## Ranked Teams Meet in Southern Showdown

### THE COLGATE 13

Thirteen newsy notes on this week's game against the No. 7 Spiders.

- Colgate and Richmond clash in a marquee matchup of ranked teams. The Raiders are coming off a 55-13 road thumping of Yale, while Richmond lost at Stony Brook. **These two teams advanced deep into the 2015 NCAA playoffs.** Colgate won twice on the road before succumbing in the quarterfinals at Sam Houston State. The Spiders went one step further, advancing to the semis before losing at eventual champion North Dakota State.

- Richmond owns a 3-1 series lead against Colgate, although **this is the first meeting since 1997.** Colgate's 43-13 home win over the Spiders took place in 1983, and Richmond has since won three in a row. The Raiders open 2017 at home against Richmond on Sept. 9.

- Colgate linebacker **Trent Williams** and quarterback **Jake Melville** earned **Patriot League Player of the Week** recognition for their roles in last weekend's 55-13 triumph at Yale. Williams swept defensive honors from the Patriot League media reps and College Sports Madness, while Melville picked up the Madness offensive nod.

- Colgate jumped two places to 21st** in this week's FCS Coaches Poll. The Raiders stayed in the 23rd position in both the STATS FCS and Hero Sports Media polls. Colgate finished 13th in last year's final FCS Coaches Poll and 17th in the STATS FCS Poll.

- Who says **Jake Melville** can't throw. The fleet-footed Colgate quarterback took to the airways last Saturday and **passed for a school-record five TDs** as the No. 23 Raiders whipped Yale 55-13. The previous Colgate record for passing TDs in a game was four, held by several players. Current Raiders assistant coach **Greg Sullivan** was the most recent to throw four, back in 2009 against Lehigh.

- Colgate scored its most points ever against Yale in a series dating to 1909, and the 42-point win was the largest Raider margin of victory in any game since a 46-3 triumph at Fordham in 2006.

- And defense? **Colgate held Yale to 12 rushing yards**, intercepted four passes and sacked Bulldog quarterbacks five times for a combined minus-36 yards.

• **Dan Hunt in just two seasons as head coach** has returned Colgate Football to national prominence. Hunt is 15-13 overall, including a pair of NCAA playoff victories last season, and already stands 9-3 against Patriot League competition. **This is Hunt's 21st season** as a member of the Colgate coaching staff, the first 18 of which he served as an assistant under head coach Dick Biddle. The Raiders won seven Patriot League crowns in the Biddle-Hunt Era and advanced all the way to the 2003 NCAA title game.



• **Colgate is the preseason pick of the Patriot League** coaches and sports information directors to repeat as conference champion. The Raiders were 6-0 in the Patriot League last year and 9-5 overall en route to two playoff victories and a berth in the NCAA FCS quarterfinals. Fordham, Holy Cross, Lehigh, Bucknell, Lafayette and Georgetown round out the 2016 predicted order of finish.

• **LB Charles Cairnie already has been named to the Hero Sports FCS Defensive Player of the Year Watch List.** The senior has turned in tackle career bests in each of his last two games. He posted 15 stops in the opener at Syracuse and had 13 last year at Sam Houston State in the NCAA quarterfinals. Both were game highs.

• **John Maddaluna's 147 receiving yards were a career high,** capped by a 39-yard TD catch. He added an 8-yard end around to score his first collegiate rushing touchdown.



• **Pat Afriyie had two sacks in the game and now 16 for his career.** That's tied for sixth on the all-time Raider chart (see **Colgate Records Watch** below) and over halfway to the Colgate record of 28½ set by Kelly Robinson from 1979-81. Afriyie and fellow D-line returnees **Brett Field** and **Alex Campbell** combined for 25 of Colgate's Patriot League-leading 36 sacks last season. Victor Steffen missed most of 2015 with an injury but has returned and started both of Colgate's first two games.

• **Colgate's 2015 Patriot League crown was the eighth in program history,** and the Raiders are the only Patriot League team to win multiple playoff games in the same year (also 2003 en route to the NCAA championship game). Colgate was the lone team in last year's playoff field to win twice on the road (at New Hampshire and James Madison).

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – An early Colgate touchdown was no match for the ACC.

The Raiders struck for an opening TD drive and led 7-0 before Syracuse unveiled its new-generation of offense and won the Central New York matchup, 33-7.

Jake Melville hit Owen Rockett for a 19-yard TD on the game's opening drive. But the Orange defense stiffened and limited Colgate's senior quarterback to just 82 passing yards for the game. Syracuse quarterback Eric Dungey completed 34 of his 40 attempts for 355 yards.

Colgate linebackers Charles Cairnie with 15 and Kyle Diener with nine were the game's tackle leaders. Cairnie's total was a career high. Colgate's defense held Syracuse to four field goals to keep the game in hand through three quarters.

Colgate scored on the game's opening possession. They needed help – Syracuse ran into the punter, Josh Cerra, resulting in an initial first down – but Colgate went 75 yards in 12 plays covering 6 minutes.

Melville scrambled left and found Owen Rockett for Rockett's first career TD, a 19-yarder.

Syracuse answered with 20 straight points and led 20-7 at intermission.

NEW HAVEN, Conn. – Colgate's Jake Melville took to the airways and passed for a school-record five TDs as the No. 23 Raiders whipped Yale 55-13.

Colgate scored its most points against the Bulldogs in a series dating to 1909, and Saturday's 42-point win was the largest Raider margin of victory since a 46-3 triumph at Fordham in 2006.

Melville finished 22-of-32 for 315 yards and five touchdowns against just one interception. The Raider offense had a 300-yard passer, a 100-yard rusher (James Holland 110) and a 100-yard receiver (John Maddaluna III 147) in the same game for the first time since 2012.

And defense? Colgate held Yale to 12 rushing yards, intercepted four passes and sacked Bulldog quarterbacks five times for a combined minus-36 yards.
