Raiders Open 2016 Slate, Renew Rivalry at Syracuse

Thirteen newsy notes on this week's season opener against the Orange.

• Colgate and Syracuse meet in football for the 67th time and first since 2010. **The Raiders hold a 31-30-5 series advantage.** The margin was 31-15-5 after Colgate's 19-14 win in 1950, but the Orange have won the last 15 meetings. The teams initially met in 1891, and three of the first six contests were played in Hamilton. Colgate went 4-1-1 in that opening six-game stretch, including a 2-0-1 home record. Beginning with 1902, all 60 encounters have been played in Syracuse with the Orange compiling a 29-27-4 edge. The series was played annually from 1912-61, minus two breaks during the war years of 1918 and 1943.

• This is **Colgate's fourth straight road season opener** against a BCS opponent: Air Force 2013 (lost 37-13), Ball State 2014 (lost 30-10) and Navy 2015 (lost 48-10).

• **Colgate is the preseason pick of the Patriot League** coaches and sports information directors to repeat as conference champion. The Raiders were 6-0 in the Patriot League last year and 9-5 overall en route to two playoff victories and a berth in the NCAA FCS quarterfinals. Fordham, Holy Cross, Lehigh, Bucknell, Lafayette and Georgetown round out the 2016 predicted order of finish.

• **Dan Hunt in just two seasons as head coach** has returned Colgate Football to national prominence. Hunt is 14-12 overall, including a pair of NCAA playoff victories last season, and already stands 9-3 against Patriot League competition. **This is Hunt's 21st season** as a member of the Colgate coaching staff, the first 18 of which he served as an assistant under head coach Dick Biddle. The Raiders won seven Patriot League crowns in the Biddle-Hunt Era and advanced all the way to the 2003 NCAA title game.

• **Colgate enters the season ranked among the nation's top 25 in four preseason polls:** Lindy's 12th, STATS FCS 21st, Athlon 23rd and Hero Sports 23rd. The Raiders finished 13th in last year's final FCS Coaches Poll and 17th in the STATS FCS Poll.

• **The Raiders return** nine starters on offense and eight on defense.

• LB Kyle Diener was the choice of the conference coaches and SIDs as **Patriot League**

Preseason Defensive Player of the Year, and DL Pat Afriyie earned the same honor from College Sports Madness. Both Raider defenders were included on the Hero Sports Preseason All-America Second Team, and Afriyie also picked up the same honor from College Sports Madness.

- **Afriyie in two seasons has 14 sacks** -- nearly halfway to the Colgate record of 28½ set by Kelly Robinson from 1979-81. Afriyie and fellow D-line returnees Brett Field and Alex Campbell combined for 25 of Colgate's Patriot League-leading 36 sacks last season. On offense, Jake Melville compiled 3,625 yards of total offense for the second-highest figure in program history, and **Colgate led nation in fewest passes had intercepted with two**. Tailback James Holland led the Raiders and finished seventh nationally with 16 touchdowns and 96 points.

- Endicott's Maine-Endwell All-Star baseball team that won the Little League World Series has a Colgate connection. **Assistant coach Joe Hopko '91 lettered three seasons** for the Raiders and caught three TD passes at the fullback position during his senior year of 1990. Included was a two-TD performance in Colgate's 28-27 win that season over Bucknell.

- **Colgate's 2015 Patriot League crown was the eighth in program history**, and the Raiders are the only Patriot League team to win multiple playoff games in the same year (also 2003 en route to the NCAA championship game). Colgate was the lone team in last year's playoff field to win twice on the road (at New Hampshire and James Madison).

- **Colgate won nine games (9-5) last season** for the ninth time in program history. Seven of those wins were consecutive and all by single digits -- 4, 2, 9, 7, 4, 7 and 6.

- The Raiders last season thrived on disciplined football. **They led the Patriot League in fewest penalties per game** at 4.8, were among the top 10 nationally in both fewest sacks allowed and fewest tackles-for-loss allowed, finished eighth nationally in fourth-down conversion rate at 67.4, and led the Patriot League in rushing at 206.4 yards per game.

- Former Colgate assistant coach James Cregg helped the **Denver Broncos to the Super Bowl championship** last season as offensive line coach. Cregg coached the Colgate defensive line from 2000-03 and was part of that memorable 2003 run to the NCAA title game.

HUNTSVILLE, Texas – The second-best postseason run in Colgate football history ended when the Raiders fell 48-21 to No. 10 Sam Houston State in the NCAA Division I Football Championship quarterfinals.

Seven days after limiting the national top-ranked offense at James Madison to just 298 yards, Colgate couldn't slow the new No. 1 offense in Sam Houston State. The Bearkats racked up 653 total yards for their third-best mark in program history.

Jake Melville, James Holland and Alex Greenawalt all registered touchdowns to lead the Raiders.
