COLGATE FOOTBALL GAME NOTES NCAA DIVISION I FCS PLAYOFFS

10TH PLAYOFF APPEARANCE DRAWS REMATCH WITH UNH

Colgate's return to the NCAA Division I Football Championship features a familiar foe. The Patriot League champion Raiders take on New Hampshire this Saturday in Durham. The game is a rematch of the Sept. 12 contest in Hamilton, won 26-8 by the Wildcats. These teams met in the regular season in 2013 and in the playoffs in 2005, both in Durham. New Hampshire won those meetings as well, and Colgate is looking for its first victory against the Wildcats since 1986.



Both teams enter at 7-4 and playing their best football of the season. The Raiders have won five straight and seven of eight, while UNH is riding a four-game winning streak. Colgate captured its eighth Patriot League championship with a perfect 6-0 record, capped by last Saturday's 14-10 win over Bucknell. The Raiders won their final five conference games by an average of 5.2 points.

This is Colgate's first season rematch since 1982, when the Raiders and Boston University played on consecutive weekends. That year, the Raiders won 22-21 at BU on the season's final weekend, and then hosted the Terriers one week later in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. Colgate took that one as well, 21-7. **See history inside back page.**

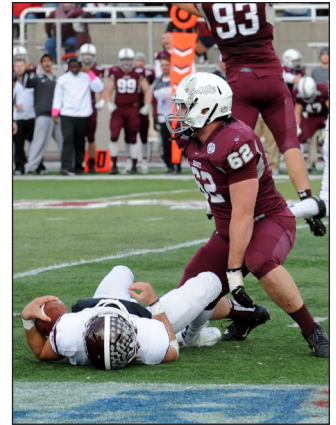

schedule for its eighth conference title, and this week the Raiders reaped the acclaim. Dan Hunt was named 2015 Patriot League Coach of the Year and he led a league-high 12 Raiders onto this season's first and second teams.

First-team members are linebacker **Kyle Diener**, tight end **John Quazza**, offensive linemen **John Weber** and **Jordi Dalmau**, and defensive lineman **Pat Afriyie**.

Second-team recipients are quarterback **Jake Melville**, defensive linemen **Alex Campbell** and **Brett Field**, tailbacks **Demetrius Russell** and **James Holland**, defensive back **Ty McCollum** and wide receiver **John Maddaluna III**.



CAMPBELL PATRIOT PLAYER OF WEEK

Colgate's **Alex Campbell** on Monday was named Corvias Patriot League Defensive Player of the Week and Patriot League Madness Defensive Player of the Week. He compiled 11 tackles, two sacks and forced a fumble last Saturday as Colgate held off Bucknell 14-10 to complete a perfect 6-0 sweep in the Patriot League.

Campbell matched the career-high tackles mark that he set the week before against Lehigh and recorded two of the team's five sacks. One of his sacks came with Bucknell in the red zone and led to a missed field goal for the Bison, while another helped Colgate gain possession late in the second quarter for a TD drive that made it 14-0 just before halftime.

Campbell in the last four games has 36 tackles and six sacks. For the season, he's fifth on the team with 54 tackles and third in sacks with 6½.

GATE SACK PATROL

Colgate's three-man defensive front of **Pat Afriyie**, **Brett Field** and **Alex Campbell** has combined for 24 of the team's Patriot League-leading 34 sacks. And Tuesday, all three were named to either the All-Patriot League first or second team.

Afriyie has 9½ sacks and already stands sixth on Colgate's all-time season list. The sophomore is up to 14 for his career and that's good enough for 10th on the Colgate chart.



Field has a sack in each of the last four games and eight for the year (Afriyie and Field are 1-2 in the Patriot League), tying for eighth on Colgate's season listing. Campbell has 6½, and six of those have come in the last four games.

Colgate as a defense compiled 20 sacks over the recent four-game stretch run against Fordham, Lafayette, Lehigh and Bucknell. **See charts left.**

DIENER ONE SHY OF 100

Linebacker **Kyle Diener** goes into Saturday's NCAA playoff game with a team-high 99 tackles, including 5½ for lost yardage. He has led or tied for the team lead in tackles in tackles five times this season.

His pass breakup against Fordham's two-point conversion try on the last play of the game preserved Colgate's 31-29 victory and wound up being the championship decider.

FOURTH DOWN? GIVE HIM SIX!

Colgate against in the clinching win against Lehigh went 3-of-3 on fourth down conversions, with TDs on all three plays. And none of them were gimmes.

2015 COLGATE RAIDERS GAME NOTES



Jake Melville scored the game's first TD on a fourth-and-9 scamper that went 28 yards to pay dirt. The junior quarterback struck again in the second quarter, converting a fourth-and-1 into a 13-yard touchdown that made it 21-14. And then **Demetrius Russell** turned the trick in the third period as he took a fourth-and-1 handoff and bolted 9 yards for the score that made it 35-28.

Colgate leads the Patriot League in fourth-down conversions at 65.8 percent (25-of-38).

MELVILLE CLOSING ON TOP 10

Quarterback **Jack Melville** needs just 77 passing yards Saturday at UNH to climb into Colgate's season top 10. The junior has completed 56.3 percent of his passes for 2,102 yards and eight touchdowns against just one interception.

Melville's only interception of the season came Sept. 26 at Holy Cross. His current streak of passes without an interception has reached 180, and he has thrown just one pick in his last 337 pass attempts dating to last season.

Colgate as a team leads the nation in fewest passes had intercepted with one.

In addition, Melville quarterbacked the Raiders to a perfect 6-0 Patriot League campaign and enters next season with a 9-0 record in starts against Patriot League opponents.

RAIDER STATISTICAL LEADERS

Colgate's **Pat Afriyie** leads the Patriot League in forced fumbles with five, sacks with 0.86 per game (9½ total) and tackles-for-loss with 1.6 per game (17½ total). Nationally, Afriyie is second in forced fumbles, ninth in sacks per game, and 15th in TFLs.

Jake Melville is second in yards-per completion (13.1), **Ty McCollum** is second in passes defended with 14, **John Maddaluna III** is second in yards per reception at 15.3, and **Brett Field** is second in sacks with 0.7 (8 total).

Colgate as a team leads the nation in fewest passes had intercepted with 1, and fewest TFLs allowed with 38. The Raiders are tops in the Patriot League in rushing offense (197.5), fourth-down conversion percentage (65.8), fewest sacks allowed (10) and fewest turnovers lost (11).

Tailback **James Holland** found the end zone twice against Lehigh and has eight TDs in the last five games. The sophomore posted his first three-TD game at Lafayette. Holland leads the Raiders with nine TDs, all rushing, and 54 points.

THREE TIMES 1,000

Colgate for possibly the first time in program history has three players in the same backfield with at least 1,000 career rushing yards. **Demetrius Russell** reached the 1,800 mark with his career-high 141 yards against Lehigh, and just passed NFL great Marv Hubbard to reach Colgate's top 20. **Jake Melville** is at 1,354 and **John Wilkins** 1,028 to complete the trifecta.

RAIDERS 3RD NATIONALLY IN GRAD SUCCESS

Colgate student-athletes improved by one position to third nationally in the latest NCAA Division I Graduation Success Rate release.

The Raiders for the fourth straight year are at 98 percent, placing Colgate alongside peer schools Columbia, Davidson, Duke, Harvard, Loyola-Chicago, Notre Dame, Princeton, Stanford and Yale.

The NCAA's Graduation Success Rate includes transfer students and student-athletes who leave in good academic standing. The GSR measures graduation over six years from first-time college enrollment.



RAIDERS PICKED 3RD, FINISHED 1ST

Colgate for the second year in a row under head coach Dan Hunt made a two-place improvement in their predicted order of finish.

The Raiders were slated for a third-place result in this year's Patriot League football race, yet captured their eighth conference championship with the 49-42 thriller over Lehigh. In Hunt's debut season of 2014, the Raiders were picked for fifth but finished third.

Hunt in his two seasons as Colgate head coach is 9-3 against Patriot League competition.

HEPPEL SELECTED PATRIOT LEAGUE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dr. Cornelius Kerwin, the chair of the Patriot League's Council of Presidents and President at American University, announced June 8 that Jennifer Heppel had been appointed as the League's fifth Executive Director. She comes to the Patriot League after working the past five years at the Big Ten Conference.

In her role as Associate Commissioner for Governance at the Big Ten, Heppel worked directly with the presidents/chancellors, faculty representatives and administrators in implementing the policy initiatives of the conference.

Colgate is honoring the memory of Ryan Adams '19 and Carey Depuy '19, who died Sept. 20 in a small plane accident. The Raiders are wearing helmet stickers with the two students' initials for the remainder of the season.

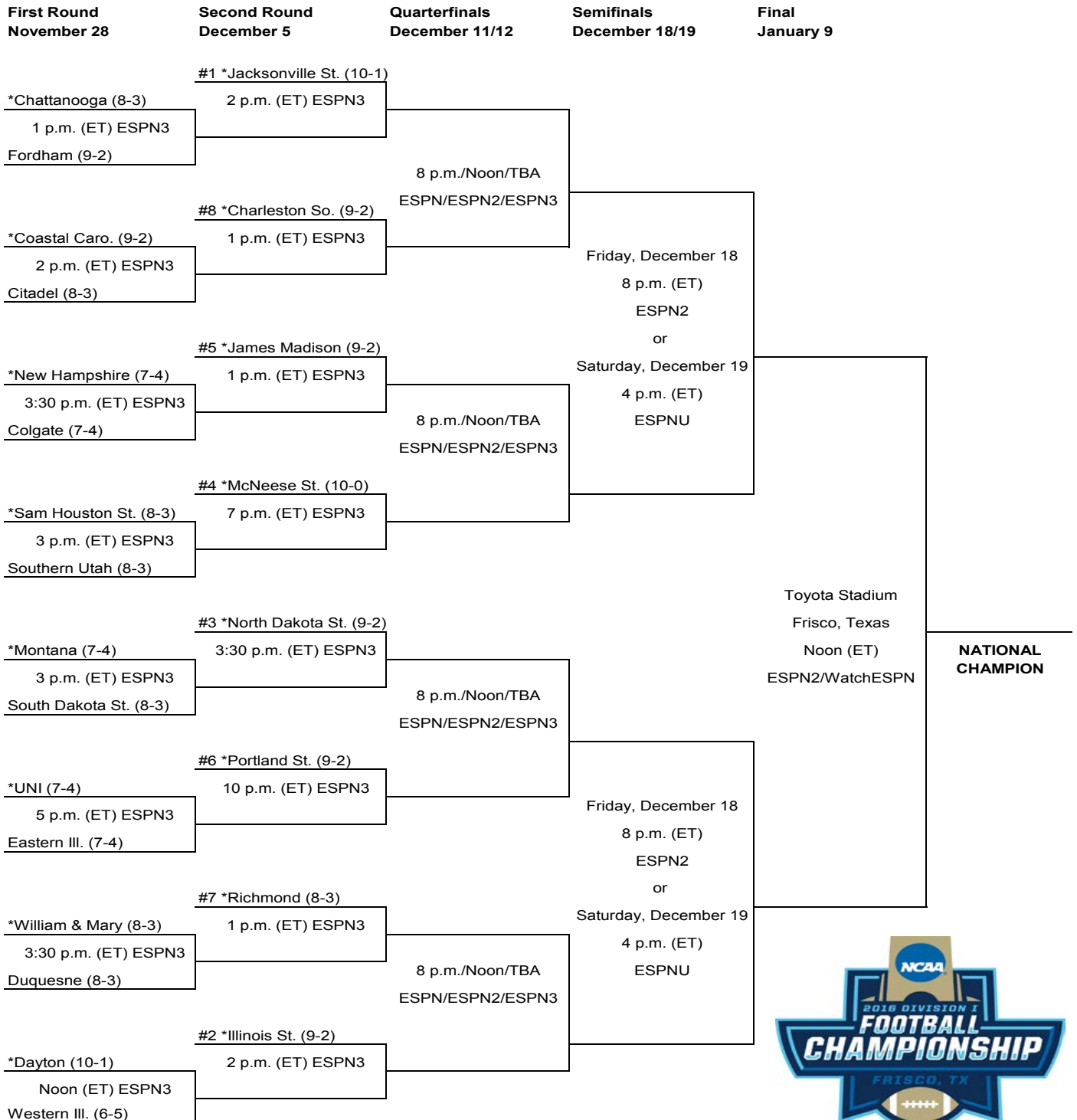
