY

 The Chants and RedHawks will be meeting for the first time.

A COASTAL WIN WOULD...

- Give Coastal an opening victory for the second straight season.
- Improve Coastal's record in the MAC-SBC Challenge to 3-0 after wins over Central Michigan and Buffalo last season
- Give Coastal their 21st consecutive home-opening victory, dating back to 2005.

IT'S GOOD TO BE HOME

- The Chanticleers have won 20 consecutive home openers dating back to 2005.
- The last time Coastal fell in a home-opening game was Nov. 19, 2004 in a 77-74 loss to Anderson.
- Anderson's head coach at the time was current Coastal head coach Kevin Pederson, who coached the Trojans from 2002-05.

FUN BELT MEETS MACTION

- Coastal's season will start with an opponent from the MAC for the second year in a row.
- The Chants beat Central Michigan by a three-point margin, 65-62, in the 2024 season opener on Nov. 4.
- Coastal later beat Buffalo on Feb. 8, 2025 73-65 at the HTC Center.
- The opponent for the second round of the MAC-SBC Challenged is based on NET ranking and will be announced at a later date.

COASTAL CHAOS

- Head Coach Kevin Pederson coined the term "Coastal Chaos" prior to last season due to his philosophy of tough defense and forcing teams to be uncomfortable.
- The stats backed up the chaotic defense, as the Chants led the Sun Belt with 20.3 turnovers forced per game and ranked second in steals per game with 10.88.

PRESEASON HONORS

- Prior to the season, graduate guard Kristin Williams was named to the preseason All-Sun Belt Second Team.
- · Last season, Williams led the Sun Belt and ranked

- fourth in CCU program history with 82 made 3-pointers while averaging 10.8 points per game, ranking third on the team
- The Chants were picked sixth in the preseason SBC Coaches' Poll, their highest preseason ranking since 2020

FRESH FACES

- Coastal Carolina brought in 10 new players to the roster in 2025-26, among 29 programs welcoming 10+ new players this season.
- Among the new players are seven transfers and three freshmen

A COACHING VETERAN IN THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, KEVIN PEDERSON (PRONOUNCED PEH-DUR-SON) WAS NAMED THE SEVENTH WOMEN'S BASKETBALL HEAD COACH IN COASTAL CAROLINA UNIVERSITY HISTORY ON APRIL 12, 2022.

Pederson came to Coastal Carolina with more than 20-plus years of head coaching experience, 400-plus career wins, 15 trips to the NCAA postseason tournament, and administra- tive experience at the collegiate level.

Most recently, Pederson led the Chants to their most successful season in five years by going 23-9 and 12-6 in Sun Belt Conference play in 2024-25. The season marked the third time in recent history that Coastal had won 20 or more games and ranked as the second-most wins in a season in program history. The Chants also reached the Sun Belt Tournament semifinals for the first time ever, while making their first appearance in the WNIT.

The 2024-25 squad set program-records for most points in a season with 2,379, most made three-pointers in a season with 240, and also led the Sun Belt Conference with 20.3 turnovers forced per game and +9.6 scoring margin.

Following the historic campaign, Savannah Brooks was named to the All-Sun Belt second team after leading the Chants with 13.1 points per game and ranking third in the conference with 2.3 steals per game.

Alancia Ramsey earned All-Sun Belt third team honors after averaging 12.3 points per game and 6.4 rebounds per game in her sophomore season. Ramsey finished the season averaging 13.2 points per game in conference play.

Pederson led Lander University to unprecedented success during his 17 years (2005-22) in Greenwood, S.C., as he guided the Bearcats to a 356-160 overall record fueled by 13 NCAA Division II Championship Tournament appearances, including the last eight straight seasons.

Most recently, Pederson directed the Bearcats to a 24-5 overall record, a 15-3 Peach Belt Conference record, and advanced to the 2022 NCAA Division II Championship Regional final.

Pederson owns an impressive .699 winning percentage (444-191) through 21 seasons as an intercollegiate head women's basketball coach with all of those 444 career wins coming at South Carolina institutions in Lander (356-160) and Anderson University (88-31).

The all-time wins leader for Lander women's basketball and conference wins leader in women's basketball for the Peach Belt Conference, He led the Bearcats to two NCAA DII Region Championships (2011-12 and 2020-21), four Peach Belt regularseason championships (2007-08, 2009-10, 2019-20, and 2020-21), two Peach Belt Conference division titles (2015-16 and 2016-17), and four Peach Belt Tournament Championships (2007-08, 2008-09, 2015-16, 2019-20).

In his four years as the head coach at Anderson (2002-05), he led the Trojans to a Carolinas-Virginia Athletic Conference (CVAC) regular-season championship in 2004-05 and back-to-back tournament championships in 2003-04 and 2004-05.

Pederson, a three-time Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBC) Region Coach of the Year (2009-10, 2019-20, and 2020-21) and three-time conference coach of the year (2004-05, 2009-10,

and 2020-21), has recorded 15 20-win seasons, including eight 25-plus win seasons, and was the first coach in the state of South Carolina to lead a team to three straight NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 appearances.

He has recorded a 20-14 career record in the NCAA DII Championship Tourna- ment, making 15 appearances in 21 seasons. He has taken his teams to seven Sweet 16 appearances (2004-05, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2018-19, 2020-21 and 2021-22), made two Elite 8 appearances (2011-12 and 2020-21) and reached one Final 4 (2020-21).

His teams have finished in the NCAA DII Top 25 national rankings eight times, including his most recent 2021-22 Lander squad completing the season ranked No. 10 in the NCAA DII Top 25 Coaches Poll and No. 11 in the D2SIDA Final WBB Poll.

During his career, he recruited and coached the 2011 WBCA Division II Player of the Year Shannon McKeever, the NCAA Division II All-Time Leading Scorer in Lashonda Chiles, and mentored at least one Division II All-American in 10 different

Pederson has also coached 44 all-conference players, eight conference players of the year, three conference defensive players of the year, four conference fresh- man of the year, and one conference female athlete of the year. While at Lander, he also coached two Peach Belt Conference Elite 16 Award winners in Cierra Revell (2021) and Sarah Crews (2022), as well as eight Lander Female Athlete of the Year Award winners.

Pederson started his coaching career as an assistant coach for the men's basket- ball team at Anderson College (S.C.) from 1999 to 2005. He also served as the head junior varsity coach for the men's team from 2000 to 2002 before taking over the reins of the women's basketball program in January 2002, first on an interim basis and then full-time.

Pederson, a native of Fairfax, Va., worked five seasons for the Clemson University men's basketball program as a student manager from 1994 to 1999 under Rick Barnes and Larry Shyatt before joining Anderson College in 2001.

He earned a bachelor's degree from Clemson and a master's degree from the United States Sports Academy.

Pederson is married to the former Adair Clary of Gaffney, S.C., who earned a bachelor's and master's degree from Clemson. They have two children, Conner and Clary.
